Warsaw, Dec. 16.—The editors of three Polish anti-Semitic papers, "Gazeta Warszawska", "Rzezpospolita" and "Roswo", were summoned to court for the third time to account for publishing libelous statements in which Deputy Isazz Greenhaum was accused of anti-Polish activities.

In 1922 the papers published a report of a Jew-ish conference which was supposed to have been held in London where Greenbaum, a member of the Polish Parliament, was reported to have spoken against the Polish state and prompted the adoption of a resolution against the Polish Republic.

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Jerusalem, Dec. 16 .- One hundred delegates, representing all the Jewish settlements and com-munities in Palestine, participated in a conference held last night in Tel Aviv for the purpose of considering the necessary measures to be taken to as-

sidering the necessary measures to be taken to as-sist new immigrants who are coming to Palestine. Representatives of the Zionist Executive in Pal-estine and the Vaad Leumi, the Jewish National Coancil of Palestine, were present. Fifty-eight per cent of the Jewish immigrants who come to Palestine are in possession of finan-tic the palestine are in possession of financial means with which to establish themselves, according to a report submitted to the conference. The sum of £342,000 was brought into the country by Jewish immigrants in the course of the last six months. Fifty-three per cent of those who pos-

Fifty thousand Jews have entered the country since 1919, according to the report submitted.

DAILY DIGEST OF PUBLIC OPINION ON JEWISH MATTERS

Sees Danger in Duchess Cyril's Activities Possible serious consequences of the activities here of the Grand Duchess Cyril, who is progagating the cause of her husband, Duke Cyril, self-proclaimed "Czar of All Russia", is previsioned by the "Forward" of December 13.

"Soon after the arrival of the Duchess", says the "Forward", "we were assured in her own name and in the name of the aristocratic ladies who brought her over here, that her visit had nothing to do with political motives. And indeed the Duchess at first refused to make any statements on the subject of her husband's pretensions to the Russian throne.

"Now, however, we find that her visit here is far from being devoid of political motives. It is reported from Washington that the high society women have been exerting themselves very strenuously to secure for the Duchess an official welcome from the government.

"This shows very plainly that the aristocratic women are working directly to help the Roman-offs regain the Russian throne. These women are not "nobodys". They are the wives of the greatest financiers in the country, men who have a tremendous influence in the highest circles of our government. It is hard to believe that these women have gone into this enterprise without the approval of their husbands.

This matter is assuming a serious character, for it is not impossible that our government may take a friendly attitude toward the Cyril enterprise. It is highly important to keep an eye on this thing.

Contract Labor in Disguise

They always demanded such a law, according to which our government would actually become the agent for supplying the capi-culies with charm labor whenever they might be talists with cheap labor whenever they might be in need of it. This is contrary to the old law prohibiting the importation of contract labor; it would mean importing competitors to the workers in this country; it would mean keeping the workers here in constant fear."

How Roumania Metes Out Justice To The Jews.

In Transylvania (By Our Correspondent, D. Jacobi)

Bucharest, Dec. 8.-The special representative Bucharest, Dec. 8—The special representative of the J. T. A. has just returned after investigating conditions in the province of Transylvania on the spot for several months. The Jewish minority in the province numbers about 250,000 out of a total population of six million. Mostly, they are concentrated in the towns, but there is a considerable Jewish population also in the villages; in the district of Marmaros there are a large number of Jewish peasants and about thirty to forty completely Jewish "lages. In the towns of Szat-mar and Marmaros Siget, the Jews form a majority of the population. In most other towns they joint of the population. In most other, towns tary are a very large section of the population. Jew-ish landed property in the province, which was at one time considerable, has been largely re-duced by means of "land nationalisation", which practically results in dispossession of the minorities

When Transylvania was part of Hungary, the language of instruction in the schools was Hungarian. Under the Treaty of Trianon, the minority populations have been given the right to have minority schools with the language of instruction their mother tongue. The Government maintains that the Iews are not a minority in the sense of the Treaty, that they are Roumanians of the Jewish faith and are therefore obliged to use Roumanian as the longuage of instruction in their schools. They may have Jewish schools, but the language of instruction in those schools must be Roumanian. The Jewish teachers in the province, who received their training when Transylvania was Hungarian, are not sufficiently competent in the Roumanian are not sunficiently competent in the Kommanian language. The establishment of a Jewish teachers' training-college is not permitted, and the admission into the country of Jewish teachers from abroad is refused by the authorities. The Jewish children are therefore compelled to attend the Roumanian Government schools in which no attention is paid to the special requirements of the Jewish religious teaching, and where they are compelled to attend on the Sabbath and are subjected to anti-Semitic attacks by both teachers and pupils. Soon after the annexation of Trans-ylvania, the Roumanian Government agreed to permit the establishment of Jewish secondary schools on condition that within a transition period of seven years the language of instruction in these schools should be made Roumanian or Hebrew. This provision has been withdrawn by the present Government and it is now demanded that Roumanian shall be immediately made the language of instruction.

HEINE WAS OF ARYAN ORIGIN, ANTI-SEMITE CLAIMS (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Berlin, Dec. 16.-Heinrich Heine, Germany's poet who during his lifetime and after death was declared to be a Jew in spite of his Baptism and was denounced by German Nationalists, was not of Semitic origin, but of Aryan blood, according to Dr. Paul Koerner who printed an article to this effect in the various publications of the anti-Semitic Voelkische Party

According to Dr. Koerner, Heine was the natural son of a Prussian aristocrat and a Jewish mother. To prove his thesis he quotes Heine as speaking about his "deep native German feelings" and says that every one "even the bitterest opponent of the Jews finds in Heine's work so many references which give every Aryan heart a rare and joyful purely German sensation".

DISAGREEMENT OF BOLSHEVIST LEADERS CAUSES ANXIETY AMONG UKRAINIAN

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Warsaw, Dec. 16.—Travellers who have arrived recently from Ukrainia report that there is an increased nervousness felt among the Jewish population of Ukrainia on account of the political tension prevailing at present among the Bolshevist The disagreement between Trotzky and rulers. the triumverate, and his resignation as War Minister, is considered as a precursor of a much graver situation.

The Jews in Ukrania who have suffered under the intense anti-Semitic tactics of the Soviet Government, who, in their attempt to Ukrainize the entire administration, have removed even Jewish communists from their positions, are afraid of catastrophic consequences should the conflict between Trotzy and the other Commissars reach a critical state.

The anti-Semitic feeling among the peasantry was never stronger than now and despite all barriers which make emigration practically impos-sible for Ukrainian Jews who desire to leave Russia some have succeeded in reaching the Polish frontier.

SEVENTY THOUSAND ALIENS TO BE EX-PELLED FROM ROUMANIA (Tewish Telegraphic Agency)

Vienna, Dec. 16.—Two decrees, expected to be issued shortly by the Roumanian Government, will affect many Jews now living in Roumania, according to reports received here from Bucharest. One decree will concern the fate of seventy

thousand aliens who will have to leave the country because their residence in Roumania is con-

sidered undesirable by the political police.

The other will deal with the allocation of 100,000 Russian and Ukrainian emigrants, who will be placed in territories which they will not be allowed to leave without a permit from the government.
