MUNICH AND LEIPSIC CENTERS OF ANTISEMITIC "INTERNATIONALE."

Movement Intensified Since Ford's European Visit Two Years Ago.

Prague, Sept. 4. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The anti-Semitic "internationale" has its headquarters in Munich and Leipsic. From these two points, the propaganda of hate is broadcast to Austria, Czecho-Slovakia and even in countries where anti-Semitism has been hitherto unknown, such as the Scandinavian lands and Italy.

This fact, the J.T.A. is able to state after an exhaustive investigation of the scurces of the anti-Jewish propaganda. The fact seems clear, too, that the agitation attained its present intensive form following the visit of Henry Ford some two years ago to Carlsbad where he met the German deputy Jung and a group of unscrupulous Czecho-Slovakian politicians.

The J. T. A.'s information is to the effect that the central office of the Jew baiters is working hand in hand with the Catholic church in Central Europe. The Jesuit order is apparently actively linked with the movement.

The Movement is also honeycombed with "monarchists." It may be said that all monarchists nurse as an aim second only to their desire to put themselves again in power - the determination to harass Jewry.

HITLER WINS IN LIBEL SUIT.

Berlin Vorwaerts To Pay 6,000,000 Marks Damages For Saying Hitler Got "Jewish and Ford Money."

Munich, Sept. 4. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Adolph Hitler, leader of the Bavarian Fascisti, was awarded yesterday 6,000,000 marks, damages in his libel suit against the editor of the Vorwaerts, the Socialist daily of Berlin.

The libel proceedings against the Socialist editor were instituted by the reactionary leader of Bavaria following the publication by the Vorwaerts of a report that the Hitler Organization was receiving financial aid from "American Jews and Henry Ford."

ESTHONIA DODGES GUARANTEE OF MONORITY RIGHTS.

Gecil Insists Government Pledge Itself In Writing.

Geneva, Sept. 4. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The failure of Esthenia to live up to its guarantees of the rightsof the minorities and its refusal to sign a declaration pledging itself in this respect was taken up by the Council of the League of Nations.

The delegate from Esthonia, pleading before the Council insisted that such a guarantee from Esthonia was inadvisable and suggested that the Council be satisfied with a verbal undertaking instead.

Lord Robert Cecil taking issue with the Esthonian delegate insisted that verbal promises would not suffice and that the pledge must be written and regularly signed.

It was impossible to compromise on this question, Lord Cecil pointed out. In order to avoid such precedents, Esthonia must sign as Latvia did, he declared.

A subcommittee consisting of delegates from Britain, France, Sweden were appointed to grant a hearing to the Esthonia delegates and endeavor to find a solution.

"OZE" AND J.W.R.C. TO WORK TOGETHER.

Werlin, Sept. 4. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The convention of the "Oze", the Jewish association dealing with the problems of hygiene of Jews, closed yesterday with a decision to cooperate with the Jewish World Relief Conference. The "Oze" undertook to relieve the J.W.R.C. of all sanitation work in the zone in which it operates.

A resolution proposing that the "Oze" broaden its scope to include educational work was defeated. A proposition to make the "Oze" a world Jewish organization instead of confining itself solely to Russia was warmly debated.

Professor Albert Einstein was elected honorary chairman of the new Executive. Professor Wasserman, the famous Jewish medical scientist of Berlin, Professor Besredko of Paris and Dr. Ratcliffe Salaman of London were elected vice-presidents.

PEOPLE'S RELIEF TO JOIN HANDS WITH ORT.

Boston, Sept. 3. (J.T.A.) The proposition that the People's Relief amalgamate with the "Ort" for reconstruction work in the war-wracked countries was adopted at the closing day of the convention here.

The report of Baruch Zuckerman on behalf of the administration psking a budget of \$200,000 plus \$75,000 for expenses was approved.

A resolution was adopted asking the Joint Distribution Committee appropriate \$100,000 for workmen credits institutions in Europe.

JEWS ORDERED TO LEAVE BESSARABIA BY OCTOBER.

KISHINEV, Sept. 4. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) General Popovicci, the military commander of Besearabia, has issued instructions that all alien refugees must leave the country by October 1.

The order makes no exceptions and includes within its scope those refugees for whom Dr. Nansen of the League of Nations' Russian Refugee Commission recently appealed. Through Dr. Nansen's intervention orders were given in the Spring to delay enforcement of the exputation order until some place was obtained where the homeless aliens might find abode.

The present order, however, requires all aliens to be out of the country by October whether they have found a place to go or not. It is estimated that some 10,000 refugees are affected by the ruling.

ARAB AGITATOR HELD FOR MURDER PLOT.

JERUSALEM, Sept. 5, (Jewish Tolegraphic Agency) The well-known anti-Zionist agitator, Andullah Smara of Tul Kerem has been taken into custody on the charge that he had concected a plot to assassinate a number of leading Englishmen in Palestine.

The arrest was made by the governor of Tul Kerem. Smara was invited by the governor to his home and there informed that the government had reasons to believe that he was involved in a murder plot. The papers connected with the plot were demanded of him, Smara in the meantime being detained.

JDC HELPS TARBUTH SCHOOLS.

WARSAW. Sept. 4, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The local offices of the Joint Distribution Committee acting upon instructions of the American headquarters have appropriated \$8.000 for the Hebrew "Tarbuth" schools here. The Joint also gave the sum of \$5,000 towards the Teachers Institute of the Tarbuth.

The money will be used for the Tarbuth institutions of both Warsaw and Wilna.

JEWISH PASSENGERS STONED ON TRAIN.

RIGA, Sept. 3. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Jewish passengers riding on the Kishineff-Czernowitz line were stoned and six of them wounded when the train made a brief stop at Red Land last Friday.

A group of anti-Semites gathered at the station bombarded the coach with rocks when the Jews were sighted on the train. One of the victims is in a serious condition.
