ROUMANIAN STUDENT STRIKE BROKEN Numerus Clausus Will Not Be Introduced. Deans' Conference Decides

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Bucharest, Mar. 1.- The numerus clausus against the Jewish students in the Roumanian Universities will not be introduced, according to a decision taken at a conference of the deans of Roumanian univer-sities with Under-State Secretary Angelescu.

The strike of the anti-Semitic students was broken. Lectures have begun again at the colleges. Four of the students who participated in the anti-Jewish demonstrations during the middle of February were sentenced by the court, two to one month

in prison, two to two weeks. The rest were acquitted.
The conference of the deans also decided against accepting regulations compelling the Jewish communities to furnish Jewish corpses for the clinics, as demanded by Professor Alexander Cuza, leader of the Roumanian anti-Semitic movement.

GERMAN JEWISH AN JEWISH HILFSVEREIN CELE-BRATES 25TH ANNIVERSARY Expended 47,000,000 Marks for Education and

Berlin, Mar. 1 .- The twenty-fifth anniversary of the establishment of the Hilfsverein der Deutschen Juden, the relief organization of German Jewry, will be celebrated here in May.

In connection with this anniversary, the organization will issue a report of its activities up to the

end of the war.

It appears from a preliminary report that the organization has expended 47,000,000 marks for relief of Jewish distressed and for education of the Jewish youth in the East European countries and in the Orient.

The same leaders who organized the Hilfsverein are still at its head: Herr James Simon, president, Dr. Paul Nathan, vice-president and Eugene Landau.

Thon of the Palestine Land Development Co. and Mr. Goldwater of the Economic Board for Palestine.

Roumanian students attacked the Jewish passengers, using clubs and knives. Over one hundred Jews were injured, among them Leib Essler, Jacob Bercovic, Leibisch Elefant, Wolf Rotmann.

UNKNOWN PHILANTHROPIST DISTRI-BUTES MONEY IN LONDON JEWISH OUARTER

Bernard Baron Believed To Be "Mysterious

Stranger" (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Mar. 1.-The Jewish population of London, Whitechapel was greatly puzzled by the appearance of a stranger who distributed money in the district.

The stranger came to Buxton Street, Brick Lane, on several evenings and distributed sums of between £10 and £15 among the people in the street. The sums distributed totaled about £100 on each visit. The "Daily News" stated yesterday that the

stranger is believed to be Bernard Baron, Jewish philanthropist who recently gave large gifts for charity, including £10,000 for the Hebrew University. When asked by a representative of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, Mr. Baron declined to affirm or deny the report.

MONARCHY SOUGHT AS CURE FOR POLAND'S FINANCIAL CRISIS

(Tewish Telegraphic Agency)

Warsaw, Mar. 1.—Advocacy of the monarchistic form of government as a solution for the present economic crisis in the country is assuming the proportions of a movement. It is intended to amend

the Polish constitution in this direction.

The National Democratic Party, the largest parliamentary group which holds 100 seats in the Diet, has decided to increase the power of the president and to pass a new electoral law. The Christian Nationalists who hold 20 seats in the Diet, as well as the Conservative Party of Posen have decided to work for the establishment of a heredity monarchy and to amend the electoral law. The Peasants Party and the Radical Peasants Party are reported to be in favor of the monarchistic idea. amendment of the electoral law is believed to aim at a Polish homogeneous majority in the Diet.

COMMUNIST OFFICIALS SENTENCED TO JAIL FOR TERRORIZING JEWISH POPULATION

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Moscow, Mar. 1.—Three Communist officials were sentenced to prison for terrorizing the Jewisl population, in a trial which lasted twenty days.

The case was brought against Gutkin, president of the district Soviet in Luhin, Podol; Tchebetarioff, secretary of the Soviet, and Judge Sokolow. The three officials and a number of others were charged with bribery, corruption and terrorizing the population.

Gutkin was sentenced to nine years imprison-ment, Tchebetarioff to five years and Sokolow to four and one half years. The other officials re-ceived sentences of from one to two years.

Tchebetarioff arrested the president of the Kereason. Judge Sokolow staged a false trial against them. Gutkin closed the Jewish cemetery and fined the poor heavily. One hundred and and fined the poor heavily. One fifty witnesses testified against them.

