CRY OF "KILL JEWS" RESOUNDS THROUGH ALL BERLIN

Charlottenburg the Scene of Anti-Jewish Demonstration Tuesday, and Kurfurstendam, Wednesday.

JEWISH HOMES BOMBED NEAR HANOVER, GRAVES DEFILED AT BADHOMBURG

Berlin, November 15 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). After several days respite the anti-Semitic nationalists have reorganized their forces sufficiently to stage a number of menacing anti-Jewish demonstrations in various parts of Berlin.

Kurfurstendam, Steinplatz and other thoroughfares in West Berlin were the scenes last night of hostile demonstrations in which the cry "kill the Jews" was incessantly raised. Order was restored with great difficulty.

On Tuesday night a grave anti-Jewish demonstration took place at Wilhelmplatz in Charlottenburg in connection with the meeting of the prohibited anti-Semitic Deutscherold Organization. Deputy Wulle, nationalist anti-Semitic leader, who is understood to have been proposed as the chief of police of Berlin in the event of the success of the Hitler putsch, was the principal speaker. The inflammatory speeches inciting the mob to violence against the Jews, were interrupted by songs having as their refrain "Down with the Government, kill the Jews". Jewish residents of this section barricaded their houses and none dare appear on the streets before the police reinforcements arrived and dispersed the demonstration.

In view of the apparent ease with which these demonstrations can be organized in the face of the proscriptions against assemblies, Jews of Berlin fear a repetition of the pogroms of last week. The police are acting as energetically as possible, proceeding against notorious nationalist ringleaders wherever they can. The Deutsches Tageblatt, organ of Deputy Wulle, was suppressed, charged with inciting the Reichswehr to insubordination.

The socialists of Berlin have started a widespread movement to counter the anti-Semitic general agitation.. A mass meeting was called last night where addresses were delivered by deputies Hildenbrand, Kuenstler and Hoffman. The pogrom and pogrom agitations were denounced as damaging to Germany's reputation in the world. The speakers maintained that the Jews had done their duty during the war, pointing out that the first German soldier to be killed was the Jewish deputy Dr. Frank. Socialists proceeded to point out that the present anti-Semitic campaign was intended to divert the public's attention from those actually responsible for Germany's defeat and to destroy the Republic. Democracy it is essential to unite and smash the reactionary anti-Semitism, the socialist speakers urged.

With Berlin itself in the throes of pogrom panic, reports from other parts of Germany are equally disquieting. At Wolfenbutel, near Hanover, serious anti-Jewish excesses took place in the course of which Jewish houses were bombed and windows smashed.

At Badhamburg, the Jewish cemetery was invaded by nationalist hooligans who defiled the graves and smashed sixty grave-stones.

# SPLIT BETWEEN VON KAHR AND HITLER MENACES BAVARIAN JEWS

Von-Kahr Continues Expulsion of East-European Jews.

Munich, Nov. 15 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Differences between Dictator von Kahr and the Fascist leader Hitler which are growing increasingly acute are becoming a real menace to the Jews of Bavaria. Dictator von Kahr is inflicting greater hardships on the Jews in order to disprove the national socialists' charge that he is friendly to the Jews.

Von Kahr is accused of having betrayed Hitler, and anyone who is courageous enough to speak a word in favor of the Jew and against oppression is classed as a Jewish slave. Even Cardinal Faulhaber, who recently deplored the attacks on Jews, has not escaped this classification at the hands of the national socialists. "Down with Rome, down with the Jews" are among the war cries of the National Socialist followers of Hitler.

Apparently to deny these strictures von Kahr's ~~xxxx~~ administration is dealing more harshly than ever with the Jewish deportees. The Bavarian finance minister has sequestered the property of the exiled Jews. Demanding payment of taxes from the deportees, it has confiscated their wealth to the last penny until the expelled have had to appeal to Jewish institutions to transport their furniture to their new home in exile.

There are many evidences of ~~frankly anti-Semitic~~ official anti-Semitism in Munich, not the least of which is von Kahr's latest announcement that the expulsions will be continued.

## ----- JEWISH CORRESPONDENT RELEASED

Berlin, November 15 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Jacob Lescinsky, Berlin correspondent of the Jewish Daily Forward of New York, has been released after several days in prison on the charge of exaggerating reports of the Jewish pogroms last week. Arrested the latter part of last week he was released only to be re-arrested on an order from the war ministry. An appeal against his arrest was lodged with General von Seeckt and the war ministry by the Foreign Press Association of Berlin through its President.

## DENY EINSTEIN FLED GERMANY BECAUSE THREATENED

Scientist Has Not Visited Russia, It Is Declared.

Berlin, November 15 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Reports that Professor Albert Einstein left Berlin because he had been threatened with assassination by anti-Semitic organizations are denied in quarters close to the noted Jewish scientist.

It is also denied that Professor Einstein visited Moscow. It is true he was invited to visit Soviet Russia, but he declined, according to a statement by Professor Ehrenfest with whom Einstein is staying at Leyden, Holland. Professor Ehrenfest confirms that Professor Einstein has left Germany in order that he may study quietly and that the scientist had not been to Russia.

## WARSAW FASCISTI THREATENS JEWS

Warsaw, Nov. 15 (J. T.A.). The proprietors of the Jackozki Café in Sachsengarten are in receipt of a warning signed by the Central Fascisti Committee not to admit Jewish patrons on the penalty of having the café blown up.

