

MORGENTHAU COMMISSION REPORT ON POLAND DISCUSSED AGAIN

Not "Protocols" But Other Anti-Semitic Statements Were to Be Inserted.

The statements made by Henry Morgenthau in the speech which he delivered at the Men's Club of Temple Israel in Far Rockaway, that the other two members of the American Commission to Investigate the anti-Jewish excesses in Poland, General Edgar Jadwin and Homer H. Johnson, insisted on inserting the "protocols of the elders of Zion" into the Commission's report, caused a sensation in the leading Jewish circles in New York City.

Mr. Morgenthau also stated in his speech that Louis Marshall and Judge Julian W. Mack were informed of the intention of the other two Commission members to insert the "protocols" into the report.

In a press statement, Mr. Louis Marshall confirmed the fact that he and Judge Mack had negotiated with General Jadwin and Mr. Johnson concerning the report. The question under discussion, however, was not the insertion of the "protocols" but other statements of an anti-Semitic nature which were made by certain Polish anti-Semitic leaders and which General Jadwin and Mr. Johnson wanted to include in the report. General Jadwin and Mr. Johnson, however, agreed to eliminate these statements.

The question still remains open as to why these two members of the commission did not sign the report of Mr. Morgenthau. The Jewish Telegraphic Agency has sent out inquiries to General Jadwin and Mr. Johnson concerning the matter.

CONFLICT BETWEEN JEWISH WORKERS AND ARABS AT AFULEH STATION

Two Arabs and Several Jews Wounded; One Arab Killed.

Jerusalem, Nov. 28.—Several Jewish workers and two Arabs were wounded and one Arab was killed in a fight which occurred between the Jewish workmen and Arabs of the neighboring villages at Afuleh Station, between the Jewish colonies Merchoviah and Balfouria.

Jewish workmen started plowing on a strip of land which was considered by the neighboring villages as disputed land. The Arabs endeavored to prevent the work and threw stones at the workmen. Thereupon the Jewish workmen fired on the Arabs. Several arrests were made.

COMBAT ANTI-SEMITISM IN POSEN

Posen, Nov. 28.—"Glos Poznanski" is the name of a new Jewish paper issued in the Polish language here. The paper was established by the Jewish Merchants Association for the purpose of counteracting the anti-Semitic propaganda of the Polish National Democratic press in Posen.

Another step to counteract the anti-Semitic oppressions of the Jewish population in Posen was the establishment of a Mutual Credit Bank which will extend credit to Jewish merchants.

HERBERT SAMUEL RECEIVES DR. S. ROSENBAUM

Jerusalem, Nov. 28.—Sir Herbert Samuel, High Commissioner of Palestine, received today Dr. S. Rosenbaum, former Minister of Jewish Affairs in Lithuania. The High Commissioner evinced great interest in the position of the Jews in Lithuania.

JEWISH CHRISTIAN CONFERENCE HELD IN LONDON

381 Delegates Present.

London, Nov. 28.—Three hundred and eighty-one delegates representing the Anglicans, Roman Catholics, Congregationalists, Presbyterians, Baptists, Quakers and Jews were present at the Conference to create a better understanding between Jews and Christians which was opened here last night at the Liberal Synagogue. One hundred and eighty Jewish delegates were present.

Rabbi Israel I. Mattuck, who presided, stated that despite the differences in the various religions, there is one underlying principle which unites them all. This is the unity in the belief in God. This forms a foundation upon which all religious beliefs can meet on the ground of mutual respect.

Mrs. Hanbridge, head mistress of the Foundation School in the London East End stated that sixty per cent of her pupils were children of foreign Jews and forty per cent were English Christians. Once a week a common service is held which is approved by the Chief Rabbi and the Bishop of Kensington. Other speakers at the

POLISH ZIONIST DEPUTIES AND SENATORS FORM SEPARATE CLUB

Deputy Rotenstreich of Galicia is chairman and Deputy Koerner of Congress Poland vice-president of the new section.

LITHUANIAN GOVERNMENT ELIMINATES MINISTRY OF JEWISH AFFAIRS

Kovno, Nov. 28.—The name of the Ministry of Jewish Affairs is now being eliminated from all official documents. The Ministry of the Interior has taken over the entire property of the Jewish Ministry.

The Government upheld the decision to confiscate the premises of the Ministry which are now occupied by the Club of Jewish Deputies. The building is to be occupied by the Lithuanian National Students Organization.

The Club of Jewish Deputies, however, has decided not to leave until it is forcibly ejected.

