## SPLIT BETWEEN HUSSEIN AND PALESTINIAN ARABS.

Call Hedjaz King A Self Seeker.

JERUSALEM, June 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A split, between Hussein, King of the Hejjaz, and the recognized Spokesman of the Arab Confederation and the Palestine Arab Congress, which represents the Arab nationalist movement in Palestine, has been created as a result of the recent negotiations of the Hussein-British treaty respecting the Arab Confederation.

In a statement issued by the Arab Congress of Palestine. Hussein was charged with "having acted not to safeguard the interests of his people, but rather that of himself and his sons", the Emir Feisul of Mesopotamia and the Emir Abdullah of Transjordanian.

The breach developed following the publication by the Palestine government of the British text of the Hussein treaty, under which Palestine was excluded from the scope of the Arab confederation. The Palestine Arab Congress immediately, on the publication of this version, wired Hussein that the published draft "contradicts your message, especially regarding Palestine".

"It had been decided", the message continued "to bring complaint to Your Majesty believing it impossible that you would agree to such a project which would never be found acceptable by any Palestinians."

Hussein's reply to the message of the Arab Congress failed to deny the British version of the treaty but merely confined itself to an expression of hope that the Arabs "would continue to have good faith in me."

Upon receipt of this reply, the Palestine Arab Congress issued a statement declaring that "there is no longer room for any faith" in King Hussein. The statement also challenged "Hussein's competence" to act for the Palestinian Arabs, declaring that he sought to protect his own family rather than the interests of the people who commissioned him.

The Congress turned down the proposal that a delegation be sent to Mecca, but instead decided to send a strengthened delegation to London to represent the Palestine Arab Congress there.

**JEWISH RABBI KNIGHTED BY GREAT BRITAIN.**

LONDON, June 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A Jewish rabbi, Professor Herman Gollancz, has been knighted by the British government. This is the first time in the history of Great Britain that such an honor has been accorded a Jewish clergyman.

Rabbi Gollancz is a brother of Sir Israel Gollanch, the noted Shakespearean scholar who is now visiting America.

The British government at the same time conferred the privileges of knighthood on David Davis, the Lord Mayor of Birmingham.

**SOVIET FILES CLAIM ON RUSSIAN PROPERTY IN PALESTINE AND SYRIA.**

LONDON, July 1, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Soviet representative here, Leonard Krassin, according to the "London Post", has filed a protest with the British government against the sale by the Russian Palestine Society of the charitable institutions, hospitals, hotels and other institutions, which it declares are the property of the Soviet government.

The note, which was filed with Lord Curzon, declares that the Russian society has transferred its headquarters to Berlin and without any authority under the auspices of a group of monarchists is disposing of the property which rightly belongs to the existing Soviet government.

The Soviet note declares that while the Soviet government does not recognize the mandatory governments erected in Palestine and Syria by Britain and France it voices protest nevertheless against their countenancing the deeds of the Russian Palestine Society.

Similar notes were sent to France and Italy.

**HUSSEIN TO BREAK OFF AND TRY AGAIN, SAYS REPORT.**

Complete Independence for Palestine, Is Arab Demand.

LONDON, June 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The London "Morning Post" publishes a story to the effect that rumors are rife that King Hussein has decided to recall the present Minister to London Dr. Najie Al Hasin, and to suspend the present negotiations with Great Britain owing to the great dissatisfaction aroused in Arab circles by the treaty recently concluded between Hussein with England.

Hussein is dispatching a deputy foreign minister with new proposals, says the Post.

The Hejjaz legation at Cairo publishes a statement declaring that the Hejjaz would never tolerate "protection under any foreign power" nor "would it permit its sacred places to be under foreign influence." Moreover, Palestine, it declares, must have complete independence.

**ORT TO RAISE MILLIONS TO TEACH HANDICRAFT.**

DANZIG, July 1, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A campaign to gather a million dollar fund to be used in its work of fostering instruction in handicraft and agriculture will be launched by the Ort, it was decided at the world meeting of representatives of the organization held here.

Messrs Bramson, Silberfarb, Ticmkin, Zegeliniski, Singalovski, Lavevich and Professor Frankfurt were elected members of the new executive committee.

