SCHIFF'S HEIRS NOT TO ASSIST ENEMIES OF JEWS.

VIENNA. June 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The J.T.A. learns from a person in close touch with Felix Warburg that all reports regarding the negotiations between Premier Bethlen and the banking house of Kuhn Loeb and Company for the loan that Hungary plans to float are baseless.

The Warburg family, the Schiff family, and Kuhn, Loeb and Co., maintain the Jewish traditions of Jacob Schiff, it is stated.

If the official Hungarian telegraphic agency endeavored to convey the impression that Count Bethlen negotiated in Paris with representatives of Kuhn, Loeb and Co., this was either done in an effort to mislead, or negotiations were conducted with a Paris bank which has business associations with Kuhn, Loeb and Co.

It is possible, it is further stated, that Premier Bethlen tried to obtain the assistance of the Paris bank to mediate with the Kuhn-Loeb house to participate in the proposed loan.

INTERNEED REFUGEES AT DANZIG APPEAL TO AMERICAN JEWS.

NEW YORK. June 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A moving appeal addressed to "American Jewry" by the Committee for Self-help of the Jewish refugees from Russia and the Ukraine now interned at Danzig, arrived in the New York office of the J.T.A. today.

The appeal, signed by J. Becker, Chairman, B. Bromberg, Secretary and others in the name of the 500 to 600 refugees who, forced to leave Poland where they sought refuge, were detained in Danzig in internment camps upon their arrival there en route to America, calls upon their American brethren to "mobilize all your forces in an attempt to influence the American Government to permit us to enter the country when the new Russian quota begins".

"Think of the sword of Damocles hanging over the heads of 600 innocent Jewish wanderers", the appeal urges.

WITOS AND CABINET SUPPORT PERCENTAGE NORM.

WARSAW. June 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Premier Witos and his entire Cabinet have come forward outspokenly in favor of the percentage norm, providing for the restriction of numbers of foreign students but particularly against Jewish students.

The Minister of Instruction, Glombinski, at the last session of the Education Committee declared himself whole-heartedly in favor of the numerus clausus. Glombinski's attitude is taken to be that of the government generally.

The only question, Glombinski said at the hearing, was whether it is advisable to have the restrictions go into effect immediately or be delayed until the next semester.

The percentage norm will be introduced into the private as well as public schools, the directors of the private schools having pledged themselves to exclude Jewish pupils.

JOSEPH BALACHOWICZ, NOT BULAK MURDERED IN POLAND.

WARSAW. June 15, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Reports today to Warsaw newspapers say the man found murdered in Bialowierz Woods was Joseph Balachowicz, and not Bulak.

Joseph is the younger brother of the well-known insurrectionary general of White Russia, and had helped the latter in his struggle against the Soviet Power. Joseph Balachowicz is also known as a leader of pogrom bands, which operated in Minsk and Homel.

ANTI-SEMITIC LITERATURE PROHIBITED IN SYRIA.

LONDON. June 1, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) It has been discovered recently that an Armenian had been importing into Syria a number of anti-Semitic publications, such as La Vieille France, and that ten parcels of pamphlets dealing with the Damascus Affair had arrived in Beyrout and were lying in the Custom House, says a dispatch to the "Jewish Chronicle".

Mr. J.D. Farhi, President of the community, together with Chief Rabbi Dr. Tagger, interviewed the Governor of Great Lebanon, and requested that the authorities should not permit the delivery of this pernicious literature, and that the government should not allow the importation of anti-Semitic propaganda into Syria. The request was granted and the ten parcels of pamphlets confiscated.

Among the numerous victims of the bands of brigands who are ravaging Lebanon is a Jewish family of Bhamdoun, a village situated some two hours' train journey from Beyrout. A father, his wife and their child were murdered during the night of May 10th. The Jewish community has protested to the government against the atrocity.

ENGLAND NEEDS ZIONISTS, LLOYD GEORGE ORGAN SAYS.

LONDON, June 16, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Arab control of Palestine would mean that it would soon become a part of French Syria or fall in the hands of the Turks. This is the contention of the Lloyd George organ, the "Daily Chronicle" in an editorial today.

England cannot afford to have either the French or the Turks such near neighbors to the Suez canal, the paper asserts. The Chronicle adds that even if there were no Jews involved in the matter, the government could not give the Arabs the demands they are asking, as they are not fit to be trusted with self-government.

The case against the Jews in Palestine has been completely disproved, the paper says. "The Jews are bringing brains and money to Palestine. The civil and religious liberties of all, regardless of creed, are amply safeguarded. Sir Herbert Samuel in his conciliatory policy, it declares, has missed no opportunity to give all possible concessions to Arab sentiment." "Perhaps, says the editorial, "it would have been better if Samuel had been firmer from the beginning."

"The concessions may have conveyed a false idea of weakness. Britain," it declares, "in its treaty with King Hussein of Hedjaz has recognized the independence of Mesopotamia, Transjordan, Arabia and has offered its assistance in creating an Arab confederation.

"Generosity could go no further, yet in the midst of negotiations, Hussein announced that Palestine was included in the treaty. It was false, but it wrought much mischief."

"In view of England's generosity to Hussein, it is reasonable to ask him", concludes the Chronicle. "to use his influence with the Arabs in Palestine against following a course there heading fast to rebellion.

