ROLMANIAN PROFESSORS CONDEMN ANTI-SEMITIC AGITATION AMONG

Resolution Sets Mark of Cain on Professor Cuza, Creator of Anti-Semitic Movement in Roumania.

(Tewish Telegraphic Agency) Bucharest, Nov. 7.—Condemnation of the anti-Semilic agitation carried on by Professor Cuza for many years, leading to anti-Jewish disturbances and culminating in the latest outbreak of the Faslassy, was embodied in a resolution adopted today at a meeting of the professors of the University

m jasy. The professors' meeting was called for the pur-pose of considering the situation created in Rou-man owing to the anti-Semitic agitation carried m by the Fascisti students organization which was responsible for the murder. Professor Cuza, the leader of this movement, was present and was asked to explain his relations with the anti-Semi-

tic student bodies. The resolution adopted by the professors states that the murder of Jassy which stains the name of the Roumanian people is the result of Professor Caza's agitation who, instead of implanting Natotal feeling in Roumanian youth, cultivated latted and violence among them." The resolution also expresses regret that Professor Cuza shows no penitence for this crime.

The text of the resolution was telegraphed to the Minister of Education.

CONFERENCE FOR UNDERSTANDING BE-TWEEN JEWS AND CHRISTIANS CALLED IN LONDON

Church of England, Congregationalists, Presbyterians, Quakers and Unitarians to Participate Will Strive to Minimize Differences on Ground of Common Belief in God. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, Nov. 7.—Christian and Jewish organizations, churches and synagogues, will participate in a unique Christian and Jewish Educational Conference which will be opened here on November 27 at the Liberal Synagogue under the leadership of Claude Montefiore, English scholar and philanor Claude Montenore, English Scholar and philar-thropist, for the purpose of discussing the possi-bility of an understanding between Christianity and Judaism on the grounds of common belief. The initiative for this Conference was taken by

the Social Service Committee of the Liberal Synagogue. They hope to bring about a closer rela-tionship between religious Jews and Christians. While they do not desire to ignore the fundamental difference between Judaism and Christianity, they strive, at least, to minimize the differences separating Christianity and Judaism and they believe in a possible approach to the subject on the grounds of common belief in God, which is funda-mentally in both religions, it was declared today. The religious bodies and organizations who have

already agreed to participate in this Conference aiready agreed to participate in this Conference include the Church of England, Congregationalists, Wesleyans, Presbyterians, the Quakers and Unitarians. Claude Montefore will speak on the subject, "I'ews and Christians". Other topics which will be discussed at the conference are "Education of the Young in Social Responsibility"; "School and Home"; "Dynamic Force of the Beitef in God"; "The Responsibility of Organized Religion".

LITHUANIAN GOVERNMENT PROCEEDS AGAINST JEWISH CREDIT INSTITUTIONS PROCEEDS

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Kowno, Nov. 7.-The Lithuanian Government has refused to recognize as public institutions the 83 credit banks, known as Vols Banks, established in the post-war period in Lithuania, with the assistance of the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee.

The banks are established on co-operative principles, and their purpose is to help the artisans and small businessmen with short-term credits at

a low rate of interest.

The economic structure of Lithuanian Jews depends upon the existence of these banks. Government, in refusing to recognize them as public institutions, imposes heavy taxes upon them, which will jeopardize their existence.

REGISTRATION OF ALIENS URGED BY SECRETARY DAVIS

Philadelphia, Nov. 6.-Registration of all immigrants immediately upon arrival in this country under the United States Bureau of Naturalization was advocated today by James J. Davis, Secretary of Labor, in an address before the local Chamber

of Commerce Americanization Committee.

Pointing out that of 14,000,000 aliens in this country, 8,000,000 are not citizens, the Secretary suggested that enrollment for a preparatory course in citizenship could be defrayed by the immigrants themselves paying a \$10 fee to cover instruction in the English language and American history. The Secretary urged passage of a law by Congress making compulsory the enrollment of every foreign-born person in the country.

RESIGNATION MORGENTHAU'S HENRY DUE TO EMBEZZLEMENT OF KAUFMAN, MEMBER OF GREEK REFUGEE COM-MISSION, CHICAGO "TRIBUNE" ALLEGES.

Henry Morgenthau, in His Statement, Declares Report Is Tissue of Lies. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

New York, Nov. 7.—The resignation of Henry Morgenthau, formerly United States Minister to Turkey, as head of the Greek Refugee Settlement Commission, which administered the affairs of the Greek refugees under the League of Nations, was ascribed in a cable from Vienna to the Chicago "Tribune" yesterday to the severe criticism of the Greek press against Mr. Morgenthau, the head of the Commission, owing to the fact that one of its imembers, a certain Mr. Kaufman, embezzled Greek refugee funds.