FUNDS FOR JEWISH COLONIZATION IN RUSSIA REDUCED, CHARKOFF CON-FERENCE OF COLONIZATION WORKERS HEARS

. Rosen Warns Against Turning Ozet Into Battlefield Against Zionists; Settlers' Numbers Reduced from 10,000 to 4,000, Merezhin Says

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Moscow, Mar. 1.-The sums originally allotted by the Joint Distribution Committee for settling Jews on the land in Russia were reduced, Dr. Joseph Rosen, head of the Agrojoint, the agency of the Joint Distribution Committee in Soviet Russia declared in an address delivered at a conference

of the Ozet, the Jewish society for settling Jews on the land, held in Charkoff.

"I will be the happiest man on earth when you will say, 'We don't need your help any more,' " Dr. Rosen declared.

Admitting that the sum for the colonization work in Russia was reduced under Zionist pressure, Dr. Rosen stated that the colonization work in Russia has, nevertheless, many friends among Zionists in Russia and abroad. He sharply protested against the spreading of calumnies against the colonization.

"The Ozer, however, must beware of turning the society into a battlefield against the Zionists. Beat your opponents with the facts. The cooler you act, the greater the effect," Dr. Rosen stated.

M. Merezhin, leader of the Ozet, replying to Dr. Rosen declared that "Nobody wants to turn the Ozet into a battlefield against the Zionists. However, when we are asked by the masses who it is who hinders the colonization work and why the number of settlers on the land this year was reduced from 10,000 to 4,000, we are obliged to tell the truth."

Mr. Mcrezhin bitterly attacked Sokolow, Jaborinsky and Bialik for carrying on propaganda in America against the colonization work. He accused them of portraying only the dark side of Russian life and withholding everything favorable.

BALTIMORE BRANCH OF ALLIANCE IS-RAELITE UNIVERSELLE ELECTS OFFICERS (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Baltimore, Md., Mar. 1.-The activity of the Alliance Israelite Universeile before the Council of the League of Nations was emphasized at a meeting of the Baltimore branch of the organization in the address of the president, B. H. Hartogensis.

Mr. Hartogensis said the Alliance had taken particular pains to keep the League Council informed as to the deprivation of minority groups in South-eastern Europe. Jews, he said, suffered most, being excluded from schools from rights to trade and from equal rights at law. He said this was truly notably in Hungary, Poland and Roumania.

Besides Mr. Hartogensis, the following officers were elected: William Levy, vice-president; Herman Gamse, treasurer, and Herbert Miller, secretary.

JEWISH POPULATION OF BAVARIA DE-CREASING

Berlin, Feb. 9.-The Jewish population Bavaria is decreasing, according to figures pub-lished here. The Jewish population was 49,163, as against \$4,77 on December 1st, 1910, a decrease of 5,014, in spite of the natural increase during of 2.014, in spite of the natural increase during the past fifteen years, according to the figures which were published by the "Bayerische Israelitische Gemeindereitung." The Jewish communities containing more than 1,000 members are Munich City. 16,058 (in 1910, 11,085); Munich Pistrict, 10,587 (11,539); Luewigshafen, 1,241 (733); Fuerth, 2,304 (2,256); Nuremberg, 8,603 (7,351); Wierzburg, 2,261 (2,514); and Angsburg, 1,203 (1,217).

There are in Hungary a large number of very Con-servative-minded people and avowed anti-Semites, but they are nevertheless no race protectors. The but mey are nevertheress to race protectors. Ine-left are wrong in terming these people race pro-tectors because they are thereby driving them into the camp of the race protectors. By race protectors we understand above all, people of Nationalisi views, both in internal and foreign affairs, who are not far removed from the idea of a dictatorship. In addition to that, they have their well-known anti-Semitic program. According to this definition I can say that so far as I know, there are no race protectors in prominent State positions. On the other hand, it is right to say that there are men of extreme Conservative and anti-Semitic views holding such positions."

UNITED SYNAGOGUE CONVENTION TO BE HELD IN BALTIMORE

Baltimore, Md., Mar. 1.—Preparations are being made for the fourteenth annual convention of the United Synagogues of America to be held here on April IS and 19. It will be a notable gathering and will bring together some of the foremost Jews of the United States and Canada. The delegates, of whom more than 700 are expected, will represent about 200 various synagogues.

