## ANTI-SEMITIC SOCIETY STARTS MILITARY BRANCH.

## Hires Unemployed E-Soldiers for Terrorist Work.

VIENNA, March 9, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A new terrorist branch of the anti-Semitic Hackenkreuzlers has been organized here under the name of the "Astra". Its membership is recruited from unemployed ex-soldiers who are paid for joining the organization. All of the members are provided with guns and other military equipment and each member must give oath to obey without any questions all of the orders.

Demand that the Austrian government demobilize all of these private military organizations and confiscate their equipment is contained in a note submitted by the ambassadors from the various powers. The military organizations, they declare are in violation of the peace treaty.

Threats are being made by Dr. Walter Diei, leader of the Hackenkreuzlers that if members of the Austrian Social-Democratic party cause any interference with the activities of his society, the Hackenkreuzlers will see to it that the lives of Jews in Austria will cease to be safe.

Even the police, hitherto looked upon as impartial and fairly disposed to even handed dealing seems to be turning anti-Semitic. According to reports. Dr. Reder, attorney for the Hackenkreuzler organization has been named to a police commissionership.

Condemnation of the leniency of the police towards the activities of the anti-Semites is expressed here generally through the liberal press. The "Avenä" a radical paper, which censured more outspokenly the supine attitude of the police toward the anti-Semites has been confiscated.

The Vienna "Morgen Zeitung" in a strong editorial contrasts the inactivity of the police against the anti-Semites for posting placards about town inciting the people to Jew-baiting with its action in suppressing the Abend for daring to speak against the Jew baiters.

## ZIONISTS GAINING IN AUSTRIA.

VIENNA, March 8, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Unusual success is greeting Zionism in Austria. Nearly 50,000 shekels have been sold. The Keren Hayesod fund also has gained a few thousand new members.

#### **SAYS JUGO-SLAVIA WILL SHELTER REFUGEES.**

NEW YORK, March 9, (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) The Jugo-Slav government has extended an invitation to all of the Russian Jewish refugees who have been ordered expelled from Poland to make their home temporarily in its country. They will be permitted to settle there until they obtain permission to immigrate into some other country.

Report to the above effect was brought here by the representative of the White Star Line who arrived in New York yesterday.

#### **GUZA'S CANDIDACY OUTLAWED BY ROUMANIAN GOVERNMENT.**

BUCHAREST, March 9, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Professor Guza, the insanely violent anti-Semitic leader of Roumania will not be able to make his planned race for Parliament. His application to enter the race has been rejected by the government as not being in conformity with the law.

The government, it is understood, strongly objects to allowing Guza to enter Parliament, realizing that he would accentuate the Jewish question by introducing extreme anti-Semitic measures.

#### **POLISH ZIONISTS OPPOSE DANZIG FOR CONGRESS.**

WARSAW, March 9, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Polish Zionist Organization is opposed to the convening of the next world Zionist Congress at Danzig. (No reason for their opposition is given). While Danzig has not been definitely selected for the congress as yet, rumors of its selection have persisted following the visit here by Sokolow.

#### **RUSSIAN JEWS WITHOUT MATZOTH.**

NEW YORK, March 9, (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) Many Jewish communities of the Ukraine will be without "Matzoth" for the Passover unless American Jews come to their aid. Word to this effect has been received from Mr. Boris D. Bogen, director of the Joint Distribution Committee's activities in Russia.

The various Landsmanschaft bureaus, it is announced, will accept remittances for Matzoth to their friends in Russia until March 16.

#### **DEPUTY GRUENBAUM TO APPEAL FOR REFUGEES.**

WARSAW, March 9, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Deputy Isaac Gruenbaum will deliver the principal argument on behalf of the Russian Jewish refugees in the discussion in the Sejm scheduled for April 1.

Deputy Gruenbaum was selected for the task by the "steering Committee" of the Sejm.

**CONFERENCE OF JEWISH WOMEN TO HELP IMMIGRANTS.**

NEW YORK, March 9, (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) Over 200,000 Jewish women will be represented at the American-European Conference of Jewish Women, which is to meet in Vienna on May 6th to 13th. This conference which has been called by the Council of Jewish Women will devote itself principally to devise means toward alleviating the condition of immigrant women and children on their way from one country to another. The question of providing better hotels for the women and children and employment for those detained for an indefinite period in European cities will be considered.

Arrangements for the conference are being made by Miss Estelle M. Sternberger, Executive Secretary of the Council of Jewish Women, Mrs. Alexander Kohut, Chairman of the Council's committee on European Reconstruction, and Mrs. Nathaniel E. Harris, Chairman of the Committee on Foreign Relations.

**CAPTAIN ROSENBLUTH'S LOYALTY WINS STATE \$41,512.**

ALBANY, March 9. (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) The loyalty to the state's interests of Capt. Robert Rosenbluth recently the object of charges in connection with the death of Major Alexander Cronkhite resulted today in the recovery by the State of \$41,512.00.

Following his graduation from the Yale Forestry School in 1911, Rosenbluth entered the state's forestry service. Visiting on one occasion at Dannemora, he found that the Chateaugay Ore and Iron Company was trespassing on state lands and had cut down timber belonging to the state.

Rosenbluth instituted action against the company. The ore concern fought the matter, but in view of the Court of Appeals' recent decision upholding Rosenbluth's contention, the company today capitulated and paid the money to the state treasury.

**DAVID A. BROWN LOSES IN DETROIT PRIMARY.**

DETROIT, March 9, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) David A. Brown, Detroit business man and particularly well-known for his leadership of recent Jewish relief drive was unsuccessful in his candidacy for the Mayoralty nomination of Detroit. Brown ran third among the six candidates in the race.

The two winners at the primary who will contest at the regular election are Frank E. Doremus, former Democratic Representative, and James W. Inches, former Police Commissioner.
