

POLISH GOVERNMENT IS URGED TO GIVE SUPPORT TO JEWISH EMIGRATION

Minister of Labor Promises to Support Jewish Emigration Society's Demands
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Warsaw, Aug. 13.—Representations to the Polish Government that it lend its support to the Jewish emigration movement from Poland, were made by Mr. Leon Halter, director of the Jewish Emigration Society.

Some time ago the Polish Emigration Office recommended to the Government that it lend greater assistance to Jewish emigrants. This recommendation however, has not materialized until now.

In the memorandum submitted to the Ministry of Labor and Public Protection the Jewish Emigration Society urged the authorities to accord equal treatment to the Jewish emigrants. For this purpose it was demanded that the Ministry of Labor create a special department for Jewish emigrants, that it lend material support to the Jewish Emigration Society in the same measure as is accorded to non-Jewish emigrants, that steps be taken to prepare the Jewish emigrants for the countries to which they intend going by opening special language courses to them and teaching them trades. It was also urged that the Jewish Emigration Society be represented in the proposed colonization companies for Brazil and South Africa.

The Minister of Labor has promised to support the demands of the Jewish Emigration Society.

KLAN MARCH IN WASHINGTON TO BE OPEN, WITHOUT MASKS

Washington, D. C., Aug. 13.—The Ku Klux Klan, having lost its plea for a parade here, hooded and masked, filed a plea today with the police, asking a permit to parade Sept. 13 without the pillow case headdress.

L. A. Mueller, Kleagle and Washington emissary from Atlanta headquarters of the Klan, made the application for the parade permit and Superintendent of Police Hesse said he would approve it now that the Klan has agreed to abandon the peaked and concealing hood.

HAKOAH WINS MATCH WITH POLONIA OF WARSAW

Warsaw, Aug. 13.—The famous Viennese all-Jewish sport club Hakoah added another victory to its record of achievement in international sport here yesterday.

In the match between the Hakoah and the Polish Students' Football Association "Polonia," the Hakoah was victorious with a score of 6 to 0.

PALESTINE WILL HONOR MEMORY OF KARL NETTER, THE PIONEER COLONIZER

Noted Jewish Communal Worker and One of Founders of Alliance Israelite
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Jerusalem, Aug. 13.—Tribute to the memory of Karl Netter, pioneer of Jewish colonization work in Palestine and founder of the colony Mikveh Israel, will be paid by Palestine Jewry on August 22nd.

The celebration will take place in the Mikveh Israel school.

Karl Netter was born in Strasburg in 1828. He was one of the founders of the Alliance Israelite Universelle, and for a long time the Alliance was housed at his home. His name is most closely connected with the foundation of the agricultural school at Jaffa. In 1876 Karl Netter submitted to the conference of Constantinople the memorandum in favor of the Jews of the East, prepared by the meeting convened about that time by the Alliance at Paris.

Karl Netter died at Jaffa, Palestine, Oct. 2, 1882.

OBJECT TO THE FILM "CITY WITHOUT JEWS"

Berlin, Aug. 13.—Objection to the presentation of a film with a Jewish theme was voiced by leaders of both the anti-Semitic movement in Germany and leaders of the Jewish community.

The Berlin theater "Alahambra" featured a film production of Hugo Bettauer's famous novel "A City Without Jews." In a statement issued by the Verein der National Deutschen Jugend, the organization protested against the production of the film, referring to a statement issued in 1924 by Dr. Naumann, president of the organization, when the book was first published. In his statement, Dr. Naumann protested against propagating the idea that a State deprived of its Jewish citizens must disappear merely because of the fact that without the Jewish commercial ability and quickness it would be incapable of existence. Jews must be desirable, Dr. Naumann said, not as financiers or relatives of American financiers, not as able directors and attorneys for one purpose or another, but

N. Y. STATE ENACTS LAW ON KOSHER MEAT SALE IN RESTAURANTS

Amendment to Text of Bill Passed in April Issued by State Secretary
(Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Albany, N. Y., Aug. 13.—Florence E. S. Knapp, Secretary of State, made public the text of the amendment to the New York State penal law with regard to the sale of kosher meat in restaurants, which became a law on April 9, 1926 and was approved by the Governor.

The amendment reads as follows:

"A person who with intent to defraud, sells or exposes for sale in any restaurant or other place where food products are sold for consumption on the premises, any article of food or food preparations and falsely represents the same to be kosher or as having been prepared in accordance with the Orthodox Hebrew religious requirements; or sells or exposes for sale in such restaurant or such other place both kosher and non-kosher food or food preparations for consumption on the premises not prepared in accordance with the ritual or not sanctioned by the Hebrew Orthodox religious requirements and who fails to display on his window signs and all display advertising in block letters at least four inches in height "kosher and non-kosher food served here" shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

"This act shall take effect immediately."