GERMAN NATIONAL PARTY HAS BILL READY FOR NEW PARLIAMENT TO DEAL WITH THE JEWS

Practice of German Medieval Times to Be Revived (Jewish Daily Bulletin Mail Service)

Berlin, Nov. 20.—The text of a Bill to regulate the Jewish question in Germany is published in the latest issue of the "Mitteldeutsche Press", "Schlesische Volksstimme" and other German Nationalist organs. The Bill is to be introduced by the German National Deputies into the new German Parliament which is to be elected on December 7th.

The Bill says: "All Jews domiciled in Germany or resident in the country are deprived of their citizenship and declared to be aliens. All Jews who entered Germany later than January 1st, 1914, will be expelled. The whole of their possessions will be confiscated. They will be allowed only enough to pay their travelling expenses as far as the German frontier for themselves and the members of their families. It remains open to the Jews who are given permission to remain in Germany to leave our country voluntarily, but if they do so they will not be permitted to take more than a fifth of their property with them across the frontier. The other four-fifths of their property will be confiscated by the State Treasury."

The Bill would prohibit Jews from engaging in any of the artistic pursuits and from being medical men, lawyers, journalists or bankers. All banking houses, newspaper offices, publishing houses, printing establishments, theatres, cinematographs, film studios, etc., now in Jewish hands are to be confiscated and become the property of the State.

The Bill provides that if the enforcement of this law will lead to disputes with other countries, and the Jews of these countries succeed in getting their Governments to enforce reprisals against German subjects resident in their countries, one thousand of the most prominent Jews in Germany should be immediately arrested and held as hostages. Should war result in consequence, all the Jews in Germany should be immediately put to death.

ABE GOLDBERG NOT AUTHORIZED BY ZIONIST ORGANIZATION, ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE CABLES GERMANY

Steps with regard to the oppositional activities of Mr. Abe Goldberg were taken yesterday by the Administrative Committee of the Zionist Organization of America, of which Mr. Goldberg is a member, in a cable addressed to the Zionist Organization of Germany, as follows: "Reports received here state that Abraham Goldberg is engaging in propaganda in Berlin. Please make public Goldberg in no way authorized to make statements or engage in propaganda in the name of the Zionist Organization of America. His visit to Europe was undertaken on representation necessary for him to attend private affairs."

A Dangerous Friendship

The friendship between President Coolidge and Henry Ford, whose propaganda has spread race hatred throughout the world and whose name was an inspiration to the Hungarian and Roumanian mobs who murdered thousands of Jewish people, cannot be regarded with equanimity, says the "Jewish World" of Philadelphia in its issue of Nov. 23. Pointing out that Ford has become too welcome a guest at the White House, the paper continues:

"Calvin Coolidge certainly has the right to choose his own friends, but it is questionable if President Coolidge has the same right. The President's friendship for Henry Ford can be interpreted to mean that he approves of Ford's anti-Semitic propaganda.

"It is now the duty of the Jewish citizens, particularly our good Jewish leaders who fought so devotedly for the Republican party in the last campaign, to call to the attention of President Coolidge the dangers of his friendship for Ford."

Finds Fault With Argentine Immigration Project

"Die Presse", a Jewish paper of Buenos Aires, has an editorial in a recent issue, explaining the nature of the immigration project of the Argentine government, contained in a Bill on Land Settlement which was presented some time ago to the Argentine Parliament.

"The now famous project has nothing to do with direct colonization on the part of the government," "Die Presse" points out. "It is called a 'colonization project' because it makes it possible for organizations interested in this kind of work to acquire land for their purposes.

"The bureau which the government will establish is to serve merely as a medium for establishing relations between the lazy Argentine landowners and the wide awake capitalists of Europe and the United States. It cannot be denied that even this alone is a good thing for Argentine. It will infuse life into dead land and dead capital. But it is not what we, who are interested in immigration, have been hoping for."

Lithuania's Gratitude . . .

How Dr. S. Rosenbaum, until recently Minister for Jewish Affairs in Lithuania, had devoted the best of his great abilities in the course of the past decade toward the upbuilding of a strong, independent Lithuania, only to be spurned and insulted now by the Lithuanian government, is related in an article which appears in the "Neuer Hain" of Warsaw (issue of Nov. 10) written by Ben-Zion Katz.

"The Lithuanian government cannot deny the facts: it deprived the Jewish Ministry of its budget, then it turned out the Minister himself (Dr. Rosenbaum), and finally it dragged Dr. Rosenbaum into court on a hypocritical charge—a splendid reward for his self-sacrificing services to Lithuania. . . ." writes Mr. Katz.