The government should take an early opportunity of testing the Palestine Policy in Parliament. The Arabs have been encouraged to believe that public sentiment is not behind the British government in its Palestine policy. The government must disabuse the Arabs of that idea."

BANDITS WHO KILLED GENDARMES CAPTURED.

JERUSALEM, June 16, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The government has officially announced that all but one of the twenty bandits who last week attacked the company of gendarmes escorting the High Commissioner, Sir Herbert Saamuel, and killed five of the Britishers, have been captured. They are now being held temporarily at Lebanon.

The bandits who are not Bedouins as originally supposed, but Druses, are members of a robber band which for some time has been engaged in general plunder of the neighboring communities. The capture of the bandits came only after a company of British cavalry had burned one of the villages in the vicinity of Mettulah, and following a series of severe engagements between the troops and the bandits.

TEL-AVIV BOND ISSUE ALL SOLD.**State Bank Gives Diesengoff \$150,328 Check.**

NEW YORK, June 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) H.C. Richards, President New York State Bank, handed Mayor Diesengoff of Tel-Aviv a check for \$150,328.97 in payment of the 32,000 pounds of the Tel-Aviv bond issue. This purchase by the State Bank completes the disposal of the 75,000 pound municipal bond issue.

The Bank in acquiring the bonds does not intend to make any profit on them, it is said, but is planning to resell them without premiums to individual buyers.

Mayor Diesengoff only recently arrived in America in connection with the arrangements for the sale of the issue and the rapid disposal of them has been a surprise to all.

Judge Bernard A. Rosenblatt, of the Palestine Securities Company, which floated the bonds for Tel-Aviv issued a statement expressing gratification over the complete success of the first bond issue in Jewish history.

In a statement to the J.T.A. Mr. Richard of the State Bank said "I am satisfied that the bonds not only offer a good investment with a fair profit, but that at the same time, it presents an opportunity to do something for a very worthwhile cause. We took over the bonds with the distinct understanding that the bank was not to make one cent of profit from their disposal."

ALBERT LUCAS DIES FROM ILLNESS.

NEW YORK, June 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Albert Lucas, Secretary of the Union Orthodox Jewish Congregation of America, and Secretary of the Joint Distribution Committee died Thursday at his home at Edgemere, L.I. after a protracted illness. The illness which ended in his death is attributed in great measure to his untiring efforts in relief work since the World War. Mr. Lucas was 63 years old.

Mr. Lucas was born in England August 12, 1859 and was educated at the schools of the City of London. He married Rebecca Nieto, daughter of the late Rabbi H. Nieto, who was for many years rabbi of the Spanish and Portuguese congregation of this city. She survives him.

Rev. Dr. David de Sola Pool conducted the funeral services Sunday in the chapel of the Shearith Israel Congregation at Cypress Hills Cemetery.

The Union of Orthodox Jewish Congregations adopted resolutions expressing its "deep sorrow at the death of Mr. Lucas. His passing", the resolutions declare "constitutes not only a momentous loss to the Union of Orthodox Jewish Congregations, but to the World Jewry and to the cause of traditional adherence to the Orthodox faith."

GERHARDT HAUPTMANN TAKES STAND AGAINST JEWISH ANTISEMITES

Berlin, June 18 (J. T. A.). Gerhardt Hauptmann, on the occasion of the first anniversary of the assassination of Walter Rathenau, writes in the TAGEBUCH: "Rathenau was a Jew. That was the cause of his being murdered. But fanatic German Christians were not the only ones that attacked Rathenau. Fanatic German Jews acted the same way towards him. In Munich, I spoke with Jews who expressed opinions that led to the murder of Walter Rathenau".

"It was the joint enmity of German and Jewish anti-Semities", Hauptmann says in conclusion, "that created the atmosphere that made possible the assassination of so capable and devoted a man as Walter Rathenau".

The article has made a deep impression in all progressive circles.

GERMAN SOCIALIST LEADER TELLS ZIONISTS TO GO TO PALESTINE.

Berlin, June 18 (J. T. A.). There is great excitement here over the bitter attack of former State Secretary August Miller, a Right Socialist, against Zionists who occupy government positions.

Miller visited Palestine and describing his impression of the country in the VOSSISCHE ZEITUNG, writes:

I was never a friend of the Zionists, especially of those who do not go to Palestine but remain in their adopted countries. The fact is, there are three Zionist leaders who occupy important official positions in Prussia. From the political viewpoint, much can be said against this, but it seems that political tact is not very well developed in them".

This refers first to Dr. Badt, an influential associate, of the Prussian Minister of the Interior Severing, and second, to Hans Goslar, head of the Prussian Press office. The third is non-existent.

Dr. Badt is a member of the Prussian Diet and was attacked last week by German-Nationalist members of the Diet on the same grounds. In his answer Dr. Badt pointed out that England had had many Jewish Ministers, and that the Zionist Louis Brandeis occupies a position in the highest court in the United States. Besides, Dr. Badt stated, in such a case the only judge can be the man's own conscience.

Political circles here comment on the simultaneous appearance of Miller's article and the attack of the German-Nationalists, which is not regarded as a mere coincidence.
