JOIN DRUZE REBELLION WAHABIS AGAINST FRANCE

Strive to Acquire Damascus As Capital of Wahabi Empire; Rabbi Tager, Chief Rabbi of Damascus, Threatened by Rebels

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Paris, Feb. 16.-Diplomatic advices from Syria say that 10,000 Wahabi soldiers, having crossed the desert of Transjordania, are now at the borders of Diebel Druze and have allied themselves with the Bedouins against the French.

The report says a large force of Wahabis are at Ouadi-Moussi, in Transjordania, practically on the border of Syria. These troops are in British controlled territory and if the report of the number and location is correct, the situation may well cause complications between the British and the French

in Asia Minor. Henri de Jouvenel, the French High Commissioner in Syria, who has been in Angora trying to induce the Turks to withdraw their support of the Diuzes, is now hurrying back to Syria. His hopes of "Locarno pacts" between the Syrian tribes, ap-

parently have failed. If the Wahabis are to add to the Syrian troubles the situation may well become worse. The Wahabis after their Hedjaz victory and the capture of Mecca, wish to get Damascus as the capital of their Islam Empire. Beyond a doubt Ibn Saud has been supply-

ing the Druzes with arms and ammunition.

The wamittee is composed of representatives of all classes of the Jewish population, the Jewish press, the associations of the Jewish merchants, artisans, and writers and journalists. The committee decided to issue an appeal to the Jewish population of Warsaw, urging mutual aid.

RIVY COUNCIL, HIGHEST COURT I ENGLAND, ANNULS RULING OF PALES-PRIVY TINE SUPREME COURT IN JERU-SALEM WATER QUESTION

Declares That Court Misinterpreted Article II of Palestine Mandate

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, Feb. 16 .- The Privy Council, the highest court in England, annulled the judgment of the Palestine Supreme Court in the Jerusalem-Urtas water dispute.

Judgment, which was handed down by the judicial committee of the Privy Council, permitted the governor of Jerusalem to appeal against the Urtas governor of Jerusalem to appeal against the Urtas water court. The Privy Council delared that an ordi-nance of the Palestine Supreme Court. The aside the ruling of the Supreme Court. The Urtas villagers' petition was dismissed and the respondents have to pay the cost of the proceedings, including the cost of the appeal.

The Lord Chancellor in handing down the judg-ment declared that the interpretation of the Palestine Supreme Court of Article II of the mandate in a supreme Court of Article 11 of the mandate is not justified. "If all civil rights of every inhabitant existing at the date of the mandate would be enforced, nothing in Falestine would be altered as long as the mandate is in force and effective

legislature would be impossible, he declared.

### WRITINGS OF MOSES MENDELSOHN TO BE REPUBLISHED ON 200TH ANNIVER-SARY OF HIS BIRTH

His Life Marked Beginning of New Epoch (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Berlin, Feb. 16 .- The writings of Moses Mendelsohn, the great German Jewish philosopher with whose life the epoch of enlightenment and eman-cipation in Jewry began, will be republished on the occasion of the two hundredth anniversary of his

This decision was taken by a special committee established in the city of Berlin for the purpose of preparing a complete and critical edition of Mendelsohn's works. It is expected that the volumes deisonn's works. It is expected that the volumes will appear in 1929, when the two hundredth anniversary of his birth will be celebrated.

All persons who are in possession of Mendelsohn manuscripts, letters and first editions were urged to

notify the committee. Moses Mendelsohn was born in Dessau, Septem-

Moses Menucisonn was born in Dessay, September 6, 1729. He died in Berlin, January 4, 1786, Among his best known works are "Jerusalem," "Phaedon" and "Morgenstunden."

#### HAKENKREUZLER DESECRATE MEMO-RIAL TO JEWISH WAR HEROES (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Berlin, Feb. 16.—The Jewish population in Karls-ruhe was terrorized last Sunday night by a band of Hakenkreuzler, according to reports received here.

The Hakenkreuzler stormed Jewish houses and broke into the synagogue, where they demolished the memorial tablets to the Jewish soldiers in the German army who fell during the World War.

#### COMMISSION PERMANENT MANDATES HOLDS EXTRAORDINARY SESSION IN ROME TO CONSIDER SYRIAN SITUATION

Italy Aspires to Mandate Over Syria, It Is Stated (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Rome, Feb. 16.—An extraordinary session of the Permanent Mandates Commission of the League of Nations was opened here this morning

detailed memorandum concerning the situation in Syria was submitted to the Commission by the French Colonial Office. A petition of the Syro-Palestine Committee was also submitted to the commission.

