### CANADIAN GOVERNMENT CONFIRMS CANCELLATION OF AGREEMENT WITH ICA

Ica Felly Understands Reasons, Says Minister of Immigration

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Montreal, Oct. 17 .- The local office of the Tewish Colonization Association (Ica) confirms the report that the Canadian Government is refusing to admit further Jewish refugees despite the agreement in which it entered with the Ica to permit the entry of 5,000 Jewish refugees.

The cable received by the Ica here from the Ica Paris office does not indicate the reasons for the action of the Government, nor does it give any details.

The agreement which was concluded between

the Canadian Covernment and the Ica provided the Camadian. Government and the lea provided for the admittance of 5,000 refugees on condition that these refugees would in no way become a burden to the Canadian Government. Only 3,000 have been admitted up to the present. The agreement referred especially to the Jewish refugees who were in Roumania waiting for admittance to the United States and debarred from entering because of the new immigration law. The Rou-manian Government repeatedly postponed the expulsion of the refugees, in view of the promise made by the Canadian Government to admit them.

## YESHIVAH STUDENTS GRANTED PRIVI-LEGE OF THEOLOGICAL SEMINARISTS

(Tewish Telegraphic Agency)

Konno, Oct. 18.—The students of the Yeshivah in Telz, Lithuania, one of the largest Tahandical Academies in Eastern Europe, were placed on a status equal to the students of the religious seminaries of other denominations, with regard to mili-tary service, according to the decision of the Li-

thuanian Cabinet passed today.

The Lithuanian Draft Law excludes from military service all students of religious seminaries. This, however, had not been applied to the stu-dents of the Jewish Yeshivoth. The present de-cision of the Lithuanian Government was secured after numerous delegations and appeals of the Tewish religious leaders.

#### Communists Arrest Hebrew Teachers (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London Oct. 18.—Thirty-two Jewish candidates are among those nominated today by the various

British parties in the present election. The list of 1,400 nominees for the Labor, Con-servative and Liberal parties, was published today. The Liberal Party is in the lead with regard to

the number of Jewish candidates, numbering 14; the Labor Party numbers 6, and the Conservatives 12. It is interesting to note that the Palestine ques-

#### American Jews Blamed for Canada's Refusal to Admit Jewish Refugees

Dwelling on the subject of Canada's decision to close her doors to two thousand Jewish refugees after she had admitted only three of the five thousand she had agreed to admit to her shores, the Day of New York points out that the blame for this rests partly with the American Jews.

"Of course", writes this paper, "it is not very honorable on Canada's part. But it must be said that the American Jews are partly to blame for this themselves

"When the agreement between the Canadian Bovernment at Ottawa and the Ica was made it was understood that the Jews of the U. S. would support this work financially, that is, they Support this work financially, that is, they would contribute the necessary funds that would be required to bring over and settle the 5,000 re-fugees. The American Jewish Congress made ex-bress promises in this direction. The Federation of Ukrainian Jews in America sent out appeals to the American Jews to help. But the American Jews failed to keep their pledge."

#### IBN SAUD TELLS ENGLAND HE CAPTURED MECCA

#### Wahabis Will not Hold Mecca, Is Opinion (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, Oct. 18.—In a daring communication to His Majesty's Government, Ibn Saud, leader of the Wahabis, informs Great Britain that Mecca was captured by his tribesmen.

Perfect order was maintained, no pillaging and no violence was committed, according to Ibn

Saud's communication.
London, Oct. 16.—The occupation of Mecca by Wahabi tribesmen is confirmed by the British consular representative at Jeddah. Trustworthy reports indicate that no excesses have been committed, except that King Hussein's palace has been looted with the willing assistance of certain dis-affected Hejaz tribes. The consular authorities at Teddah succeeded in getting a letter delivered to the Wahabi leader, who replied with assurances of his pacific intentions toward all except Hus-sein himself.

The question as to what repercussions this event will have on the Moslem world gives rise to much speculation here. The Times, in an editorial, despeculation here. The Times, in an editorial, de-clares that the Wahabis entrance into the Holy City is "a challenge to the Mosiem world." Other observers, however, point out that Indian Moslem leaders already publicly announced that they would welcome Ibn Saud's guardianship of the Holy

places in preference to Hussein's. It may be doubted, however, whether the people of Mecca, or even pilgrims, will approve of shops or nececa, or even pilgrims, will approve of shops being shut at prayer time, tobacco smoking in the streets strictly forbidden, ritualistic practices and invocations to saints sternly put down, as in the cities of Ibn Saud's own dominions in Neid. Some observers think, however, that Ibn Saud, remembering the fate of his ancestors, who held Mecca and Medina 10 years and found their power the stretch thought shortly after will not right the day.