During the general strike last week a mob of Fascisti stormed this café, beating the Jewish guests. Fifty Fascists were arrested on the spot, while one hundred made their escape.

Preparatory to the trial of the fifty which is pending, it is announced that revolvers, rifles and iron bars were found in the prisoners' possession.

## POLICE OF LODZ BEAT, HOLD FIFTY JEWS

Warsaw, Nov. 15 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Fifty Jews of Lodz were sat upon by police at Sgierszastrasse and after being beaten into submission were marched off to the nearest police station where they were again subjected to terrible beatings in the course of which their clothes were torn off and their money seized.

Lodz, according to the report, is in ~~the~~ state of ferment because of the police brutalities, and the deputies for that city are submitting an urgent interpellation in the Sejm. Victims of the police rowdism include Rabbi Aronisaak Schmlitz.

COUNT APPONYI LISTED FOR DESTRUCTION WITH PROMINENT JEWS OF BUDAPEST.

Magyar Supporters Made Treaty With Hitlerists For Pogrom and Putsch In Hungarian Capital.

Budapest, Nov. 15 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Count Albert Apponyi, the distinguished Hungarian statesman was listed with prominent Jews of Hungary who were to be assassinated in the event the proposed putsch against the government and pogrom on the Jews had come off as scheduled.

This announcement is made officially by the police who had reported that a treaty had been found in possession of the insurrectionary deputy Ulan, drawn up with M. Doemel, the special diplomatic emissary of the Hitler group in Munich.

A complete plan for a pogrom in Budapest was also found in the deputy's possession as well as a list of important persons to be assassinated, including besides Count Apponyi, the Jewish deputies Vaszonyi, Fabian and Rassay.

Searches of the houses of the anti-Semitic politicians are being continued, the result of the incriminating evidence discovered so far being the arrest of leaders of the Awakening Magyars, Deputy Konrad Weiss, Drs. Alexander Daniel, and Alexander Adorgan. The arrest of Deputy Goemboes, a leading spirit in the anti-Semitic and anti-Bethlem forces, is also expected.

LOOT JEWISH SHOTS DURING FAIRS IN POLAND.

Warsaw, Nov. 15 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). High prices have served as a pretext for looting of Jewish shops during the recent fairs at Kalwarja in the district of Czacow, and Niedzwicamala in the Lublin district.

At the former place some of the leaders were arrested and part of the booty recovered. Of 250 leaders at the latter place only 48 arrests were made and but a small part of the booty recovered.

## REFORM JEWS JOIN ORTHODOX IN SEMINARY ENDOWMENT.

More Than \$300,000 After Louis Marshall's Appeal For Jewish Theological Seminary.

New York, November 15. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Differences as to religious observance between Reform and Orthodox Jews seemed to be completely obliterated at the Jewish Theological Seminary dinner at the Astor Hotel last night when prominent Reform Jews vied with the conservative and Orthodox in liberal giving for the million dollar endowment fund of the Seminary.

The object of the dinner was to begin the New York campaign for half of the million dollar quota. Following Louis Marshall's stirring appeal more than \$314,000 was announced as raised before the exercises were over.

Sol M. Stroock who announced a contribution of \$15,000 on behalf of his family and himself, presided. The address of the evening was delivered by Louis Marshall, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Seminary. He decried "adjective Jewry" and said that although he belonged to a Reform Congregation he was a member of the Board of Trustees of the Seminary but would extend the same help to the Hebrew Union College or the Yeshivoh if they were in need.

After describing the present time as serious in the history of Judaism, Mr. Marshall declared he was more concerned over those who were indifferent to their faith than with the "narrowminded bigots and fanatics who are opposed to one of a different faith."

Mr. Marshall in part said: "The Jewish Theological Seminary of America, in common with the Hebrew Union College at Cincinnati and the 'Yeshivohs', dedicated to our religion, to our tradition, to our literature, to our ethics, are the lighthouses by which we can guide ourselves and they are isles of safety to which we can resort in all the attacks our enemies direct at us. Upon the perpetuation of our religion and our faith depend the continuance of the Jewish people and their influence upon the world."

More than 800 persons attended the dinner.

Contributions to the fund from Jews of New York, announced last night, include: \$25,000 each from Mortimer L. Schiff, Felix M. Warburg, Louis Marshall; \$15,000 each from Bertram Stroock, Louis I. Stroock, Sylvan L. Stroock; \$10,000 each from Mr. and Mrs. M. Lurie, and Henry A. Dix; \$5,000 each from Mrs. Jacob H. Schiff, Moses Ottiniger, Adolph Lewishn, Samuel Untermeyer, Adolph S. Ochs, Herbert Lehman, Irving Lehman, Jacob Sperber, R. Sadowsky. Besides the individual donations, there were a number of large collective contributions from synagogues and their affiliated societies, including Temple Emanu-El, Anschei Chesed, Bnai Jeshurun and Petach Tikvah. Rabbi Max Drob, Chairman of the drive, announced that other States had contributed as follows: New England, \$25,00; New York (exclusive of New York City) \$25,000; Michigan, \$10,000; Ohio, \$15,000; Pennsylvania, \$75,000; Maryland \$15,000; New Jersey \$30,000; Illinois \$25,000; and Missouri \$5,000.
