JEWS MOURN PRESIDENT HARDING

Straus, London, Bloom, Hillquit Pay Tributes To Fallen Chief

New York, July 3 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Jews of all factions, reform and orthodox, and of all political affiliations joined in expressing deep sorrow today at the death of President Harding.

Jews, it was recalled, have special reasons to remember the President because of his approval and signature of the Lodge Resolution approving the establishment of the Jewish National Home.

President Harding's thoughtful act in sending on the occasion of last Rosh Ha-Shannah a special greeting to Jews is also still fresh in the memory of American Jewry.

Harding had many of the characteristics of McKinley Oscar St. Straus declared when informed of the President's death. "He had a kind and lovable disposition and served his country with utmost devotion.

"This is a tremendous shock", declared Meyer London, former Socialist Congressman. "It is personal shock for I knew him well. President Harding endeared himself to all who knew him, whatever the political differences have been. Politics are now forgotten in the love all factions had for him as a man".

"Regardless of all party" Morris Hillquit declared, "all men join in the national mourning for President Harding".

"He was a man of big heart" declared Congressman Sol Bloom. "I am greatly shocked".

President Harding's last utterance to the Jews was made on August 21, 1922 when he addressed New Year Greetings to the Jews of America

"The commemoration this year of Rosh ha-Shannah, the New Year day of the Jewish people, will mark the end of a year peculiarly notable in Jewish annals. It has seemed the definite assurance to the Jewish people that their long aspiration for re-establishment of Jewish nationality in the homeland of this great people is to be de-

finately realized. This is an event of notable significance not only to the Jewish people but to their friends and well-wishers everywhere, among whom the American nation has always been proud to be numbered.

ZIONIST ORGANIZATION SENDS MESSAGE TO MRS HARDING

New York, August 3 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The Zionist Organization of America, following a special meeting today of its Administrative Committee, dispatched a telegram of sympathy to Mrs. Harding. At this meeting it was also decided to enter the name of President Harding in the Golden Book of the Jewish National Fund, as a tribute to his services to the Jewish People in giving official approval to the establishment in Palestine of a Jewish National Home. The telegram, signed by Louis Robison, Acting Chairman, is as follows:-

"THE ZIONIST ORGANIZATION OF AMERICA MOURNS THE GREAT IRREPARABLE LOSS WHICH YOU AND THE NATION HAVE SUSTAINED IN THE DEATH OF YOUR NOBLE HUSBAND, OUR GREAT PRESIDENT. OUR GRIEF IS TOO PROFOUND TO GIVE ADEQUATE UTTERANCE TO OUR FEELINGS. THE JEWISH PEOPLE WILL FOREVER REMEMBER WITH GRATITUDE HIS GREAT SYMPATHY AND PROFOUND UNDERSTANDING OF OUR CAUSE TO WHICH HE WAS ALWAYS READY TO GIVE HIS AID AND ASSISTANCE"

The Zionist Organization of America also sent the following telegram to President Calvin Coolidge:

"IN THIS HOUR OF GRIEF WHICH HAS BEFALLEN OUR NATION WE ARE NOT UNMINDFUL OF THE HEAVY BURDEN WHICH HAS FALLEN ON YOUR SHOULDERS. MAY GOD GIVE YOU THE STRENGTH TO GUIDE OUR NATION IN THIS GRAVE HOUR".

UNITED SYNAGOGUE AND RABBINICAL ASSEMBLY SEND CONDOLENCES TO MRS HARDING.

New York, August 3 (J. T. A.). The following telegram was sent today to Mrs. Harding by Louis M. Epstein President of the Rabbinical Assembly and Elias L. Solomon, President of the United Synagogue.

"THE RABBINICAL ASSEMBLY OF THE JEWISH THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY AND THE UNITED SYNAGOGUE OF AMERICA DEEPLY SHOCKED BY THE IRREPARABLE LOSS TO THE NATION IN THE SUDDEN PASSING AWAY OF YOUR BELOVED AND DISTINGUISHED HUSBAND, PRESIDENT WARREN G. HARDING, EXPRESS TO YOU THEIR DEEP SINCERE SYMPATHY IN YOUR BEREAVEMENT.

