DISAGREEMENT ON LANGUAGE QUESTION LEADS TO FIST FIGHT AMONG WARSAW JEWISH LEADERS

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Warsaw, Dec. 15.—The disagreement between those who advocate Yiddish and the supporters of Hebrew as the language of instruction in the Jewish schools in Poland led to a fist fight, as a result of a resolution which was introduced and rejected in the Polish Parliament.

Deputy Noah Prilutzky introduced a resolution urging the Polish Government to grant subsidies for the Yiddish schools. The Club of Jewish Deputies proposed an amendment to the resolution, demanding subsidies for "Hebrew and manding substitutes for frebrew and viousin schools." As no agreement was reached between the Club oted against the resolution and he, in turn, voted against the Club's amendment. The Sejm rejected the entire resolution.

This parliamentary incident led to severe fights between the advocates of Hebrew and Yiddish. The between the advocates of riebrew and yiddish. The latter demanded that Isaac Greenbaum, Dr. Joshua Thon and Dr. Shipper be excluded from membership in the Jewish Writers and Journalists' Association of Poland as "traitors to Yiddish." Deputy Prilutzky's followers arranged a lecture by him in the Club of Jewish Writers and Journalists in order to afford him the connectionity of

nalists in order to afford him the opportunity of defending his attitude. When Greenbaum began his address, a fist fight developed in which journis address, a list light developed in which jour-nalists, writers, deputies and enthusiastic followers of both sides engaged. Police tried to intervene but withdrew from the hall when Deputy Shipper, who presided, assumed responsibility for the conduct of the meeting.

Scholom Ash, the well-known Jewish writer, who was present appealed to the audience, asking them not to dishonor the name of the writer's club.

Greenbaum was beaten. The meeting ended in chaos, one wing singing the Zionist hymn, Hatkivah, and the other the hymn of the Bundists, The Oath.

COUNCIL OF NATIONAL MINORITIES TO BE FORMED IN POLAND (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

ROUMANIAN GOVERNMENT ISSUES NEW INSTRUCTIONS FOR CITIZENSHIP APPLICANTS

(Jewish Daily Bulletin Mail Service)

Paris, Dec. 3.—The "Paix et Droit", official organ of the Alliance Israelite Universelle publishes the text of a statement issued by the Roumanian Minister of the Interior to all Prefects and Mayors Minister of the interior to all Prefects and Mayors in the country with regard to the regulations for conferring citizenship. The regulation which defines the Roumanian nationality, provides that persons domiciled in the old kingdom or in the annexed territories, except in places where they have administrative domicile or where they were born, have to submit their applications to the local administrative authorities, together with the docu-ments on which their applications are based. The authorities have been instructed to transmit such applications to the locality indicated by the applicants; the decisions of the administrative organs are to be communicated to the interested parties, with the date on which the forty days allowed for

appeal expire, indicated.

The Minister of the Interior, the statement proceeds, has received complaints from persons who have submitted applications accompanied by documents, including their army discharge papers, that their documents have not been returned to them, and that no reply has been made to their applicaand that no reply has been made to their appica-tions which would enable them to lodge an appeal within the time allowed. The Minister of the In-terior, therefore, instructs all Prefects and Mayors of the annexed provinces that the commissions for military recruiting are examining the discharge papers of all applicants. It is therefore necessary that the discharge papers should be immediately returned to the interested parties, after cognizance has been taken of the facts contained in them, for the purpose of verification of the claims for citizenship. Mention should also be made that there is a right of appeal within forty days, and notice should be given of this in time to allow the appeal to be lodged.

ARAB PAPER COMPLAINS AGAINST THREE LANGUAGE SYSTEM IN PALESTINE

(Tewish Telegraphic Agency)

Jerusalem, Nov. 27—Complaint against the three language system in Palestine, and the dominance of English is voiced by the Arab paper, "Al-Jezirah." English is voiced by the Arab paper, "Al-Jezirah."
"It is a fact," the paper states, "that the official language in Palestine is neither the language spoken by the majority nor that of the Jewish minority, but English, the language of our imperialist rulers. The proportion of Arabs who know the English language is not over one per thousand. Hebrew language is not over one per thousand. Hebrew is spoken by only ten per cent of the Palestine Jews. Anyone living among the Jews may see for himself that Palestine has become a Tower of Babel, where they speak every language but Hebrew, which they are now learning in special evening schools.

"English is the only language used by the ma-jority of the Government Departments in all their jority of the Government Departments in all their proceedings. It has replaced the Turkish language of the old regime. What then, is the difference between the past and the present? The Government might explain that if it employed Arabic it would provoke protests from the Jews and if it used Hehrew it would arouse the wrath of the Arabis. Therefore, it uses English. Such an apol-

ogy is worse than a fault.
"Disregarding the expenses incurred in employing translators in Government offices, we must consider the more serious point of the appointment of new officials. A knowledge of English is the first requirement for appointment to a post in the Gov-ernment offices. This destroys the chances of Mosernment onces. In descroys the chalces of Mos-lems who were trained in Turkish schools and have no knowledge of any European language, except a little French. The Government of Palestine is re-sponsible for this injustice and for the barring of Moslems from public positions," the paper concludes. No. 53.

