PROHIBIT ASSEMBLING TO PREVENT MOB ACTION AGAINST JEWS IN
UPPER SILESIA

Excesses Continuous Since Plebiscite

Berlin, Oct. 19. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Anti-Jewish excesses in Beuthen and neighboring towns of Upper Silesia have become so frequent and reached such a point that Police President Beck has issued an order prohibiting assemblages of more than five persons, in any of these towns in order to ward off the danger of pogroms.

The excesses first made their appearance following the plebiscite in Upper Silesia when so-called self-defense organizations were established whose real work has been the spread of anti-Semitism disguised as nationalism.

Jewish shops have been plundered in Hindenburg, Beuthen, Gleiwitz and neighboring towns. Last May a grenade was thrown in the midst of memorial exercises held for Jewish soldiers and during the entire summer groups of ten and twenty youths systematically attacked individual Jews on the streets with rubber cudgels. Many Jewish victims of these hooligans were taken to the hospital, suffering from concussion of the brain. Placards were posted about the town advising Jews to go to Palestine. Jewish factories were entered by the mobs and plundered. The factories have been the scene of pogroms twice in the recent past, once on September 22nd and the second time on October 5th. But the pogroming in a somewhat milder way goes on regularly. As a result the Jewish population has given notice that it will not participate in the general social life until Jewish life is made secure.

The Jewish representatives in accordance with this decision withdrew their representation from the German distress committee of Beuthen which occupies itself with the work of relieving the condition of the unemployed. The absence of the Jews from this committee has been seriously felt and the chairman, Doctor Casperkowitz has issued a proclamation condemning the anti-Jewish excesses, pointing out that it is depriving the city of the section.

ARREST MORE JEWISH LABOR LEADERS FOR WARSAW BLAST.**Military Funeral for Jewish Soldier Victim.**

WARSAW, Oct. 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Some of the principal labor leaders have been arrested by the police as suspects in connection with the Warsaw explosion. Among them are Marcus Lev, chairman General Workers Cooperative; Suravicz, secretary, Jewish Commercial Travelers, and Vontral, Executive member of the Travelers.

Other Jewish unions are being investigated in the police roundup.

Meanwhile a Jewish soldier who was killed in the explosion has been buried with military honors, the Jewish Sejm Deputies, Jewish Senators, representatives of the Rabbinate and Kehillah participating. A military band followed the hearse.

BAVARIANS DISSATISFIED WITH FORD.

MUNICH, Oct. 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Bavarian nationalists are very indignant at the announcement that Henry Ford plans to give back \$7,000,000 war profits to the Government. The Munich "Voelkischer Beobachter" says Ford should have used the money to fight "the Hebrew hoarders of Wall Street, who are more responsible than anyone else for Germany's economic misery".

MORE THAN 3,000 HEAR ZANGWILL AT TEMPLE EMMANU-EL.**America Needs National Theatre, He Tells Audience.**

NEW YORK, Oct. 19, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) More than 3,000 persons crowded into Temple Emmanu-El last night to hear Israel Zangwill who lectured on the drama under the auspices of the New York Section of the Council of Jewish Women. Mrs. Irving Lehman presided.

The drama, Zangwill said, was one of the most difficult of the arts from the author's viewpoint. He had tried every branch of literature with the exception of epic poetry, he declared, and he had found the drama by far the "toughest".

The fault with the drama today, if it might be termed a fault, he said, was the tendency of managers to hitch their plays to theatrical stars.

"The great need of America today is a national theatre. Not a Shakespeare Memorial Theatre which I understand is projected, but an inspirational theatre, where art may receive its fullest expression."

So far as the American stage is concerned, Zangwill said, he discerned a great improvement since his last visit here. The screen especially had a great opportunity, although as yet it had not attained its fullest development. It has many advantages over the speaking stage, especially in its ability to reproduce elaborate and identical scenic settings, he declared.

"WHEN POLES ARE BEING KILLED JEWS MUST NOT AMUSE THEMSELVES".

List Shows a Number of Jews Also Killed.

