WARSAW JEWS AGREE TO FURNISH CORPSES FOR DISSECTION.

WARSAW, March 21, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Following a stormy discussion, the Jewish Kehillah of Warsaw has decided to turn over to the medical schools bodies of unclaimed Jewish dead for dissection purposes.

The Kehillah was told that unless it agreed to this proposal, Jewish students would not be admitted to the anatomy or other medical classes. Speakers at the Kehillah meeting declared that unless the Community furnished corpses, it would result in the extinction of Jewish physicians in the future.

ROUMANIA SUPPRESSES POGROM REPORT.

LONDON, March 21, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Roumanian authorities are evidently suppressing reports to the outside world of anti-Semitic disturbances. A telegram sent by the J.T.A. representative in Transylvania to the London office giving details of a meeting at Klausenburg of anti-Semitic teachers followed by an attack on Jews March 11 was filed at the telegraph office of the place but did not reach the news agency here, as is seen from the copy of the wire the correspondent sent this office by mail.

CHARGES AMERICAN JEWS CONSPIRE TO SEIZE POLISH TRADE.

WARSAW, March 21, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) American Jews are leagued with their Polish brethren in a conspiracy to monopolize the trade of Poland, Deputy Dmowski, a well-known anti-Semite, declared at the "Rozwoj" conference in Lodz.

American Jews, he declared, have sent eighty million dollars to the Polish Jews to help them get this economic stranglehold of Poland. Dmowski's statements were received with loud cheers.

TWO JEWS EXECUTED FOR ALLEGED MILITARY OFFENSE.

LONDON, March 21, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Two Jews, Isaac Handel and Jacob Sava, sentenced to death by a military courtmartial on the charge of having destroyed army telegraph lines were executed in Athens, according to a story printed in the London Daily Express.

In announcing their death, the Greek communique expressed regret that the executed men were of the Jewish faith adding that the "Greek government highly esteems the Jewish people".

ARABS CALL ANOTHER STRIKE TO PROTEST ARREST OF AGITATORS.

JERUSALEM, March 21, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Arab Executive has called another strike for Wednesday in protest against the arrest on the occasion of the last strike demonstration of some of the more disorderly.

The Arabs demand the discharge of the Jerusalem chief of police for permitting the arrests and also the release of the imprisoned agitators.

The former strike which resulted in police interference was called by the Arabs to celebrate their boycott of the elections.

SOVIET DENIES SPECIAL PRIVILEGES TO ANY SHIP COMPANY.

LONDON, March 21, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The official Soviet agent here has issued a statement repudiating an alleged statement by the representatives of the White Star Line that they are the only steamship company operating in southwestern Russia empowered to do business in Russia. "The White Star company", the Soviet representative said, "possesses no privileges from the Soviet government not held by any other company".

IMMIGRANT BARS ~~NEW~~ AT NEW SOUTH WALES, BUT MAY CHANGE LATER.

LONDON, March 21, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Jewish immigrants except those of British nationality can find no refuge at present in New South Wales, but the future may see a change of this policy, according to word received from the government at Sidney by the Jewish Correspondence Bureau.

"The government's policy" writes the Secretary of the Immigration Bureau, "is at present restricted to the immigration of Britishers and the government would welcome Jews of British nationality under appropriate safeguards as to their finding employment here. The question of extending immigration facilities to persons of other nations will receive consideration at a later date."

JEWS TEXTILE WORKERS NAME EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

LODZ, March 20, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) 5 socialists, 3 communists and one Poale Zionist were elected to the Executive of the Jewish Textile Workers here.

CLEVELANDER LEAVES MANY REQUESTS TO JEWISH CHARITIES.

CLEVELAND, March 21, (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) A number of Jewish institutions were made beneficiaries of the will of Charles Hisenman, for twenty years President of the Cleveland Federation of Jewish Charities, who died last week.

The will provides \$10,000 for a Jewish home for poor children. The sum of \$50,000 is left for the Federation of Jewish Charities, \$2,000 for the Jewish Publication Society of America and \$2,500 for the Hebrew Union College. The will provides that upon the death of the widow, two thirds of the remainder of the estate is to go to charity. The entire estate is estimated at \$250,000.

TO CELEBRATE CENTENARY OF DR. SABATO MORAIS.

NEW YORK, March 21, (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) The celebration of the one hundredth anniversary of the birth of Dr. Sabato Morais, founder of the Jewish Theological Seminary, will take place on April 18 at the Mikveh Israel Synagogue of Philadelphia, of which Dr. Morais was at one time a rabbi. Dr. Cyrus Adler, acting President of the Seminary will present a paper on Dr. Morais and a tablet will be erected in the synagogue and a medal struck in commemoration of the event.

The Seminary will also hold a celebration of its own. The Seminary, Dr. Adler also announced, has now sixty-seven students in its Regular Rabbinical Department and twenty-two are pursuing studies for the degree of Doctor of Hebrew Literature. The Teachers' Institute has an enrolment of 340 students in the regular. post-graduate and extension departments.

ANNOUNCE ENGAGEMENT OF FELIX M. WARBURG'S SON.

NEW YORK, March 21, (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) The engagement of Gerald Felix Warburg, son of Felix M. Warburg of the Kuhn, Loeb & Company to Miss Marion Bab of Vienna has been announced. Mr. Warburg has been studying music in Vienna since last July and met Miss Bab there.

"JOINT" DISCONTINUES ORPHAN BUREAU.

NEW YORK, March 21. (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) Owing to the exhaustion of most of the immigrant quotas and the consequent dwindling of the number of those seeking to bring orphaned relatives here, the Joint Distribution Committee has announced its closing of the Orphan Bureau.

During its existence, the Orphan Bureau brought approximately 500 orphans from various points in Europe to relatives in America.
