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CHICAGO CONFERENCE INAUGURATES I. O. B. B. CAMPAIGN FOR \$2,000,000

Cultural Fund to be Asked of All American Jews; Purposes and Plans Outlined at Conference (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Chicago, Aug. 30.—The inauguration of a \$2,000,000 campaign for a cultural fund was decided upon at a conference called by the Independent Order B'nai B'rith, which was opened here Sunday morning.

Forty-four leaders of the Order were present at the sessions held at the Chicago Beach Hotel, when the B'nai B'rith Wider Scope Committee submitted reports in which the general nature of the appeal was outlined. Speakers emphasized that funds will be asked of all American Jews and the fund will be administered for all activities of the Order outside of the organization proper.

Dr. Boris D. Bogen, Executive Secretary of the I. O. B. B. and national director of the campaign, in outlining the purpose of the drive, stated that 50 per cent of the funds collected will be allotted for the budget for five years of the Hillel Foundations established by the B'nai B'rith at American universities. The other 50 per cent will be distributed.

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IN JASSY IS DISSOLVED

Bucharest, Aug. 30.—The Jassy Chamber of Commerce, which recently elected Senator Elijah Mendelsohn to the Roumanian Senate, was dissolved by an order of the Roumanian government.

It was stated that the Chamber was dissolved for the purpose of effecting the election to the Senate of Mr. Czerkez, the candidate of Premier Averescu.

A temporary committee to reorganize the Chamber was appointed. Several Jews are on the committee.

At the time that Mendelsohn was elected, Averescu stated that the Chamber of Commerce would be dissolved. Mendelsohn was later unseated by a vote in the Senate.

GERMAN EXPEDITION FINDS ANCIENT TEMPLE OF BAAL

Berlin, Aug. 30.—The ancient Temple of Baal, god of the Canaanites, was unearthed by a German archaeological expedition on the site of the ancient city of Shechem.

The expedition, which is headed by Professor Ernst Sellin, started its work in 1914, but was interrupted during the war. Professor Sellin believes that the Temple of Baal which he discovered is that referred to in Judges, Chapter 9. The excavation laid bare the temple in its entirety.

LOUIS MARSHALL'S CRITICISM STIRS TURKISH JEWS; LEADER REPLIES

Gad Franco, Author of New Bill, Offers Explanation; Adoption of Swiss Code Made Minority Clauses Unnecessary, He Says; National Minorities Congress Adopts Resolution on Subject; Marshall Reaffirms Stand, Proving His Point that Turkish Jewish Leaders Had No Right to Renounce Charter of Liberty Made Act of International Concern

Constantinople, Aug. 30.—The criticism of Louis Marshall, president of the American Jewish Committee, of the act of the Turkish Jewish notables, members of the Jewish National Assembly of Turkey, in renouncing the claim of Turkish Jewry to the national minorities rights guaranteed to it under the treaty of Lausanne, found wide echo among Turkish Jews.

Mr. Marshall's accusation of cowardice directed against the Turkish Jewish notables has created consternation in the Turkish Jewish community.

Gad Franco, well known Turkish-Jewish lawyer and former president of the Jewish Communities in Turkey, when interviewed by the correspondent of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency took exception to the statement of Mr. Marshall.

"While I regret the immoderate and certainly unmerited terms used by Mr. Marshall in his criticism of the act of Turkish Jewish leaders, I can only attribute this to Mr. Marshall's desire to defend the Turkish Jews from themselves, although Mr. Marshall apparently knows little of the present actual conditions of Jewish life in Turkey," Mr. Franco stated.

Mr. Franco expressed the opinion that the Jews of Turkey have renounced their minority rights guaranteed by the Treaty of Lausanne but not unconditionally. "These rights have no longer any legal standing in Turkey in view of the recent decision of the Turkish government to apply the Swiss code, which recognizes the equality of all Turkish citizens irrespective of race or creed." Mr. Franco added that the bill concerning the status of the Jewish communities in Turkey, of which he was one of the authors, contains the request of Turkish Jewish leaders to the government for certain counter

guarantees of Jewish prerogatives and rights. Mr. Franco further expressed the hope that this new information will induce Mr. Marshall and others who believe that the Jews of Turkey have been betrayed to revise their opinion.

