FIFTEEN HUNDRED JEWS GREET DR. THOM.

New York, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic agency). Dr. Osias Thon, president of the Polish Tarbuth, prominent Jewish member of the Polish Parliement, chief rabbi of Krakow and member of the Greater actions Committee of the World Zionist Organization, was enthusiastically greeted by more than 1,500 Jews at a reception in his honor, held konday evening, January 21 in Cooper Union.

The meeting which was the inaugural of Dr. Thon's campaign for funds for the support of the Tarbuth's chools in Poland as well as *reception in his honor, was opened by Philip Wattenberg, president of the Galician Federation, who in turn introduced Rueben Brainin, renowed Hebrew and Yiddish writer, the chairman of the meeting. Er. Brainin presented Dr. Thon, whom he characterized as the greatest advocate of a reunited Israel.

Dr. Thom, in an address which was enthusiastically received, said that he was moved to come to america for three main reasons. First, to become acquainted with the Jews of america, who he said were assuming the greater share of the burdens of World Jewry; second, to raise money for the Tarbuth schools of Europe which are threatened with extinction unless funds can be had at once; and third, for the Keren Hayesod. Dr. Thon spoke in both Hebrew and Yiddish.

Other speakers of the evening were Dr. Chaim Weizmann, president of the Vorld Zionist Organization, who lauded Dr. Thom for his past accomplishments and wished him success in his mission to this country; Raboi Hirsch Masliansky, Bernard Semel, N. Ribalov and J. Rudavsky.

ASK BAR OF NON RUSSIAN COMMUNISTS IN MILITARY HONORS

London, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic agency). Telegraphic reports have been received here telling of the visit of a deputation of troops forming at the Moscow garrison who called on Kalimin, chairman of the VZIK, the executive committee of the kussian Soviets, demending that communists of non-Russian origin be not permitted to share prominently in military reviews and other fermondes.

NOTED HEBREW SCHOLAR DIES IN TUNIS

Tunis, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The well known Hebrew scholar, Rabbi David Hadidah, is dead. Rabbi Hadidah is a descendant of the Spaniols, the Spanish Jews who fled Spain in the days of the Inquisition.

EATER ACTIONS COMMITTEE MEETING POSTPONED

London, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The executive offices of the World Zionist Organization announces a meeting of the Greater Actions Committee to take place in London at the end of February. The meeting was originally called for January 3, following the resignation of Saloweitchik, but was postponed when the Zionist Organization of America protested that the notice given was too short to permit the representation of the American members of the Committee.

WILL REQUESTS SON TO FOLLOW JEWISH TRADITIONS

London, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Isaac Alexander, known as Alexander the Great Tailor, who died a few days ago, has left a will disposing of his estate, which is valued at 63,000 pounds. The document makes a specific request that his son, Claude, should not gamble on the stock exchange and that he should follow the best traditions of the Jewish religion.

SEPHARDIC CONGRESS WILL BE CALLED

London, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency), It is learned here that an international congress of the Sephardim will be convoked in the spring. It is prenned to have the Congress meet either in Salonika or Rome. Sephardic leaders purpose to organize for participation in the work of upbuilding the Homeland in Palestine.

CONFIRM EARLIER REPORT OF UKRAINE POGROM.

Beilin, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic agency) Further reports confirm the anti-Jewish outbreaks in Southern Europe, particularly in Oliviopol, Elisabethgrad andGolta. The Russian newspaper, Rul, published in Berlin, gives more complete details regarding the outbreak in the Ukraine. The Rul accounts for three Jewish dead and 18 wounded in Golta and 18 Jewish dead and 118 wounded in Colta and 18 Jewish dead and 118 wounded in Oliviopol, with 12 pogromists also wounded.

The outbreak started in Golta, says the Rul, where a mob released a peasant who had been arrested after a quarrel with a Jew. The Golta police finally succeeded in restoring order. News of the Golta with the constraint reached Oliviopol a few hours later and still more violent disorders followed there, where the mob is reported to have laid waste all Jewish dwellings. The Oliviopol police refused to aid the Red troops in their attempt to bring about order, which was restored only after a batallion of infantry was able to arrive from a meighboring town.

ARAB DELEGATIONS ELECT COMMITTEE TO CONFER WITH HUSSEIN.

Jerusalem, Jaruany 22 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Arab delegations in Amman, which have gathered to confer with King Hussein of Redjas over the proposed anglo-arab treaty, have elected a committee of two members from each country represented in the conference. This committee will discuss the treaty with King Hussein.

Internal troubles, it is reported, continue to give Hussein much concern, the tremist partisans creating considerable disturbance with their repeated reiteration of the charge that the Loderates have sold out to the Zionists.

Hussein yesterday received a delegation of Moderate Party Arabs from Jerusalem to whom he delivered this message, "May God lead you in the proper way." Emir Abdullah, Hussein's son, is influencing the Arab delegations in the question of the Caliphate, so that when the matter comes up for decision they will favor the Hedjas family.