PALESTINE IMMIGRATION FIGURES PUBLISHED

Jerusalem, Nov. 28.—8,191 Jews enter Palestine in the first nine months of the year 1924, according to final official figures issued today. Of these, 3,226 are men, 2,522 women and 2,443 minors. During the same period 1,701 emigrated.

Tel Aviv—The City of the Jews, For the Jews, By the Jews

(By Our Correspondent, Dr. Wolfgang von Weist)

Jerusalem, Nov. 6.—Fifteen years ago a city was founded in the sandy dunes which stretch away to the distant horizon north of the ancient Philistine city of Jaffa.

A handful of Jaffa's worthy citizens managed at that time to scrape together enough money to purchase the sandy piece of Palestine situated half-way between Jaffa and the Arab cemetery on the sea-shore. 300,000 francs were loaned to these people by the Jewish National Fund, and with this money they built the first modern city of Palestine.

Half a year ago I wrote in the "Neue Freie Presse": "Today this city has a population of 15,000 within an area of 400 hectares." Today, speaking to the City Mayor, Mr. Dizengoff, who has an almost uncanny reputation for far-sightedness, and who has stood at the head of the municipality since its foundation, I am told by him that Tel Aviv has already a population of 25,000!

When I ask about the present area of the city I am told that it may have grown while I am asking the question; what, then, is the use of asking? Yesterday, for instance, they bought another couple of hundred dunams land, and a few more real estate deals are about to be closed by the municipality. What is the use of citing figures if they are already wrong as soon as given?

When the High Commission requested of the Governor of Jaffa a plan of Tel Aviv, Major Campbell found none to send him! And this is what the Governor had to say in excuse: "It is impossible to prepare a plan at this time, for it will be obsolete before we finish it. We can't keep pace."

80 buildings completed last month, some 400 under construction, two large factories—including the silk mill of the Vienna banker, Mr. Delinger,—being built, the corner stone laid for the new City Hall (the "old" one has been standing already these ten years almost!)—such is Tel Aviv in October, 1924.

But how did this city become the big place it is today, after starting out as a mere cottage settlement?

Like everything that the Jews in Palestine are doing: from necessity, thanks to the enmity of the Arabs.

It was on that ill-starred First of May, 1921, that a pogrom suddenly broke out in the streets of the Old Town of Jaffa. The Arab police had joined the rabble of the port in plundering and murdering the Jewish inhabitants, while the British garrison stood by idly, without lifting as much as a finger. Some fifty Jews and a little more Arabs were killed, and not a thing was done by the authorities to prevent it.

In less than one hour the Jewish self-defense force had managed to throw a cordon between Tel-Aviv and the Arab sections of Jaffa. No Arab could pass to Tel-Aviv, and no Jew to Jaffa proper. And after one more hour there began—this time with the aid of the authorities—a systematic evacuation of the Arab section of the city, which had for some 80 years past housed peacefully side by side Jews and Moslems. Motor trucks carried the Jews with bag and baggage from their old dwelling places to Tel-Aviv. And

VICE-MAYOR DISMISSED BECAUSE HE IS A JEW

Berlin, Nov. 20.—Dr. Herz, Vice-Mayor of the Spandau suburb of Berlin, has been dismissed by a majority vote of the local Municipal Council. The President of the Council, in informing the Vice-Mayor of the decision, writes: "As a recognized and active solicitor in Altona before you took over this post, it will not be difficult for you to start your career as a solicitor again and thus provide for your family."

The central organ of the Social Democratic Party of Germany, the "Vorwaerts", writing on the subject of Dr. Herz's dismissal, condemns it as a violation of the Constitution of the country. "Councillor Dr. Herz", it writes, "has obtained wide recognition as an expert in Municipal affairs. But he has two faults. He is a Jew and he is a Social Democrat. The most serious of the two faults, we suppose, is that he is a Jew. Of course, all other considerations are valueless against such a fault, and a man who is guilty of it must be got rid of."

CONGRESS OF JEWISH YOUTH IN ITALY

Rome, Nov. 18.—A Congress of the Jewish Youth in Italy has just concluded its session at Leghorn. All the Jewish communities in Italy were represented, among those present being the President of the Federation of Italian Jewish Communities, and the Rabbis of the chief towns in Italy.

A message was received from Dr. Ch. Weizmann, President of the Zionist World Organization.