Geneva, Aug. 30.—A resolution dealing with the possibility of renunciation by national minorities of the national minorities rights guaranteed to them under the peace treaties was adopted by the National Minorities Congress, which concluded its sessions here on Saturday.

The resolution declares null and void every decision of any national group renouncing its minority rights, whether or not these rights are embodied in the international treaties. The resolution also denounces as a violation of public order, the attempts of governments to effect renunciation by the national minority groups of their rights.

VASZONYI'S WIDOW GETS PENSION FROM KEHILLAH

Budapest, Aug. 30.—A fund of ten million kronen was voted by the Kehillah of Budapest for the widow of Wilhelm Vaszonyi, late Hungarian statesman and leader of the Liberal party.

Vaszonyi died in poor circumstances, it was learned, all of his income having gone for charitable purposes.

Vaszonyi died recently as a result of wounds received in an attack made upon him by members of the Awakening Magyars.

AUSTRIAN JEWISH SCIENTIST ANNOUNCES AN IMPORTANT NEW MEDICAL DISCOVERY

"Hormon" Is Name of Fluid Discovered in Heart

Vienna, Aug. 30.—An important scientific discovery, which holds promise for the future cure of heart and nerve diseases, was announced by Professor Loewy of the University of Graz.

"Hormon" is the name of a fluid discovered by Professor Loewy which is said to be located in the heart and which connects the nerves and the heart. It is stated that due to this discovery it will be possible in the future to regulate the functioning of the heart. It also contains new possibilities in nerve therapy.

MAX REINHARDT WILL COME TO UNITED STATES

Vienna, Aug. 30.—Max Reinhardt, well known German Jewish theatrical producer, will leave for the United States the end of September, it was learned here today.

It was stated that Mr. Reinhardt's journey to the United States is in connection with a huge theatrical undertaking in California.

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**NATIONAL MINORITIES
CONGRESS OFFICE WILL
BE LOCATED IN VIENNA**
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Geneva, Aug. 30.—The Executive Committee elected by the National Minorities Congress before its adjournment, held two sessions here. The sessions were devoted to a discussion of ways and means of carrying out the resolutions of the Congress. It was decided that the headquarters of the Congress are to be in Vienna. Another session of the committee will be held in Dresden, Germany.

In a statement issued by Dr. Leo Motzkin, chairman of the Committee of Jewish Delegations and member of the Executive Committee of the National Minorities Congress, he attached great importance to the outcome of the Congress, particularly concerning the Jewish national minorities.

Dr. Motzkin conferred with Dr. Sokol, the permanent delegate of the Republic of Poland at the League of Nations.

**JEWISH EMIGRATION FROM
HUNGARY IS REVIEWED**
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Budapest, Aug. 30.—The volume of Jewish emigration from Hungary in recent years is reviewed in reports made public here.

The reports deal with the emigration from Hungary, which has increased in recent years because of the difficult economic situation in the country. It appears that the emigrants went to many countries, including Brazil, Siberia and Palestine.

The report mentions the fact that the Budapest Polytechnic has supplied several engineers for Palestine and that four Hungarian professors are instructors at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem. Several groups of Hungarian Jews have established colonies, the report states.

**On the Dispute in the Chicago Jewish
Welfare Institutions**

The report from Chicago that a Jewish dispute, involving the question of religious freedom, has arisen there and as a result the Moses Montefiore Hebrew Free School in that city has summoned the Chicago Jewish Charities to a 'Din Torah' (rabbinical trial) because the latter withdrew financial support from the school when it failed to alter its course of studies to conform to the requirements of the Jewish Education Committee, is termed by the "Jewish Daily News," orthodox paper of New York, "a war of Reform Judaism against Orthodoxy."

"The conflict of the orthodox school of Chicago," the paper writes, "against the Charity Federation which is conducted by a Reform Jew is not a conflict of one school nor is it a conflict that involves only Chicago; it involves the orthodoxy of the entire country. It involves the great question; shall the orthodoxy of America allow itself to be fought and stifled by the Reformed Jews who are in a position to employ the charity Federations as an instrument for their fight against orthodoxy?"