"BOSTON GLOBE" EDITORIAL CENSURES PROPOSED HAMIGRATION LAW.

Bostor, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic agency) Sharp censure of the proposed change in the Immigration Law is voiced in an editorial, "List's Be Fair," in the Boston Daily Globe, one of the most influential newspapers in New England, on Monday. Excerpts from the editorial are as follows:

"This attempt to make a fundamental change in the selection of immigrants to the United States has already caused considerable excitement.... While the proposal does not viblate the letter of our treaties, which guarantee to other nations equal treatment of their Nationals, it violates the spirit of those agreements... A remendous strain will be placed on our relations with many foreign governments if the bill is brought near a vote while still containing the provision recently adopted by the committee....

"When a large view is taken of the contributions to human progress made by representatives of the various European stocks, it is impossible to avoid very general distribution of the honors....

"Any change in the Immigration law, must have due regard for hopest dealing. .mmericans, native and naturalized, like to think hopesty a characteristic of their country."

SENATOR UNDERWOOD URGES ANTI-KLAN PLANK FOR DEMOCRATS.

Cleveland, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Senator Oscar Underwood of Alabama, candidate for the Democratic nomination for the Presidency, will ask that his party adopt an anti-Ku Kluxklan plank at the convention in New York in June, he declared today in an address before the Cleveland Chamber of Commerce.

POLISH CHASSID MOUXRNS DEATH OF RABBI.

Warsaw, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Tribolski, Poretp of the Sheprievitz Eshate near Lodz, mourns the passing of one Chassidic rabbi. Although a Pole, Tribolski was for long a constant Chassid of the Rospschar Rabbi Weltfried, whom he was used to consult in all of his business affeirs, taking the rabbi's advice in all things, even the law. When Rabbi Weltfried died, Tribolski transferred his allegiance to his rabbi's son, Rabbi Israel. Upon the latter's death a short time ago, he was left without an advisor. Last week he figured in a lawsuit against a neighboring Poretz, Sirgembo, and lost. Tribolski created considerable stir in the court, when upon the announcement of the verdict, he shouted out, "My rabbi is dead; while he lived I never lost a case!"

JEWISH RAILWAYS ELL'LOYEES DISCHARGED OR DEWOTED.

Vienna, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic agency) Reorganization of the Austrian railways is taking place chiefly at the expense of the Jewish employees who are heing discharged en masse or are being demoted to inferior positions.

DICKSTEIN SECURES REVISION TO IMMIGRATION BILL PROVISION.

Washington, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic A ency) Congressman Samuel Dickstein, member of the House Immigration Committee, has succeeded in influencing the committeeto make an important revision in the proposed Johnson Bill, it is learned. The committee, according to reliable incommation obtained today, has decided to drop the requirement of production of original documents by the immigrant regarding nationality, wrison record, military service and the like. An affidavit setting orth the facts will be accepted as sufficient.

Liere appeared before the House Committee on Monday Wilbur J. Carr, director of the Consular Service; Preston Doughten and Mr. Huddle of the Visa Office of the State Department, who presented their views on the provisions of the bill which provide for immigration certificates. They unanimously opposed the present broad powers given consular of-icials by the bill and urged that the discretion and authority of consular representatives in issuing certificates be limited, stating their contention that it is unwise to vest too great authority in them.

Despite the general secrecy which is being maintained with regard to the committee's executive sessions, it is learned that the matter of the 1890 cersus has not been finally disposed of, although there seems little likelihood of its abandonment. The committee, it is expected, will not complete its work in time to report the bill back to the House before next week.

MACEDONIAN REVOLUTIONISTS HARASS JEWS.

Paris, January 22: (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Jewish refugees arriving from Bulgaria, report that the Macedonian Revolutionary Committee, which is seeking to liberate Macedonia from the Serbs and the Greeks, are imposing heavy demands of money upon the Jewish population, asking sixty million leva. Many Jews do not possess enough money or goods to pay their individual quotas, while others have been forced to dispose of all of their property through terrorization. Nobody dares ask protection of the government, the refugees relate. Large numbers of Jews are preparing to flee the country.

London, January 22 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). British official size have been informed of the critical Jewish position in Macedona and the government is making an investigation through its own chancels. The situation has become aggravated since the revolutionary committee has delivered an ultimatum to the Jews that they must pay an additional six million levy by January 25, or massacres will follow.

The Jewish communities are helpless, having no single representative in Parliament. The press is silent and the government is passive. Emissaries if the Revolutionary Committee are calling on individual Jews. Some, who have refused to submit to their demands for money, nave been maltreated. A Jewish deputation visited the Foreign Minister but was informed that the Government is too weak to protect them. The Jews have already paid the Revolutarionary Committee nine million levs.
