"PAN-ARAB" CONGRESS URGES COMPLETE FREEDOM.

JETUSALEM, Oct. 22, (Jewish Telegraphic agency) Complete freedom for all "Arab countries" and the early establishment of an Arab Federation to include all Arab states, are two of the important resolutions adopted at the "Pan Arab Congress" just concluded at Macca, say reports from the Moslems' Holy City.

The meeting decided also to urge the boycott of "British, French and Jewish goods".

Representatives of all Arab rulers, including King Hussein of the Hedjaz, Emir Abdullah of Transjordana, and King Feisul of Messopotamia will meet in conference shortly to take action on the resolutions, it is announced.

CALLS "GOD OF VENGEANCE" A FOUL SPECTACLE.

LONDON, Oct. 22, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Sholom Ash's play, "The God of Vengeance" is the subject of a bitter attack in the Sunday "Express" which vehemently upbraids the licensing authorities for permitting the company of Jewish players from Vilna, Poland, to produce this piece in London.

The "Express" recalls that the play, to which it refers as a "foul spectacle", had been suppressed in New York and demands an explanation of the authorities for countenancing its appearance here.

The authorities have retorted with the excuse that no one in the department is able to read Yiddish.

CHRISTIAN SOCIALISTS HAVE EASY VICTORY IN AUSTRIAN POLL.

VIENNA, Oct 22, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Christian Socialist Party had an easy victory at the Parliamentary election yesterday throughout Austria.

Of the numerous Jewish candidates nominated by a bloc formed of all Jewish organizations not one was elected. The Greater German Party, too, went down to defeat.

NO JEWISH VOTE, CHRISTIAN SCIENCE MONITOR DEMANDS.

BOSION, Oct. 22, (Jewish Telegra nic agency) Israel Zangwill urged the Jews of America to unite for political action, saying that there should be a Jewish vote, and adding: "If there is no Jewish vote today, it is a disgrace", the Christian Science Monitor states editorially.

"If this advice of one of their racial leaders is generally followed by the 3,000,000 Jews in the United States, it would seem almost certain that there will develop another of those race conflicts that have done so much to prevent the establishment of peace in certain European countries.

"Coming at a time when America is being appealed to for co-operation in solving the problems of the war-swept countries of Europe, this counsel to transport across the Atlantic racial divisions that have existed for centuries will doubtless meet with a nation-wide protest.

"If there is to be a Jewish party in the United States, its advocates will incur a grave responsibility for raising an issue incompatible with the spirit of American institutions.

"Mr. Zangwill has specified no grounds for a Jewish vote. Why should there be a Jewish vote, any more than a Welsh, Scottish, or Danish vote? There are no national or state laws that discriminate against the Jews. They fill public positions on an equality with all other races. If there is to be an organized Jewish vote, as Mr. Zangwill advises, is it to be used to obtain special privileges for a race constituting about 3 per cent of the American people?

That there is a prejudice against cortain types of Jewish immigrants from Central and Eastern Europe may be admitted without conceding that this can be lessened or abolished by political action. American political life has been troubled in the past by efforts of this or other party to secure votes by professing to be the special friend of some race or nationality. It was noped that the attempts to divide Americans along the lines of racial groups were daminishing. Is there any good reason for reviving them on behalf of the Jewish people?, the Monitor concludes.

EX-JUDGES HONOR JUSTICE LEVY.

NEW YORK, Oct. 22, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Three former Judges of the Court of Appeals, Aaron E. Parker, Samuel Seabury and Abraham I. Elkus, were speakers yesterday at an informal reception tendered to Justice Aaron J. Levy, candidate ror Justice of the Supreme Court, at the Hotel Commodore. Frank L. Polk, chairman of his campaign committee, presided.

SAYS ZANGWILL'S SPEECH INCREASED ZIONIST DIFFICULTIES.

BOSTON, Oct 20, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Judging by the reports of Mr. Zangwill's speech he discloses ambitions which render a compromise between political Zionists and Arabs impossible, cables the London correspondent of The Christian Science Monitor.

"Not Palestine alone is coveted but southern Syria and Transjordania also. Naturally to the Arabs who individually fear the future expropriation of their lands, political rights and nationality and who envisage the evolution of a great united Arab state. including Palestine, oppose this project tooth and nail.

