## ALL PORTUGAL HUSHED IN TRIBUTE TO JEWISH POET LAUREATE.

LISBON, July 17, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Abilio Manuel Junqueiro, Portugal's poet laureate and the greatest figure in Portuguese literature during the last half century is dead.

The poet was of Jewish descent. During the funeral which was held Sunday, five minutes silence prevailed throughout Portugal as a tribute to the dead poet.

The body was removed Saturday from Estrella Church to Parliament House where it lay in state until Sunday, when the burial took place.

All phases of Portuguese national life were represented at the funeral.

## 25 WOUNDED IN TEL-AVIV LABOR CLASH: GENDARMERIE BLAMED.

JERUSALEM, July 16. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Twenty-five Jewish workmen were wounded and twenty are under arrest in the Jewish municipality of Tel-Aviv, Palestine, as a result of a clash between orthodox and unorganized laborers and the organized members of the "Histadruth" or Federation of Labor.

The clash arose from a dispute over the rights of the unorganized to work. Jewish leaders are blaming the gendarmerie for the casualties, declaring that their intervention intensified the difference between the two factions.

## HOOLIGANS ATTACK KEHILLAH HOUSE AT NIGHT.

KRONSTADT, July 17, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Choosing a late hour of the night, hooligans stormed the Siebenbuerger Kehillah House and the Rabbinical office.

Sixty of the Kehillah House residents were forced to flee for safety in their night clothes to the roofs.

**LEAGUE OFFICIAL SUGGESTS JEWISH REPRESENTATION.**

VIENNA July 17, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A suggestion that it would be highly desirable for Jews to have a representation as Jews in the League of Nations Union was made here by Sir Willoughby Dickinson, chairman of the Minorities Commission of the League of Nations.

Such a representation would be invaluable in safeguarding the rights of Jewry throughout the world, Sir Willoughby said.

The British government, he added, is always seeking as far as possible to uphold the rights of Jews without discriminations. The Minorities commission of the League, he said, is well acquainted with the oppressive steps against Jews in various countries and as far as it is in its power will seek to curb them.

**ASKS REVISION OF BEILIS TRIAL.**

RIGA, July 16. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Revision of the trial of Mendel Beilis, who was acquitted of the blood libel in Kiev in 1912, is demanded by M. Sarudni, an attorney, speaking at Mohilev, says a report from that place.

M. Sarudni declared he is in possession of new material proving who were the real assailants of the youth Justshinsky.

**SOVIETS ARREST 28 ZIONISTS.**

RIGA, July 16, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Twenty-eight young Jews have been taken into custody by Soviet officials at Lupovetz, Province of Kiev, charged with conducting propaganda for the Zionist movement.

The arrests were carried out in two raids, fifteen being taken during the first search.

**SKELETON NEAR SYNAGOGUE MAKES TOWN NERVOUS.**

BERLIN, July 17, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Fragments of a skeleton unearthed by workmen in digging beneath the foundation of a synagogue in Bebera has aroused great excitement in the town.

So-called experts were summoned following the discovery of the bones, and their conclusion is that the skeleton is of a man who died from violence, perhaps a century ago.

The anti-Semitic press is devoting a great amount of space to the find.

**BRITISH ENGINEER DIES OF ARAB ATTACK.**

JERUSALEM, July 17, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The wounds received by the District Engineer Wigley, a Britisher, when a party of which he was a member was attacked by Arab bandits, have proven fatal.

The others of the group, the Egyptian driver of the tramway and his assistant were killed on the spot. The party was transporting 2,000 pounds for the pay of railroad workers. The attack was made near Tul Kerem.

Taylor, another Britisher, who was wounded at the time is in a serious condition.

**CHICAGO GOLF ASS'N BARS JEWS FROM CHAMPIONSHIP CONTEST.**

CHICAGO, July 16, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Six Jewish golf clubs have protested against the act of the Western Women's Golf Association barring Jews from participation in the Association's championship contest.

In explanation the president of the Association stated that the latter comprised active clubs and only members of such clubs were entitled to participation in the contest.

The Jewish clubs however contend that they have sought many times to become enrolled as active clubs but on various pretexts their applications had been rejected.

Two years ago, the Association debated the proposition of admitting Jews to active membership. Many Jews at the time sent in their resignations from the clubs.

The club leaders are said to have admitted that difficulties have been placed in the way of Jews in the Association but they declare that "it is for the Jewish members' own good."

**2 BOOKS FROM HEBREW UNIVERSITY PRESS.**

JERUSALEM, July 16. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The promoters of the Hebrew University in collaboration with the National Library of Jerusalem have embarked on the university's first publication enterprises. Two volumes in Hebrew consisting mainly of scientific papers translated from other languages will soon be off the press.

**HIRSCH QUILTS IN PROTEST TO "IRON CLAD" LEASE.**

NEW YORK, July 17, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Nathan Hirsch, formerly Chairman of the Mayor's Committee on rent profiteering, resigned yesterday from the Real Estate Owners' Association as a protest against its "ironclad lease", which Samuel Untermyer has agreed to fight in the courts as counsel for the Federation of Tenants' Associations.
