HOUSE IMMIGRATION COMMITTEE FILES MAJORITY REPORT ON JOHNSON BILL

Dickstein and Sabath Will File Minority Report Within Few Days

Washington, February 11 (Jewish Telegraphic agency). The Immigration Committee of the House of Representatives filed its kn-jority Report on the Johnson Bill Saturday. The report was signed by 14 members of the Committee, and accompanying it was a separate statement from Representative Bacon of New York. Congressmen Sabath and Dickstein will file a Minority Report early this week. The Jewish Congressmen departed from the regular custom of filing a Minority Report along with the Committee's hajority Report, hoping that by so doing they would gain for their Report additional emphasis.

Representative Badon's statement records him as agreeing with the Majority Report in all provisions of the Johnson Bill except that section which refers to the 2% quota based on the census of 1890. Representative Bacon proposed instead to give the President authority to suspend immigration whenever unemployment or industrial depression warrants such a measure.

The Majority Report states that despite the unfavorable condition of international exchange and prevailing high steamship rates, between 1,500,000 and 2,000,000 immigrants would have entered the country during the past two years had there been no restriction immigration measure such as the 3% law which is now in effect.

The report pictures an alleged alarming condition which requires an even greater restriction than at present. It especially warms of the necessity of passing a new law to eplace the present law if the 3% measure is allowed to lapse.

The report predicts the largest novement of immigration in the history of the world, beginning July 1st, 1924, if the 3% law is allowed to expire and if no other legislature is enacted, strting that the exclusion clausar of the act of February 5,1917, will be powerless to stay the tide.

"Such a situation should not be permitted to arise", the report reads. "The country demands the restriction of immigration. The public demand is not only for restriction but for more rigid and more effective restriction than that imposed at present. The decision to base the 2% quota on the census of 1830 was reached, after a long and careful_"consideration of every element of the immigration problem, "the Committee reports. The change in the

census hasis is made to slow the stream of those types of immigrants not easily assimilated which crowd in the larger cities with a slight knowledge of america and american institutions. There has grown to be a great indigestive mass of atheix aliens with alien sympathies and alien purposes. It is a menace to the social, political and economic life of the country. It creates alarm and apprehension and breeds a racial natred which should not exist and will not exist when the balance is restored.

The report quotes President Coolidge's last message to Congress when he said that a continued policy of restrictive immigration is necessary. It also quotes the late President Harding's message to the previous Congress, recommending legislation for the registration of aliens in order to show Mr. Harding's recognition of the danger of ron-assimilation.

The report states that the original quota law was passed in 1921 to meet in emergency and that this emergency is as great now as it was then. The report states that 39,730 Jews were admitted to the country during the period from July to November, 1923. Provisions of the Johnson Bill were summed up in the report as follows: Preserves the basic immigration law of 1917; retains the principle of numerical limitation as inaugurated in the act of key 19,1921; changes, the quota base from the census of 1910 to the census of 1890; reduces the percentage from 3 to 2, plus a small base quota for each country; counts certificates, not persons; provides for preliminary examination overses; exempts wives, children lunder law and parents over 55 of American citizens; reduces classes of exempted allens; places burden of proof on alien rather than on the United States; Heets the situation with reference to admission of persons ineligible to citizenship; carries numerous sections to lessen hardships of immigrants.

The dangerous political possibilies of the Bill have been related to President Coolidge, according to one report. It is understood that the floor leader Longworth and Representative Snell, Chairman of the Rules Cormittee, informed the President Saturday, the statement is made, that the passage of the Johnson Bill might lose the electoral vote of New York State and cause the defeat of the Republican State ticket. The Sterring Committee, it was said saturday, would renew consideration of the Johnson Bill and strong pressure will be brought to bear to displace it with the Bacon proposal.

"The hill", said lir. Dickstein, who declined to sign the committee report, "puts a premium upon one type of immigrant and a discount on every other type. It creates among the Hungarians, the Czecho-Slovaks, Serbians and Jews of Eastern Europe the sense of inferiority which is instinctively felt when a man is proscribed against as if he will not be helpful and serviceable to america,

"Our country's policy should be, and has been since its origin, to open its gate without fear or favor to all men who may become good Americans, good citizens, and men calculated to enhance the wealthand the morel and spiritual resources of the United States."

