

LUCIEN WOLF, SECRETARY OF ANGLO-JEWISH JOINT FOREIGN COMMITTEE CELEBRATES 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF LITERARY WORK

Congratulated by President of Anglo-Jewish Association

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, Nov. 3.—Lucien Wolf, noted British journalist, Anglo-Jewish historian, Jewish communal worker and secretary of the Joint Foreign Committee, received warm congratulations today from David Greenglass, President of the Anglo-Jewish Association, on the occasion of the former's fiftieth anniversary of communal and journalistic work at a meeting of the Anglo-Jewish Association held here yesterday.

President Greenglass wished Mr. Wolf strength and health that he may continue his work in the service of the Jewish people throughout the world.

Lucien Wolf was born in London, January 24, 1857. He began his journalistic career at a very early age on the "Jewish World" which he joined in 1874, and was principal leader-writer for that journal until 1893. He was assistant editor of the daily "Public Leader" in its twentieth year, and after other journalistic experience became foreign sub-editor and leader-writer of the "Daily English" in 1891. He is a fellow of the Institute of Journalism and has held honorary positions in connection with it.

STRIKE PROCLAIMED BY ARAB EXECUTIVE NOVEMBER 2ND FAILED

Jerusalem, Nov. 3.—The day of strike and protest proclaimed by the Arab Executive of the Jewish Congress Association on November 2nd, the seventh anniversary of the Balfour Declaration, was a complete failure.

Arab stores and shops in the entire country were open in spite of the fact that they were urged to close. Only the Arab stores in the Holy City of Jerusalem, immediately under the eyes of the Arab Executive headquarters, observed the call.

SIR HERBERT SAMUEL RETURNS TO JERUSALEM

Geneva, Nov. 3.—Sir Herbert Samuel, High Commissioner of Palestine, left for Palestine immediately after the discussion of the Palestine reports by the Mandates Commission.

He is proceeding directly to Jerusalem instead of, as previously planned, going to London.

CHOLERA RAGING IN MOGGA; WYAHABI COMMANDER VICTIM

RUSSEN REFUSES SONS' HOSPITALITY

JOINT FOREIGN COMMITTEE TO PROTEST TO LEAGUE AGAINST ROMANIA IF INJUSTICE IN BUKOVINA CONTINUES. LUCIEN WOLF DECLARES

Anglo-Jewish Association Makes Grant For Instruction Of English In Mid-Eastern Countries, Including Palestine (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, Nov. 3.—The question of the Roumanian Government's attitude toward 20,000 Jews in Bukovina who are deprived of their citizenship in violation of the peace treaty of St. Germain, was taken up today at a meeting of the Anglo-Jewish Association when Lucien Wolf, Secretary of the Joint Foreign Committee submitted his report on the matter.

The Roumanian Government in Bukovina is determined on denying a great number of Jewish applicants the right of citizenship, demanding that they submit proof that they are entitled to it. The burden of proof, however, rests with the Government and not with the applicants. "If this great injustice continues, the Joint Foreign Committee will be compelled to submit its protest to the League of Nations," Mr. Wolf declared.

The new Government of Geneva has informed the Joint Foreign Committee that it is in agreement with the view of the previous government concerning the satisfactory settlement of the dispute with regard to the Sime Sunday Law which was to be imposed on the Jewish community of Salonica against which the Jewish community protested. It is expected that this will be brought about shortly, according to Mr. Wolf's report.

Mr. Joseph Cowen in the discussion of this matter, declared the fact that MacDonald's letter to Lucien Wolf, informing him that the British Government is unable to intervene in the Sunday Law dispute with Greece, was published. He further expressed his doubts of whether this matter will be satisfactorily settled shortly, stating that "Mr. Wood lives in an atmosphere of cynicism" which he does not share.

The meeting of the Anglo-Jewish Association further made preparations for providing facilities for the instruction of the English language in Iraq, Palestine, Syria and other Mid-Eastern countries.

DR. MENACHEM SCHINDLER KILLED IN STREET CAR CRASH IN CHICAGO

Was First Of Palestine Pioneer's Fall Victim as Townsman's Inactivity, Coroner's Verdict Says

Chicago, November 3.—Dr. Menachem Schindler, prominent Zionist leader, was among the 20 who were killed yesterday morning in a street car accident here.

