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## PROPOSE TO CONFISCATE PROPERTY OF EAST-EUROPEAN JEWS LIVING IN GERMANY

Ludendorff Sponsors Measure Because  
of Confiscation of Kaiser's Property  
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Berlin, May 1.—A bill aiming at the confiscation of the property of East European Jews and other foreigners in Germany was introduced yesterday by the parliamentary representation of the anti-Semitic party of the Voelkische.

The bill, which is sponsored by fifteen deputies, bears the signature of General Ludendorff and Dr. Best, president of the Prussian Supreme Court.

The bill, which was conceived as a counter action for the confiscation of the property of the Hohenzollerns, is entitled: "Bill concerning the confiscation of the property of bank and stock exchange magnates and other parasites on the people." It demands the "confiscation of the entire property of the bank and exchange magnates of the Eastern Jews who settled in the country since August 1, 1924 and of all other foreigners, as well as those who increased their property due to the war, revolution, inflation and deflation of the currency." The bill asks for the confiscation of these properties for the welfare of society, "without reimbursement."

## FOUR JEWISH STUDENTS WOUNDED BY ANTI-SEMITES IN BUCHAREST UNIVERSITY

Bucharest, May 1.—Four Jewish students were seriously wounded in an attack of anti-Semitic students made Wednesday at the University of Bucharest. The attack was made during a lecture in the Department of Natural Sciences.

Minister of Foreign Affairs Mitineu yesterday received Dr. Olschwanger, a representative of the Zionist Organization, who arrived here in the interests of the Zionist Organization Month. The Minister expressed his, as well as the government's sympathy for Zionism and promised protection for the Organization Month activities.

## FRANCE FACILITATES NATURALIZATION OF ALIENS

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Paris, May 1.—Facilities to acquire French citizenship are being granted by the French government to foreign residents in France, according to a report in the French Chamber by Pierre Leval of the Ministry of the Interior.

During the year 1924, 6,000 foreigners were naturalized and 11,000 during 1925. Two thousand examinations of applicants for citizenship were heard last month in order to accelerate the naturalization of aliens, the staff of the naturalization department has been enlarged. Persons without means are not charged the fee, 15 francs.

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## DEMANDS OF PALESTINE JEWRY TO MANDATORY FORMULATED BY COUNCIL

Jerusalem, May 1.—The views of Palestine Jewry with regard to the developments in the country and the necessary requirements for further progress were formulated yesterday at a meeting of the Vaad Leumi, the national council of Palestine Jews.

The meeting adopted in principle a memorandum which is to be submitted to the Permanent Mandates Commission of the League of Nations at its forthcoming session in Geneva in June.

The memorandum will be presented to the Commission by a special delegation of the council, which will proceed to Geneva. The delegation will consist of Mr. M. Dizengoff, former mayor of Tel Aviv, Rabbi Uziel and Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff.

The memorandum also formulates the demands of Palestine Jewry to the mandatory power.

## PARTICIPATION OF JEWISH CLUB IN FORMING POLISH CABINET IS EXPECTED

Leaders Will Insist on Fulfillment of  
Jewish Demands

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Warsaw, May 1.—The participation of the Club of Jewish Deputies in the Polish parliament in the forming of a new Polish cabinet is still being discussed in leading political circles here.

The resignation of the coalition government, headed by Count Skrzynski, will become effective in a short time, probably during the first week in May.

It is doubtful whether Count Skrzynski will undertake the task of forming a new cabinet. It is more certain that he will enter the new government as Minister of Foreign Affairs.

Two combinations in the forming of the new government are being negotiated now, one of a government based on the joined forces of the Right parties and the center; the other, a combination of the Left parties and the center. Leaders of both combinations express the desire to draw the Club of Jewish Deputies into their combination, declaring that it would be impossible to form a cabinet without the participation of the Club.

It was stated today on good authority that the Club of Jewish Deputies will not agree to participate in the forming of the cabinet unless assurances are given that the demands of the Jewish population will be met by the incoming government. It is doubtful, however, whether the Club of Jewish Deputies would join the combination of the Right and the center groups.

