#### EXPELLED JEWS MUST LEAVE PROPERTY IN BAVARIA

Munich, November 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). As a means of adding privation to indignity, an order has been issued by Dictator von Kahr to the Jews expelled from Bavaria, that their property must not be removed from the country.

Jewish business men and manufacturers have received orders from the police authorities that the machinery and equipment of their factories as well as their products must remain in Bavaria, and their factories must be conducted in their absence by managers appointed for the purpose. An attempt to take any of their property along will result in the sequestration and sale of the establishments for the benefit of the Bavarian State Treasury, the owners are warned.

Protests against the expulsion and demands for the publication of the secret order exiling the Jews from Bavaria, may, it is hoped in some quarters, lead to a mitigation of the expulsion decree. The fact that the illegality of the expulsion of the alleged aliens is being questioned may give those that have not yet been exiled a chance of appeal against the order

## JEWISH QUESTION BEFORE HULLAN RIGHTS LEAGUE

Paris, November 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Various phases of the Jewish question have been placed upon the agenda of the international conference of the Leagues for Human Rights, beginning here November 3. The Committee of Jewish Delegations, with offices in Paris, is responsible for bringing the Jewish question to the attention of the League.

### TMPHUS RAGES AMONG LODZ JEWS

Lodz, November 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). A typhus epidemic is raging in the Jewish quarter of Lodz. The town council met in special conference yesterday to take action against the spread of the Epidemic in other centers of the city.

Reports from Kutno, Pintek and Jostynin are that the epidemic is making headqay there.

ZIONISTS RESENT ARABS ON E UAL FOOTING WITH JEWS

London, November 1 (Jewish Telegraphic agency). The actions Committee of the Zionist Organization at its concluding session Wednesday right, unanimously adopted a resolution deploring the attempt made by the British Government to place the arabs inPalestine on an equal footing with the Jews through the establishment and recognition of an Arab Agency.

This, the principal question before the meeting, occupied the members throughout all of the committee's sessions stretching over four days.

The resolution declares that Zionists appreciate the efforts of the British Government to introduce harmony between the Jews and Arabs of Palestine. The Zionists voiced the conviction, however, that harmony can be best attained by the complete realization of the Balfour Declaration. Although the rejection by the arabs of the Agency proposal "deprives the offer of its value", the XXXXXXXXX Zionists find the attempt to place the Arab Agency on an equal basis with the Jewish body is not in accordance with the terms of the Palestine Liandate. The Actions Committee reiterates, however, the Zionists' desire for friendly cooperation with the Arabs.

Dr. Weizmann, in closing the session, expressed his complete satisfaction with the "Earnest and deliverate nature" of the protracted debate.

With regard to the extension of the Jewish agency, the scheme proposed on behalf of the Executive by Dr. Feiwel, providing for the coopting of representatives of the Zionists, Keren Hayesod and of other representatives of important Jewish organizations, was adopted.

### TO EXCLUDEJEWS FROM REICH GOVERNMENT

Berlin, Nov. 1 (Jewish Telegraphic agency). The exclusion of Jews from the Government of the Reich, is commanded in a resolution adopted by the German National Federation, petitioning the party leaders in the Reichstag to take measure looking to the prevention of the cooperation of Jews in the Government.

### NOTED JEWISH SURGEON DIES IN BERLIN

Berlin, November 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Professor Ferdinand Karewski, famous surgeon and director of the Jewish Hospital, is dead here of heart disease.

### MRS SCHWEITZER TO BUILD TBBERIAS HOSPITAL

Jerusalem, November 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Mrs. Rebeccs Schweitzer, widow of the noted leader of American Zionism, is expected in Palestine shortly in connection with the projected hospital at Tiberias, which was planned during Mr. Schweitzer's lifetime.

A total of about 350,000 was contributed for the building by the late Zionist and philanthropist, and it is understood to be Mrs. Schweitzer's wish to proceed without delay with the erection of the hospital building at Tiberias, which is lacking in adequate hospital facilities.