JULY INCOME OF KEREN HAYESOD BREAKS RECORDS

London, Aug. 13.—All records in the income of the Keren Hayesod, Palestine Foundation Fund, were beaten during the month of July.

The amount received by the Keren Hayesod headquarters in London during July totaled £75,073. The highest income the Keren Hayesod registered until now was in May, 1923, when it amounted to £66,236.

The July income of the Keren Hayesod includes £29,000 from the United States of America, £25,000 from Mr. Bernard Baron, the millionaire tobacco manufacturer of London, and £5,000 from the Jewish community of South Africa.

The revelations made by the "Isvestia", organ of the Soviet government, regarding Henry Ford's connections with the anti-Semitic movement in Europe, as disclosed at the trial now taking place in Moscow of Druszelowsky, agent provocateur charged with fabricating anti-Soviet documents, are the subject of editorial comment in the "Day" of Aug. 13.

Referring to Druszelowsky's assertions regarding his associate Boris Brasol, who imported the infamous Protocols of the Elders of Zion into the United States and was connected with the "Dearborn Independent's" anti-Semitic propaganda, the paper observes:

"In order that the Russian monarchists might be able to create an approach to the half-liberal elements in Europe, it was necessary first of all to wash their hands of the Jewish blood that still dripped from them. It was this noble mission Brasol undertook with the assistance and the money of Henry Ford, if the statements of the "Isvestia" are true.

"Brasol's mission failed. But the present trial in Moscow has accomplished one good thing: it has shown Henry Ford, if he previously failed to see, the type of creatures he is connected with. On one side, a blood hound of the late Czar, on the other side, an agent provocateur and document forger. It is almost becoming an honor for us to be attacked by such specimens, but it is surely no honor for a person of Henry Ford's position to be allied with them, if he still desires to retain the respect of his fellow-citizens in his own country."

Haifa vs. Jaffa

The competition between Haifa and Jaffa for the role of Palestine's future greatest harbor is described by a correspondent in the "Christian Science Monitor", wherein the writer renders his impressions of Palestine.

"Haifa, according to the optimists, is to have a brilliant tomorrow," we read. "Possessed of one of the finest harbors in the eastern Mediterranean, it is, they say, the natural outlet for Syria as well as Palestine. The extension of the Palestine railways to Ras-el-Nakura, on the Syrian frontier, there to connect with the line which the French

authorities intend to build from Beirut, will bring a great increase in traffic.

"Further in the future a pipe line and railway from the Mosul oil fields will make of the harbor a center of export and import not only for the Mediterranean littoral from Dan to Beersheba, but also for the whole northern part of the Arabian Peninsula, as far as the borders of Persia and distant Kurdistan.

"Jaffa protests, and receives strong support from Tel Aviv, that however bright may be the future of Haifa, Jaffa now handles approximately 60 per cent of the sea-borne trade of Palestine and serves the richest and most populous part of the country. It is stated that the Jaffa roadstead can be made to meet Palestine's present needs at a fraction of the cost required to adopt Haifa to problematical future requirements.

"The big development plans for Haifa will not be carried out without considerable opposition from Jaffa and Tel Aviv. Nevertheless, nature seems to have destined Haifa to be the leading seaport of the Syro-Palestinian coast, while leaving Jaffa with only indifferent anchorage and the arguments of the Sharon folk are hardly likely to change the official decision."

Hopes Senator Straus Will Continue

The announcement that State Senator Nathan Straus, Jr. will not accept a renomination is viewed with regret by the New York "World," which expresses the hope that he may change his decision.

"It would be hard," declares the paper, "to name an activity which would have afforded Mr. Straus the chance for such swift and flattering public recognition as the career which is now to be interrupted. It is true that he had the ability, the energy, the earnestness of purpose, to make good use of his opportunities. Senator Straus will be remembered in New York State and City. If he should relent and retain his seat it will be cause for satisfaction."

The Extent of Jewish Philanthropies

That the Jews are more generous than others in giving assistance to causes not related to their own people, is the opinion of "The Presbyterian" of August 5, wherein we read:

"There are denominations within the bounds of the Protestant faith that seldom give to Christian enterprises not under their own auspices. This cannot be said of Jewish givers. All worthy causes find sympathy and help from generous Jews. This must be recognized by any observer of the names of donors where the need is human and tender and heart-stirring. The motives may be more selfish or less selfish than other givers, but they are sufficiently forceful to produce the gift. It is not a sufficient explanation to say that much of their wealth is secured through their Gentile patrons. That does not lessen the fact that as a race, they rank as generous givers."

**LEADERS BACK COMMENT
ON RESULTS OF ACTIONS
COMMITTEE'S MEETING****Extended Palestine Is Near Political
Possibility, Goldberg Says**

Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver and Mr. Ab. Goldberg, members of the Zionist Actions Committee who just returned from London, commented yesterday on the results of the session.