## PHILADELPHIA LAUNCHES UNITED PALESTINE APPEAL DRIVE FOR \$375,000 QUOTA

Philadelphia, May 2.—Philadelphia will inaugurate its campaign for \$375,000 for the United Palestine Appeal this evening with a dinner at the Benjamin Franklin Hotel. The sum of \$375,000 represents the largest sum of money which the Jewish community of Philadelphia has ever been asked to contribute to Palestine.

Twelve hundred men and women, under the leadership of Judge William M. Lewis, will inaugurate the campaign. Rabbi Stephen S. Wise, National Chairman of the \$5,000,000 United Palestine Appeal, will be the principal speaker at the dinner. Judge William M. Lewis will preside.

The campaign will last ten days.

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### SIX U. S. PRESIDENTS WILL BE INSCRIBED IN AMERICAN EDITION OF J. N. F. BOOK

The celebration of the twenty-fifth anniversary of the establishment of the Jewish National Fund at a national convention here Sunday, May 9th, will be featured by the inauguration of an American edition of the Golden Book of the National Fund, in which will be inscribed the names of American men and women who have rendered service to the Jewish people. Along with other volumes of the Golden Book, the American edition will be placed in the archives of the Jewish National Library of the Hebrew University in Jerusalem.

First Americans to be inscribed in the American volume are the six Presidents of the United States who have publicly endorsed the establishment of the Jewish National Homeland in Palestine. They are: John Adams, Benjamin Harrison, Theodore Roosevelt, Woodrow Wilson, Warren G. Harding and Calvin Coolidge.

In making public the establishment of an American volume of the Golden Book long one of the picturesque features of the Jewish National Fund, Edge Bernard A. Rosenblatt, Chairman, said:

"Zionism is considered a modern movement because it did not receive the endorsement of the leading countries of the World until the Versailles Treaty was signed. But it has been advocated this country since the first days of its Republic.

Mordchai M. Noah, probably the first Zionist in the United States, and prominent in public life as the editor of the New York "Tribune," popular playwright and sheriff of New York, secured an endorsement of the restoration of Palestine as the Jewish Homeland from John Adams, second President of the United States. President Harrison approved the idea when a petition was sent to him in 1891 by William M. Barton, a noted Christian scholar and minister, and signed by several hun-

### HEBREW ATLAS PRAISED BY PRESIDENT COOLIDGE

The Hebrew Atlas, published by the Hebrew Publishing Company, Ha-Sefer, was commended by President Coolidge.

Upon receipt of a sample copy of the atlas, E. G. Clark, wrote on behalf of the President that the Atlas, published in Hebrew, is "not only an interesting achievement in itself, but has a further significance as a step in the comprehensive plan of reviving the use of that language."

Mr. Louis Marshall, president of the American Jewish Committee, purchased a number of copies of the Atlas for distribution in the Jewish schools in Poland and Lithuania, it was learned yesterday.

The Hebrew Atlas is published under the editorship of Vladimir Jabotinsky and Dr. S. Perlman.

### POLAND SEEKS \$200,000,000 LOAN FROM BIG POWERS

International financial control for Poland without, however, infringing on the Polish sovereignty, was foreshadowed today in a report from Warsaw published in London by the Central and Eastern European Financial News, a despatch to the New York "Herald-Tribune" states.

The report says that negotiations are now proceeding for a \$200,000,000 Polish loan from the United States. Great Britain and some other states which are members of the League of Nations. The states granting the loan, according to the report, would appoint a committee to exercise control over Polish finances. The loan, it is said, will be offered at very favorable terms.

### Asks Some Questions About James Waterman Wise

"How did the newspapers discover that young James, son of Rabbi Stephen S. Wise, has decided to abandon his studies for the rabbinate?" asks Zivion in the "Forward" of May 1.