Dr. Zhitlovski, the American delegate, was among the speakers at the banquet of the Ort held yesterday.

**KU KLUX AND FORD ARE TWINS, SAYS REPUBLICAN LEADER.**

NEW YORK, June 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The movement to nominate Henry Ford for President is closely allied to the Ku Klux Klan agitation, Charles D. Hilles, Republican National Committeeman from New York, and one of the leading figures in the Republican National Party declared in a statement to the New York "World" of today.

Hilles warned that the time has past when the Ford Boom can be considered merely as another Ford joke.

The Hilles statement, says the World "is believed to voice the sentiment of a large part of the National Committee, and it is believed that it will be followed by active steps looking to the building up of such a sentiment that Ford's nomination by either party will be impossible."

"He boasts of his bigotry" says Hilles of Ford. "Our government demands complete separation of church from state and guarantees tolerance toward both race and creed. The Declaration of Independence includes a statement that all men are created equal under the law. The spirit of the Constitution is protective of the minority in fundamental rights.

"Thus two millions of Jews are now a part of us. They have made some of our best citizens. They have filled acceptably high public positions in the Cabinet, the Supreme Court the diplomatic service, the Senate and the House. But in spite of the American spirit of tolerance and the fact that the Jews have contributed so much to our civic life, Henry Ford, with the bigotry of the Ku Klux Klan, has declared war upon them."

**COUPONS OF TEL-AVIV BOND ISSUE REDEEMED.**

NEW YORK, July 2, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The first coupons of the bonds of the Jewish municipality of Tel Aviv will be paid on July 2nd in dollars by the Guaranty Trust Company and Harvey Fisk and Sons, commercial agents.

The issue was brought to the United States by Judge Bernard A. Rosenblatt and was disposed of with the help of Mayor Diesengoff of Tel-Aviv. The total issue was 75,000 pounds.

**MRS. FELS BUYS \$E100,000 WORTH OF LAND IN PALESTINE.**

JERUSALEM, June 29, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Mrs. Mary Fels, prominent Zionist and widow of the late Joseph Fels, the multi millionaire soap manufacturer and land tax exponent of Philadelphia has purchased some tracts of land in Palestine, costing approximately a total of \$E100,000.

Mrs. Fels plans, according to reports, to open the land to settlement for the sons of Jewish colonists of Petach Tikvah, Zichron Yaakov, and other colonists, at present inadequately supplied with land for cultivating purposes.

**BELIEVE DR. MARTIN MEYER WAS MURDERED.****Enough Poison To Kill Several Found In His Body.**

SAN FRANCISCO, June 30, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Temple Emmanuel of San Francisco was crowded to the last seat and hundreds unable to get in stood outside during the funeral services held at the temple for Dr. Martin A. Meyer, rabbi of the temple, who was found dead Thursday, sitting in an arm chair in his studio.

Those attending included representatives of virtually all creeds.

The theory that Dr. Meyer died of heart failure as first supposed has now been entirely discarded. Dr. John R. Clark, the autopsy surgeon found slight traces of cyanide poisoning. Late today, Professor F.T. Greene, the coroner's chemist, discovered in the body enough poison to have killed several men.

Cyanide kills instantly. Dr. Meyer was found with a book open in his hands. The conclusion of the authorities is therefore, that he either committed suicide or the poison was administered by some slayer. Perhaps the poison was in a cigar, they say, perhaps it was on the pages of the book and he may have put it into his mouth when he wet his fingers to turn a page.

Dr. Meyer's friends scout the suicide theory. He was the life rabbi of Temple Emmanuel. He wielded an influence that was felt not only in San Francisco, but through the entire western coast. He had enjoyed a game of golf on the day of his death and remarked that he was feeling wonderfully well.

Dr. Meyer, it is said here, took out a life insurance policy for a large sum a few years ago. Reports vary as to the amount, but it is understood to be not less than \$100,000.

The theory that some anti-Jewish influence is responsible for the rabbi's death is widely held here. "There has been more than one rabbi and more than one Catholic priest killed mysteriously in and near San Francisco recently" the newspapers quote one holding this belief as saying.