Pointing out that the Hebrew Free School of Chicago agreed to accept financial support from the Charity Federation only on condition that the Federation refrain from interfering with the school's method of teaching, the paper characterizes the behavior of the Charity Federation as "a crime" and observes: "It is a crime when an effort is made to force someone to do things against his conscience through the means of money and to seek to violate the freedom of conscience of others under the mask of a charity organization which undertook to keep from intruding into anything except to collect money and distribute it.

"In certain American cities," the paper proceeds, "there are community charity chests, mutual city drives which include funds for Christian as well as Jewish institutions. What would we say for example if after a drive of this kind the Christian ministers, who participated in the work of collecting the funds, were to make out a program of

**BRITISH WARSHIP INTER-
VENES IN BEDOUIN FEUD**

Jerusalem, Aug. 30.—The protection of a British warship at Ababa, the Transjordanian port on the Red Sea, was invoked because of a feud between two Bedouin tribes.

The warfare is being waged by a Bedouin tribe, subjects of Egypt, and the Bedouins of the Akaba region. Emir Shakher was intrusted with the mission of making peace between the tribes.

what is to be done in the Young Men's Hebrew Association, or if these ministers decided to abolish Kashruth in a Jewish hospital? Or if Jews, let us say, were to try to dictate in Christian institutions? The Federation of Charities in Chicago has no more right to dictate to the Hebrew School or to any other school! A partnership between the Reform and Orthodox Jews can be possible only in the matter of collecting and distributing funds, but in nothing else.

"It is a war of the Reformed Jews against orthodox Judaism, a war in which the wealthy Reformed Jews or their paid assistants desire to use the whip of money to suppress orthodoxy. It is a war which the orthodox Jews must take up."

The hope that the dispute in Chicago may turn into a sort of Jewish "Dayton trial" is expressed by the "Jewish Morning Journal," another orthodox paper in New York. While assuming a more impartial tone, than the "Jewish Daily News" the "Jewish Morning Journal" declares: "We are certain that in the end the orthodox Jews will overcome the Reform Jews even in Federations proper, and keen observers among the latter admit that the future is ours. But the transition is difficult and lasts longer than it should because those who assume the role of representatives of orthodoxy do not abide firmly enough by the principles it is their duty to defend. If the Chicago "Din Torah" could become in our Jewish world a sort of "Dayton Trial," the large orthodox element of American Jewry would become more conscious and would find it much easier to assert the independence and self reliance which it should have."

**Warns America Against Peril of State-
Religion**

That America is imperilled by the menace of a state religion, that such a state religion has already virtually been established in one state and is dangerously near being established in other states, in consequence of the unabated movement of the Fundamentalists, is the warning sounded by Dr. Albert C. Dieffenbach, well known lecturer and writer and editor of the "Christian Register," a Unitarian weekly of Boston.

Writing in the "World" of Aug. 29, Dr. Dieffenbach, declares:

"A state religion is one which is recognized and preferred to all others. Such a religion has been established by law in Tennessee. The majority Fundamentalists in the various denominations have prevailed not only in their churches but also in the Legislature. A dogma has become a statute. A virtual state church has thus arisen, composed of many sects, with like doctrines and political purposes, and the effect of their dominance and solidarity is the setting up of a monarchy in the heart of a democracy.

"The soul of the American idea is that our country was conceived in freedom and dedicated to liberty.

RUZZES DETERMINED TO FIGHT TO THE END, ARAB EDITOR REPORTS

Jerusalem, Aug. 30.—The determination of the Druzes to continue their fight against the French was reported by the Arab paper, "Meraat el Sherk." The editor of the newspaper, who returned from Djebel Druze, said that the Druzes have sufficient arms and arms but that they lack physical and medical instruments. The Druze schools have been closed and the pupils are engaged in aiding the support of the wounded and of ammunition. The Druzes have decided to fight on all fronts and to concentrate on the Djebel Druze front and to continue the fight to the end.