Dr. Schindler was on his way home from a meeting of professional men, when he had addressed on a Zionist matter. Dr. Schindler was taken immediately to the St. Joseph Hospital, where he died shortly after. His body was so mangled, especially his feet, hands and face that it was almost impossible to recognize him.

The funeral of Dr. Schindler, which will take place on Wednesday, is being arranged by the Zionist Organization of Chicago. It is stated that the body will be taken to Palestine, possibly when Rabbi Cohn, Chief Rabbi of Palestine, returns to Palestine.

DR. WISE STRONGLY ATTACKS COOLIDGE ADMINISTRATION, HOWEVER PRE-DICTS HIS RE-ELECTION

Shame Threatens The Nation, He Says.
Congregation Members Leave In Protest.

"Not as a partisan but as an American and as a teacher of morals, I declare that the party in power deserves a crushing rebuke on Tuesday for the act of its leadership in inflicting the Harding-Coolidge ticket upon the nation," said Dr. Stephen S. Wise in his first political sermon of the campaign last Monday morning in Carnegie Hall. "Let Harding pass, for he is dead. But Coolidge lives, and the ticket of which he was a part was nothing more than a ghastly joke, perpetrated by a group of leaders who knew that the America of 1920 was war weary and was sure to dismiss the party of Woodrow Wilson with a shrug of impatience. A great party, that is to say, a party with great and high leadership, would have been sobered and solemnized by its responsibility. Instead of that they 'put something over'; that something which was 'put over' was the ticket of which the President of the United States is a surviving member, and the character of the men, who 'put it over' is revealed by the circumstance that the leader of the conspiracy was put out of the Cabinet a few months ago in very shame.

"Harding was the jovial figure-head of the group of reactionaries and corruptionists which, unashamed and unbuked, as they ought to have been ere this, are about to reimpose upon the nation a saturnine figurehead, the difference between him and his predecessor being chiefly that the genial Harding trusted everybody, and the calculating Coolidge trusts nobody, least of all himself.

"The so-called 'leader of his party' is a piteably inconsequent, though not uncalculating figure in the hands of men pitilessly and ruthlessly bent, for the most part, upon serving party policies, however unworthy, and personal ends, however selfish and corrupt. The President of the United States sat as a member of the Harding Cabinet. He retained the old Cabinet when he became President, and when the most shameless betrayal of their country was disclosed touching even members of the Presidential Cabinet, not one brave strong word was spoken excepting as against those men in both political parties who had the courage to speak out in condemnation of the nation's betrayers.

"I grieve over the circumstance that we are asked to place at the head of the nation for another four years a man who, by his unworthy example, has brought it about that the American people seems for a time to have lost its capacity for moral indignation and even for moral discrimination. Shall the election of Tuesday register this verdict?

"In the matter of foreign policies, the Ad-

DAILY DIGEST OF WORLD PUBLIC OPINION ON JEWISH MATTERS

Jewish Vote Should Not Go to Enemies.

Analyzing the question of the Jewish vote, M. Katz, writing in the Freiheit, (Nov. 1) says:

"In spite of the fact that the Jewish population in this country is divided into various classes and each class votes according to its own interests, it cannot be denied that there exists something that can be called a 'Jewish vote.' The Jews as a rule express their displeasure at election time to those who are against them."

"In the present election it must be admitted that Mr. Coolidge, the representative of American reaction, the friend of the Ku Klux Klan, the man who signed the anti-immigration bill, does not deserve the vote of the Jews."

A. F. of L. and the Jewish Refugees.

Mr. B. Rozman writing in the Forward (Nov. 1) says:

"The most important news this week in reference to Jewish immigration is the decision of the Executive Committee of the American Federation of Labor to help pass a resolution in Congress providing that those Jewish refugees who have been stranded in various European ports be admitted to the United States in spite of the quota law.

"The A. F. of L. has great influence in this country regarding the immigration question and it is to be hoped it will succeed in having Congress adopt the resolution."

JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE URGED TO INTERVENE AGAINST PERSECUTION OF JEWISH RELIGION, ZIONISM AND HEBREW IN RUSSIA

Jewish Colonization Plan of Communists Termined Campaign On American Jews' Purse

Protest against the Soviet Government and the Jewish Communists for persecuting Zionists and attacking the Hebrew language and the Jewish religion in Russia was voiced yesterday at a luncheon given by the American Zion Commonwealth on the occasion of the Seventh Anniversary of the Balfour Declaration.

"What has the Joint Distribution Committee, which was in a position to exercise influence on Russian authorities, done in order to stop this cruelty against the Zionist workers on the part of the Yevsektzia; has the J. D. C. taken any measures in this direction, and if not why?" This was asked by Mr. Emanuel Neuman, Secretary of the Palestine Foundation Fund, who presided at the luncheon.

"The fields of Ukraina and Crimea which are wet with Jewish blood, are being offered to the starved and tortured Russian Jews as a substitute for Palestine. It is misrepresentation, audacity and trickery combined. The Jewish Communists know very well that uncultivated land, of which there's plenty in the Russian Empire, is not the most important element in a colonization enterprise. More important are hundreds of millions of dollars necessary for the promotion of such a plan, which they hope to obtain from American Jews through misrepresentation and propaganda which give rise to baseless hopes," Mr. Neuman stated.

MARYLAND JEW BEQUEATHS \$1,500,000.

Hagerstown, Md., Nov. 3.—An estate, valued at from \$1,500,000 to \$2,000,000, was disposed of in the will of Samuel M. Bloom, reputed to be the wealthiest resident of Hagerstown. The will was filed for probate October 31. The Washington County Hospital, of Hagerstown, was the largest beneficiary, receiving more than \$1,000,000.

MAIN SYNAGOGUE IN ODESSA CLOSED BY GOVERNMENT

Riga, Nov. 3.—The main synagogue in Odessa has been closed by order of the Communist authorities, for political reasons, according to information received here.

A particularly strong attack on the Zionists in Odessa was made by the "Emes", the Yiddish organ of the Jewish section of the Communist party, in an editorial by Tschemerynsky. The writer says that Odessa has always been the center of Zionist activities where the ideology of Bialik and Ussishkin was preached. Odessa was also the center of Zionist emigration to Palestine. Lately these activities have been renewed and the "Emes" threatens the Zionist leaders in Odessa with further repressions.

SCHMELKE HOROWITZ, PRESIDENT OF LEMBERG JEWISH COMMUNITY, DIES

Lemberg, Nov. 3.—Schmelke Horowitz, for many years president of the Jewish community here, well-known philanthropist and founder of the Lemberg Chamber of Commerce, died here today at the age of 85.

Mr. Horowitz was one of the most distinguished representatives of the Haskalah movement in Eastern Galicia. At the age of 39 he was knighted by the Austrian government.

LATVIAN FASCISTI ATTACK ZIONIST MEETING

Riga, Nov. 3.—A meeting arranged by the Zionist Organization on the occasion of the Seventh Anniversary of the Balfour Declaration was attacked by bands of Latvian Fascisti. The Fascisti endeavored to disperse the meeting, but the assembly of Zionists resisted. Several of the Zionist members were injured.

The struggle was ended when the Jewish deputies, Lazarson and Nurock, who were to address the meeting, summoned the police.

DR. CHAIM WEIZMANN RETURNS TO LONDON, SATISFIED WITH RESULTS

London, Nov. 3.—Dr. Chaim Weizmann, President of the World Zionist Organization, returned to London today, accompanied by Dr. Berthold Feiwel. When asked for his opinion of the result of the Mandates Commission discussion on the Palestine reports, he expressed his satisfaction with the deliberations of the Mandates Commission.

ST. LOUIS ORTHODOX JEWISH COMMUNITY ORGANIZED

St. Louis, Nov. 3.—A United Orthodox Jewish Community which will be known under the name, Vaad Ha'er, was organized today at a conference in which representatives of all local orthodox congregations participated.

The new organization will be the official representative of the local orthodox Jews.