Vienna, February 11 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The Social Democrat leader, h. Leuthner, in a strong speech in the Austrian Parliament, attacked the Hakenkreuzler and the numerus clausus Saturday. Deputy Leuthner especially attacked the expulsion of nor-Aryan students from the student kitchens and criticized the professors who, while under the pay of the State, engaged actively in anti-Semitic disturpances.

ROUMANIAN REFUGEES ARRIVE IN CANADA

POLAND CONDONES BOYCOTT AGAINST JEWS

Wersaw, February 11 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Official condonement of the boycott against Jews has been given by the Polish Government. The approval of the boycott came in an answer to a protest from the Jewish Sejmclub, who directed their appeal to the Minister of the Interior. The Government officially replied that the Polish constitution does not recognize boycots as illegal.

MACEDONIA REVOLUTIONARY COMMITTEE CONTINUES ACTIVITES

Sofia, February 11 (Jewish Telegraphic agency). The activities of the Macedonia Revolutionary Committee have not abated in any measure despite the Government's promise to put a stop to their practices. The revolutionists are making increasing demands for morey upon Jewish citizens who, in order to escape their threats of reprisals ff payments are not made, are fleeing the country.

A delegation of Jewish citizens called upon the Bulgarian Prenier Zenkoff, and asked him to take steps to protect them against the revolutionists. The Premier evaded the issue by telling the deputation that Christians suffer as much from the revolutionists as the Jews.

ANTI-ZIONIST MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT ARE HONORED

London, Fébruary 11 (Jewish Telegraphic agency). A number of strong anti-Zionists, formerly members of Parliament, are on the horor list which has just been announced by the King following the resignation of the Baldwin Ministry. PHILADELPHIA JEWS PROTEST AGAINST JOHNSON IMMIGRATION BILL

Philadelphia, February 11 (Jewish Telegraphic agency). Two thous—and Jews in Philadelphia attended a large mass meeting Sunday in the arch Street Theafre, to protest the Johnson Immigration Bill. The meeting was held under the auspices of the american Jewish Congress and addresses were delivered by Sir Stephen S. Vise, Jos.—Barondess, Anthur L. Lemport, William E. Lewis and M. Katz. Resolutions proposed at the close-of the meeting were unanimously adopted. Jacob Ginsberg, Editor and publisher of The Jewish world.

Dr. Wise delivered a brilliant address in which he condemned in strong language the Johnson Immigration Bill. "Jews want justice not special favors", said Dr. Wise, who added this was the reason why Jews protested so vigorously against the proposed bill. Dr. wise also declared that all the immigrants together could not bring such shame upon the country as have the politicians in Washington, referring to the teapot dome oil scandal. A tribute to Woodrow Wilson by Dr. Wise brought the audience to its feet in a token of respect to his memory. A resolution on the war President was adopted.

In the morning, prior to the mass meeting, the Executive Committee of the American Jewish Congress held a successful meeting at the Hotel Adelphia and the regional conference closed with a dinner at the Hotel which was attended by members of the Executive Committee, and leading men of the community. Congressmen Dickstein, Eugene Allesandroni, Dr. Stephen S. Wase, Mr. Joseph Barondess, Mr. Lamport and others spoke at the banquet. The immigration work of the Congress was highly praised and a fund for the continuation of the Congress was raised.

COME TO AMERICA TO RAISE FUNDS FOR TARBUTH

New York, February 11 (Jewish Telegraphic agency). NOVEL AROUSES IRE OF RABBIS

New York, February 11 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency), Denunciation of the Emeriment anonymous author and the publishers Boni & Liveright of the recent novel "Haunch, Paunch and Jowel were voiced yesterday by Rabbi Samuel Schulman of Temple Beth-El, who spoke of the book as "stinking" and "le cherous".

Horace Liveright, defending the book, later made public his answer to a protesting letter from Dr. Stephen S.Wise of the Central and Free Synagogues, in which Dr. Wise referred to the novel as "a degraded piece of work". Rabbi Schulman refused to name this "stinking" book, but it was recognized instantly by the congregation.

Mr. Liveright maintains that the author died five years ago and offers as a proof that he is not arti-Jewish in the publication of the novel, the fact that he refused to publish less than a year ago a volume defending the Ku Klux Klan, although he was offered \$10,000 for his imprint.

