KING HUSSEIN TO BE PROCLAIMED CALIPH

London "Times" Warns Britain Against Interfering With Caliphate

Jerusalem, January 11 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The Arab press in Transjordania has issued a call for the proclamation of King Hussein of Hedjas as Caliph.

King Hussein is expected to arrive tomorrow (Saturday) in Amman. Great preparations have been made for his reception. A torchlight procession will meet him, carrying flags which hail Hussein as liberator of the Arab race. King Hussein will be accompanied by his Foreign Minister Fuad el Khatib Bey, Major John Philby the British xxxx adviser to Transjordania, his son Emir Abdullah, ruler of Transjordania, and a number of leading Transjordanian sheikhs.

King Hussein has pardoned the Transjordanian rebell now imprisoned in Hedjas, while Emir Abdullah has granted amnesty to the whole Adwan tribe which had engaged in warfare against Transjordania.

The reports about the purpose of the Conference in Amman are still conflicting. While according to one version the object of the conference is the discussion of the proposed Anglo-Arab Treaty, according to other reports the setting up of a federated Arab State to include Mespotamia, Hedjas, Transjordenia and Palestine is the aim of the conference. The conference is considered but a preliminary conference to the Pan-Arab Congress to be held at the end of this month in Jeddah. There is much excitement throughout the Arab world over the pending conferences. The Arab press expects as a result of these conferences of the demands of the Arab interests, and a greater cosmideration of the demands of the Arab nation.

London, January 11 (Jewish Telegraphic AgencyP. The London Times in an editorial published today declares the proclamation of King Hussein as Caliph a tactless step. The Times demands, if the report be correct, that the Brittish Government instruct Sir Herbert Samuel and his Secretary M. Clayton not to proceed to the Conference of Amman: Great Britain must not create the impression that it wants to interfere in the question of the Caliphate. Great Britain would make a serious migtake should it interfer in the selection of the Caliph which is a purely

Moslem affair, the paper says.

ARAB FARMERS ORGANIZE PARTY.

The aims of this party are of a non-political and purely economic nature. The Party desires to strengthen the position of the Arab farmer. The leaders of this party are not allied, and some of them are even antagonistic to the Executive of the Arab Congress.

The Deutsche Zeitung of Berlin urges the starving Berlin population to pay a visit to Maximilian Harden's luxurious villa in Brunevald and give him the answer he deserves for his article in the American Hebrew in which he urged the United States to discontinue relief activities in Germany. Harden's article is used also by other anti-Semitic papers for inciting the masses against the Jews.

JEWISH FINANCIER COVERS DUDGET OF VIENNESE PROPLES HOME AND UNIVERSITY

Vienna, January 11 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The Jewish firancier Siecried Dosel who recently undertook to cover the budget of the Viennese University has announced today that he will pay for the upkeep of the Viennese Peoples' Home and Peoples University for the next five years. He contributions will amount to several million kronen annually.

ROUMANIAN MINISTER OF INTERIOR FORBIDS INCITING LITERATURE IN BESSARABIA

Kishineff, January 11 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Proclamations MIX calling upon the local population to rise and massacre the Jews are being widely circulated here as well as in a number of other Bessarabian towns by Fascisti followers of Prof. Cuza. These proclamations led to a conflict between the civil and military censors, the former having confiscated the proclamations and the military censor having permitted their circulation. The Minister of the Interior then intervened with the Minister of war, calling to his attention the fact that the circulation of literature of an inciting character had been forbidden since October.

ROUMANTA AND UKRAINIA ARRANGE FRONTIER POINT FOR JEWISH REFUGEES

Agreement To Go Into Effect Affer Ratification of Russo-Roumanian Trade Agreement.

Bucharest, January 11 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). An agreement, arranging for special frontier points through which will be regulated the repatriation of Ukranian and Roumanian Jewish refugees, was signed today by the respective delegations meeting in Bucharest. The agreement will, however, go into effect after the Russo-Roumanian Trade Agreement has been ratified. The special frontier points were created because in the past, a number of Jewish refugees while attempting to cross the Dneister were fired upon from the Roumanian and Russian borders. The points of control are at Tighina, Cetatea, Alba and Atebi.

BUDAPEST POLICE MAKES IMPORTANT DISCOVERY IN CONNECTION WITH Revolution Planned to Raise Leader of Awakening Magyars to Dictator of Hungary.

Budapest January 12(J.T.A). The Budapest police have discovered threads linking the bomb outrage at Chongrad with the Alfoeld Brigade which is a union of all secret organizations in Hungary.

Johann Saggi, who had been arrested for complicity in the Chongrad affair, testified before the Judge that the Alfoeld \$ Brigade had planned a revolution with the purpose of establishing a dictatorship under Ivan Hedjas, leader of the awakening Magvars.

MAKOAH ELEVEN BEATS BRITISH ARMY TEAM.