JEWISH FARMER IMMIGRANTS LAND IN UNITED STATES

The first large group of Jewish farmer immigrants arrived here on the S. S. "Albert Ballin". They were permitted to land, with the purpose of proceeding to Texas, California and Arizona to engage in farming there.

These Jewish farmer immigrants come from Bessarabia, Poland and Russia. They bring certificates from their governments, showing that they engaged in farming there. 25 were taken to the Hias building before leaving for the West.

MONEY WILL NOT PAY FOR LIFE

(By Our Special Correspondent, D. Moskvin)

Moscow, October 17.—What is the cash value of Jewish life and limb lost through the pogroms in Russia perpetrated during the period of foreign intervention?

An attempt to do this is being made now in Moscow. Here, in the offices of the "Society for Helping the Victims of Foreign Intervention," an account is being made up of hundreds of thousands of men and women who fell prey to the bestiality that came in the train of the foreign intervention armies and the claims of these victims are being recorded in cold figures to be presented as a counter-claim to the governments that are demanding reparations from Russia for the losses endured by their citizens in the time of the revolution.

The Society founded months ago, has proven to be a tremendous reservoir into which flow incessantly rivers of blood and tears, a recording book of the most dreadful sufferings and agonies conceivable by the human mind.

Since its inception the Society has received in all 34 of a million claims, representing the interests of three million individuals. Each claim is an exhibit of losses in the way of property and money which can be calculated and paid for in cash. But there are other things in the claims—recitals of agonies endured, of arrests and executions, of vindictive brutalities and raping, of shootings and hangings, of numerous forms of inquisitorial punishments and sadistic tortures committed by the soldiers of the white and black armies—can these things be appraised and paid for?

Of the 34 of a million claims received tens of thousands are from Jews. These are individual cases only. The 1500 programs that took place in the Ukraine, the 125 thousand Jews killed, the 200 thousand orphans, the tens of thousands of crippled and mutilated bodies, the 30 thousand raped Jewish women, the half a million homeless men, women and children—all these are not recorded.

A Jewish woman, Krayne P. of Nikolaiev, writes: "My home is wrecked, the furniture, clothing, bedding, silverware, money, etc. have been plundered. My father and 17 year old brother were fearfully tortured by Denikin's soldiers and later murdered. I was brutally raped, in consequence of which I am suffering from syphilis which has ruined my life."

Dr. Moses Balatner, of Kherson, writes: "Denikin's soldiers robbed and plundered the homes of my father and brother. Everything was destroyed or taken away, jewelry, pearls, diamonds, money, silverware, precious antiques, a surgical cabinet, a costly library, mirrors, valuable rugs; in all totalling 300 thousand rubles. My mother and father, unable to survive the beating they received, died soon after the pogrom. My brother Mendel and his wife Eta and their children, Hillel and Joseph were burned to death in the barracks, which were set on fire by Greek soldiers under the command of French and English officers."

It appears that the foreign armies that were sent into Russia during the time of the intervention, i. e., Greeks, French, English, Czechoslovakian, etc. kept pace with the Russian soldiers.

Joseph Koshin's claim reads: "In the course of 1918, 1919 and 1920 I was tortured on more than one occasion by the English soldiers. With red hot spears they burned my organ; they beat my head and chest from which I have become a consumptive."

The money debts which the governments claim from each other will possibly be paid. But these debts, the debts of blood, can never be paid. Blood cannot be paid for with money. . .

JEWISH REFUGEES DECLARE HUNGER STRIKE IN PROTEST AGAINST WHITE STAR LINE

Cherbourg, Nov. 3.—A hunger strike has been declared by the 125 Jewish refugees maintained at the Atlantic Station here by the White Star Line, because of their inability to proceed to the United States.

The strike was prompted by the attitude of the Sicuan Siao Consulate which has given the refugees the alternative of either remaining at Cherbourg at their own expense until permitted to enter the United States or of proceeding to South America immediately. The refugees consented that they had broken up their homes and severed all connection with their respective countries on the strength of the White Star Line's promise to transport them to America and they were not inclined until the last of the "olive" wave.

The French government has intervened to attempt to effect a settlement between the refugees and the company.

