BERLIN'S JEWISH QUARTER LIKE A BELEAGUERED CITY

Workmen Denounce Pogroms

Berlin, November 8 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The sections of the city inhabited by Jews, which were the scenes Monday and Tuesday of intermittent riots and plunder today present a most depressing spectacle.

With a cordon of police drawn around the Jewish quarter, the streets have assumed the appearance of a beleaguered city. Crouching behind windows that had been smashed in the course of the rioting, with temporary bars in place of the broken-in doors, many of the residents are barricaded indoors. Others have fled to other and presumably safer sections of the city.

In Friedrichstrasse, the shopping center of Berlin, a large number of shops owned by Jews were plundered by a mob led by anti-Semitic agitators.

The United Trade Council of Berlin has issued the following appeal: "The German Voelkische agitators have incited the working masses to pogroms, spreading terror and horror in the Jewish quarters of Berlin. These Voelkische demagogues have deliberately engineered these disorders in order to justify a reactionary dictatorship. The plunder of Jews serves no purpose. If Cohen doesn't speculate today, Stinnes and Thyssen will do so tomorrow. Only when capitalism falls will the Jewish as well as the Christian speculators be crushed".

CARDINAL PLEDGES CATHOLIC INFLUENCE AGAINST POGROMS

Munich, November 8 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Cardinal Faulhaber has addressed a communication to Premier Stressman deploring the attacks on the Jews in Germany and pledging the "moral influence of the Catholic Church" against the perpetrators of these disorders. "The purblind hatred against our Israelite brethren" is denounced by the Cardinal as subversive to the Netherlands' best interest.

POGROMISTS SENTENCE ALTENHAUSEN JEWS TO HANGING

Laterer "Commute Sentence", But Mercilessly Beat and Rob Them.

Munich, November 8 (J. T. A.). Two Jewish families in the village of Altenhausen near Coburg were sentenced to be hung by a "military court" improvised by a band of thirty armed Hitler soldiers. Coburg is the mobilization center of Hitler and Erhardt. The Jews finally had their sentences "commuted" by their assailants the affair ending in the merciless beating of the victims, after being separated from all their possessions, including money and valuables, in addition to having their homes completely demolished.

WEIZMANN HINTS AT REPLY TO ZANGWILL

London, November 8 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Dr. Chaim Weizmann, President of the World Zionist Organization, due to sail for New York November 24, hinted in an interview with the JTA that he would reply in America to criticisms of Israel Zangwill with regard to the Zionist Movement.

Although the Zionist leader did not single out Mr. Zangwill by name, he said he would reply to recent criticism and deal with the present situation.

His primary object in making this trip to America was the enlargement of the Jewish Agency, Dr. Weizmann said. He added that he would confer for that purpose with leaders of American Jewry and with the heads of the various organizations. He will also attend the Keren Hayesod conference which has been called for December where he will outline the plan for the formation of the Agency.

Dr. Arthur Rupin/who is accompanying Dr. Weizmann, will endeavor during his visit to America, to stimulate private investment in Palestine.

REFUGEE PROBLEM AT ROUMANIAN - SOVIET PARLEY

Bucharest, November 8 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The Roumanian Cabinet decided last night to commence negotiations for a commercial treaty with Soviet Russia. It is understood that attention will be paid to the question of the several thousand refugees from Russia in Bessarabia and other parts of Roumania. Most of these refugees are Jews.

SOVIET CELEBRATION IN JERUSALEM STOPPED

Jerusalem, November 8 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Proclamations hailing the Bolshevik revolution on the sixth birthday of the Soviet regime were confiscated by police as soon as they appeared. A number of communists have been arrested.

ATTOMAN TIUTIUNIUK TURNS "STATE'S EVIDENCE" AGAINST POGROMISTS

Paris, November 8 (J. T.A.). Attoman Tiutiuniuk, pogromist and counter-revolutionary leader has turned "state's evidence" against the anti-Bolshevik, according to a letter of his published in a number of papers here. The bandit leader says he realizes that the Russian peasants are now loyal to the Soviet Government. Ever Doroshenko, President of the Ukrainian Rada, he says, has arrived at the same conclusion.

