RUSSIAN GENERAL, COUNT SPIRIDOVICH, ISSUES ANTI-SEMITIC LEAFLET IN NEW YORK

Plans to Create Universal Gentile's League and Publish Book to Surpass Infamous "Protocols". A universal Gentile's League whose purpose should be to unite the 200,000,000 Slavs, save Russia and create a universal anti-satan federation to protect the Aryan race from Jews and Jewish influence, is the latest adventure of the Russian Gen-eral, Count Artemyi Ivan Cherip Spiridovich, Ruseral, Count Artemyl Ivan Cherip Spiridovich, Russian monarchist and anti-Semitic propagandist, the associate of the famous Brazul.

Count Cherip Spiridovich now makes his appear-

ance in New York with the issuance of a leaflet in Russian under the emblem of the Swastica, with the title "Let's Save Russia" and the slogan, "Antisatanists of all countries, unite."

Count Cherip Spiridovich, citing Henry Ford as Count Cherip Spiridovich, citing Henry Ford as his authority, states that the Jews are responsible for all the evils of the world and for the collapse of Russia. He states that he has written a book, "The Unknown in History", which was ready for publication February 8, 1922, but on that date armed men, posing as officers of the United States Government, seized the manuscript. However, he had a copy and he now plans to publish the book.

ZANGWILL, SHAW AND WELLS S GREETINGS TO EMMA GOLDMAN (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, Nov. 13.—Israel Zangwill, George Ber-nard Shaw and H. G. Wells sent messages of greeting to Emma Goldman, deported from the United States as an undesirable alien, at a ban-quet given in her honor last night.

Colonel Josiah Wedgwood, member of the Labor Government, was toastmaster. Bertrand Russel and Rebecca West spoke. Miss Goldman, in her address, denounced the Soviet Government, declaring that it is the "greatest counter-revolutionary government in the world."

She also commented upon an alleged statement of the United States Immigration Commissioner that she has been debarred from the United States for ever. "Forever, is a long time", she stated and claimed that the United States officials have apclaimed that the Omice States officials have approached her to return to America on certain terms. "However, if I ever go back to America, it will be on my own terms", Emma Goldman declared.

HUNGARIAN BISHOP SEES NO HOPE FOR JEWS OF HUNGARY IN NEAR FUTURE

Lord Bishop Baltazar Here in Interests of Only Hungarian College Where "Numerus Clausus" Does Not Prevail-Asks for Support of American Jews

New York, Nov. 14 .- "The condition of the Jews in Hungary is very sad and there is no hope of a m rungary is cury sad and there is no nope of a change for the better in the near future." Lord Bishop Baltazar told a representative of the Jew-ish Telegraphic Agency yesterday at the St. Regis Hotel.

The Right Rev. Lord Bishop Dr. Desider Balta-zar of the Trans-Tibiscan Reformed Church of Hungary is in this country in the interests of the College of Lebreczen, of which he is president. His object in coming here is to secure funds for this college and he is going to make a special ap-peal to the leading Protestants, Jews and liberalminded people in general to contribute the total of \$200,000, which is needed to keep the college

going.

"My appeal to the Jews", said the Bishop, "is hased particularly on the fact that the College of Lebrezcen is the only institution of higher learning in Hungary which does not place any restrictions in the way of Jewish students. All other colleges in Hungary have the 'numerus clausus' which limits the number of their Jewish students to not more than 5 per cent. In reality three are practically no Jews in any of Hungary's colleges because those who succeed in being accepted are persecuted by their centile fellow students to such persecuted by their gentile fellow students to such an extent that they are obliged to leave before long.
"The College of Lebreczen is 400 years old and.

during the entire course of its existence has served as a bulwark of enlightenment and culture, always fighting the forces of reaction. We welcome Jewish students, who today form one-sixth of the total body of 4,000. In one class, in the girls' depart-ment, 90% of the students are Jewish."

Bishop Baltazar explained that since Horthy has come into power the government, unable to tolerate a liberal institution, has withdrawn its support from the college, so that it depends entirely on the members of the Diocese over which the Bishop presides.

"As for the liberal minded gentiles in Hungary "As for the liberal minded gentiles in Hungary", said Bishop Baltzara, in reply to a question of the representative of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, "Re are organized to fight the reaction of the government and the so-called 'rising Magyars'. Our men write and preach in defense of the Jews. But I must say", he added, 'that there are no liberal minded men among the Catholies in Hungary. "J personally," continued the Bishop, "have all my life fought every injustice against the Jews. I have always been first in defending the Jews against the folish bleach-rimial tales." The "Arbkors" in Soviet Russia (Br Our Moscow Correspondent)

Moscow, Oct. 23.-Among the privileged castes in Soviet Russia there is on which, though little hown to the outside world, is nevertheless as con-sections in Russia as the Tcheka and equally This caste consists of the so-called "arblors" who are the workers and village correspond-

ens of the Soviet press.
These "arbkors" are deeply hated by the peasans and workers because they serve as informers for the Soviet power. Despite the official position which they hold they are constantly abused, persented and frequently even beaten by their felbe workers. In a number of instances "arbkors" were actually murdered by workers who suspected them of furnishing treacherous information to the Swiet officials.