The report of the Chicago "Tribune" further claims that the embezzlement had been estab-

lished.

"The statements of the Chicago "Tribune" concerning my resignation as being due to the activities of a certain Mr. Kaufman who, as alleged, embezzled funds of the League of Nations Greek Refugee Settlement Commission, is nothing but a

retrigge Settlement Commission, is nothing that itside of lies". Henry Morgenthau declared to a representative of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency. "Kaufman is a Russian who had nothing to do with the work of the League's Greek Rejugee Settelement Commission. He never handled a red cent of the Refugee Fund. In fact, I never met him. The money Kaufman used was probably the funds of the Italian order, Knights of Malta, which had nothing to do with the Commission of which I was the head and from which I have resigned. My resignation cannot be ascribed in any way to the activities of any one. I resigned in Septem-I am not aware of any criticism on the part ber. of the Greek press other than favorable to the Commission", Mr. Morgenthau stated,

"I have finished my job successfully. I have accomplished my two purposes: I have obtained financial support from the government to the extent of £10,000,000 and I have organized the work of re-colonization of Greek refugees. It is now the task of younger men to take care of the administration work. My three associates, Mr. John Campbell of Great Britain and two Gr. ks, are still working. No one has been appointed as my

successor.

"The task which the Greek Refugee Settlement Commission had to accomplish was one of the largest undertakings of its kind in the history of the world. It concerned the fate of 1200,000 the world. It concerned to fate of 1200,000 state of the world. The task of the world was a test of the Turkish-Greek War. They had to be re-established in their own country," Mr. Morgenthau concluded.

OUR FOREIGN NEWS LETTER

The "Arian" Bank Swindel (By Our Vienna Correspondent)

Vienna, Oct. 12.—Under the slogan "Christian capital must be freed from the hegemony of the Jews" there were established in Austria after the war a chain of banks exclusive for "Arian" business. The inefficiency and compution which went into the creation of these properties when the total control of the substantial through the bankruntey of the anti-Semitic Deutsche Bodenbank and the so-called "official" Merchants' Bank.

Now we learn of the failure, under even more scandalous circumstances, of the anti-Semitic, Arian North-Austrian Bank. The scandal is so outrageous that the government has decided to investigate the matter. After announcing their insolvency the officials of the bank were airaid to show their faces before the depositors and creditors. The police actually had to drag them out of their beds, one by one, after which they were hauled into court and put to a rigorous cross-examination.

examination.

This bank was organized by a Swede, Niels Hugo Lenquist, who created a board of directors composed of clerical, anti-Semitic Austrians. Through publicity and advertising which cost a fortune an attempt was made to acquire a large number of depositors. But after some time it appeared that the number of depositors was much insufficient compared to the expenses under which the bank was laboring. From reports made now it is seen that the bank's assets are less than 10 million marks, as against 25 million in liabilities.

It is now made known that the anti-Semitic board of directors of this Arian bank, in their corruption and inexperience, frisanced various unprofitable businesses which resulted in great losses to the bank.

Having noticed some time ago that they were headed for ruin the directors of the bank decided to sell their business to the "Overseas Banking Co." an English firm. In this connection it is interesting to note that the Christian-social government conspired with the officials of the bank, for when the Englishmen requested Dr. Grimm, Finance Minister, for information regarding the North-Austrian boat of the Section of the Christian social government control of the Bank's stock. In making the transaction the honest Arian board of directors guaranteed that the bank's operations could be conducted within the minimum limits of the original capital invested.

Before long the Englishmen discovered the true state of affairs and demanded the 300 million which they had given as deposit, but they could get no satisfaction from the board of directors which was composed entirely of members of the "Arian Association". Of course the Englishmen are now taking action against the "honest" Arians.

But in the meantime the depositors cannot get their money. Among those who suffered heavily through the bank's collapse are members of the Austrian aristocracy, leaders of the clerical, anti-Semilic element and a number of prominent mon-

LAY CORNERSTONE OF NORWOOD SYNAGOGUE

Norwood, Nov. 3.—The Norwood congregation laid the corner stone for their new synagogue yesterday afternoon. There was a considerable attendance from the congregations of the other churches of the town.

Rev. David M. Shohet, rabbi of the Fowler Street Synagogue in Boston, and Rabbi J. A. Bankovitz officiated, and Rev. The new building which is to be the synagogue, will stand at 933 Washington Street, almost directly opposite the plant of the Norwood Press.

This will be the first synagogue in the history of the town, and it is the result of 17 years of labor since the local congregation was first granted a State charter. Some 24 years ago the first Jewish family came to this town, in the persons of Mr. and Mrs. Benjamin Cushing, who now reside at \$93 Washington Street. Since that date the little group has been constantly increasing and a Jewish Women's Club and a Hebrew School are now numbered among the activities.
