LEAGUE APPOINTS COMMISSION TO IN-OUIRE INTO JEWISH CITIZENSHIP RIGHTS IN ROUMANIA

Report of Alliance Israelite Universelle Describes Plight of Tens of Thousands of Jews in New Roumanian Territories-Anti-Semitism Is Long Secret of Roumanian Politics, Report States -Will Submit Question to League of Nations If Commission Fails.

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Paris, Nov. 8.-A committee of the League of Nations was appointed to inquire into the situa-tion of many thousands of Jews in the newly acouired provinces of Roumania with regard to their conzenship rights which is threatened by the atti-ude of the Roumanian Government, it was stated today in a report of the Alliance Israelite Universelle submitted at its annual meeting which was held here today.

Representatives of the Alliance Israelite Universelle have taken up this matter with the representatives of the Roumanian Government in Geneva but they have disputed the figures sub-mitted by the Alliance, claiming that only a small number of Jews are affected by the clause in the new Roumanian nationality law which places the harden of proof upon every applicant for Rou-manian citizenship, that he resided in the newly acquired territory before 1918. It was only after the representatives of the Alliance threatened to raise the question publicly that the establishment of the Commission was consented to

The report of the Alliance further deals with the situation of the Jews in Roumania and states "While the Roumanian ministers denounce and sensite violence in their public speeches, they do nothing to prevent it. It is difficult to believe that anti-fewish excesses would be possible did the Government not maintain an attitude of pas-

The movement against the dominant party in The movement against the dominant party in Comming was speedily suppressed, but the Government permits anti-Jewish disturbances. This comment was the lewish population peculiar attitude towards the Jewish population has long been the secret of Roumanian politics and the Bratiano government simply continues to maintain this tradition", the report states.

If the Commission appointed to examine and inquite into the situation of those Jews who are re-used cuzenship will not solve the problem, nothmg will be left except to bring the question be-fore the League of Nations.

The report of the Alliance also deals with the condition of the Jews in Poland and it deplores the situation, which is "aggravated by internal dissentions between the various factions and parties, the Folkists, Zionists, Agudists, and the Assimilations who, instead of presenting a united front, fight each other and paralyze their activities. This dissention removes the possibility of securing respect for the rights accorded the Jews through the International Minorities Treaty", the report conchides.

POLISH GOVERNMENT MISREPRESENTED MINORITIES' PROBLEM AT GENEVA. JEWISH DEPUTIES DECLARE IN

POLISH PARLIAMENT (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Warsaw, Nov. 8—Support of the pacific policy of the Minister for Foreign Affairs M. Skrzynski, at the last session of the League of Nations at Geneva, was voiced today in the Parliament by General, was voiced today in the Pariament by the President of the Club of Jewish Deputies, Dr. Leon Reich, during the debate on the vote of confidence in the Grabsky Government. While supporting the Government's foreign policy, Depthy Reich said, they could not vote for the motion because M. Skrzynski had misrepresented at Geneva the position in Poland with regard to the national minorities. The Government had not national minimum demands of the Jewish minority. The Jewish deputies, therefore, would vote against the Government.

Similar declarations were made by the deputies of the Ukrainian and White Russian minorities. The German minority deputies, on the other hand, declared that they would vote with the Government. The vote of confidence was carried by 210 votes against 170, the minority being composed of the parties of the Right, the Jews, Ukrainians and White Russians, and the majority of the Socialists. DR. CHAJES, CHIEF RABBI OF VIENNA. COMES TO AMERICA

Vienna, Nov. 8.—Dr. Zevi Chajes, Chief Rabbi of Vienna, is leaving for the United States the end of November. He will lecture at the Jewish Institute of Religion, of which Dr. Stephen S. Wise is acting president. Dr. Chajes will also lecture at Columbia University.

It was during one of his High Holiday sermons that Dr. Chajes declared that he had decided to leave his Rabbinical position in Vienna and settle in Palestine. Dr. Chajes stated that when he entered the pulpit, he promised himself that after a period of 12 years he would devote himself to research and study in Iudaica.