#### **OUR FOREIGN NEWS LETTER**

#### The Jewish Colony in Kaifengfu-A Dying Branch of Our Race.

Shanghai.-My trip to Kaifengfu was a terrible disappointment. I had for years been looking fordisappointment. I nad for years been nowing for-ward to making the journey; to seeing and speak-ing to that cld colony of Jews who, though living for centuries among a strange people, had remained faithful to their heritage. Imagine my sadness to find that the Jewish Colony, so-called, is a colony in mann only; that those who profess to belong to the colonial strange of their religion, know nothing of Jewish history and tradi-tions, know nothing of Jewish rites and customs. The Chinese Jews are Jews in name only; the few descendants of the once existing colony (there are only about a hundred and fifty left) live in different quarters of the town, never meeting together for religious or communal purposes. In their own homes they observe no Jewish customs; the same gods adorn their altars as are found in the ordinary Chinese home. They have no sacred books left; inundations swept some away, poverty forced them to dispose of them to others. They no them to dispose of them to others. They no longer have a temple; ignorance and spiritual apathy consumed it. No one is left to them to expound the Law; no one is there among them who has even the slightest knowledge of the Herwel language, or the faintest conception of what it means to be a Jew. They do not even circumsize; as to keeping their race pure, it is difficult to say to what extent intermarriage has thinned their Jewish blood. One wonders in what sense they can be called Jews. In appearance, in behaviour, in practice and belief, they are indistinguishable from the Chinese around them. A Chinese-inscribed tablet is the only record they have of their history, and very meagre at that; even the laver that once was the property of their synagogue was sold and is now used in a Christian church as a baptismal fount. The few manuscripts they had up to recent times preserved, are now dispersed to the four corners of the world, lodged in different museums and libraries as witness to the complete demoralization of a once-unified people. In memory only does their race exist, and that perchance will soon fade, if nothing is done to resurrect their Jewish consciousness and give it a new life. It will practically mean and give it a new me. It will practically making converts of a strange people. For they are Jews no longer. They are Chinese. Absorbed, assimilated, rendered indistinguishable; every vestige of Jewishness as completely effaced as last year's snow, a terrible warning to the assimilating Jews all over the world? The sad-

assimilating by the work of the sau-ness of it makes one weep.

The Jewish Colony is no more. A once-flourish-ing branch of the Jewish tree has withered and died.

### WORLD CONFERENCE OF CHALUZIM PRO-TESTS AGAINST PALESTINE IMMIGRA. TION RESTRICTION

(Jewish Daily Bulletin Correspondence)

Danzig, October 5.—A resolution protesting against the restrictions on immigration to Palesine and the obstacles placed in the way of Jew-ish immigration by the officials of the Palestine Government, has been adopted by the Conference of the World Organization Heboluz which has been held here. The Zionist Organization is called upon to take steps to safeguard the freedom of Jewish immigration to Palestine.

The colonization work in Palestine is imperilled by the fact that the Chaluzim and the Jewish working-class population as a whole are so little represented in the immigration movement to Palestine, says the resolution. The immigration Palestine, says the resolution. The immigration of Chaluzim and working-class Jews, it proceeds, must be the first and decisive factor in the immigration movement, and the distribution of immi-gration certificates in Palestine and the Diaspora must be carried out according to this view.

## SOVIET PENAL CODE TO BE TRANS-LATED INTO YIDDISH

(Jewish Daily Bulletin Mail Service)

Riga, Oct. 5.—Short term courses for training judges in the Yiddish language are to be started shortly in the Ukraine. A commission will be appointed to prepare the necessary legal terminology in the Yiddish language and to translate the Soviet Penal Code into Yiddish. This is in accordance with the decision now being carried into effect for giving equal rights to the languages of the national minorities. Several law courts have already been established under this decision, in which business is conducted in the Yiddish lan-

#### AGUDAH CONFERENCE OUTLINES POLICY ON PALESTINE

(Jewish Daily Bulletin Mail Service)

Cracow, Oct. 5 .- Among the resolutions adopted by the Conference of the Central Council of the Agudas Yisroel Organization recently concluded here, is one dealing with the work in Palestine,

which says: The Central Council calls upon every Agudist to acquire during the month of Tishri at least one square metre of land in Palestine for himself and the male members of his household, to the value of one shilling. The names of all purchasers will be entered in the Sepher Hajishub. The land so purchased will be administered by the Palestine Central Office of the Agudas Yisroel. The first Central Office of the Aguas Aistroet. Inc. mis settlement of the Aguas Yisroel." A building will be be named "Aguas Yisroel." A building will be rected in Jerusalem to serve as the headquarters of the Aguas Yisroel in Palestine, but permarks for the Aguas Yisroel in Falestine, but permarks grants to Palestine.

On the subject of the Palestine Communities rdinance, the Conference decided: The Com-Ordinance, the Conference decided: The Communities Ordinance is not a local but a general question, affecting the whole of Diaspora Jewry. The Communities Ordinance of the Jewish National Council is in basic contradiction to the principles of the Torah and it is impossible, therefore, to give consent to this Ordinance. This Conference draws the attention of world Jewry to the fact that it lodges its protest against the ratification of the Draft Ordinance of the Jewish

National Council.

The fuancing of the Educational and Charitable Instiutions and the rehabilitation of the Jewish communities disintegrated through the World War are the paramount problems for the Jewish people today. Let me explain to you my proposition for solving this
