DR. WISE STRONGLY ATTACKS COOLIDGE ADMINISTRATION, HOWEVER PRE-DICTS HIS RE-ELECTION

Shame Threatens The Nation, He Says. Congregation Members Leave In Protest.

"Not as a partisan but as an American and as a teacher of morals, I declare that the party in power deserves a crushing rebuke on Tuesday for the act of its leadership in inflicting the Harding-Coolidge ticket upon the nation," said Dr. Stephen S. Wise in his first political sermon of the campaign last Monday morning in Carnegie Hall. "Let Harding pass, for he is dead. But Coolidge lives, and the ticket of which he was a part was nothing more than a ghastly joke, perpetrated by a group of leaders who knew that the America of 1920 was war weary and was sure to dismiss the party of Woodrow Wilson with a shrug of impatience. A great party, that is to say, a party with great and high leadership, would have been sobered and solemnized by its responsibility. Instead of that they 'put something over'; that something which was 'put over' was the ticket of which the President of the United States is a surviving member, and the character of the men, who 'put it over' is re-vealed by the circumstance that the leader of the conspiracy was put out of the Cabinet a few months ago in very shame. "Harding was the jovial figure-head of the group

reactionaries and corruptionists which, ashamed and unrebuked, as they ought to have been assaurance and binding and his predecessor being chiefly that the genial Harding trusted everybody, and the calculating Coolidge trusts nobody, least of all himself.

"The so-called 'leader of his party' is a piticaby inconsequent, though not uncalculating figure in the hands of men pittlessly and ruthlessly bent, for the most part, upon serving party policies, however unworthy, and personal ends, however selfish and corrupt. Jewish Vote Should Not Go to Enemies. Analyzing the question of the Jewish vote, M. Katz, writing in the Freiheit, (Nov. 1) says:

"In spite of the fact that the Jewish population in this country is divided into various classes and each class votes according to its own interests, it cannot be denied that there exists something that can be called a 'Jewish vote.' The Jews as a rule express their displeasure at election time to those who are against them.'

"In the present election it must be admitted that Mr. Coolidge, the representative of American reaction, the friend of the Ku Klux Klan, the man who signed the anti-immigration bill, does not de-serve the vote of the Jews."

JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE URGED TO INTERVENE AGAINST PERSECUTION OF JEWISH RELIGION, ZIONISM AND HEBREW IN RUSSIA

Jewist Colonization Plan of Communists Term-

ed Campaign On American Jews' Purse Protest against the Soviet Government and the Jewish Communists for persecuting Zionists and attacking the Hebrew language and the Jewish religion in Russia was voiced yesterday at a lunch-con given by the American Zion Commonwealth on the occasion of the Seventh Anniversary of the Balfour Declaration

"What has the Joint Distribution Committee, which was in a position to exercise influence on which was in a position to exercise influence on Russian authorities, done in order to stop this cruelty against the Zionist workers on the part of the Yevsektzia; has the J. D. C. taken any meas-ures in this direction, and if not why?" This was asked by Mr. Emanuel Neuman, Secretary of the Palestine Foundation Fund, who presided at the luncheon.

"The fields of Ukrainia and Crimea which are wet with Jewish blood, are being offered to the starved and tortured Russian Jews as a substitute for Palestine. It is misrepresentation, audacity and trickery combined. The Jewish Communists know very well that uncultivated land, of which there's plenty in the Russian Empire, is not the most important element in a colonization enterprise. More important are hundreds of millions of dollars necessary for the promotion of such a plan, which they hope to obtain from American Jews through misrepresentation and propaganda which give rise to baseless hopes," Mr. Neuman stated.

MARYLAND JEW BEQUEATHS \$1,500,000.

Hagerstown, Md., Nov. 3.—An estate, valued at from \$1,500,000 to \$2,000,000, was disposed of in the will of Samuel M. Bloom, reputed to be the wealthiest resident of Hagerstown. The will was filed for probate October 31. The Washington County Hospital, of Hagerstown, was the largest beneficiary, receiving more than \$1,000,000.

MAIN SYNAGOGUE IN ODESSA CLOSED BY GOVERNMENT

MONEY WILL NOT PAY FOR LIFE

(By Our Special Correspondent, D. Moskvin) Moscow, October 17.—What is the cash value of lewish life and limb lost through the pogroms in Russia perpetrated during the period of foreign intervention?

An attempt to do this is being made now in Moscow. Here, in the offices of the "Society for Helping the Victims of Foreign Intervention," an account is being made up of hundreds of thous-ands of men and women who fell prey to the bestiality that came in the train of the foreign inter-vention armies and the claims of these victims are being recorded in cold figures to be presented as a counter-claim to the governments that are demanding reparations from Russia for the losses endured by their citizens in the time of the revo-

The Society founded months ago, has proven to be a tremendous reservoir into which flow inces-santly rivers of blood and tears, a recording book of the most dreadful sufferings and agonies conceivable by the human mind.

Since its inception the Society has received in all 34 of a million claims, representing the interests of three million individuals. Each claim is an exhibit of losses in the way of property and money which can be calculated and paid for in cash. But there are other things in the claims recitals of agonies endured, of arrests and executions, of vindictive brutalities and raping, of shootings and hangings, of numerous forms of inquisitorial punishments and sadistic tortures committed by the soldiers of the white and black armies-can these things be appraised and paid for?

Of the 34 of a million claims received tens of thousands are from Jews. These are individual cases only. The 1500 programs that took place in the Ukrainia, the 125 thousand Jews killed, the 200 thousand orphans, the tens of thousands of crippled and mutilated bodies, the 30 thousand raped Jewish women, the half a million horneless men, women and children—all these are not recorded.

A Jewish woman, Krayne P. of Nikolaiev,

writes: "My home is wrecked, the furniture, clothing, bedding, silverware, money, etc. have been plundered. My father and 17 year old brother were fearfully tortured by Denikin's soldiers and silverware, money, etc. have been later murdered. I was brutally raped, in consequence of which I am suffering from syphilis

which has ruined my life.

Dr. Moses Balatner, of Kherson, writes: "Denikin's soldiers robbed and plundered the homes of my father and brother. Everything was destroyed or taken away, jewelry, pearls, diamonds, money, silverware, precious antiques, a surgical cabinet, a costly library, mirrors, valuable rugs; in all totalling 300 thousand rubles. My mother and father, unable to survive the beating they received, father, unable to survive the rather, unable to survive the beating they received, died soon after the pogrom. My brother Mendel and his wife Eta and their children, Hillel and Joseph were burned to death in the barracks, which were set on fire by Greek soldiers under the command of French and English officers."