"I know," the writer says in the course of his observations on the subject "that actors and actresses have their press agents, whose duty it is to keep the names of their employers before the public eye. But how did the papers learn that a young man whose name is James Wise does not want to be a rabbi? I am afraid the publicity devil may have had something to do with it. Heaven knows in this country, where the publicity agent's work begins and where it ends. For in the midst of the great news that James Wise does not want to be a rabbi, we learn, by the way, that the same James is publishing a book, and precisely on the subject of religion, Judaism, etc., that is, we are expected to become interested in the book and buy it as soon as it appears."

### Fears "Protestant-Catholic-Jewish Peril"

The fear of "a national peril of Protestant, Catholic and Jewish bigotry" voiced in a recent issue of "The Herald of Gospel Liberty, Official Organ of the Christian Church," published in Dayton, Ohio, is ridiculed by the "American Israelite" of April 29.

"The Protestants of the country," avers the "Israelite" editorially, "are in the saddle and are riding the high horse. However, that they may become a national peril there is no danger. The Catholics are quite able to speak for themselves, but the warning that Jewish bigotry is a danger to the country is something to laugh at. There is just about as much danger of the earth colliding with the moon and the destruction of both. But fortunately for the American people, statements like the one made in 'The Herald of Gospel Liberty' have no weight."

### Statistics for Harvard

A fact overlooked by Professor Julian L. Coolidge, who recently asserted that since 1895 the Jews at Harvard have increased 650 per cent, is pointed out by the "Jewish Independent" of Cleveland. In an editorial under date of April 30 the paper observes:

"While Prof. Coolidge's figures show a healthy increase in Jewish enrollment (a fact that needs no Jewish apologies) the explanation could well accompany the 650 per cent increase screeching, that from 1895 to 1922 the Jewish population increase in the United States was 450 per cent."

## DISCRIMINATION AGAINST JEWS IN AMERICAN UNIVERSITIES CHARGED AND DENIED

**Adolph Lewisohn, Well Known American Philanthropist, Reveals Facts, Citing Case of His Grandsons; Discriminating Has Social not Racial Character; Universities Deny Charges; "Jewish Daily Bulletin" Makes Survey**

Denials were made by leading Eastern universities of the charges that they were discriminating against Jewish students in the consideration of entrance applications, made by Adolph Lewisohn and Gustave A. Rogers at a luncheon to discuss the raising of funds for the proposed Yeshiva of America.

Mr. Rogers asserted that several eastern universities had discreetly informed heads of preparatory schools that it would be wise for them to leave Jews out in filling their quotas of applications. Mr. Lewisohn said that his own grandsons had been excluded from a large Eastern university.

Dr. Ernest M. Hopkins, President of Dartmouth, in reply to an inquiry, telegraphed:

"Believe charges that universities in general are discriminating against Jews to be false and the reasons ascribed for this to be ingenious hypotheses but nothing else. Statement of these gentlemen, so far as Dartmouth is concerned, has no semblance of truth and no basis in fact. Am becoming somewhat impatient at gratuitous interpretation of entrance systems of respective colleges from different groups who see in these systems principles never existent and purposes never considered.

"Five years ago we began restriction of enrollment to 2,000, the number then enrolled, beyond which we could not go without diluting educational advantage which Dartmouth could offer. This has necessitated refusal of hundreds of applications each year and for present year applications for admission to freshman class number more than 1,800 and represent ratio of three to one to number which can be accepted. There are undoubtedly many Jews in number declined, but we have no reason to suppose and do not believe percentage varies from percentage declined in other groups."

President W. H. P. Faunce, of Brown University, was reported by the Associated Press to have said:

"Brown University has never excluded, and never will exclude, any man on sectarian or racial grounds."

Yale University officials affirmed that a man of any race or creed who had proper credentials and training was eligible for enrollment, according to Associated Press despatches. Columbia University made an official statement to the same effect.

Jacob Freedman, Social Director of the Jewish Students' House at Columbia University, denied that he had said that the Thorndike psychological test was used at the university to eliminate Jewish students, as he was quoted in the New York "Times."

"What I did say," Mr. Freedman declared, "was that the Thorndike test cannot gauge the personality or social desirability of the student, and so can-

not be used as a means for exclusion on social grounds.