A telegram was sent to the King of Italy expressing the loyal sentiments of the Congress and recalling the spirit of liberty and equality in which the Sovereign has always interpreted the best traditions of Italy.

The question of the schools in Italy was discussed. A telegram was sent to the Minister of Education drawing his attention to the spiritual needs of the Jewish children in the country in view of the recent reforms in the school system, by which Catholic instruction is obligatory to all school children.

on the other hand, in the Nevo Sholem section and other "boundary lines" it was the Arabs who were ejected by the self-defense force from their homes.

Camping at first in tents, the refugees were at once put to work laying out streets and building roads, to prepare the ground for the new settlement. The slogan was "The Jews Will Not Return to Jaffa!"

And thus, out of the Arab pogrom, built by the refugees themselves, arose the city on the "Hill of the Springs"—Tel-Aviv. A city built by Jews, a city of the Jews, a city for the Jews.

MORTIMER L. SCHIFF GIVES \$25,000 TO JEWISH THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY

A gift of \$25,000 from Mr. Mortimer L. Schiff in honor of the seventieth birthday of his mother, Mrs. Jacob H. Schiff, was given to the Jewish Theological Seminary of America, according to an announcement made yesterday by Rabbi Max Drob, chairman of the One Million Dollar Endowment Fund Campaign. This is Mr. Schiff's second gift of \$25,000 towards this fund, of which \$950,000 has already been collected in cash and pledges from the Jews throughout the country.

During the past twelve months, Mr. Schiff has donated to the Jewish Theological Seminary approximately \$325,000. Sixty-four thousand dollars was contributed by him towards a fund which was devoted to the purchase of the Elkan Adler Library, the acquisition of which has made the library of the Jewish Theological Seminary the largest Jewish library in the world. Mr. Schiff also gave \$10,000 towards the purchase of the Israel Solomon collection and \$3,000 for re-arranging the library. Mr. Schiff recently gave jointly with Mr. Felix M. Warburg, his brother-in-law, the sum of \$215,000 to the Seminary for the purchase of a building adjoining the institution at 531 West 123rd Street, New York, to be used as a library building.

Mr. Schiff also presented several valuable manuscripts and a copy of the first Bible printed by Gutenberg, now in possession of the Library.

U. S. VISA REFUSED TO GRAND DUKE CYRIL, SELF-PROCLAIMED CZAR OF RUSSIA

A visa to go to America has been refused to Grand Duke Cyril of Russia by the French Government and American consular officials, according to a Paris cable to the New York "Times".

The Grand Duke, who has been living in France since the revolution, was hotly opposed to the French recognition of the Soviets and announced his intention of "taking refuge in the only country which so far has not recognized the Soviets." The so-called Czar has temporarily left Paris and taken refuge in Coburg, Germany.

The Grand Duchess arrived in Paris from Germany with a numerous suite, on her way to New York, for which she will sail Saturday to collect funds for Russian refugees. She was received by the Russian colony at the station with the full honor due an Empress.

LONDON JEWISH CHRONICLE PRAISES JEWISH DAILY BULLETIN

MUSSOLINI PROMISES TO PROTECT CATHOLIC RIGHTS IN PALESTINE

Rome, Nov. 18.—The Catholic Union for the protection of the Holy Places has forwarded to the Italian Prime Minister and to the Italian Minister for Foreign Affairs the resolution on Palestine and Zionism recently adopted by the Union and submitted by it to the Permanent Mandates Commission of the League of Nations at its last meeting at Geneva.

After reading the resolution, Signor Mussolini instructed the Prefect of the Province of Naples, where the headquarters of the Catholic Union for the Holy Places are situated, to assure the Union that the Government is watching the Catholic interests in Palestine with sympathy and will do everything possible to safeguard them.

The Catholic newspapers in Italy express their gratification at the declaration of the Government.

LOUIS LIPSKY ARRIVES IN LONDON

Conference were Father Day, who baptized Hans Herzl; Reverend Mellone, Lillie Montague and Laurie Magnus, Quakers, and Edward Bernstein.

Claude Montefiore, in closing the Conference, confessed at first he was hesitant about the practicability of calling such a conference for the purpose of bringing about a meeting between the majority and the minority not in the spirit of abnegation. "A common platform between the Jew and the Christian exists", he stated. "Christianity and Judaism are the two great religions upon which European civilization is built. The Conference has strengthened my belief in England, for only England could have produced such a conference. The aim was not a spiritual tug of war, but recognition of one religion by the other, instead of mere toleration."