WHAT THE PERMANENT MANDATES COM-MISSION RECOMMENDED TO THE LEAGUE COUNCIL CONCERNING THE ARAB PETITION

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service) Geneva, Dec. 7.-The revised text of the report

It also devoted a portion of its meeting on the afternoon of Oc-tober 30th to the special examination of the report toper solution. After discussion, the Commission drew up its conclusions. It notes that the petition contains two kinds of complaints which it is necessary to separate clearly from one another: (a) First, the petitioners allege a large number of facts which if found to be accurate should be regarded as administrative abuses; and (b) Secondly, the peas administrative address; and (b) Secondry, the petitioners protest against the terms of the Mandate itself as established by the Council of the League of Nations on July 2th, 1922. With regard to the facts in the first category, the Commission having tacts in the first category, the Commission maying fard the High Commissioner's statements contesting the accuracy of certain of the facts mentioned, and explaining others, is of the opinion that there is no need to recommend the Council to take any action in the matter. If, however, the signatories desire to present a petition on any specific point, in accordance with the rules of procedure, the Mandates Commission will be ready to consider it. The Commission proposes that the Council should transmit to the petitioners the text of the present resolution, together with the Minutes of the discussions of its Sessions relating to the Palestine Mandace, containing the High Commissioner's replies to questions asked.

"As regards the protests of the petitioners against the terms of the Mandate itself, and more especially as regards the desire for the establishment in Palestine of a fundamentally different regime from that of the Mandate at present in force, the Commission considering its task confined to super-vising the execution of the Mandate in the terms prescribed by the Council, is of opinion that it is not competent to discuss the matter."

JEWISH IMMIGRATION INTO MEXICO IN-CREASES; INCOMING GROUPS HAVE PROFESSIONS AND TRADES (Tewish Daily Bulletin Special Despatch)

Mexico City, Dec. 15.-Jewish immigration on a large scale into Mexico is no longer a probability: it has become an established fact. Each boat to the port of Vera Cruz brings an ever-increasing number of Jews. The number of immigrants has increased from an average of seventy-five to five hundred a month, and it will continue to grow, ac-cording to the reports of the newly arrived. With Mexico's present status as a refuge for

With Mexico's present status as a retuge for homeless Jews, the attitude of the immigrants has changed. They come here, now, not to stay the length of time necessary for the': [egitimate entrance into the United States ... Mexican clitzens; but with the prospect of making their homes in Mexico. In the port of Constantinople alone, according to an immigrant from there. There were cording to an immigrant from there, there are thousands of Jews with the sole idea of reaching Mexico. These immigrants will reach Mexico not later than the month of February, coming as they do in relatively small detachments. The majority of them are Russians and Ukrainians, some Poles and Lithuanians, Czecho-Slovakians, Germans and others from the region of the Balkans.

Statistics compiled from the employment register of the B'nai B'rith agency in Mexico City show that approximately sixty or seventy per cent have trades and professions, and part of the remainder have some experience or apprenticeship The number of merchants hardly ex-en per cent. While the distribution in them. ceeds fifteen per cent. varies with each boat, the entire proportion runs something like from ten to fourteen per cent tailors and seamstresses, ten per cent shoemakers, ten or fifteen per cent mechanics and three to

four per cent carpenters.

BOOK REVIEWS

"Liberalizing Liberal Judaism" (Macmillan) by James Waterman Wise is a book dealing mainly with the problem of "the descendents of believers in Judaism." The circle which it embraces is, however, much larger, for not only does the problem concern the descendants of German Jews and the "ever increasing number of East European Jews," as the author himself puts it, but it is of great interest to everyone who has learned to think of religion in terms of historical development and is willing to search for the truth in religion. essenth for the truth in religion. willing to search for the truth in religion, even

at the risk of the discomfort of doubt. Once the principle laid down by the author that the purpose of religion is to help man to "live well"—a principle which is so basically in accordance with Jewish doctrine-is agreed upon, the other conclusions, presented so forcibly, seem to be a logical consequence and an expression of a

sincere striving for religious truth.

Taking Judaism as the point of departure, through the process of spiritual development, safety from the standpoint of Jewishness is secured in advance. However, the candor with which the author treats the entire problem reaches the point of revolutionary endeavor. Although it may ap-pear very difficult at first to accept some of the suggestions made by the author, this book is a valuable contribution to modern Jewish religious thought.

The first American edition of "Yiddish Folk ongs", adapted for voice and piano, made its appearance. The Bloch Publishing Company deserves credit for issuing the collection of fifty Yiddish folk songs by Sarah Pitkowsky Schack, pro-viding a novel feature for the American Jewish

Folk songs depict the soul of the people—their sorrow, their joy, their struggle and their hope. In former times, before the synagogue reached its In former times, octore the synagogue reached its stage of stagnation, folk songs were a welcome feature even in the synagogue service. The Orthodox prayer book contains a number of folk songs composed in the Aramaic language. The Selichoth and the Knoth are largely productions of a similar nature, although they are framed more in

a similar nature, although they are trained more in the style of a prayer.

The Jewish Folk Songs, which are the products of the Yiddish language period, possess both in contents and melody such a direct appeal to Jewish sentiment and philosophy of life, that they are of unusual interest to even those who are already a generation apart from the mode of life they portray. In fact, as an educational means and one which at the same time is of entertaining value, they are unparallel and much sought in Jewish home life and family gatherings.