According to Lenin, who created the "arbkors" this, these non-professional proletarian journalists were to fulfill an important cultural function in the interests of communism by spreading among the peasants and workmen with whom they labor sit by side the communist principles and a daily mowledge of the activities and interests of the aboung class, to establish a more intimate con-tended to the workers in each ballity and the wider interests of the proletarian

But the trouble is that, like most theories of the communists, the "arbkor" idea has turned out in practice as a crippled, perverted thing. correspondents are for the most part ignorant, modured types who misrepresent matters in beworkers, who are constantly "discovering" counter-revolutionary movements in the factories and on the farms. The most devoted readers of the arbon letters are the members of the Tcheka who never fail to take action on the complaints made by the "arbkors" against their fellow-workers.

In line with the general "arbkors" there are spetal Jewish "arbkors" whose duty it is to "com-

mmize" the Jewish masses.

But the Jewish "arbkors" know that it is very amount to influence the minds of the Jewish masses in favor of communism both because the less, being more intelligent than the rest of the toyulation, has his own opinions and because the agonity of lews belong to the middle class, to whom communistic ideas do not appeal. Hence the lewish "arbkors" employ the policy of insultng and abusing everything that is held scared by the Jenish people. They trample on the syna-sgrat, on Zionism, on Jewish traditions and idals. ROUMANIA MAKES EDUCATIONAL CON-CESSIONS TO MINORITY NATIONALITIES (Jewish Daily Bulletin Mail Service)

Bucharest, Oct. 25.-At the last Cabinet meeting Professor Anghelescu, the Minister of Education, reported on the situation in regard to the minority nationality schools in Roumania. He stated that certain concessions had recently been made to the minorities in educational matters with a view to bringing about a more peaceful relationship with them. Professor Anghelescu announced that a draft Bill is being prepared for introduction into Parliament which will regulate also the conditions in the private schools. The Bill will be submitted for consideration to a special commission on which the representatives of the minority nationalities will be invited to serve.

It is reported from an authoritative source that the Bill referred to contains a number of clauses guaranteeing to the national minorities their right of developing their national culture. Apart from Roumanian language and Roumanian history, instruction in all subjects will be given in the minor-

ity languages.

ROUMANIAN CITIZENSHIP LAW: LISTS OF CITIZENS PUBLISHED; JEWS EXCLUDED

Bucharest, Oct. 29 .- The lists are now being published of persons who have been registered as citizens by the authorities. As was feared, large numbers of Jews have been excluded from the numbers of Jews have been excluded from the lists, particularly in the provinces of Bukowina and Bessarabia, among them many who have been and dessarana, among them many who have been resident in their present homes for the last twenty or thirty years. In the town of Hilboka, for example, only 48 Jewish families have been registered out of 200 families resident there. The same applies to the towns of Vijnitz and Lukavetz. The Association of Roumanian Jews is taking up the matter with the Government. matter with the Government.

MOVEMENT LAUNCHED TO BUILD TEXTILES TOWN IN PALESTINE

Jerusalem, Nov. 13.—A movement for establishing a big textile industry in Palestine has been launched here by the Rosenberg Brothers, prominent textile manufacturers of Lodz, the great textile goods centre of Poland, who are now in Palestine in connection with their scheme. The project concerns the establishment in Palestine of a special town completely given over to the textile in-dustry in the same way 2s Lodz is given over to it in Poland. As a beginning, about 200 to 300 small textile manufacturers will be invited to setthe in Palestine and establish their factories there while preparations are being continued for the development of the industry. The project has received the approval of the Zionist Executive.

The Chief Rabbi of Arnheim prohibited Cantor Tashlitzy from giving a concert, being of the opinion that it is not in conformity with the dignity of the position which he holds in the synagogue.

The cantor resigned, declaring that in his opinion a cantor is not lowering the dignity of his position by singing in a concert and cited the custom in America, where cantors are permitted to appear on the concert stage. The question will be sub-mitted to the Rabbinical court here.

JEWISH CHILDREN IN RUSSIA IGNORANT OF COMMUNISM, YIDDI'SH ORGAN COMPLAINS

Moscow, Oct. 23 .- Dissatisfaction at the fact Moscow, Oct. 25.—Dissatisfaction at the fact that the children in the Jewish Children's Homes in Soviet Russia are not given sufficient Communist education is expressed in an article today in the Yiddish Communist organ here, the "Emess. the riodish Communist organ here, the Emess. The writer, who has been conducting a campaign on behalf of the jewish "pioneers" who are or-ganized in the Communist Child Movement, states that he has visited many Jewish children's homes and he finds among the children an appalling igorance of Communism and an absolute indifference to what it stands for. This is particularly so among the older children between 14 and 16.

The fault, he declares, lies with the administrators and teachers at these Jewish children's homes, who are not Communists. The only way out of the difficulty is to appoint only Communists to such positions. The local educational authorities, he complains, are not taking sufficient interest in the affairs of the Jewish children's homes. The attitude also of the local Young Communist organizations in regard to the work among the Jewish children is not sympathetic. When he applied to the secretary of the organization for the Province of Homel that a Communist should be sent as instructor to a Jewish Children's home containing about 70 Jewish children, the reply was that it was not worth while.