President Coolidge has signified his pleasure of meeting the delegates in Washington, following the convention here. Washington Jewry will escort the delegates to the Capital City where sessions will be resumed after the visit to the White House

Probably the most important of the questions to be considered at the convention here will be the adoption of a uniform prayer book for all Orthodox congregations and the proposed establishment of a Jewish Center and synagogue in Jerusalem. Orthodox Jewry never have had a modern synagogue in the Holy City.

CAPTAIN ECKENER, PILOT OF Z. R. 3, ATTACKED BECAUSE OF JEWISH ORIGIN Nationalist Students Object to His Participation

At the celebrations, however, Captain Eckener was given a tumultuous welcome.

R. 3, Dr. Karl Arnstein, because of their Jewish origin, the "Deutsche Zeitung" even suggesting that Dr. Arnstein was not completely a Jew, his father having been a German Bohemian Jew and his mother a German Catholic.

RUSSIAN REFUGEES Have the Feelings of Humanity Become Blunted?

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service) Berlin, Feb. 11.-An appeal on behalf of the Russian refugees is made by Dr. Fridtjof Nansen in an article contributed to the "Deutsche Allgemeine Zeitung" here in connection with the conference to consider refugee problems which is to be

held this month in Geneva.

"Have the feelings of humanity become blunted?" Dr. Nansen asked. "Have we become hardened by the glut of misery and suffering in the last few years? Something of that kind must have happened, for in earlier times it was not necessary to do so much in order to rouse the desire to help in mankind. A fire in a town, an earthquake, a few people left without a roof over their heads, and recrybody was there eager to help. And now cries help go up from thousands and tens of thousands to refugees, innocently suffering and dying and those who were once so ready to help hear them but act as if they had not heard, for it is certain that they find it more convenient so.

In Poland, where a large number of refugees had been concentrated, the order went forth one fine day that all those who had crossed the frontier from Russia without permission and could not show that they were political refugees must leave Polish territory. Practically all these refugees were Russian Jews, numbering thousands. To go back to Russia was impossible without running the risk of being shot. To go over the borders into another country was also impossible, so they were driven across the frontier to Datzig. They could not be kept in such a small community, so they were tossed backwards and forwards like termis balls between the different frontiers, until at last through the mediation of the League of Nations the Jewish central organization in Paris (Ica) declared itself ready to assume responsibility for their maintenance until some solution was found. So thousands of these Jewish refugees were for a long time kept in a concentration camp near Danzig, until finally the possibility

was opened up for them to go to America."

Dr. Nansen stated that he estimates the number of Russian refugees scattered over Europe at a million. Many hundreds of thousands, he said, are permanently unemployed, and it is undeniable that they are a source of anxiety and disfavor to the

countries in which they are now staying.

"The possibility has now been brought up of sending many of them to South America, where there is still room for many millions. In order to consider this and other schemes closely related to it, the representatives of all Governments interested in the problem have been invited through the League

DAILY DIGEST OF PUBLIC OPINION ON JEWISH MATTERS

Nordic Blood in Jewish Veins, Contends Author of Nordic Theory

The contention that there is, among others, a strain of Nordic and Negro blood in the Jews, is put forth by the author of the Nordic theory, Lothrop Stoddard, in an article on "The Pedigree of the Jews," which appears in the March number of the "Forum."

Dr. Stoddard attempts to prove that the presentday lews are not really descendants of the ancient Hebrews, owing to intermarriage with other races. Hebrews, owing to intermarriage with ounce races. There were, he asserts, "two primal elements in Jewry's racial make-up: an ancient cross between Semitic and Hittite-Armenoid stocks." The Semitic, he says, was the original root. He then makes the statement that during their sojourn in Egypt the Jews absorbed Negro blood.

"A Negroid strain," he writes, "undoubtedly exists in fewry; to it the friezy or woolly hair, thick lips, and prognathous jaws appearing in many fewish individuals are probably due. Although at that time the population of Expty was predominantly Hamile, the trickle of Negro blood, which has a fine as a strongly wrotified. The infusion of Nordic blood took place on the return to Palestine, Dr. Stoddard contends, basing his belief partly on the assumption that David was the son of an Amoritish mother and that the description of him in the Bible as "admoni" means

that he was "blond."