"ALL THE SYNAGOGUES AFFILIATED WITH OUR ORGANIZATION WILL OFFER UP SPECIAL PRAYERS TONIGHT AND TOMORROW FOR THE REPOSE OF THAT NOBLE SOUL THAT HAS GONE TO ITS REWARD"

DMOWSKI, POLISH NATIONALIST TO BECOME FOREIGN MINISTER

Warsaw, August 3 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). It is learned that Roman Dmowski, ranking member of the Polish Delegation to the Peace Conference, will succeed Foreign Minister M. Seyda, whose resignation is expected very soon.

M. Seyda had indicated sometime ago that he wished to be relieved of his office, but Prime Minister Witos prevailed on him to continue to serve until a desirable successor would be found. It is understood M. Dmowski has accepted Premier Witos' invitation and the change will soon be announced.

The prospective appointment of M. Dmowski is looked on with apprehension by Jewish and other minority leaders because of Dmowski's outspoken and ultra-Polish nationalism.

WANTS COMMUNISTS TO UNITE WITH ANTISEMITES

Berlin, August 3 (J. T.A.) The startling proposal by the anti-Semitic Count Reventlow for an alliance between the Communists and the anti-Semitic "Voelkische" group is receiving much comment here. The alliance is urged on the ground that both parties are opposed to the Cuno regime, and are in position to create a "united front".

Oddly enough, Count Reventlow is permitted to outline his plan in the Communist organ, "Die Rote Fahne".

INJUNCTION ISSUED FOLLOWING LONDON SYNAGOGUE QUARREL

London, August 2 (J. T.A.). A synagogue quarrel reached its climax before Judge Romer when the court granted an injunction restraining Aaron Gold, Isaac Becker and other members of the Board of Management of the German synagogue, Spital Square, East End, from interfering with the synagogue activities.

Gold, Becker and a few others had announced a meeting of the synagogue for July 15. The President, Jacob Berliner, prohibited the meeting and notified the police. The Board members thereupon forced the door of the synagogue and are believed to have also removed the marriage register.

In issuing the injunction, Judge Romer severely rebuked the members for their squabbles in a house of worship.

"HABIMA" TO FINANCE ITSELF BY LOTTERY

Moscow, August 3 (J. T. A.). Permission has been granted to the Hebrew players of the "Habimah" to organize a lottery in order to raise funds for the theatrical enterprise.

Tickets for the lottery totaling 30,000 gold rubles including lottery prize tickets valued at \$8,000 gold roubles has been printed in Russian, with the name of the company in Hebrew.

ANOTHER POSEN TOWN DECLARED "JEW-FREE".

Warsaw, August 3 (J. T.A.) Another town has been added to those which are entirely free of Jews and again the anti-Semites are rejoicing. The latest town which is declared now to be completely blessed is Mrocze, in Posen.

As a result of anti-Semitic activity all Jews have fled the town. The synagogue has been turned into a farm warehouse and its costly candelabra has been turned over to the church.

U.S. MORE INTERESTED IN IMMIGRATION THAN IN LEAGUE, SAYS DAVIS

New York, August 3 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The immigration question is more important in the eyes of America than the League of Nations, Secretary of Labor Davis says in an article written for the London Evening News, according to an Associated Press dispatch today.

"The flood of humanity - this inchoate mixture of racial prejudice - threatens American civilization," the Secretary wrote and he asks how long the British government would tolerate an annual invasion of 357,000 aliens. "Let it be understood that we will not be a dumping ground for Europe's undesirables. Ellis Island", he goes on to say further, "is a reasonably comfortable though often too maligned barrier".

JEWISH PHYSICIAN DISCOVERS DIABETES CURE, REPORT

New York, August 2 (J. T.A.). Dr. Max Kahn, a member of the medical faculty of Columbia University, has discovered a cure for diabetes, it was announced at a meeting of physicians at Beth Israel Hospital yesterday. The new remedy which takes the form of artificial fat and is called intravin is highly praised by another Columbia professor, Dr. McKee, professor of chemical engineering, who has worked out a method for its manufacture. "It is a triumph of research", he declared.