WAHABIS BURN 100,000 NARGHILES ON AUTO-DA-FE IN MECCA

Holy Smoke From Holy City Marks Beginning of Tobacco Prohibition. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Cairo, Nov. 8.—Holy smoke which ascended from the Moslem Holy City will put an end to further smoking, now that Mecca is under the reign of the Moslem puritans, the Wahabis.

The Wahabis have seized 100,000 narghiles and burned them on an auto-da-fe in the bazaar of Mecca, according to a report received here today. They have also prohibited further importation of tobacco, raw or manufactured, cigarettes or cigars, within the limits of the Holy City.

According to the doctrines of the Wahabis, the puritan sect of the Mosiem faith, smoking is as great a sin as drinking.

NEW DISCLOSURES ABOUT ANTI-SEMITIC INTERNATIONAL PROJECT: P. POSAL TO PAY GERMAN REPARATIONS WITH CON-FISCATED JEWISH MONEY

(Jewish Daily Bulletin Mail Service) Berlin, Oct. 26.-Sensational disclosures about the project for establishing an anti-Semitic Inter-national are made in a book by the French author and philosopher, Pierre Dominique, which is to be published shortly under the title "Deux jours chez Ludendorfi," says the "Vossische Zeitung" here.

The Swastika

(By Our Vienna Correspondent)

Vienna, Oct. 15.—An interesting volume entitled "The Hakenkreuz—the History of a Symbol" has just appeared here from the pen of Herr Iorg Lechler. It is particularly important at this time to become familiar with the facts in this book because of the fact that the Hakenkreuz, which is the German equivalent of Swastika, is used as the emblem of the German and Austrian anti-Semites, who are waging a bitter war of persecution and extermination against the Jews of Central Europe.

Herr Lechler gives an outline of the history of the Swastika. The exact origin of this symbol is rather uncertain, he says, but he proves that it is certainly not true that the Swastika was originally certainly not true that the Swashka was originally an old Aryan German symbol, a product of the Teutonic spirit, as the pseudo-scientific pamphlets written by zealous Hakenkreuzler would have it. On this point Herr Lechler's book has caused considerable grief among the members of the German anti-Semitic circles, but to the Jews it is rather cheerful information.

The Swastika, according to the author, has been used for many centuries as an ornament or as a symbol among nearly all tribes and nations, being in vogue at various periods in history among the Chinese, Japanese, Hindoos, the Negroes of North Africa, the Indians of North, South and Central

America, etc.

It existed among primitive tribes, as evidenced by the crude sculptures and drawings which have by the crute schiplines and drawings which have been unearthed by archaeologists, and has even been traced as far back as the Stone Age. It spread from one part of the world to the other either in the form of decorative ornament or as a symbol of social and religious customs and in time it was brought over from Asia to the American continent.

As regards the original meaning of the Swastika symbol, scientists and historians are as yet unable to give a clear explanation. It is not impossible that in most instances the Swastika had no definite symbolic meaning but served merely as a decorative ornament created by the mind of primitive man for the satisfaction of his rudimentary esthetic sense. On the other hand it is evident that some tribes and races regarded the Swastika as a symbol of their sun-god, as has been shown by Herr Wilke in his book "Relations Between the Cultures of India, the Orient and Ешгоре."

It should also be mentioned that the Swastika was likewise prevalent in the Semitic countries, including Palestine. This has been substantiated by the McAlister excavations in the near East.

A Danish archaeological expedition has an-nounced that it discovered a Swastika in the ruins nounceu that it discovered a Swastika in the Hillis of a synagogue near the Sea of Therias. But there is no truth in this. The writer of these lines had an opportunity several months ago to inquire about this from the famous German archaeologists Kohl and Watzinger and they stated emphatically that this is impossible, a statement which they made on the basis of their vast knowledge of the subject and their own experi-ences in excavating in Palestine. The Danish ex-cavators were deluded by an ornamental design in the form of two crossed lines which resembles somewhat a Swastika.

At any rate Herr Lechler has shown the world that the Hakenkreuzler in their falsehood and unscruppiousness stop at nothing in trying to justify their hypocritical philosophy and do not hesitate to pervert deliberately historical facts which are well known to every serious truthful scientist.
