ABDULLAH SUPPRESSES REVOLT; KILLS 82 REBELS.

JERUSALEM. Sept. 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The uprising against the Government of Transjordan has been suppressed by Emir Abdullah's forces, after inflicting 82 casualties among the insurrectionaries, say advices from Ammon.

The leader of the revolt, it has been established, is Sultan Pasha Adwaan, Chief of the Belka tribe.

In suppressing the revolt Abdullah's forces made use of aeroplanes and machine guns.

The situation across the Jordan is described as having been restored to "normal".

JEWS SCORE HEAVILY IN CZECHO-SLOVAK ELECTIONS.

More Than 40 Jewish Deputies Elected.

PRAGUE. Sept. 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) More than 40 Jewish deputies were elected to the municipalities throughout the Czecho-Slovakian Republic, the results of the elections just made known disclose.

The "Jewish ticket" polled an unprecedented large vote, ranking eighth in the list of fourteen parties.

In Prague itself, hitherto represented by only one Jewish deputy, two were chosen, Doctors Singer and Kavka. The Jews in Prague polled a vote of 8551. Casting 3423 votes in Pressburg, the Jews obtained four seats. They elected also four in Eperjes, two in Kaschau.

In Grossevljus, the Jewish ticket received the largest vote. Eleven Jewish deputies were chosen there. Thirteen of the Jewish nominees were chosen in Muncacs, 6 in Prestan, 1 in Tepitz, and 1 in Leitmeritz.

EMIR ABDULLAH'S CAMP RAIDED BY TRIBESMEN.

Bedouin Rebels Withdraw Following Losses, Report.

THEORIES OF REVOLUTION OFFICIALLY SCOTED; LONDON AWAITS CONFORMATION.

JERUSALEM, Sept. 17, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Bedouin tribesmen belonging to the Adwan and Belk clans attacked Sunday the military camp of Emir Abdullah, ruler of Transjordan, according to reports just received here.

The attackers are reported to have retreated, after sustaining heavy losses.

The reports add that the assault on Abdullah's camp was probably carried out by a raiding party. Theories of a general uprising throughout the Palestine territory east of the Jordan River are eagerly discounted.

A section of the press here connects the movement with that of the rebel Ibn Saud, who stated recently he was mobilizing a force of 15,000 troops for the purpose of occupying Emir Abdullah's territory, which formerly was part of Palestine but which was declared autonomous in May, with Abdullah, elder son of King Hussein of the Hedjaz, as ruler.

LONDON, Sept. 17, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) No confirmation of the report circulated by Reuter that a revolution has broken out in Transjordan against Emir Abdullah, has been received by the Colonial Office, the J.T.A. was informed upon inquiring there. The Colonial Office believes that absence of such confirmation negates the report.

That something has been brewing in Transjordan for some time is ascertained from the information that the rebel Od Effendi and his consorts were arrested and deported to Jedda, following the discovery of a revolutionary plot against Abdullah.

It is learned also that General Tudor, Commander of the British Militia in Palestine, recently convoked at Jericho, near the Dead Sea, all Sheiks in the vicinity, including also those of the territory east of the Jordan and ordered them to behave. Unless they behaved peacefully in time of peace, the Palestine Government would not hesitate to apply methods of war, the General warned the Sheiks.

ZIONISTS CLOSE POPULAR SCHOOL TO PARE EXPENSES.

JERUSALEM, Sept. 17, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The need of cutting down expenses has impelled the Zionist Organization to close the Arab-Jewish school at Tiberias.

The school was held in high esteem by Arabs as well as Jews, as it made it one of its purposes to promote friendly relations between the two races.

CATHOLICS OPPOSE SPENDING MONEY FOR JEWISH CONVERTS.

BERLIN, Sept. 17, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Jews who desire to make easy their path to life by adopting Christianity will no longer be able to do so, if a movement started by a Catholic faction in Kiel is successful.

This group is opposing the collection of money by the Konsistorium for a Jewish mission. You can't de-Judaize a man by religion, as Jewishness is more than faith, they contend, and a baptized Jew remains one, "internally".