"When the Jews returned to Palestine," we read, "they found it inhabited by a mediey of tribes, mostly of Sentitic and Amendio origin to be sure, but also partly of Nordic and Mediterrate an blood. The Amorites, those giant 'Sons of Anak, were patently Nordics, and David, the son of an Amoritish mother and described as blond, represents the infusion of Nordic blood into Jewry which then took olace." which then took place

Further, we are told that in Babylonian Captivity only a remnant of Jews retained its Jewish self-consciousness and it was this remnant which was "more Semitic and less Armenoid," that returned to Palestine under Ezra and Nehemiah.

with their return, the writer declares, began the period of Jewish "racial self-consciousness."

"Those Jews who breied the call of Nehemiah and Era to return to Palestine and rebuild the Holy City were, in very truth, a 'chosen remann,' the most realons and particute of the Jewish folk. Warned by the faxe of the Tost Ten Tribes, they resolved at all costs to preserve their identity as the 'Chosen People,' and they realized that the best way to do this was to keep themselves aloof from their neighbors, not only in their faith and from their neignbors, not only in their faith and customs but also in their blood. Of course, these principles had been conceived iong before har they had been lating observed. Now, however, under the rigorous discipline of a miling priestly class. Jewry displayed a cohesion and self-con-sciousness never before armined. For the next sciousness never before attained. For the next five centuries, down to the great dispersion and the Romans, incernarringe with foreigners greatly lessened, inbreeding was the rule, and consequently the tendency was roward the formation of a stable Jewish type."

Dr. Stoddard says the Semitic type "must have almost entirely disappeared" somewhere between

the 8th and 10th centuries and divides Jewry into two groups, Sephardic Jews of the West and Ash-kenazic Jews of the East, taking no cognizance of the German Jews.

"The Sephardim," he says, "have for the past thousand years been breeding away from the old Armenoid toward the long-headed Semitic and Mediterranean racial types. The Ashkenazim, on the contrary, have not only been breeding away from the Semitic toward the Armenoid type, but have also taken up a great amount of Central Asian and Mongoloid blood which was unknown to ancient Jewry and which has never flowed in Sephardim's veins."

The conclusion to which Dr. Stoddard arrives on the basis of his theories is this:

"Such, in brief, is the surprisingly complex pedisuch in Drier, is the surprisingly complex peu-gree of Judah. It effectively disposes of the fiction that the modern few is the true scion of the an-cient Hebrew. The proportion of genuine Hebrew blood today should be very small even among the Sephardim, while among the Ashkenazim it must be infinitesimal.

Nevertheless, the modern Jew is still very much a Jew. In fact, he is probably more self-consciously 'Jewish' than was the Jew of 1000 B. C. And this applies alike to Ashkenazim and to Sephardim. However much they may differ, they yet possess a common 'Jewishness,' instinctively recognizable both by themselves and by the rest of the world.

"How explain this seeming paradox? It is due unquestionably to the biological effects produced reflexively by the Jewish doctrine of the Chosen People. Believing themselves to be a race, the Jews have constantly tended to create one! This is not a mere juggling of words; it is scientific

fact."

The "Jewish Moraing Journal" pointed out in its issue of Feb. 14 that Dr. Stoddard's arguments are based on ignorance and wrong facts.
"At one point," says the paper, "Dr. Stoddard's ignorance is so obvious that anyone who is even

sightly posted on the divisions among the Jews can notice it. The Western Jew is called by him a Sophardi and the Eastern Jew an Ashkenazi. We wonder what he did with the German Jews. did he transform them into Hittite—Khazar—Armenoid Jews of the East or into the Semitic-Spanish Jews of the West? Such a 'denial' of the existence of the German Iews amuses us

Regarding Dr. Stoddard's remarks about David and Nordic blood in the Jews, the paper, observes:
"We concede that he is not obliged to know the Talmudic tradition that David's mother was the daughter of a well known Jewish family, but it is a ridiculous error to believe that 'admoni' means blond. The Bible gives the same description of Essau, and according to Stoddard's theory it would mean that only Jacob was a Semite, while his twin brother was a Nordic!

"Equally far from the truth, or opposed to the uth," the paper continues, "is his opinion on the truth," the paper continues, "is his option on the fews who returned from Babylon to Palestine Mr. Scodlard knows that the Talmud embodies the Jewish spirit, but he does not know that this sure source of Jewish traditions and interpretation of Jewish historical facts is very definite on this point, declaring that the real aristocrats, the purest families among the Jews, remained in Babylon and those who returned were "Assarah Yochsten groups with ten different pedigree records some of whose origin was not established. (Mishna Kiddishin, 4-1). This was so well known in Talmudic times, seven-eight hundred years
