"KU KLUX KLAN DID NOT MODIFY ITS POLICY TOWARDS JEWS"  
DECLARES IMPERIAL WIZARD EVANS IN STATEMENT TO JEWISH

New York, August 29th (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) An inquiry of The Jewish Telegraphic Agency at the Atlanta Headquarters of the K K K concerning the lately circulated reports that the klan has modified its policy with regard to Jews who have served in the American Army has made it possible for them to join the order, brought the following reply.

Dear Sirs:

I am in receipt of your kind communication of August 18th., and in reply beg to advise that the prerequisites for membership in the Klan have not been changed.

Our organization is founded upon the Christian religion and as a prerequisite for membership therein, we require that applicants be native-born, white, gentile protestant American citizens of good moral character.

We recognize the right of all men to associate themselves together. The particular group which we are endeavoring to associate, come under the prerequisites heretofore given in this letter.

SEND INVESTIGATING DELEGATION TO CRIMEA

Moscow, August 29th (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A group of Jewish men and women in Whitebsk who are anxious to settle on the land, have sent a special delegation to Crimea for the purpose of investigating the possibility for them to settle on farms in that region.

BORIS SAVINKOFF, LEADER OF RUSSIAN SOCIAL REVOLUTIONARY PARTY ARRESTED AND SENTENCED TO DEATH IN MOSCOWRevolutionary Tribunal Recommends Mercy But He Refuses to Be Pitied

Moscow, Aug. 29th (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Boris Savinkoff, well known leader of the Russian Social Revolutionary Party and leader of the opposition to the Bolshevik Regime, was arrested by the Soviet Government after it was revealed that he entered Russia under a false passport, according to official report published to-day by the Soviet Government.

Moscow, Aug. 29th (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Boris Savinkoff, arrested for entering Russia under a false passport, was sentenced to-day to death by a revolutionary tribunal. The tribunal, however, has recommended his mercy because of the fact that he had admitted his guilt, has renounced the counter-revolutionary idea, has acknowledged his mistake, and declared that all those who love the Russian nation must recognize the Soviet Government. When notified of this recommendation, Savinkoff declared: "I expect death. I ask for no pity, but remember that I too was a revolutionary fighter."

"GIVE UP HOPE" SAY ANTI-SEMITES TO ROUMANIAN JEWS

Dante Described Inferno Only For Jews, They Say

Bucharest, Aug. 29th (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) "Lasciati ogni speranza voi d'entrare" (Abandon hope, all you who enter here), this fiery and sinister inscription which Dante, the Italian poet of the thirteenth century has indelibly inscribed on the gate of his inferno, described in his classic, "The Divine Comedy", is the motto of an Anti-Semitic leaflet issued here in many copies in connection with the beginning of the new school year.

The author of the Anti-Semitic leaflet states that Dante, who, as known from other sources, associated himself with Jewish contemporary poets in Italy, was also an Anti-Semite; he described this inferno, only because he wished the Jews to find a boat there.

The leaflet, which is decorated with <sup>the</sup>Swastika, the emblem of the Anti-Semites, bitterly attacked Roumanian Jews and outlines a full program of their destruction. The Roumanian Jews, the author says, regard the Christians as the servants of the Jewish International, which aims to conquer the world. "It is our task, not to grant to the Jews citizenship rights, to exclude them from the army and expell them from Roumania."

LEAGUE OF NATIONS SHOULD CALL JEWISH WORLD CONGRESS IS SUGGESTIONS OF DR. JITLOWSKY

Warsaw, August 29th (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) A new idea in regard to the calling of a Jewish World Congress was submitted to-day for discussion by Dr. Chaim Jitlowsky, well known American Jewish writer who is now a guest here, in a lecture which caused great interest in many Jewish circles. In his lecture, Dr. Jitlowsky mainly proposed that a Jewish petition, signed by millions of Jews should be drafted and submitted to the League of Nations, putting forward the demand that the League of Nations call a Jewish World Congress for the purpose of electing Jewish representatives to the League of Nations. The League of Nations should also take upon itself the task of solving the Jewish question according to Dr. Jitlowsky's plan.

POLISH GOVERNMENT DEFENDS HER JEWS ... IN HUNGARY

Vienna, Aug. 29th, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The prolonged conflict between the Polish and Hungarian governments concerning the mistreatment, interning and expulsion of Galician Jews who are resident in Hungary has of late become so acute, that the Hungarian government was compelled to agree that a mixed commission of both governments take up the matter for final settlement. This Hungarian-Polish Commission has now started its work and will make a thorough survey of the situation. It is stated that the Polish Government has prepared a full plan which will be submitted to the Commission as to the steps necessary to put an end to the sufferings of Galician Jews in Hungary.

260 STRANDED REFUGEES WILL RECEIVE NEW VISAS

Bucharest, Aug. 29th (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The American Consul here was authorized by instructions received from Washington to issue, beginning September 1st, two hundred sixty new visas for the Russian stranded refugees who hold visas issued the following year. Altogether there are 1800 stranded refugees in Roumania.

WORK ON THE SCHWEITZER MEMORIAL IN TIBERIAS WILL BE STARTED

New York, Aug. 29th (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Work on the erection of the Hospital in Tiberias in memory of the late Peter J. Schweitzer, will commence shortly according to word received by Mrs. Rebecca Schweitzer from the London headquarters of the Keren Hayesod.

The sum of \$25,000 handed over to the Keren Hayesod by the late Mr. Schweitzer will not be released for building purposes, the beginning of November. Since Mrs. Schweitzer has decided to finance the additional cost of the building, it is expected that the new hospital will be a valuable factor towards the sanitary improvement of medical conditions in Palestine. Mrs. Schweitzer plans to revisit Palestine in connection with the dedication of the hospital in the memory of her husband.

COL. KISCH ARRIVES TO-DAY IN LONDON

London, Aug. 29th (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Col. Kisch, political representative of the Zionist Executive in Jerusalem, arrived here to-day. He will return to Palestine on September 14th.

JEWISH WORLD RELIEF CONFERENCE AT CARLSBAD PROCLAIMS IDEA OF WORLD RELIEF FEDERATION; EXECUTIVE OF FIFTEEN AND CENTRAL COUNCIL OF SEVENTY ELECTED

Carlsbad, Aug. 29th (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) The Jewish World Relief Conference which came to a close yesterday, adopted a resolution proclaiming, on behalf of eighty-seven organizations representatives who participated in the conference, the idea of creating a Jewish World Relief Federation with a Jewish World Relief Fund. The Conference elected an executive committee of fifteen and a central council of seventy.

Those elected to the Executive Committee are Dr. Leo Motzkin, Messrs. Eifroykin, S. Liosberg, Latzki, Temkin, Dr. Chajes, Mr. Jochelman, Mr. Klee, Dr. Brutzkus, Prof. Eisler of Vienna, Rabbi Weil of Kolmer, representing the Agudath Israel, Dr. Oscar Cohn, Alfred Berger, Mme. Anita Mueller, and Mr. Friedland, representing the Ha 'Chaleutz.

The Executive Committee was requested to make negotiations with the various Jewish communities, federations and social relief organizations with a view to their joining the Federation and Fund.