JEWISH FINANCE MINISTER AROUSES HITLER'S IRE.

MUNICH, Sept. 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A proposal that the German Reich's Bank be boycotted as a protest against Dr. Hilferding, the Jewish Socialist who is finance Minister in Stresemann's cabinet, is made in Hitler's organ of the Bavarian Fascisti, the "Volkische Beobachter".

The paper declares Hilferding's appointment, including as one of its duties of office the supervision of the Reichs Bank, is but another step towards "the enslavement of the German masses by the united Jews."

FASCISMO SPREADS TO PALESTINE.

JERUSALEM, Sept. 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A branch of the Mussolini Fascismo has been established in the Italian colony of Jerusalem, headed by Dr. Noncini.

It is expected that a branch will also be launched in Haifa in the near future.

SOVIET WELCOMES FOREIGN AID IN RUSSIA.

PARIS, Sept. 4, (J.T.A. Correspondence) Mr. Grinberg, representative of the Jewish World Relief Conference, has received a letter from M. Lander, representative of the Soviet government, for affairs relating to the Foreign Relief organizations, in which he writes:

"There should be no doubt whatever about the question that Russia is in need of assistance. I must emphasize that notwithstanding the fact that the Government is now liquidating the Committee for combatting the effects of the famine, the country has by no means yet recovered from the famine and economic depreciation. The Government is taking heroic measures to heal the wounds of the country, but the want is so great, that the means at the State's disposal can in no way suffice, and we welcome therefore the foreign organizations who are coming to our aid."

M. Lander stresses in particular the need of restoring the possibilities of agricultural work in Russia, of securing homes for the vast number of waifs and strays, and of providing medical aid for the population.

MOST POLISH PROFESSORS FOR NUMERUS CLAUSUS.

WARSAW, Sept. 1, (J.T.A. Correspondence) As already reported, M. Hadamar, the famous French Professor of the Paris Institute de France, recently wrote a letter to M. Szerpinski, the Professor of the Warsaw University denouncing the "Numerus Clausus". Szerpinski's reply to Professor Hadamar was of an insulting nature.

According to the "Rzeczpospolita", Prof. Hadamar had since written to Professor Raznewicz about the "Clausus". The latter assured the writer that he fully shared the views of Szerpinski, adding that the same opinion was held by the majority of the Polish Professors.

JDC SUMMONED FOR USING ENGLISH.

KOWNO, Sept. 3, (J.T.A. Correspondence) The Governor of Kowno and surrounding districts, a well-known anti-Semite, has brought proceedings against the "Joint", because its letter-headings are printed only in English and not in Lithuanian.

The Secretary of the Joint, M. Marcus, called upon the Minister of Interior, and explained to him that the JDC is an international relief organization and is active in many countries, but nowhere has any complaint been made that its stationery was not being printed in the language of the country. The Minister promised to look into the matter.

TOKIO SURVIVOR LIST PUBLISHED BY STATE DEPARTMENT.

Mrs. Fleisher In Washington To Learn Fate of Son.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Mrs. Simon B. Fleisher is in Washington to keep in touch with the State Department in order to learn something definite regarding the fate of her son, Benjamin Wilfred Fleisher, editor of the Tokio Japan Advertiser, and his wife.

Mr. Fleisher is the founder and first vice-president of the American-Japan Society of Tokio and president of the Pan Pacific Congress of Journalists.

The State Department has received word from the American Embassy announcing the following among the survivors:

G. Baer, W.W. Baer, George Bloomendell, P. Borosky, J.L. Koffman and family, L. Kopilova, U.G. Levitsky, Mrs. Charles and Master David Reich, L.C. Sharman.

The list of dead includes Mrs. M. Mendelsohn and child, and Jacob Stuchinsky.

MOND TO CONFER WITH MARSHALL ON PALESTINE BANK.

To Address Zionist Workers Sunday.

By Radiogram from the "Berengaria" Sept. 18. (J.T.A.) Sir Alfred Mond has accepted the invitation of Morris Rottenberg who is returning from Europe on the same steamer to address the conference of Zionist and Keren Hayesod workers to be held Sunday, September 23 at the Hotel Astor. Sir Alfred declares that his visit to the United States is purely a business one, but he agreed to address this gathering and the reception in his honor at Greystone, the home of Samuel Untermyer.