New York, Nov. 3.—A cable has been received by the Eastern Shetland and Immigration Aid Society, 2150 Ave. C, from a representative at Cherbourg, French, Chaim Baran, confirming the report of a hunger strike but suggesting the possibility that an early settlement will be effected between the refugees and the White Star Line.

JEWISH ACTRESS DIES WILL BE OPERATED IN VIENNA

Warsaw, Nov. 3.— Esther Rachel Kaminsky, internationally known actress on the Yiddish stage, became seriously ill here today. She has been taken to Vienna where an operation will be performed.

ministration, therefore the party has had a minimum part in the plans and programs looking to world peace. For it has been divided into a number between the chance of Senator Lodge, the demagogues, a Senator Pepper, the war but unconvincing dreams of the only Baran, and the attempted reconciliation of all these irreconcilable things, chiefly through the whitewashing force of the "deception" in Spain.

"But there are those who distrust and quite emphatically distrust both parties. A great nationwide liberal-programme party must and will come into being in coherence and unity of purpose and be reached. For the present leader of the movement out of which such a party may grow, I have seen reason. For twenty years I have seen him fight, and I know that he is valor and purpose and courage though I cannot tell whether under his leadership the new party of liberalism is to be born."

About a dozen members of the Central and Free Synagogues at Carnegie Hall walked out while he was talking and Dr. Wise reported their departure as a sign of offense at his remarks. He also expressed the hope that in protest against his sharp utterance some might withdraw from the membership rolls. He pointed out, however, that no conscience would not be clear if it did not, even at the hottest time, make known its stand in the political arena, in matter how many of its congregation might disagree with him.

Said Dr. Wise: "The plan, unworkable truth is that we are on the eve of a party triumph which, in my judgment, assumes the proportions of a national tragedy."

wherein in foreign politics and for many years his articles signed "Epiphany" were one of the characteristic features of the "Forward Review." In 1922 some communications by him in the London "Times" on Russian finance attracted international comment and evoked the unique compliment of a disclaimer by the Russian Minister of Finance.

Mr. Wolf has shown a strong interest in Anglo-Jewish history. He was intimately concerned with the Anglo-Jewish Historical Society, compiling the official catalogue and the "Goldsmiths Anglo-Judaica," a bibliography of Anglo-Jewish history, both in collaboration with Joseph Jacobs. He suggested the Jewish Historical Society of England, and became its first president in addition to editing for it the volume devoted to "Maccabean Ben-Zion's Mission to Oliver Cromwell." He has devoted considerable attention to Anglo-Jewish pedigrees, of which he has made large collections, and wrote "Sir Moses Montefiore," a monumental biography. He also contributed important articles in "Anti-Semitism" and "Judaism" to the "Encyclopaedia Britannica," and on the latter subject wrote adversely in controversy with Lord Balfour, with whom, however, he joined forces in 1915 for the Jewish Territorial Organization.

meeting, was presided by President Goldsmid for his devoted work in arranging the execution of the will of his late brother, Sir Ellis Goldsmid, by which the Anglo-Jewish Association received £25,000 for educational purposes. Mr. Goldsmid pointed out that from the Persian Gulf to Palestine there is a great demand for a knowledge of the English language for trade purposes.

The Anglo-Jewish Association further made a grant of £200 for providing educational facilities for the children of Jewish refugees stranded in Eastleigh Camp. The local county council has provided teachers and the swimming company purchased the necessary building. Mr. Claude Montefiore who visited the school, reported the enthusiasm of the Christian teachers for the Jewish pupils.

Dr. Menachem Schenkin, who met his death in Chicago, was 54 years old. He was one of the first Palestine pioneers, having gone there from Russia 12 years ago. He started his Zionist activities when he was very young. Later he became a rabbi in the Government of Poland. He concentrated his activities on the spreading of the Hebrew language and national aspirations among the Jewish youth.

In Palestine he occupied one of the prominent positions, helping in the formation of many new colonies and was one of the first builders of the modern Jewish city, Tel-Aviv. During the war he was exiled from Palestine by the Turkish Government and found temporary refuge in Egypt. He then proceeded to America where he devoted himself to promoting Zionist enterprises. Traveling back and forth between Palestine and America, he was one of the few Jewish Jews to bring the message of New Palestine to American Jewry.