Jerusalem, Aug. 30.—Transjordanian militants are protesting against the closing of Druze refugees in Transjordan, according to despatches received from Amman. Inhabitants of Alzaraka have despatched a memorandum to Emir Abdullah protesting against the settlement of the refugees there.

The rising tide of fundamentalism we have seen a Legislature assume the authority, become, in fact, exacting what the Emperor or King once was. Tennessee and Mississippi, with the States preparing, have utterly despised Jefferson, whom we have cherished as the exponent of an inalienable American right.

The simple truth is the prevailing religious powers in Protestantism do not believe in freedom. I say this deliberately. Every week it is my duty to study representative religious journals. They speak for all the churches in an authoritative way. I say, with an accurate knowledge of the facts, that with the exception of three or four of the number liberty is never mentioned in a word tabooed.

The issue is, Shall the soul be under authority, or shall the soul be free? In the name of Jew and Roman Catholic, Protestant in all his varieties, and non-churchman for whom one would provide his own kind of church, I plead for freedom, for freedom is the spirit of humanity which leads to peace and good-will, to progress and peace. Only let us not be deceived. Crushed to earth will rise again and only when we take it up bravely, put it on its feet and push it forward.

MARSHALL'S CRITICISM CAUSES STIR IN TURKISH JEWRY; LEADER REPLIES

Marshall reiterated his previous stand, declaring himself unwilling to modify in the slightest degree his previous statements, in which the Turkish Jewish leaders were charged with cowardice. Mr. Marshall declared:

"After reading the cablegram from Constantinople in which it is sought to justify the action of the Turkish Jewish notables renouncing the rights guaranteed by the Treaty of Lausanne to the Jews of Turkey, I am unwilling to modify to the slightest degree what I have said in my several statements on that subject. On the contrary, what Mr. Franco has said by way of apology only strengthens my conviction that the action proposed to be taken is calamitous. It is entirely true, however, that my motive in criticizing this action was prompted by the desire to defend the Turkish Jews from themselves.' It might have been added that it is likewise due to an overwhelming wish that this action shall not be regarded as a precedent to be pursued in other countries. The very fact that it is now said that the Jews of Turkey have not unconditionally renounced their guaranteed minority rights and that an attempt is now being made to secure from the Turkish government counter guarantees of Jewish prerogatives and rights' tells the whole story. The Treaty of Lausanne was not intended to confer 'prerogatives' upon the Jew or any other minorities. Its purpose was to confer upon them the fundamental rights of citizenship as recognized in the United States, Great Britain, France and other leading nations. By that treaty these rights were by the government of Turkey recognized as fundamental laws, that no law, regulation or official action was to conflict or interfere with the stipulations contained in the treaty, and that no law, regulation or official action should prevail over them.'

"It is these rights that the notables have presumed to surrender with the expectation that the Turkish government might eventually confer upon the Jews similar rights. The fallacy of this conception lies in the fact that the Treaty of Lausanne affords sanctions for rights conferred by that instrument which can be resorted to in the event of a failure to conform with their requirements. No matter what arrangement the Turkish government may make with the Turkish Jews it will have no such sanctions. It will not be a matter of international concern. It will eliminate from the fundamental law of Turkey the Bill of Rights guaranteed by the Treaty of Lausanne. It will enable the Turkish government to do just what Roumania did after 1878, and what would be done in other countries but for the fact that the treaty is a contract, not with the minorities, but with the nations of the earth. The Turkish notables have no more right to renounce this charter of liberty for the Jews than they have for the Armenians or any other of the Turkish minorities. PROPOSE JEWISH HYGIENE SOCIETY IN POLAND; EPIDEMIC CLOSES SCHOOLS

Warsaw, Aug. 30.—The closing of all Talmud Torahs and Chedaram (Orthodox Jewish schools) was ordered by the government school inspector in the city of Warsaw because of the scarlet fever epidemic.

Dr. Schor, Rabbi of the Great Synagogue on Tomackie, in his sermon on Saturday appealed for the immediate establishment of an all-Jewish hygiene society in the Republic of Poland for the purpose of popularizing among the Jewish population the tenets of hygiene and the principles of sanitary living. The Rabbi pointed to the sanitary commandments contained in the Bible.

