LUENDORFF ASSAILS JEWS, POPE AND CATHOLIC CLERGY

German War Lord, On Trial For Treason, Tells Why He Is Against Jews.

Berlin, March 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). General Ludendorff, on trial for treason in connection with his participation in the "putsch" of last November, which was unsuccessfully engineered by Adolph Hitler, confessed in his testimony of Friday to a strong anti-Semitic bias and gave his reasons for his prejudice.

General Ludendorff said that he had become acquainted with the "Jewish question", during the war and that he recognizes it as a question of race. Announcing himself as opposed to all Marxist and Communist elements the former Commander-in-Chief of the Kaiser's armies during the World War made the following statement: "In connection with this is the Jewish question. I made its acquaintance during the war. For me it is a question of race. Little as the Frenchman or Englishman can be permitted to obtain dominion over us, so little can the Jew be permitted. Freedom of the nation can not be expected from him. Therefore I was against him. The Jew does not understand German interests and therefore it is necessary to abolish Jewish influence".

Ludendorff also launched an attack against the Pope and the Catholic Clergy because he said they had lately taken the Jews more under their protection. "I want a Germany without a predominance of Marxist Jews and Catholics", he exclaimed and attributed his failure of success in the November "putsch" to the mythical Protocols of the Elders of Zion, because, he said, Judaism had pitied their universal forces against him.

At the end of his address, which lasted the entire afternoon, General Ludendorff said that this is not the time to discuss the monarchy. The nation does not exist for the dynasty, but the dynasty for the nation.

When Germany finds itself it will have a dynasty ready to serve it. I wish the German Empire to be strong and free and belong only to Germans", he said.

Another statement made by Ludendorff was to the effect that the Jewish race has had a detrimental influence on German psychology and German morals. He charged Louis Hagen and other Jews with being responsible for the present state of Rhine politics and said that he was attacked by the Jewish press because he wanted the Voelkisch movement to be racial and anti-Jewish.

Colonel Kriebel, Commander-in-Chief of the Hitler troops last November, was also on the stand Friday. He declared that at a preliminary conference of the followers of both Hitler and von Kahr, there arose a discussion in the presence of the Jewish Commercial Councillor Beuhler as to whether Jews should be allowed to participate in the "putsch". The decision not to permit their participation, Kriebel declared, loosed a storm of indignation, representatives of a number of associations protesting that Jewish non-participation was unthinkable because large numbers of Jews were members of their organizations.

CARDINAL BOURNE AND 930 PILGRIMS ARRIVE IN PALESTINE

Jerusalem, March 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Cardinal Francis Bourne, Archbishop of Westminster, arrived in Jerusalem Friday at the head of a delegation of 930 British Catholic pilgrims. Cardinal Bourne and the Catholic pilgrims were greeted by Governor Storrs and accompanied by the Palestinian ecclesiastical dignitaries, the entire party immediately proceeded to the Holy Sepulchre. The pilgrims will remain in Jerusalem for ten days and on March 10 will proceed to Nazareth.

Cardinal Bourne several weeks ago was asked by the Pope to investigate conditions in Palestine and to submit a report to him.

HUSSEIN DEPARTS SHUNA FOR AMMAN; WILL PROCEED TO MECCA

Jerusalem, March 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) King Hussein of Hedjas, departed from the home of his son, the Emir Abdullah, at Shuna in Transjordan, today. He is proceeding to Amman, whence he will leave for Mecca next week. Hussein is believed to have concluded his unsuccessful conference with Arab notables who had gathered to discuss with him the projected Anglo-Hedjas treaty and the proposed Pan-Arabic Confederation.

King Hussein on Friday received the members of the Palestine Arab Executive, who left Shuna disappointed when Hussein would give no promise that he would not sign the proposed treaty with Great Britain if their demands for nationalization of the Palestine Government were not fulfilled.

GREAT TALMUD STUDENT DIES IN HARLAU

Bucharest, March 1. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Rabbi Meyer Rabinowitch died today in Harlau at the age of 40 years. Rabbi Rabinowitch was known throughout Europe as a great Talmudist and despite the fact that he was still a young man had written a large number of books on rabbinical learning.

SIXTEEN JEWISH STUDENTS UNDER CUZA FAIL TO PASS EXAMINATIONS

Bucharest; March 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Minister of Education of the Roumanian Government has ordered a re-examination to be given following the failure of sixteen Jewish students studying law in the University of Bucharest to pass their examinations. The students were examined by Professor Cuza, who is noted for his anti-Semitism, and the Minister of Education has ordered them to be re-examined under Professor Coroiu in the presence of a special committee.

SENATORS WILL SEEK TO CHECK FLOW OF ALIENS

New York, March 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Senate Committee on Immigration, aroused by the entrance of thousands of aliens in excess of their quota allotments due to the Murkarian and other court decision, will write into the immigration bill to be reported as soon as possible after a hearing on March 11 a provision which "will make it possible for any court to throw open the doors again in this way"; according to Commissioner Henry H. Curran, Mr. Curran returned to Ellis Island yesterday from Washington. The liner Colombo is due today from Italy with almost 2000 immigrants, which will bring the total number of Italians to come in over their quota in the last six weeks up to 8000

BERNSTEIN TO APPEAL FROM KNOX'S DECISION

New York, March 1 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Herman Bernstein, editor of the Jewish Tribune, will appeal from Judge Knox's decision, vacating and setting aside the order of the Supreme Court of the State of New York, under which the sum of \$115,000 which Henry Ford had on deposit in a New York bank was attached pending the outcome of the trial of libel suit which Mr. Bernstein has instituted against the automobile manufacturer.
