HANS HORZE ADMITS HIS RAPPISH BUT DENIES OTHER DETAILS. "I AN NOT

Lordon - August 16 (Jewih Telegraphic Agency) A letter from Hans Herzl confirming his conversion to Christianity, but denying other details, appeared in Saturday's Londay Daily Telegraph. The letter reads as follows:

"In view of the statement about riself to which you gave publicity last Themday, ullow me to say that while it is true that I was haptised into the Christian Church on July 20 in Vienna, report of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency is in no other particular correct.

"Thanking you in advance for any courtesy which you may show these lines, I are Sir, Yours obediently, Hans Herzl. Lordon, August 15.

London, Adjust 16, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Has Herzl in a conversation with the representative of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency here stated, I so not important to Jewry till now. Jewry rever interested itself in my affairs, why resent now and pry into my private life".

Hans who resented very strongly the publicity given to his conversion fefused to make any other statement than to admit that he way beptised. "This is my private consern and I am really angry with Robert Stricker because of his raking public my private kiez letter which should never have been brought beyond his private. I felt bound in honor to inform ir. Stricker of my change of religion, but it was jutended only for him."

The correspondent of the J.T. A. had the impression that Hons Herzl feels that a great injustice has been done him. He is particularly arrused at the Viener Horganzaitung which published his London address and thus made his private dwelling place unsafe against inquisitiveness

GERMAN ANTI-SENTIC NEWSPAPERS MAKE LIBELOUS ACCUSATION AGAINST DR. STEPHEN S. VISE.

New York, August 18 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Court action for libel may be started against several German anti-Semita newspapers in behalf of Dr. Stephen S. Wise, of the United and Free Synagogue of New York.

The Anti-Senitic paper, the NEUE NIFER SCHLESISCHE ZEITUNG has printed what was alleged to be a part of an address delivered by Dr. Stephen S. Vise in which he was quoted as having expressed himself in insulting terms of Jesus and the Madonna.

Dr. Wise has requested Prof. Elboger of the Berlin Hochschule to demand from the newspapers adenial of their false statements and make ample apology. Should they refuse to do so, Dr. Yise will start libel suit against them.

CONFERENCE DISCUSSES OFFER OF LEXICAN PRESIDENT; EXPERTS COLLISSION MAY BE SENT SHORTLY.

New York- August 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The statement of President-elect of Hexico, General Plutarco Elias Calles, issued by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency before he sailed for Europe of the possibility of Jewish immigration into Hexico was wurnly discussed at the Executive conference of the American Emergency Committee for Jewish Refugees, which was held at the Hotel Astor yesterday under the chairmanship of Hr. Louis Marshall. Detailed repurts of the situation of the Jewish stranded refugees were submitted to the conference by B.C. Vladeck; Hiss Rosofsky and Hr. Joseph Burondess. In Robert Hiberman, delegate of the Hexican labor novement to the American Federation of Labor was asked by the conference to portray the situation in Hexico as it exists now.

The conference decided to select an administrative Committee of 21 which is to call an open conference of the committee in the middle of September. After the Conference IF. Louis Iwashul issued statement to the press representatives in which he stated:

"The statement rade by Preisdent-elect Calles, was discussed and was greatly appreciated, but we found it would be necessary to get more definite information as to how we could avail ourselves of the irritation. There are surely very many difficulties that must be smoothed out before we could adopt any policy with regard to migration into Hexico. The financial question is only one that would have to be carefully scrutinized. It would be impossible to act intelligently upon such a plan until there has been a report from an expert committee which is to be sent into Hexico by this emergency committee. We will try to select men by whose knowledge and experience they are able to form an accurate judgment as to the business and economic possibilities of imigratior into Hexico."

BOMB IN ROUHANIAN SYNAGOGUE WAS PLACED AT INSTIGATION OF JEW ROUHANIAN HILLISTER ASSERTS

Washington, Angust 18, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The placing of a bomb in a Jewish Synapogue in the city Josasel, County of Arad. Transylvania, was an act of revenge on the part of nodernist Jews against ofthodox Jews, according to a statement issued by Prince Bibesco, Roumanian Minister to the United States.

"Micording to the latest judicial inquiries," Prince Ethesco stated, "the guilt for the orine seems to rest on a man called Sirbu, who was instituted to perpetrate this crine by a Modernist Jew, seeking revenge against the Orthodox Jews, who were the owners of the Synagogue. It was never a question of airing at anybody's life"

ONLY ACTION OF CONGRESS CAN RELIEVE REFUGERS' ISOPINION

Washington August 18 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The inspructions to consuls for preference in issuing new visus to stranded emigrants holding old visus applies only to one-half of quota for each country, it was explained by the State Department to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency correspondent today. The preferences already provided by the new immigration law in favor of certain close relatives of American citizens and agriculturalists must be allotted one hulf of quota therefore only the remaining half can be devoted to preference in favor of old vian holders. It was further pointed out in well informed circles that under law only ten percent of the annual quota can be issued in any morth. Even those stranded emigrants who will reventually received visus well have to wait again a number of norths There seems therefore to be little relief in prospect for the

Commissioner General of Immigration Husband in a statement to the Lewish Telegraphic Agency Correspondent reiterated that the situation cunnot possibily he relieved or improved in any way except by action of Congress. It is the general opinion in nurters familiar with the situational Mashington that only by enlightening and exerting the necessary pressure upon members of Congress will any relief be extended to strunded emigrats holding old xxx visus.

RESIGNATION OF TRANSJORDANIAN PRINE HINISTER DENAMDED ON ACCOUNT WARABLE ATTACK

jerusalem - August 18, 1924 (Jewish Telegruphic Agency). The resignation of the Trunsjordanian Prine limister is being strongly demanded by the Arab press in connection with the disastrous attack of the Wahabis on Arman, the capital of Tranjordania. It become known today that 21 inhabituats of Arman were killed and 25 others were wounded dusing the attack of the Wahabis which was repeated only with the aid of English aenoplanes. The loss of the Wahabis was still greater. The railway between Arman and IRan was cut off. The center of the attack was the house of IRakalPasha, the chief of the Tribe Bene Sacher.

TAREFF ON IMPORTED ARTICLES TO PALESTINE GREATLY INCREASED

Jerusalen, August 18 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). A higher turiff on all articles imported into Palestine was levied by an ordinance of the government, published here today. The ordinance increases greatly the customs and duties on cereals, food stuffs, fuel, building macrials, spirits, natches, sony, paper, motorears.

ASKS PROTECTION OF PALESTINIANS IN BRAZIL

Jerusalen, August 18 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Protection for Palestinians residing in Brazil, who suffer from the Civil War now going on in that country, was asked from the Palestine government in a memorandum submitted by the population of that Land. The government was urged to take necessary speps with the British Colonial offace to secure the life and property of the Palestinian Arabs in Brazil.