During last week 148 cases of scarlet fever were registered in Warsaw. Five hundred and twenty-three cases are on record since the beginning of the month.

JEWISH FAMILY BRUTALLY MURDERED IN BESSARABIA

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Kishineff, Aug. 30.—The brutal murder of a Jewish family in a Bessarabian village is reported here. It was stated that the murder was the result of strong anti-Semitic agitation in that region.

Peasants attacked the house of the sixty-year-old Jewish farmer, Reuben Prokupetz, in the village of Tinesht, near Levele. The group of peasants, including several women, broke into the house of Prokupetz and attacked his seventeen-year-old daughter, cutting her about the head and throat. Prokupetz and his wife, who came to the rescue of their daughter, were killed and decapitated. The daughter, who survives, was taken to the hospital.

Sonia Opesca, one of the peasant girls, and two other peasants were arrested by the authorities.

S. A. OVERSUBSCRIBES KEREN HAYESOD QUOTA

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Johannesburg, S. Africa, Aug. 30.—The quota of the South African Jewish community for the Keren Hayesod, the Palestine Foundation Fund, was exceeded, reports issued here today state.

The quota of £100,000 was oversubscribed, £115,000 having been raised. Contributions were made by non-Jews as well as Jews and among the contributors were a minister, five city mayors, several members of parliament and several judges.

FACILITIES GRANTED JEWISH EMIGRANTS FROM ROUMANIA, REPORT OF HIAS DECLARES

The American Consul at Bucharest has agreed to permit the inspection of Jewish emigrants by Jewish physicians of the former Polyclinic, Oze, a statement issued by the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society of America last week.

The Roumanian doctor who hitherto was the only one to examine Jewish emigrants before the Consul was very friendly to emigrants in general and particularly to the Jews, it was stated. The emigrants are now examined by Jewish doctors who understand their language.

The Hias also obtained a concession in connection with the granting of visas. The American Consul has always demanded that every emigrant applying for a visa must bring a certificate from a shipping company stating that the voyage is fully prepaid to destination. The Consul refused to recognize tickets the emigrants bought from local representatives of shipping companies unless Hias gave a written guarantee that these tickets had been fully paid for. Most of the emigrants under the July quota had already bought their steamship tickets and faced a great hardship until Hias arranged to give the desired guarantee. This arrangement with the shipping companies has also led to the Hias exercising a certain control over the shipping agencies and thus protecting the emigrants against being exploited.

LATVIAN JEWRY MOURNS LOSS OF GREAT RABBI

Riga, Aug. 16.—The Jewish population of Dvinsk paid its last tribute to Rabbi Meir Simche Kaz, the famous Gaon of Dvinsk, who died here last week at the age of 81. The funeral of the late rabbi took place yesterday in Dvinsk, where the remains were conveyed. All the rabbis in Latvia, representatives of all the Jewish communities in the country, and the whole Jewish population of Dvinsk attended the funeral. The Jewish shops in Dvinsk were kept closed all day.

Rabbi Meir Simche Kaz was born in 1845 in the Lithuanian town of Baltermanz. He was a student of the Yeshiva of Slobodka and on graduating was appointed Rabbi in Bialystok. He was then called to Dvinsk where he was Rabbi for thirty-nine years. He was regarded as one of the greatest rabbinical authorities in the world.

Theodore Jaekel, United States Consul General in Warsaw, is named as defendant in an action filed by John Downarowitz, of Jersey City, N. J., in the United States District Court, to recover \$3,500 because it is alleged, Mr. Jaekel refused to issue the passport of Downarowitz's wife.

Where Jews Are "Gentiles"!

Salt Lake City, Utah, Aug. 25.—Utah is the only place in the world where the Jew is a Gentile!

The Mormons, or Latter-day Saints, regard themselves as "Of Israel" and those of the state not of their faith as Gentiles. They do not deliberately speak of the Jew as a Gentile; it is the other people who do this. The situation has given rise to a standing joke in Utah which is enjoyed immensely by all creeds. Tourists are told about it and enjoy it, too. Sometimes one hears the expression, "Mormon, Jew and Gentile." A group of jewelers organized for social purposes call themselves "The Mormon, Jew and Gentile Club."