WARSAW Oct. 19. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Shouting "When Poles are being killed Jews must not enjoy themselves" mobs entered the Jewish cafes of Warsaw beating up the patrons.

The full list of the victims of the blast show that a number of Jews as well as Poles suffered death. The list includes a Jewish merchant, Moses Kupferstein and seven Jewish soldiers.

ASSASSINATION PLOT MAY CAUSE FALL OF ROUMANIAN CABINET.

Killing of Jewish Editor Leads to Two Resignation from Cabinet.

BUCHAREST. Oct. 19. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The fall of the Roumanian Cabinet looks as a probability as a result of the unearthing of the Fascisti plot to assassinate a number of the members of the ministry and other leading Roumanians.

General Viatiano, Minister of the Interior, who has been generally charged with being too lenient to the Fascisti has submitted his resignation. Constantinescu, Minister of Agriculture, has announced that he also stands with Viatianu and his resignation is expected.

Other resignations are expected to follow it and it is believed likely that an entire new cabinet slate will be designated. Premier Brătianu has conferred with the King regarding the incident.

The plot was disclosed as a result of the assassination of M. Rosenthal, editor of the "Adverul" who was first on the death list prepared by the Fascisti.

MAY REPORT RUSSIAN KLANSMAN.

NEW YORK, Oct. 18. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Vladimir Magoasudi said to be the President of a Russian organization similar to the Ku Klux Klan, who arrived here on the National Greek liner Constantine at the beginning of the month, is being detained at Ellis Island because of the complaints made against him that he had organized programs in Russia and was sentenced to imprisonment in 1905. He will probably be deported.

COMMUNISTS PLACE RABBIS ON BLACK LIST.

RIGA, Sept. 29, (J.T.A. Correspondence) The Moscow "Emess" reports that it is making arrangements for the publication of a black list in which will be written down all anti-labour acts committed by rabbis and other persons connected with Jewish religious institutions, affecting both the Jewish and the general labor movement.

N. Y. AMERICAN TAKES ISSUE WITH ZANGWILL.

NEW YORK, Oct. 29, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Objection to Mr. Zangwill's advocacy of "A Jewish vote to protect Jews and to express their ethical conceptions" is expressed in an editorial in the New York American is titled: "American Jews are Americans".

"Speaking specifically of America" says the editorial "Mr. Zangwill suggests that the Jews here are so super-patriotic that if it were possible, they would be 200 per cent Americans. Certainly by all the tests of patriotism, even to the point of making the supreme sacrifice, the Jews of America have proven themselves a most worthy and desirable element of our population.

But the British publicist surely misreads both America and the three million Jews now so thoroughly a part of the nation, when he advises the organization of a "Jewish vote to protect themselves and to express their ethical conceptions." The simple answer to this advice that they do not need to protect themselves and they have no distinctive ethical conceptions. Besides Jews are so individualistic that it is impossible to organize or corral any such undesirable aggregation as a Jewish vote. To be a bit Hibernian, if such a thing as a Jewish vote were possible, the Jews themselves would oppose it."

HUSSEIN ASPIRES TO BECOME MOSLEM CALIPH, SAYS REPORT.

LONDON, Oct. 19, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) There are indications that King Hussein of the Hedjaz supported by his sons, is once more beginning to feel his way toward the re-establishment of an Arab Caliphate in Mecca. Hints of such an intention on the part of Hussein are beginning to appear in various organs inspired by the Hedjaz ruler.

The time has come, says one of these writers for the whole question of the Caliphate to be revised by a representative Moslem conference. There could be, it is suggested, no place so fitting for such a conference as Mecca and no candidate for the Caliphate so eligible as King Hussein.

As long ago as the beginning of this year Hussein was expressly described as "Commander of the Faithful" in an inscription on a cathedral mosque built at Amman.

The reestablishment of the Arab Caliphate would mean not only the renewal of the tradition forcibly broken in the sixteenth century, but would stir the Arab imagination and mark an important stage in the Arab national movement.