The hospital will be conducted by the Hadassah Medical Organization in Palestine.

# DR CORALNIK ELECTED PRESIDENT OF UKRAINIAN FEDERATION

New York, November 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Dr. A. Coralnik associate editor of the DAY, New York Yiddish daily, has been elected resident of the Federation of Ukrainian Jews, succeeding Dr. Benjamin Dubowsky, who resigned because of pressure of professional work.

The Administrative committee of the Federati n is projecting a wide scale relief program in the interest of the Jews in the Ukraine. It proposes to interest in this work the "landsmanschaft-en" of Russian, White Russian and Ukrainian Jews in America.

## BAPTIST SAYS JEWISH PRAYERS ARE SELFISH

New York, Nov. 1 ( F. T.A.). The Rev. Frederick E. Taylor, pastor of the First Baptist Church of Indianapolis, and a former president of the Northern Baptist Convention, criticized the Jews Yesterday for "praying only for the interest of their race". He spoke at the Baptist Bible Missionary conference at the Fifth Avenue Presbyterian Church. He said:

"God wanted the Jewish race to enrich the world, but instead it shut itself in. The Zionist movement will succeed only if it has for its purpose the fulfillment of the original mission of the Jewish people, and I have a suspicion that they are going to fail. They have failed in the past to fulfill their mission. The failure

has been tremendous.

LAWYERS TO AID HEBREW UNIVERSITY

New York, Nov. 1 (J. T.A.). A Lawyers committee to maintain a kxxxxxxx Department of Jurisprudence at the proposed Hebrew University in Jerusalem was announced yesterday. Offices have been established at 5 Columbus Circle, with hax Levy as Secretary, and John L. Bernstein as Treasurer.

PROTEST AGAINST RECEPTION TO GENERAL HALLER IN BOSTON

The Jewish Leader Sens Open Letter to Mayor Curley Exposing Record of General In Command of Poles Recruited In America.

Boston, November 1 (J. T.A.) In an open letter addressed to Mayor Curley, THE JEWISH LEADER a local newspaper charges that General Josef Haller, Polish Commander-in-Chief, who is soon to visit this city, is a notorious anti-Semite, heving been proved guilty of numerous atrocities against the Jews of Poland, and as such is not fit to be received as an official guest of the city of Boston.

The letter quotes official Polish documents to prove that General Haller was guilty of perpetrating excesses upon Jews, and says that any official recognition accorded to the General would be an affront to the Jews of this city as well as all other decent and fair-minded citizens.

Addressed to the Mayor, the letter reads as follows:

"It has been reported that General Josef Haller, the Polish military commander-in-Chief, who has been invited to this country by the American Legion, is to be the guest of this city. We wish to express our deep sense of regret that the City should sponsor the visit of this notorious General and we earnestly request that you deny to General Haller any official reception or honors that may in any way be construed as a manifestation of esteem toward him on the part of the City of Boston.

"Such honors should be reserved for men and women of distinction, for such as have earned universal fame and the admiration of their fellow men. General Haller cannot by any stretch of imagination be included in this category. Nothing that he has done entitles him to distinction and recognition, but on the other hand, what he has done, entitles him to a niche in the Hall of Hamans.

"General Haller is condemned in the eyes of the civilized world as the man who is guilty of those bloody outrages against the Jew-ish population in Poland, which occasioned the world-wide protest in 1919. His soldiers, the notorious "Hallerites", who, strange to say, were legionnaires brought from America, committed the most datandly crimes against innocent and defenseless men and women, whose sons were dying on the battlefields for the sake of Poland's liberty. General Haller was branded as a driminal by his own government

"Captain Peter Wright, a member of the British Mission to Poland, in his report to the British Government, in 1920, made the following statement regarding anti-Jewish excesses in Poland:

"The worst offenders are soldiers, and the worst soldiers in this respect are those of General Haller's army, which was largely recruited in America".