The petition of the Syrio-Palestine Committee states the views of the Palestine Arabs and the Egyptians, demanding that France abandon its mandate over Syria. M. Decaix represents France on the commission. Dr. Victor Jacobson, political representative of the Zionist Executive, arrived here today.

Rome, Feb. 16.-The extraordinary session of the Permanent Mandates Commission of the League of Nations was arranged to be held here at the special request of Premier Mussolini, the correspondent of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency here learns from authoritative sources. In well-informed political circles, it was stated today that Italy is greatly in-terested in the future of Syria, in connection with the opposition to the French mandate. In the event that France wishes to give up her mandate, Italy is inclined to accept the responsibility for Syria on the same conditions as France.

Rumors current here, although they remained unconfirmed, add that important members of the Council of the League of Nations are favorably inclined toward an Italian mandate over Syria.

#### GENDARMERIE IN PALESTINE BRITISH DEMOBILIZED, OFFICIAL ANNOUNCE-MENT STATES

Jerusalen, Feb. 16.-The British gendarmerie in Palestine will be demobilized, according to an official statement made known here.

The Palestine gendarmerie will be reorganized. The Jewish members of it will be transferred to the police force, while the Arabs and Circassians will form the Palestine and Transjordania frontier The Arabs will remain in the service in Palestine, while the Circassians will serve in Transjordania.

## Criticizes the "Agudath Israel"

The Agudath Israel, the Jewish world orthodox organization, is characterized by B. Z. Goldberg in the "Day" of Feb. 16, as a menace to Jewish unity because of its recent activities, which have especially

because of its recent activities, which have especially tended, he avers, to place obstacles in the way of Palestine reconstruction. "The Agudath Israel," we are told by Mr. Gold-berg "originated in Frankfort. There was a German rabbi named Samson Raphael Hirsch, who had received a thorough Jewish education as well as a classical German education. Ninety years ago he wrote a series of nineteen letters about Judaism in German, signed 'Ben Uziel.' That was a new combination in those days—classical German in a 'yar-mulke' (skull cap), university training and extreme orthodoxy. He was a fighter against Reform." Rabbi Hirsch became rabbi of the orthodox congregation in Frankfort, which, the writer says, always sought to spread its influence

"They (the Frankfort Jews) wanted to make connections with the Jewish world, and in the be-ginning of this century, in 1904, I think, the Agu-dath Israel was organized by Dr. Isaak Breuer, a son in-law of S. R. Hirsch, with the assistance at

a few Russian rabbis."

It was not until the world war. Mr. Goldberg points out, that the Agudah acquired power in Jewish life. The German government, during the time of Germany's occupation of Poland, employed mem bers of the Agudah for propaganda purposes, send-ing them among the Polish Jews to create sentiment for Germany. "The Agudah in Poland is a considerable party and has almost forty per cent representation in the Kehillah, but it must be borne in mind that in Poland, unlike in other countries, the Agudah goes with all other Jewish parties, even with the radical Bundists.

"Of course" the writer proceeds "the Agudah was thoroughly opposed to Zionism. It was assimilationist in all Jewish questions except religion. The Agudah fought against Zionism. It was only after the Balfour Declaration that the Agudah came

to Zionism.

But even since that time, Mr. Goldberg says, the Agudah has been seeking to disrupt Zionist unity.

"In Palestine proper two of the Agudah leaders have been sadly famous," he says. "Rabbi Sonenfeld, who holds that Jews must not work at all, but study, and DeHahn who actually informed on the Jews and went to the British administration against

Jews and went to the British administration against the interests of the new Jewish settlement. . . . "Now the Agudah delegation from Europe has come to America. The head of the delegation is Dr. Ehrmann, a grandson of S. R. Hirsch. They have come here to start a campaign for their Keren Ha'yishub." The Agudah, we are told, wants to uphold the old Jewish settlement in Palestine which is based and subsists on charity, as against the new reconstructive settlement, and "this explains the ra-son why the Mizrachi as well as the Jabloner Rabbi and his followers are so opposed to the

Agudah.

"I believe the Agudah question is more than a Zionist question. It is a general Jewish question This is the first time in our history that we have before us a strong organization of Jewish clericals who are sufficiently bold as well as politically trained to cause considerable trouble.