"The statement attributed to me that 'the blame for the discrimination in admitting students rests with the Board of Trustees' of Columbia University was also incorrect. I have no official knowledge which would warrant any statement of the kind. Whether or not there is a religious quota at the university I do not know, as I am in no way connected with the Board of Admissions. I do know that for the past three or four years the percentage of Jewish students has hovered about the 20 per cent line. I did not give any exact or official figures, but specifically said 'about' with each set of figures quoted."

The charge that the great American colleges and universities are discriminating against Jews in completing the personnel of entrance quotas assigned various preparatory schools, was made by Adolph Lewisohn and Gustavus A. Rogers, lawyer, at a luncheon Mr. Lewisohn gave at the Bankers' Club to discuss the program to raise \$1,000,000 for the proposed Yeshiva of America.

Mr. Rogers stated to a representative of the New York "World," that the charges in the information given him "included Harvard, Dartmouth, Princeton, Columbia and many others of the country's great institutions of learning."

"It is not a matter of absolute exclusion so much as restriction and discrimination," he said. "The universities themselves are not opposed, exactly, to having Jews in their student body, but they want only what they consider the Jew who is up to their social standard. In other words, the intelligent but irreligious Jew who does not follow Jewish doctrines. They do not want the pious Jew. Their attitude is not a racial one, in my opinion, but rather a fear of revolt by the Christian student body and the Christian parents."

"The schools fear a Christian rebellion by students who do not care to associate with Jews and they fear a predominance of Jews in their student bodies. They wish to bring the number of Jewish students to an irreducible minimum and keep it there. It is a social rather than a racial matter."

Mr. Rogers said he thought eventually each religious group would have to have its own schools—colleges specifically for Protestants, specifically for Catholics, and so on.

"Yeshiva, however, will set up no bars," he continued. "The Catholic, for example, who wishes to take a course in Hebrew literature will be welcome. We will cater, however, to the Jews who have been barred from Christian schools for non-scholastic reasons."

"This barring is not carried on any announced anti-Jew platform. The

## J. N. F. HEAD PRAISES ZEAL OF AMERICAN WOMEN FOR PALESTINE CAUSE

Mr. Julius Berger, head of the Organization and Propaganda Department of the Jewish National Fund with headquarters in Jerusalem, sailed on the Homeric last night, following a three months stay in the United States.

Mr. Berger, who came here in the interest of the Jewish National Fund, the agency of the Zionist Organization dedicated to the purchase of land in Palestine as the inalienable property of the Jewish people, studied conditions in this country.

This was Mr. Berger's first visit to the United States. In an interview before his departure Mr. Berger stated to a representative of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, that it is his impression that American Jewry has unlimited possibilities and energies which could be harnessed for the speedy reconstruction of Palestine.

Mr. Berger, who visited many parts of this country, carries away with him the impression that the American Jews would respond more readily to the appeal of Palestine, if the proper American methods of enlightenment were applied to the work of the Fund, and if the specific methods utilized during the past 25 years activity of the Fund were applied also in the Jewish communities in this country, in accordance, naturally, with the prevailing taste and custom.

Mr. Berger stated he was greatly impressed by the devotion and earnestness of the American Jewish women and their work for Palestine, particularly those women affiliated with the Hadassah Organization. The Jewish woman, who has played an extraordinary role in Jewish life under the most trying conditions, has risen to her height in America, combining both the specific qualities of Jewish womanhood and those of American womanhood, he said.

Jewish boy is restricted from entrance in many universities for no assigned reason. 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not even the combined talents of the many gifted men in our industry could succeed in putting the whole story across. I saw it in Austria, in Czechoslovakia, in Germany, in Hungary. I saw it everywhere in Europe.

"The world-war has had varied effects on various people," he said. "The Irish have been lucky enough to set themselves right with the world as a consequence of the war. Many other people have profited from the war and what has followed. The Jews of Central and Eastern Europe are the only people in the world who have not profited, who have paid the price for the war and the conditions that it has brought about.