It has now become clear that Tiutiuniuk has supplied the Soviet authorities with documents proving the participation of the states bordering on Russia in the formation of Ukrainian bands calculated to harass if not overthrow the Bolshevik regime.

It was on the information supplied by Tiutiuniuk that the Soviet authorities were enabled to rout the many bands operating in Kiev, Podol and other provinces. Many bandits were arrested and documents showing their falsifications seized.

TRY TO BLAME POLISH STRIKES ON JEWS

Warsaw, November 8 (J. T.A.). Attempts made by the Polish Fascisti and other anti-Semites to fix in the minds of the public the idea that the Jews are to blame for the blood-shed in Cracow and for the disturbances in connection with the strike in Warsaw, are being put down by the authorities.

The city is perfectly quiet and authorities apparently are anxious not to have the peace disturbed. Circulars declaring the strike situation has been provoked by the "Elders of Zion" and an anonymous Fascisti appeal against the Jews, have been suppressed.

JEWS TESTIFY AGAINST BOLSHEVISM

Lausanne, Nov. 8 (J. T.A.). Simultaneously, with the opening of the trial of Maurice Konradi, assassin of M. Vorowski, Soviet representative during the Lausanne Conference, political trials of Bolshevism are being staged here by the Bolsheviks and the antis.

Witnesses have been called by both sides. The antis having requested Dr. Pasmanik and Advocate Sliosberg, two leaders of Russian Jewry in the pre-Soviet days, to give evidence of Bolshevik methods in general, and Jewish life in particular. Neither of these leaders are coming to Lausanne, their depositions having been submitted through the Swiss Ambassador.

GENERAL HALLER RESPONSIBLE FOR MURDER OF JEWS, WRITER TO "NATION" ASSERTS

New York, November 8 (J. T.A.) General Haller, Poland's notorious anti-Semite, has been accorded a royal welcome to these shores by President Coolidge, the American Legion, and various public officials, says Victor Gertlin of Dorchester, Mass., in a letter to the Nation for November 14.

"Directly responsible for the torture and murder of innocent Jews, he is acclaimed a hero by men prominent in American affairs", Mr. Gertlin protests. "Are we to continue to kowtow to a man whose hands are stained with the blood of a people who dared remain true to the faith of their fathers? We speak of the crucifixion of Christ, but what of the Jews who were buried alive in Poland by soldiers commanded by General Haller? A traitor to civilization, he should be treated as such by the American people. Let us brand him as he deserves".

MARSHALL STRESSES NEED OF SEMINARY AID

New York, November 6 (J. T.A.). Unless a determined effort is made to provide the Jewish youth with religious education under the guidance of English speaking rabbis and pedagogically trained religious school teachers, they may grow up "agnostics and atheists", according to Louis Marshall, Honorary Chairman of the Campaign to raise \$1,000,000 for the Jewish Theological Seminary of America.

"It is worth noting that the Seminary has never before made an appeal. Should the seminary now fail from lack of financial support it would, indeed, be a sad day for the adherents of Judaism. The responsibility rests on every Jew and must not be shirked.

"Unless we are willing to alienate our young people, unless we are willing to make them agnostics or atheists, then the time has come for the Jews of America to preserve the institution which is best calculated to foster Judaism on this continent among the vast majority of the American Jews".

The campaign for the seminary \$1,000,000 endowment fund will begin on November 11. On that day seventeen fraternities composed of Jewish college men and women, will organize for participation in the campaign. During this week 150 rabbis and laymen, under the direction of Dr. Harold Korn and Rabbi Samuel M. Cohen, will address every Jewish synagogue, fraternal and mutual benefit society in behalf of the endowment fund.
