**HAKENKREUZLERS BATTLE IN STREET; SEVERAL WOUNDED.**

**Allies Ask Government to Disarm Organization.**

VIENNA, April 5, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A street battle in which three were wounded occurred here between the Hakenkreuzlers and a group of workmen in a suburb of Vienna yesterday. More than a hundred shots were exchanged.

Representatives of the allies here have asked the government to disarm and dissolve the Hakenkreuzler organization and expel the foreign agitators. This would prove a deadly blow to the Hakenkreuzlers as many of their principal leaders are imported anti-Semites from Bavaria.

**MORTOFF-ZEDERBAUM, MENSHEVIK LEADER DIES.**

BERLIN, April 5, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Leo Martoff at one time one of the closest friends of Lenin and who later became one of the bitterest opponents of the Bolshevik regime, and leader of the Menshevik party, died yesterday in a sanitarium here.

Martoff, whose real name was Julius Zederbaum, at one time planned to organize an uprising against the Bolsheviks. When Bolshevik authorities sought to capture him, Martoff escaped, making his home in various European countries where he continued his agitation against the Bolsheviks.

Despite his absence from Russia, his influence continued to be felt there. He was a devoted adherent of the Kerensky faction. Martoff has been living in Berlin for the past several months. He was of Jewish origin and was well versed in Hebrew lore. He was 55 years of age.

**JEWS ATTACKED AT CONCERT.**

BUCHAREST, April 5, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Patrons of a Jewish concert at Galatz were attacked by a mob of anti-Semites, say reports received here.

## JEWISH RABBIS GET AID FROM STRIKE FUND.

VIENNA, April 4, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The strike of the Vienna rabbis and other religious workers is still continuing. The union of Jewish clerical workers has received a subsidy for the strike period of 400 million kronen from the Social Democratic Trade Union with which it is affiliated.

## JEWS MALTREATED DESPITE GOVERNMENT'S CONCILIATORY TONE.

VIENNA, April 4, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) While the Roumanian government was extending the olive branch of peace and good will to the Jews and the latter were induced to support the government in its fight for Parliamentary ratification of the new constitution, the scenes on the streets presented an entirely different contrast, according to a statement of a Roumanian politician who has arrived here.

On the streets at the time, Jews were mocked and insulted and many of them brutally maltreated. Parliament however took no steps against the excesses.

Following the adoption of the constitution, the Minister of Interior informed a delegation of newspapermen that hereafter the anti Semites would find stern opposition to their plans from the government. During the fight for the adoption of the constitution, he stated, the energies of the government were absorbed in that question, but now that the constitution has been approved, the government will turn the full force of its energies against the Jew baiters, in the event any further disturbances occur.

## STORRS BLAMES JUNIOR OFFICIAL FOR WALLING WALL BAN.

JERUSALEM, April 4, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Governor Storrs denied responsibility for the issue of the order prohibiting Jews in Jerusalem from access to the Walling Wall on Passover. The decree was issued by a junior official, Storrs told a delegation representing the Vaad Leumi and Jewish rabbis who visited Storrs to protest against the order.

## WANT END TO CONFLICTING REST DAYS.

HIGA, April 5, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The question of a universal weekly rest day for Russia has become a serious concern of the Jewish Communists, with some of them favoring Sunday, others Monday and still others Wednesday. The "Emes" in an article on the subject says:

"Sunday is not only a rest day, but a day of the 'Sun God'. Saturday instead of being a rest day, has become a day of Jewish religious observance. Against this sanctity of the rest days, we have started a campaign in Russia. The workers in Odessa and Kiev have decided to make Monday their rest day. The workers of Poltava have decided to rest on Wednesday. But a rest day must be a general rest day throughout Russia so that there should be no confusion in production, distribution etc. A day will be fixed, one day for the whole Soviet Russia, for all its workers and all its peoples. Instead of a day of religious nationalism, it will be the rest day of the Proletarian International."

## JEWISH SCIENTIST INVITED TO MEXICO.

VIENNA, April 5, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Dr. Salvi Goldenberg, the discoverer of a new cure for gallstones "Agolitham", has received an invitation from the office of the President of Mexico and from the Department of Salubridad Publica (State Dept. of Public Health) to come to Mexico for a lecture on his discovery.

Dr. Joldenberg states that he will go to Mexico immediately and after the conclusion of his visit there will come to the United States where he will also lecture.

## KLAN STARTS BRANCH IN UNIVERSITY.

WASHINGTON, April 5, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) That the Ku Klux Klan is seeking to penetrate American universities and that the Klan chapter at the George Washington University proposed by joint lying of its members and resort to other disreputable means to work for the expulsion of Jewish students is indicated by the publication of a bulletin sent out by the G.W.U. chapter of the Klan.

"Under the provisions of the university" says the bulletin "for informing or squeaking on students who are caught in the act of cribbing, we can operate as a group. Four or five of us informing upon a student could practically insure his expulsion. In this way, by careful management, we can get rid of many persons, including the disagreeable Jews. If this university will not keep the Jews out we will put them out. We surely don't want G.W.U. to become another Columbia. We cannot put them all out, but we can fix it so no more will come."

The Klan bulletin also outlines plans for eliminating Catholics from the university.
