CHARGES JEWS SEEK HAKENKREUZLER ALLIANCE.

VIENNA, March 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) According to unconfirmed reports here, a deputation of native Austrian Jews has approached the Hakenkreuzler leader, Riehl, suggesting an alliance between the Jews, the National Socialists and the Hakenkreuzler in order to combat the "East European Jewish danger".

Although no verification of the report has been forthcoming, no denials have been made by any of native Jewish leaders.

40 ROUMANIAN POGROM LEADERS ARRESTED.

BUCHAREST, March 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Forty ringleaders of the recent anti-Jewish rioting in Bucharest have been arrested, the Minister of the Interior declared in Parliament today.

The minister's statement was in reply to a sharp interpellation on the pogroms submitted by the Socialist deputy Pistiner, who inquired what the government had done to check the anti-Jewish uprising commenced last Friday and continued unabated for three days.

VIENNA JEWISH DOCTORS MOVE TO FRUSTRATE BOYCOTT.

VIENNA, March 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Jewish medical men of Vienna have decided to give the anti-Semites a dose of their own medicine.

The medical faculty of the Vienna University having announced that only "Aryan" students will be admitted to their classes, the Jewish Physicians Association numbering more than 1,200 members, has decided on reprisals. They have announced that Aryan students will be barred from the clinics and lectures of Jewish professors.

DANISH JEWS HEAR TALK ON JUDAH P. BENJAMIN.

COPENHAGEN, March 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A large Jewish meeting was addressed here by John Finley Prince, United States Minister to Denmark. Mr. Prince spoke on the life and career of Judah P. Benjamin, Secretary of State in the Confederate Cabinet.

JERUSALEM OFFICIAL VISITING HERE ATTACKS ZIONISM.

DETROIT, March 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Charles Ashbee, the British architect who is serving as civil adviser to the city planning division of the Jerusalem municipality declared in a sensational address before the students of the University of Michigan that the Jews were seeking to drive the Arabs out of Palestine and dominate the country. The present Zionist policy contradicts Wilson's fourteen points, he stated. Ashbee charged also that the Balfour Declaration was "unjust".

Mr. Ashbee is regarded as a close friend of Governor Storrs of Jerusalem and his visit to Ann Harbor so soon after the Governor's visit at the home of Henry Ford is held by Jews here to be significant.

HADASSAH MAY BE FORCED TO CLOSE HOSPITALS.

JERUSALEM, March 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A serious financial stringency is facing the Hadassah, with the curtailment or many of the activities of the organization looming unless some way is found of covering the accumulating deficit.

The Hadassah may be forced to close all of its hospitals with the exception of the Rothschild Hospital in Jerusalem. The crisis is the result of the discontinuance by the Joint Distribution Committee of its subsidies. The Keren Hayesod, too, is not supplying enough to rehabilitate its crippled finances. The sanitation work of the hospitals is now being performed by the Palestinian government, with funds supplied by the J.D.C.

Negotiations are still pending with the J.D.C. according to Miss Seligsburg, president of the Hadassah. The "Joint" has not definitely decided the question of future subsidies to the Hadassah, Miss Seligsburg said.

A conference of the representatives of the various organizations concerned is now in progress, it is learned from Morris Rothenberg of the Zionist Administrative Committee.

ROYALTY AT RABBI'S FUNERAL.

BUCHAREST, March 13, (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) The Royal Family was represented at the funeral of Chief Rabbi Dr. Baek of Bucharest on March 1. Among those present was M. Baru, the Minister for Religious Affairs, and many representatives of public bodies.

Rabbi Baek was 77 years old. He was decorated by the King with the Cross of the Knights of Coreanus Romanei and was a Commander of the Order "Steanua Romanei".

REJUVENATION METHOD OF JEWISH PHYSICIANS GAINS.

NEW YORK, March 30, (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) The popularization of the method of "rejuvenation" or the "retardation of the senile processes" originated by the Jewish surgeon and biologist Eugen Steinach of Vienna is only a question of time both here and abroad, according to the New York Times.

This opinion is expressed in a report in the Times telling of a Steinach operation performed on Colonel E.H.R. Green, millionaire son of Hetty Green. The Times declares that the operation performed some time ago on Harold McCormick of Chicago was also one of these operations and not a glandular transplantation as had been rumored.

JEWISH STATE ONE OF TWO GREATEST WAR ACHIEVEMENTS, SAYS CECIL.

NEW YORK, March 30, (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) When the history of the war comes to be impartially written the greatest results will be the establishment of the national Jewish homeland and the creation of the League of Nations. This opinion is expressed in a statement issued by Lord Robert Cecil, the British statesman who is now in this country.

"The Jews like all other peoples must expect opposition" continues Lord Cecil. "Has not Great Britain enemies? Why worry? The Jews who have lived for 2,000 years in strange lands, must expect that someone will attack them, but they should be proud of the fact that they have good friends, who will always be with them."

"My attitude towards the Jewish question is well known. All know I am an adherent of the Balfour declaration, and I am little concerned with what the enemies of Zionism and the Jews have to say. It were better for the Jews to listen to their friends, to think more of the great historic opportunity which is theirs, rather than to listen to the Beaverbrooks and others. It is most absurd to say that Zionism is dying. Zionism is synonymous with Judaism, and the Jewish people have had sufficient experience to know that the opposition of its enemies serves only to strengthen it."

COUNCIL OF JEWISH WOMEN NAMES DELEGATES TO WORLD MEETING.

NEW YORK, March 30, (Jewish Correspondence Bureau) The Council of Jewish Women has named four delegates to the World Conference of Jewish Women's Organizations to be held in Vienna May 6th to 11th.

En route there, the delegates will visit the principal port cities of Europe and study employment and housing conditions affecting detained emigrants and refugees.

The delegates are Mrs. Alexander Kohut of New York, Mrs. Nathaniel E. Harris, Bradford, Pa. Estelle M. Sternberger, and Cecilia Razovsky, New York.