"If they get the power, they will become a dark force in Jewry. . . "

## CONFERENCE TO FORM INTERNATIONAL UNION OF LIBERAL JEWS WILL MEET IN LONDON JULY 10

Will Frame Constitution for International Body and Discuss Practice of Judaism in Modern Times

(Tewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, Feb. 16 .- The international conference of leaders of Reform Jewish congregations will take place here the second week of July, according to a report submitted to the Jewish Religious Union, the English body of Reform Jews, by the Hon. Lily Montagu, secretary of the Union.

Miss Montagu reported that the Central Conference of American Rabbis, the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, the heads of the German lewish liberal movement and members of the French liberals, were approached with a view to forming an international union of liberal Jewish congrega-tions. Encouraging replies were received. Representatives of these bodies have promised to attend the conference

A Jewish Religious Union has been formed in India and was invited to send delegates to the conference. Inquiries were also made in Scandinavia, Italy, Belgium, Holland and Central Europe, the secretary reported. With regard to the latter countries, it appears that while there are individual liberal Jewish teachers, there are no liberal congregations.

The Conference which will begin on July 10, will last three days and will consider the f-aming of a constitution for the international union, for the purpose of giving the various congregations an opportunity to cooperate with each other without interfering with their complete autonomy. It is planned that the agenda will include a discussion on "The Outlook for Judaism," "Judaism and the Bible" and "The Practice of Judaism in Modern Times."

Berlin, Feb. 16.-The application of the German Republic for admission to membership in the League of Nations was welcomed at a mass meeting arranged here last night by the Jewish People's

Party. Speakers at the meeting stressed the necessity of keeping the representatives of Germany in the Council of the League well posted concerning the Palestine mandate and the national minorities treaties.

A number of nationalistic German newspapers, including the "Deutsche Zeitung" and the "Schlesische Volkstimme" conduct propaganda against Germany's entry in the League. These papers, reporting a part of the address of Dr. Alfred Klee, in which he stated that the idea of the League of Nations had "Dr. Klee has divulged the secret that the League of Nations is a Jewish creation."

#### RISHON L'ZION **GIVES** FREEDOM OF TOWNSHIP TO REUBEN BRAININ (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Jerusalem, Feb. 16.—Reuben Brainin, well known Hebrew writer of America, was given the freedom of the township of Rishon L'Zion, one of the oldest Jewish colonies in Palestine, at a public reception accorded the guest on his visit there.

The municipality offered Mr. Brainin a building lot, in order that he might settle in Rishon L'Zion.

SEPH VASZONY, MEMBER OF HUN-GARIAN LIBERAL OPPOSITION, AT-JOSEPH TACKED ON WAY TO PARLIAMENT Assailants Members of Anti-Semitic Organization,

Awakening Magyars. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Budapest, Feb. 16.—Deputy Joseph Vaszony, former cabinet member and leader of the liberal opposition, noted for his stand against the Bethlen government in the counterfeiting plot, was attacked today on his way to parliament.

He was hit over the head and seriously injured. His assailants, who were arrested, are members of the anti-Semitic organization, the Awakening Magyars, it was stated. They had in their possession firearms which they would have used had they not been prevented from doing so by passersby who disarmed them.

A stormy meeting took place in parliament, where the opposition introduced an interpellation concerning the matter. Count Bethlen, the Prime Minister, promised to take measures immediately to punish Vaszony's assailants.

## PALESTINE OCCUPIES FIRST PLACE A COUNTRY OF LARGEST JEWISH IMMI-GRATION, FIGURES SHOW

### Has Largest Percentage of Jewish Population (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Jerusalem, Feb. 16 .- Palestine occupies the first place as a center for Jewish immigration, according to figures published by the Zionist Executive here. Palestine today has the highest percentage of Jewish population of any country.

Palestine is also, according to these figures, the fourteenth largest Jewish center in the world.

During the last fiscal year, ending June, 1925, 10,392 Jews were admitted into the United States, as compared with 29,142 Jews admitted into Palestine in the same period. During this same year 7,800 Jews were admitted to Argentina and 4,200 to Canada.

The Jewish population of Palestine is 16.5 per the Jewish population of Palestine is 10.5 per cent of the total population, a percentage larger than that of the Jewish population in Poland, where the Jews constitute only 12.9 per cent. Poland, which formerly had the largest Jewish percentage, has thus become second.