"This appeal should be made to the entire American people, because it is only America that can help this situation. I am glad to be called into this campaign, because the best patrons of the theatres, of baseball, of the opera, of concerts, of pugilism, of any form of amusement in the United States are the Jews, and it is we, of the amusement industry who profit most from this.

"The theatrical industry has been in many drives since 1914. We were in the great Hoover drive in 1922, and when it seemed that this great drive was on the verge of collapse, it was the amusement industry that saved it. Joining with Mr. Hoover, in a night letter to every theatrical man in the United States, we roused the profession. We had men out in the streets in every city from coast to coast, from the Lakes to the Gulf; every theatre threw wide open its doors and we stirred the entire American people to respond to the Hoover appeal. What we did then nationally, we stand prepared to do now. Everything, every form of entertainment that caters to the people of New York, every legitimate theatre, the opera houses, the vaudeville houses, the moving picture theatres, baseball, pugilism; every person in the industry, performers, managers, producers, press-agents, musicians, stage-hands—all will be drawn into this campaign, and we will rouse New York as it was never roused before. This is a just cause, this is a righteous cause. It is a cause that must elicit a response from Jew, Catholic, Protestant—from everybody and we of the theatre industry are for it to a man."

Julius Tannen was the first to contribute \$1,000, and offered his services to the campaign. Al Woods pledged \$20,000 and declared himself ready to head a committee to mobilize the legitimate theatres for the proposed all-theatre Sunday night benefit performance. Louis Bernstein, music publisher, contributed \$5,000 and undertook to secure contributions from other music-publishing houses.

Mr. Joseph Leblang, chairman of the Theatrical Division, announced a contribution of \$5,000 from William Klein, legal advisor of the Shubert enterprises. Mr. Klein sailed last night on the S.S.

Leviathan and before leaving was commended for his gift in a telegram signed by Felix M. Warburg, Louis Marshall, David A. Brown, David M. Bressler and Joseph Leblang.

A committee headed by John Zanfi was appointed by Mr. Brady to call on Mayor Walker to head, as honorary chairman, the division of the amusement industry's committee which is to organize the baseball and pugilistic contingent for participation in the campaign.

Joseph Leblang, Charles B. Dillingham, Winthrop Amos, Florenz Ziegfeld and Harry Frazee were appointed by Mr. Brady as members of Al Woods committee to mobilize the legitimate theatres. Harry Hershfield, the well-known cartoonist, and president of the "Cheese Club" volunteered to form a special publicity corps.

Ben Bernie was put in charge of the "super" orchestras, Joseph Weber, of "pit" orchestras, and Ralph Long of other trades affiliated with the theatres, including stage-hands and housemen. William A. Brady took it upon himself to enlist the support of the Actors Equity Association and Loney Haskell promised the cooperation of the Jewish Theatrical Guild of which he is executive secretary. E. F. Albee was appointed chairman of the committee to obtain the support of vaudeville.

Al Jolson, Eddie Cantor, George Jessel, David Belasco, Louis Mann, Julius Tannen, J. J. Shubert, Lee Shubert, and William Morris were appointed a special committee to invite the cooperation of the artists of the legitimate stage, and Mr. Leblang was instructed to invite the Actor's Fidelity.

Gus Edwards announced his readiness to direct a children's carnival for the benefit of the campaign.

The Linath Hazedeck, a characteristically Jewish social service agency, is constituted along the lines of enlisting members for voluntary social service in time of need. The organization reports that the Jewish emigrants in Paris are suffering from stomach troubles because of their inability to become accustomed to restaurant meals. The emigrant children suffer from anemia because their mothers work and cannot give them the proper care. The women who are employed at heavy work succumb to tuberculosis, the report states.

"As a body of Rabbis ministering to a large part of the Jewish population of the community, the New York Board of Jewish Ministers has learned with great regret that the Jewish Soccer Team, Hakoah, now visiting the United States, is scheduled to play and charge admission fees on the Jewish Sabbath, in violation of the tenets of Judaism, and deplores this failure of the Hakoah team and management to respect the sensibilities of religious Jews," the statement read.