"The Actions Committee meeting this year was very purposeful and rich in accomplishment," Rabbi Hillel Silver stated. "It applied itself in detail to the problems of administration and to the economic phases in Palestine.

"The major thought of the meeting was directed to the solution of the economic problems confronting the Jews of Palestine. The delegates sought to find ways of maintaining the present settlements and of providing this means for a large immigration into the country next year. There was a fine spirit of cooperation among all the parties and groups represented at the session, and much of the group antagonisms which were in evidence last year were almost absent.

"The American delegation played a rather decisive role in the deliberations and its members have returned to this country determined to carry on the work with even greater success than in the past year," Rabbi Silver declared.

Mr. Ab. Goldberg, vice-chairman of the Budget Committee, in praising the achievements of the Actions Committee session with regard to the fixing of the budget and the attention given to matters of economic rather than political nature, emphasized the political importance of the plans of an "Extended Palestine."

"An Extended Palestine is no longer a dream of the remote future, but is a political possibility which, though it may not be realized within the next few years, may prove to be of great moment in strengthening the political situation in Palestine, having its bearing on the improvement of the economic situation as well as the question of State lands for Jewish colonization.

The results of the last few years in

the activities of the Zionist Organization in Palestine, have brought the recognition of the League and of France. The Jews in Palestine have the sympathy not only of the Mandatory Power, but also of France, in the attitude of which a considerable change for the better has taken place. The Jews are looked upon as a civilizing and culture and peace-bringing factor in the Near East," Mr. Goldberg declared.

PLANNED COTTON GROWERS' ASSOCIATION IN PALESTINE

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service)
Jerusalem, July 23.—The program of the new Palestine organization of Cotton-growers has now been issued. The largest possible number of Jewish families—the program of the new limited company states—are to be settled on cotton-plantations, and the whole scheme run on a pure commercial basis. The Jordan basin is to be used for plantation, as it has proved the most suitable for irrigation purposes. Each family will receive, apart from land, three dunams for vegetable gardens and the building of a small house, but must hold shares amounting to £E.200, so as to become a shareholder in this company. In cases where immediate settlement of this amount is not possible, the instalment system will be allowed; loans will be sought for this class of settler. By an annual lottery, settlers of four years' standing will be enabled to acquire their sites and continue as independent planters; in such event, the settler will be allotted free an area of 30 dunams fully irrigated. The price for this land will be paid off in fifteen years and must clear his produce only through the company's selling agency. The establishment of cotton cooperatives will be aided.

"WHY DO THE HEATHEN RAGE" DISPUTE

(Communication to the Editor)

Comments:

Upon my return from London today I read the letter which Mr. Henry Hurwitz wrote in explanation of the suppression of my article which had been requested and accepted by the "Memorah Journal."

Mr. Hurwitz states in his letter that I made no unacceptable conditions to its publication, and that I was principally of three authors whose papers I discussed are respectively the editor and managing editor of the "Memorah Journal."

When I requested that no answer should be made in the same issue, I asked for my article the same privilege which the articles of Dr. Kallen, Mr. Cohen and Mr. Hurwitz enjoyed. The editor indicated in a note which accompanied the galley proofs that a reply to it would appear in the following issue of the "Journal", to which, of course, I raised absolutely no objections.

Mr. Hurwitz was free to reject my conditions and did not reject them; rather he accepted them with alacrity.

Mr. Hurwitz refers to the title of my article, "Why Do the Heathen Rage" (A Biblical phrase, by the way), as "the elegant memory service of Rabbi Silver."

Here, again, Mr. Hurwitz's memory seems to fail him. I submitted two titles for his consideration, the other being "A Rabbi Makes Reply" and Mr. Hurwitz, himself, selected the former.

There is one other suggestion contained in Mr. Hurwitz's letter that my article did not fully measure up to the established standard of thought and expression of the "Memorah Journal" and that the reader must judge.

As, however, again compelled to publish, Mr. Hurwitz's memory. Upon receipt of my article, he wrote that he was glad to get it and the editor after reading it. This was in April. Four or five weeks later, during which I had written and even underbrought my time to acquaint himself with the palpable definition of the article, he sent me the galley proofs.

Thereafter, at a public meeting, he announced its forthright publication. Just then the article still measured up to the existing standards of the "Memorah Journal."

It is, I think, utterly unnecessary to suppress a chuckle at the literary vagaries of this distinguished editor.

Secret Agreements to Be Replaced by Open Fulfillment of All Obligations to Jews, Polish Premier States in Sejm Address

(By Our Warsaw Correspondent)

Warsaw, July 19.—The present Polish government rejects the policy of its predecessors of concluding secret agreements with the Jewish leaders and instead of that takes the position that the national constitution and the treaty obligations guaranteeing complete equality to the Jews must be openly and honorably fulfilled. This, and no less, was the statement made today by Premier Bartel in his first official address before a plenary session of the Polish parliament wherein he outlined the policy of the new government.