It is said that one of the purposes of Sir Alfred's visit here is to confer with Louis Marshall in connection with the "investment bank" projected by a group of American Jews during the last visit of Dr. Weizmann in America.

Jacob Landau, director of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, is returning on the Berengaria after a five months visit abroad in connection with plans for the expansion of the only Jewish news service. Mr. Landau toured virtually all capitals of central and eastern Europe, besides paying a brief visit to Russia.

MCGILL TO HOLD EXAMS. ON YOM KIPPUR DESPITE PROTESTS.

Montreal, Sept. 18. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Despite the protest of the Montreal Council of Orthodox Rabbis, the entrance examination at McGill University will be held, as originally scheduled, for the day on which Yom Kippur occurs.

When the examination was first set, the Montreal Council of Orthodox Rabbis pointed out to the Principal of McGill, Sir Arthur Currie, that the examination would fall on the most solemn day of the Jewish calendar. Sir Arthur declared he would bring their protest to the Registrar. Now it has been announced that the change requested will not be made. The examination set for Yom Kippur is in the French course.

HIAS TO PAY IN POLAND IN AMERICAN DOLLARS.

New York, Sept. 18. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Remittances to Poland through the Hias (Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society) will be made in American Dollars. John L. Bernstein, president of the Hias, received a cablegram announcing that the Polish government had conceded to the Hias offices in Poland the right of paying the remittances in American dollars. The cablegram was signed, by Adolph Held, European representative of the Hias and E. W. Lewin-Epstein, European representative of the Remittance department.

JEWISH WAR RELIEF GETS \$2,000, UNASKED, DELINQUENTS SCORED.

New York, Sept. 17. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Two contributions of \$1000 each for the Jewish Relief Fund from Joseph Kohnstamm and Edward Kohnstamm of New York City were received without solicitation, according to Henry H. Rosenfelt, national director of the American Jewish Relief Committee. Joseph Kohnstamm accompanied the remittance with the following letter in which he takes to task the war relief subscribers who have failed to pay up pledges totalling three million dollars.

"The attention of the writer has been called by Mr. Edward Kohnstamm, his brother, to an article in the NEW YORK TIMES of September 3rd and it is our desire to recognize the importance of what is intended as an appeal to the hearts of civilized human beings.

"We take great pleasure in enclosing our respective checks for \$1,000 each, which go with our prayers and our best wishes for the successful raising of the fresh fund, the necessity for which seems to be due to the dereliction of various subscribers to the tune of three millions of dollars.

"It does not seem credible that there could be so many heartless people in this country who would place their names to a pledge with so little thought of what it meant. It is conceivable that some of these contributors may have met with reverses in the meantime, but it cannot be possible that so many as would be indicated by a default amounting to three millions of dollars, could have come into so unfortunate a position. It seems too bad that some method cannot be adopted to force settlement out of those who have the ability to pay, and if there is no other way such delinquents should be ostracized by any decent Society or any decent people.

"We hope that the publication of the newspaper article may have prompted many of the apparent delinquents to do their duty."

Copies of this letter have been sent to scores of communities throughout the country to serve as an inspiration to the delinquents who have not as yet paid their pledge to the European Jewish War Sufferers.

DEMOCRATS SAY MUSCLE SHOALS WOULD PROVE FORD'S UNDOING.

Washington, Sept. 18. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). According to gossip here, many of the Democrats believe that Henry Ford's aspirations towards obtaining the Muscle Shoals concession will prove the undoing of his presidential candidacy. The argument is that if Mr. Ford gets the Federal nitrate and power plant in Alabama, he automatically will become a government contractor, or at least be immersed in such interlocking relations with the government that he would be ineligible to hold Federation office. In that event, Democratic politicians contend, this would constitutionally bar him from the Presidency. In addition to the Southern democratic support which may be counted on as certain to ratify the concession, the Farm bloc, according to Senator Capper, is expected to come out as a unit for the granting of the concession to Ford.
