READY TO START DIGGING IN CITY OF DAVID.

JERUSALEM, Oct. 8. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) All preparations for the commencement of excavation operations in the City of David by the archaelogical expedition headed by Professor McAllister have been virtually completed.

The digging will begin within the next few days.

POLISH PAPERS QUESTION SINCERITY OF COOLIDGE'S GREETINGS TO JEWS.

WARSAW, Oct. 8. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Polish anti-Semitic press are much chagrined at the action of President Coolidge in sanding Rosh-Hashonah greetings to American Jewry.

One of those dailies declares that the message was evidently merely a sop thrown to the Jews to prevent them from squeating over much when the proposed further cuts in Jewish immigration are put through.

ZANGWILL ARRIVES WITH COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR JEWRY.

Future of World Jewry Lies in U.S . He Declares.

NEW YORK, Oct 8, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Israel Zangwill, the distinguished Jewish novelist and playwright of England arrived here on SS La France Saturday.

Zangwill was met at the pier by a group of represntatives of the American Jewish Congress, which he has come here to address. He was taken to the home of Nathan Straus.

Zangwill told newspapermen that he had a comprehensive plan for Jewry which he would present in his address at the Congress. The future of Judaism, he declared is in the hands of American Jews.

NEW LIST OF JAPAN QUAKE SURVIVORS.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 6, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The state Department has received another list of survivors of the Japanese disaster among which the following Jewish names figure: Hanna Tanner, Luella Tanner, Mabel Tanner and Mrs. R.K. Arnold.

MRS FELS BACK: PLANS MORE WORK FOR PALESTINE IN THE FUTURE.

NEW YORK, Oct. 8, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Mrs. Mary Fels, the distinguished single tax exponent, Zioniet and wife of the late Joseph Fels, millionaire manufacturer and land tax exponent returned on the SS La France Saturday after a protracted visit to Palestine.

Mrs. Fels plans to return to Palestine in the spring. She declares her intention to devote her energies in the future as in the past to the rebuilding of Palestine.

DR. KRASS TO TOUR U.S. FOR MONTICELLO SHRINE.

NEW YORK Oct. 8, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Rabbi Nathan Krass of Temple Emmanu-El has been selected as one of a group of prominent Americans who will tour the country in the interest of the movement for the establishment of Monticello, the home of Thomas Jefferson as a national memorial.

Dr. Krass is to accompany Governor E. Lee Trinkle Virginia. He will speak in Cleveland, Detroit, Chicago and possibly go as far as Cincinnati and other Middle western points.

WOULD-BE SLAYER OF HARDEN COMMITS SUICIDE IN JAIL.

BERLIN, Oct. 8, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The ex-sailor, Kruse, who was found concealed in Maximivilan Harden's villa and who was turned over to the police. **Add with attempting to assassinate Harden, committed suicide in jail.

Kruse had previously told the police that he had not sought to kill Harden but on the contrary was an admirer of the German Jewish journalist and came over to express his gratitude to him.

HYAMSON NAMED DIRECTOR PALESTINE IMMIGRATION BUREAU.

JETUSALEM, Oct. 8, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The well-known Zionist, H. Hyamson has been appointed director of the Palestine Immigration Bureau.

During the war, Hyamson was chief of the Jewish division of the Propaganda Section of the war cabinet headed by Lord Northeliffe.

MARSHALL AND DR. WISE TO ATTEND PROHIBITION GATHERING.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 6, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Louis Marshall and Rabbi Stephen S. Wise are announced as among those who will address the Citizenship Conference which will be held in Washington in support of the 18th Amendment and the Volstead Act. The conference will be held Oct. 13 to 15 inclusive. President Coolidge will receive the Conference at the White House.

LATVIA TO FIGHT ANTI-JEWISH AGITATION, MINISTER ASSERTS.

RIGA, Oct. 8, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Speaking to the Jewish Seim Club, the Minister of the Interior, Birsnek gave notice that the Government would fight the anti-Jewish agitation, which he declared was compromising Latvia.

At the same time, it was learned that the Government has ordered the arrest of the editor of the anti-Semitic organ "Latvias Sargs" because of its combined anti-government and anti-Jewish agitation.

STORRS DENIES RESIGNATION RUMOR.

JERUSALEM, Oct. 8, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Governor Storrs has no intention of resigning his Jerusalem post, the J.T.A. representative was informed by the Jerusalem head himself. The report printed in the "Haaretz" that he contemplated resigning in order to become ambassador to China is without foundation, Storrs declared.

EXPULSION - CONFISCATION. ARE HITLER'S PEACE TERMS.

BERLIN, Oct. 8. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Adolph Hitler, Fascisti and anti-Semite leader, has presented to von Kahr the conditions on which he will cooperate with the Bavarian dictator.

Relative to the Jews, Hitler demands as a sine quo non for cooperation, that all Jews who immigrated into Bavaria after 1914 be expelled and all their property be confiscated.

15 KILLED, 20 WOUNDED IN ZHITOMIR EXPLOSION.

LEMBERG, Oct. 8, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Fifteen Jews were killed and 20 injured when a quantity of ammunition exploded in the Zhitomir Jewish quarter, according to reports to the Lemberg "Gazeta Codzienna".

The Belshevike attribute the fire to counter-revolutionist

activity.

UNIFICATION OF YIDDISH SCHOOLS IN EASTERN GALICIA.

LEMBERG, Sept. 18. (J.T.A. Correspondence) For a long time the Yiddish schools, children's hemes and evening classes in Eastern Galicia have been under the management of three different committees—the Poale Zion, the Borochow organization and the Society "Our Children". About six months ago the Poale Zion and the Borochow organizations united, and now the society "Our hildren" has joined the common body so that all the schools in Eastern Galicia in which Yiddish is the language of instruction are now administered by one committee—the United Central Committee of the Yiddish School Organization in Eastern Galicia, it is called.

Up to the present there have been opened nine schools, twelve children's homes and a large number of evening classes. The language of instruction is Yiddish but Hebrew and Polish are also taught.

A conference will be held shortly all the teachers being present, as well as representatives of the Yiddish school organization in Warsew. A telegraphic message has been received by the new Central Committee in Eastern Galicia from the People's Relief Committee in New York (after the conclusion of its convention in Boston) urging active reconstruction of the Yiddish school system.

LLOYD GEORGE RAPS ANTI-SEMITISM ON APRIVAL IN U.S.

Zionista Cheer Former Premier as He Steps

NEW YORK, Oct. 5, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The anti-Semitic movement ic extremely stupid, thi former British Premier, Lloyd George told newspapermen who interviewed him shortly after his arrival.

There is a great future for the Jews in Palestine, but the upout ding of the Jewish homeland will require time, he added.

Among the throngs to great the British statesman as he stepped off the pier were many Zionists waving Zionist flags. Lloyd George smilingly greated them in return.

Sir Alfred Mond, former member of the ex-Premier's war cabinet was among the first to meet the distinguished visitor.

A delegation of the Zionist and Keren Hayesod Organiza-

tions was also present at the reception held at City Hall. It consisted of Samuel Untermyer, chairman; Morris Rottenberg, Herman Conheim, Louis Lipsky. Emanuel Reuman, Nathan Turel, H.L. Simons, A. Lebovitz, Boris Grabelsky,, Mitchel Salit, Dr. Morris Eisenberg and Dr. S. Bernstein.

A group of the Zionists headed by Isaac Carmel presented Dame Margaret Lloyd George with a bouquet of flowers.

BOLSHEVIK PROCLAMATIONS DISTRIBUTED BY ARABS IN JERUSALEM.