"Such declarations made at this juncture cannot fail to increase the difficulties of the British administration and render Arab opposition to anything savoring of Zionism absolutely uncompromising.

"The conflict is essentially between Jew and Arab, and in attempting to hold the balance between these rival aspirants on the one hand, and the Balfour Declaration and the docrine of self-determination on the other the unfortunate mandatory power is having an uncomfortable time.

"Without entering into discussion of the merits of political Zionism it is permissible to say that its exponents are very largely responsible for the impasse which has arisen. They at least confronted the native Arabs with the prospect of complete subjection to Jewish authority. Their scarcely concealed object was the establishment of a sovereign Jewish state. They tried to drive an impossible bargain.

"One leading Zionist whom the writer asked to explain the position of Italian Jews in a hypothetical case of war between Italy and Zionist Palestine declined to state whether they would be expected to act traitorously toward their Italian nationality or fight their Palestinian brethren, but obviously the Jews cannot have it both ways.

"If the latest proposal for an Arab Agency is finally declined by a joint council of all Arab parties this week there will be no alternative but to go on administering the country by crown colony methods, holding the balance fairly between all sections of the community. Under the circumstances this perhaps would be the best thing that could happen for Palestine", the Monitor contends.

THE PALESTINE HIGH COMMISSIONER RESIGNED?

JEFUSALEM, Sept. 29, (J.T.A. Correspondence) "We learn from trustworthy sources", the Arab paper Falastin writes, "that Sir Herbert Samuel, the High Commissioner for Palestine, during his last visit to London, tendered his resignation to the Government.

The British Government, however refused to accept it.

P.D.C. ASKS \$700.000 TO HELP PALESTINE.

Judge Mack Optimistic about the Country.

NEW YORK, Oct. 22, (Jawish Telegraphic Agency) The Palestine Bavelopment Council at a meeting yesterday at the Hotel Pennsylvania adopted a resolution providing for the immediate raising of \$700,000 to be paid for stock in the Palestine Cooperative Company and applied to credit development in Palestine.

During the discussion of the resolution Rabbi Louis Witt of St. Louis appealed for a larger concentration, so that the drive would net many times more than the amount specified.

Federal Judge Julian W. Mack, president of the Council, who recently returned from Palestine, received an enthusiastic reception from more than 500 men and women at the meeting.

Besides Judge Mack's address, in which he spoke optimistically of Palestine's future and described towns and cities through which he travelled, there was a report of the work of the Building Loan and Saving Ass'n of the Council, by Harry Fischel, its Chairman, and a statement of the progress of the aconomic development of the country, as carried out by Emanuel M. Mohi, representative in Palestine of the development organization.

What was accepted by the audience as a reference to Israel Zengwill, whose remarks on Palectine last week created a furore, is included in the following remarks:

"Just as you cannot build up Palestine by resolutions so you cannot towart that development or even hinder it seriously by paradox or epigram. You can hurt the effort by ill considered phrase or untimely protest, by speaches that, especially in translation with incidental mistranolation, put a new and dangerous and in essence a false interpretation upon our views and our wishes. But there is a curiosity for the future which is far too strong and far too powerful and, I think, far too permanent to be shaken by eloquence or epigram or even by pertinent justifiable critism".

Judge Mack emphasized the necessity of American Jews understanding the true conditions of Palestine and its actual beauties of climate and potentialities for prosperity.

Representatives from other cities reported to the council on the progress of organization and money raised, among them Leon Miller of Buffalo, Morris Avner of Pittsburgh, Israel Brodie of Baltimore, Nathan Kaplan of Chicago, Sam Waldstein of Boston and Charles Levi of Milwaukee, recently representative of the Council at the Central Conference of American Rabbis.

ITALIANS AND JEWS SUFFER LEAST FROM WHITE PLAGUE.

NEW YORK. Oct. 22, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Statisticians of the N.Y. Tuberculosis Association declare that Russian Jews and Italians resist tuberculosis more successfully than the rest of the population.

The total Jewish population including children of immigrants, is estimated at 1,600,000. The Italians on a similar Dasis number 807,048. These two races are said to have a birth rate much higher than the "older stock".