The Mormon is the only Christian who does not want to convert the Jew, or, at least, thinks he should be converted before he can be of much use from a religious standpoint. Without giving an inch of ground in their stand for the orthodox Christian story relating to the birth of Jesus and his life, the Mormons, strange as it may seem, regard the Jew as headed, one might say, for Salvation. The Mormon religion teaches that the Jews will eventually gather to Palestine and become once more a mighty people. They are more orthodox along Jewish lines than many of the Jews themselves! One of their apostles—the official title of their church is "Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints," and they have apostles, bishops, prophet, etc., as in the original Christian church—was sent to Palestine in the early days of the organization and dedicated the land for the gathering of the Jews!

Not infrequently do Mormons in their sermons make complimentary references to the Jewish people, and some years ago when Henry Ford launched his attack on the Jews, a prominent official of the church stated in the big Tabernacle that the Mormon Church was the friend of the Jew. Jewish rabbis have discussed their ideals in Mormon churches with Mormon leaders on the stand and with big sendoffs from them.

No 100 per cent, or 85 per cent Mormon will tolerate an attack on the Jew. When former Governor Bamberger was elected to the office of chief executive of Utah, in 1916, one of his most prominent supporters was a stalwart in the Mormon Church, B. H. Roberts, orator, journalist, former U. S. war chaplain and at present head of the Mormon mission in the Eastern states, with headquarters in New York City.

The position of the Mormon regarding the Jews, speaking from the religious standpoint, is interesting to the Jew, even if he has no patience with it. It is this: the Mormon believes the Jews of 2,000 years ago were mistaken through worldly pride in denying Jesus. They believe they were scattered on this account as a punishment, but that, being chosen people of God they are to be forgiven and to eventually come to their own. Disagreeing with the Jews

NEW PUBLICATIONS ARE TO BE ISSUED BY EDUCATION DEPARTMENT OF UNION

Cincinnati, O., Aug. 31.—Five new works are being added this Fall to the publications of the Department of Synagogue and School Extension of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, it was announced here. The list of new publications is headed by a History of the Jews after the fall of the Jewish State, by Dr. Ismar Elbogen, and the new publications supplement a long list of textbooks and manuals for general reading, teachers' training, students' study, school organization and management which the Department of Synagogue and School Extension has previously published. These publications are planned and supervised by the Joint Commission on Jewish Education of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations and the Central Conference of American Rabbis.

The new works include a pupil's portfolio of Kindergarten Handwork for the Holidays, by Gussie Cronheim Egelson; the House of Bondage, a Teacher's Manual, by Adele Bildersee; the History of the Jews, by Dr. Ismar Elbogen; the Spirit of Judaism, a Pageant, by Dr. Samuel Schulman and Sara Miller, and Every Mother, a morality play by Rabbi Samuel S. Cohen. In addition, the Department is also issuing a Holy Land Travel Game, arranged by Julius B. Feibelman, designed for play or instruction in the classroom or home. The map of Palestine forms the background, on which six roadways lead to Jerusalem. Each passes through eleven cities, places of Biblical interest. In all there are sixty-six such points, covering practically all of the Biblical stories. Each point on the map is numbered, and an accompanying pamphlet with corresponding numbers gives full explanation of each point on the map, together with references to the chapters and verses in the Bible.

Mrs. Egelson's portfolio of Handwork is planned to enable the teacher to present the lessons of the Sabbath and Holidays to little children through self-expression. The pupil's portfolio contains twelve sheets on which are outlined the objects to be constructed. The Holidays thus taught are Rosh Hashanah, Succoth, Chanukah, Purim, Pesach, Shabuoth and the Sabbath.

The Teacher's Manual, "Out of the House of Bondage," is published in connection with the Bible reader for the pupil, which covers the stories dealing with the Life of Moses and represents a careful development of the lessons in the pupil's book.

Dr. Elbogen's History of the Jews is designed especially for the use of adult