EXODUS TALE VERIFIED BY PALESTINE RECORDS

Philadelphia, February 11 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Announcement is made here that there are on the way to the University of Pennsylvania Museum stela from a fortress in Beisan, Palestine, the Beth Shean during the Egyptian occupation of the land. Stela and the remains of the fortress were found under a Byzantine church wrecked by thearabs. The fortress was built in the reign of Seti 1., about 1500 B.C.

In one line of his stela Ramsses III relates how he gathered the Semites to build for him his city of Ramsses. This is almost a parallel passage to that in Exodus, which records that the Israelites were forced to huild for Pharaoh stone cities, caled Pithom and Ramsses.

RECALLS DR HAINISCH'S INTEREST IN RELIEF WORK

New York, February 11 (Jewish Telegraphic agency). Recent dispatches from Vienna have served to recall in the minds of many Jews here the interest of Dr. Hainisch, President of Austria, in the relief work carried on among the middle classes in 1921-2.

Mr. James N. Tosenberg, formerly European director of the Joint Distribution Committee has a letter which he received from Dr. Hainisch a year ago thanking him for his share in having started the movement for the relief of the middle classes.

Dr. Hainisch who has been severely criticized for his ffiendly attitude towards the Jews should find many supporters in Vienna, according to Dr.Rosenberg, who recalled the fact that about 1450,000 was distributed among the needy and starving austrians. "Is it too much to hope that the men and wonen whom we were glad to aid in that critical and tragic hour will not forget that american Jew rose above the limitations of race and religion and extended their aid for the common brotherhood of man?" asks lar. PALESTINE JEWISH LABOR CONFEDERATION BROTESTS AGAINST GOVERNMENT PLACING PUBLIC WORK WITH NON-PALESTINIAN CONTRACTORS

Jerusalem, Faruary 1 (J. T. A. correspondence) The Council of the Palestine Jewish Labor Confederation has adopted a series of resolutions protesting against the passive attitude of the Jewish population in Palestine towards attacking the Government and the Hunicipal Council for not employing Jewish labor. The resolution protests against certain Government departments entrusting important works to foreign contractors. The resolution emphasizes that the British military authorities in Palestine have had the aerodrome at Ramleh constructed by a foreign contractor. Other public works have been handed over to the same foreign contractor without tenders having previously been invited. One non-Palestinian contractor has carried out Government works for the sum amounting to about LE. 100,000

FRENCH CONCERN ABOUT KING HUSSEIN'S KALIPHATE PRETENSIONS

Paris, February 1 (J. T.A.morrespondence) "Le Temps" publishes an editorial on the situation in Palestine, in the course of which is suggests that the position is one which merits the consideration of the Council of the League of Nations.

The official organ of the Transjordanian Government, it writes, demands that King Hussein should be proclaimed Caliph of arab Islam. In Lordon they assure us that England does not approve of King Hussine. But either the Eritish themselves encouraged King Hussein to stand as a candidate for the caliphate, or King Hussein has rushed forward because he has heard that the British Government is supporting another candidate. It is quite possible that both these suppositions are correct. But that as it may, King Hussein has extended his rule to the banks of the Jordan.

The King of the Hedjaz declares that Great Britain promised him that she would recognize and independence in Palestine. That is how he understands the British engagements of October, 1915. We doubt that Great Britain ever intended making a promise of that kind. Egypt and Palestine are two bases from which the Suez Canal can be defended - or attacked. Egypt already possesses an arab Government. It is therefore highly improbable that the British would ever think seriously of installing an arab Government in Palestine as well. Britain is still interested in preserving the Balance of Power. Besides, she has assumed the responsibility of transforming Palestine into a Jewish national home.

HEBREW SOCIETY'S FREE LOANS EXCEED MILLION IN YEAR

New York, February 11 (J. T.A.) Loans by the Hebrew Free Loan Society, which are made without interest or expense of any kind, exceeded the million dollar mark last year, according to an announcement yesterday of Julius J. Dukas, president of the society. Fifteen million dollars in sums from 35 to 3500 have been lent by the society. The only requirement is that the borrower procure a suitable indorser.