The Premier's address, which is regarded with good reason, as heralding a new era for Polish Jewry, was replete with agreeable surprises. It was the first time that a Polish premier declared in no uncertain terms from the Sejm tribunal, that the Polish governments have hitherto conducted a definite anti-Semitic policy directed at the economic destruction of the Jews. It was the first time that a Polish premier admitted publicly that the obligations toward the national minorities have not been carried out, that the government officials have been guided by religious and racial prejudice in their work and that the Government owed it as a duty to itself and to the country to rectify all these errors of the past.

Devoting the first half of his statement to the questions of relations with foreign governments, changes in the national constitution, unemployment, stabilization of the zloty and facilities for the acquiring of citizenship, the Premier in the second part of his address, discussed the national minorities problem and the Jewish question.

"The government will not permit," Bartel declared, "the depreciation of the demands of the national minorities for this would be repugnant to the spirit of Poland. In its internal policy the Government will seek to adjust the religious and racial conflicts and to create conditions for harmonious relationships. While the Government is determined to oppose any activities aimed against the country, the living interests of the national minorities must be satisfied.

"Faithfully to carry out the provisions of the Constitution and the various treaties, to hasten the regulation of the citizenship question, to accelerate the realization of the agrarian reforms—these are the things the Government will undertake in the interests of the national minorities."

Regarding the specific Jewish problem, Premier Bartel stated:

"In the matter of the Jewish question, taking the view that economic anti-Semitism is detrimental to the country, the Government considers it necessary to safeguard in all its activities the principles of impartiality and justice. The government will, namely, see to it that in respect to taxes and credits, as well as productive credits,

ICA ISSUES REPORT ON ITS RUSSIAN COLONIZATION WORK

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service)

Paris, July 29.—A detailed report on the Jewish colonization work in the districts of Mariupol and Zaparaje, where land was recently granted for the purpose by the Soviet Government to the Ica (Jewish Colonization Association) has just been received here by the Ica Head Office. The new colonists began to arrive towards the end of March and fresh settlers are still arriving. Forty-one colonists were settled by the 15th of June. They came from all the provinces of the Ukraine, but the majority of them from Kamenez Podolsk.

By the 6th July, 19 groups of colonists, comprising 129 families, were settled on their allotments. This first group consisted of 22 families of farmers, 16 families of tobacco planters, 4 families of carmen, 8 families of traders, etc. Altogether there are 260 persons capable of work. The group has at its disposal 111 horses.

The new farmers have been settled on three of the four estates granted to the Association. Having arrived late, they were not able to sow a large area. There was abundant rainfall in June and a satisfactory harvest is consequently expected.

The management of the Ica has introduced tractors for field work. Six conductors under the supervision of a special tractor mechanic have been engaged by the Association for this work. Two hundred desiatins have already been ploughed and much more could have been accomplished but for the unseasoning rainfall from the end of May till the 18th of June, which compelled the work to be suspended.

The Ica has advanced to the colonists the sums necessary for the purpose of providing sowings, provender, cattle and building materials. The agricultural experts of the Ica have arranged the settlement of these new colonists according to the usual procedure and according to the conditions outlined in the estimates.

**"TAXING OUT OF EXISTENCE"
POLICY BROUGHT RUIN TO
JEWS, FIGURES INDICATE**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service)
Warsaw, July 29.—The results of the "taxing out of existence" policy of the previous Polish governments with regard to the Jewish population are evident from data collected by the Jewish statistician, Ignatz A. Czerniakow.

It appears that during the year 1925, the number of Jewish artisans who received government licenses was 5,218 less than in the year 1924. This means that more than 20,000 Jewish skilled workmen were taxed out of existence.

Figures available for the year 1926 point to the fact that the ruin of the Jewish population has grown. In several districts the number of Jews who obtained artisans' licenses was reduced by one-half, the cause being the pressure of taxation and economic ruin.

The headquarters of the Jewish Merchants' Association in Warsaw has just concluded an inquiry in several hundred Polish towns. The result of the inquiry shows that 72 per cent of the industrial licenses were issued to Jews and that 83 per cent of the commercial licenses were held by Jews.

**ZIONIST ORGANIZATION
IN POLAND LEGALIZED**

Warsaw, July 26.—The Minister of the Interior has issued a circular in which he instructs all District Governors not to put any obstacles in the way of the work of the Zionist Organization in Poland. At the same time the Minister has directed all the local Zionist groups to register with the local authorities within the course of the month.

The Central Zionist Executive in Poland has in this connection submitted to the Minister of the Interior a draft statute asking that only the Central Zionist Executive should be registered and that it should have the power to issue authorization for the establishment of Zionist branches.
