ROUMANIAN "PUTCH" AND JEVISH MASSACRE PLANNED FOR YOM KIPPUR.

BUCHAREST. Sept. 26, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) In unravelling the conspiracy of monarchies anti-Samitic forces in Roumania who had contemplated a "putch" against the Government, the police discovered that to facilitate the massacre of the Jews the coup was planned for Yom Kippur.

It is also disclosed that important army men were involved in the uprising, having intended to seize the state in a manner similar to that in Spain. The government, it is said, discovered th plot one hour before it was scheduled to come off. All leaders, including eight army generals, have been imprisoned.

### OTTO KAHN ENTERTAINED BY HORTHY.

Member of Kuhn Loeb and Co. Scored For Consorting With Pogromists.

BUDAPEST, Sept. 26, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Otto Kehn, of Kuhn, Loeb and Company, New York, told newspapermen here that the purpose of his visit was to study economic conditions in Hungary and to conduct negotiations with Hungarian financiers.

Mr. Kehn arrived Monday and had an audience with Admiral Horthy the same day. Finance Minister Falley entertained Mr. Kahn at danner Monday evening, sixty political and financial leaders being present. It is understood that arrangements for the Hungarian loan were discussed at this occasion.

The "Norgenzeitung" of Vienna, commenting on Otto Kahn's friendly interests in Hungarlan finance declares bitterly that "Kahn and Horthy's pogromist regime are worthy one of the other".

HELD FOR REPUSING TO VIOLATE YOM KIPPUR.

JERUSALEM Sept. 26. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A sentence of fourteen days' arrest has been imposed on policeman Blum, of Safed. charged with baving refused to enever a summons of the court to appear in a trial on Yom Kippur.

The Jewish policeman said he thought he would be excused from duty on the Day of Atonsment and failed to answer the summons.

# FORCE JEWISH MAGISTRATE TO QUIT.

#### ANTI-SENTTIC WEEKLY DIES OF ANEMIA.

PARIS. Sept. 26. (Jewish Telegra hic agency) "La Vieille France", an anti-Semivic weekly, appearing in France for the last five years, has been discontinued, as its publishers put it "because of lack of support and interest".

LAWYER DROPS TILINGER CASE AGAINST EDITOR.

Unfrocked Rabbi Threatens To Sue Literary Digost.

NEW OPLEANS, Sept. 26. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Judeh Elfenbein-Tillinger, the unfrocked rabbi who confessed before a Rabbinical court in New York in February that he was unworthy of holding a rabbinical office, has entered suit against Dr. Mendel Silber, rabbi, and editor of the "Jewish Ledger" here, for the publication in the Ledger of an account accusing Tillinger of concorting under false precense with a Christian Minister.

Tillinger's suit against Dr. Silber is in abeyance, however, as the lawyer whom the unfrocked rabbi retained as counsel refused to handle the case any further after a conference with Dr. Silber.

It is understood that Tillinger has left for New York to enter suit against the Literary Digest for an accounting of his career published in March. Mr. Davison, a New York attorney, is said to have been retained by him as counsel for his suit against the Digest.

The owners of the Literary Digest have not been informed of any suit against them by Tillinger, who is said to have been involved as a witness against Hilsner in the famous Australian blood libel case.

HUSSEIN DEMANDS FULL INDEPENDENCE FOR PALESTINE.

Hediaz King Will Not Sign Anglo-Arab Treaty Otherwise, Envoy Says.

JERUSALEM, Aug. 25, (J.T.A. Correspondence) The "Falastin" writing on the recent declaration made by King Hussein's representative in Jerusalem says:

"Anyone reading the declaration made by the represent ative of King Hussein will believe in the King's devotion to the Arab cause, particularly as far as the Palestine question is concerned.

"This declaration will remove all doubts and will cause much better feeling in all relations with King Mussein, while doing away with the ill feeling caused by the publication of his statement by the Palestine Government.

"It is true that this declaration is not completely satisfactory as long as the British Zionist policy continues, but it gives us new energy and force to defend our rights which have been overriden and prompts us to continue our work until the British, whose policy is robbing us of our land, recognize that Palestine belongs to the Arabs and only to the Arabs."

The declaration referred to reads:-

"I have been delegated by his majesty to explain to you his intentions. The draft of the Anglo-Arab Treaty as presented to King Hussein has not mot with his complete approval. He introduced important modifications, including a stipulation for the complete and absolute independence of Palestine, in order that the inhabitants of Palestine might choose their own Government for the conduct of public affairs as they may desire. This modification leaves the Balfour Declaration ineffective.

King Hussein also demands that the Palestine High Commissioner should announce to you after the conclusion of the Treaty in the presence of the delegate from the Hedjaz, that Palestine is completely independent and unconditionally eligible to join the Arab confederation of the States in fulfillment of British pledges to King Eussein. King Hussein instructs me to assure you that if the British Government does not grant this stipulation, he will flatly refuse to sign the Treaty.

"King Hussein intends to pay a visit here when the negotiations are ended. If thy are successful, he will consult you as to what form of Government you desire. If unsuccessful, he will come to consult you as to what steps are to be taken.

I am ordered by King Hussein to say that he regards the Palestinians as his children, be they Moslems or Christians, native Jews or Zionists, who are ready to abandon the Balfour Declaration."

## WARSAW JEWS GIVE FOR JAPAN QUAKE VICTIMS.

WARSAW, Sept. 9, (J.T.A. Gorrespondence) The Warsaw Jewish community has raised a sum of 5,000,000 Marks for relief work among the Japanese children who have suffered in the earthquake. The Warsaw Rabbinate has issued an appeal to the Jewish population urging collections to be made in the synagogues during the High Festivals. The Gerer Eabbi has also issued an appeal to his Chasidim on behalf of the victims of the quake.

# FIRST X-BAY INSTITUTE IN PALESTINE.

NEW YORK, Sept. 26, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Governing Board of the Hadassah Heppitals in Palastine approved the agreement made by the Chairman on behalf of the Board, with Dr. Ratnoff, the President of the American Jewish Physicians' Committee, for the establishment of a Roentgen Institute in connection with the Rothschild Hospital in Jerusalem, under the joint auspices of the two bodies, the office of the Madassah Organization in New York announces.

The agreement provides for the purchase and installation of a complete up-to-date Reamigen equipment for diagnosis and therapy at a cost not to exceed \$10,000, which is to be contributed by the Physicians' Committee.

Washington Heights Group of Mew York Chapter of Hadassah remitted \$1,000 collected several years ago to be applied to the purchase of a part of the K-Rey equipment in the new K-Rey Institute which is to be established shortly. It is given in commemoration of Eliezer Ben Yehuda. A tablet bearing suitable inscription is to be installed in the K-Ray room.

#### NEW IMMIGRATION BILL CALLS FOR AN QUOTA.

WASKINGTON, Sept 26, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency An immigration bill which will contain new provisions and modifications of existing statutes is being worked out by Chairman Albert B. Johnson of the House Immigration Committee in cooperation with Jemes J. Davis, Secretary of Labor, for early submission to the next Congress.

The proposal will provide for admitting 2 per cent of the number of aliens here in 1880 without question, and allow up to 2 per cent more on the same basis of blood relatives of persons already here.

On the surface the new plan raises the quota admissible from 3 to 4 per cent, but it makes thecensus of 1890 instead of 1910 the basis.
