

CALL CONFERENCE ON JEWISH COLONIZATION WORK IN MOSCOW

Sessions to Begin November 18; Organizations in America Invited

A conference of all Jewish organizations and societies that are willing to assist the Jewish back-to-the-land movement in Soviet Russia will be convoked in Moscow by the Ozet, the Society to Settle Jews on the Land, according to information received by the Icor, New York Communist organization to assist the colonization work.

The conference is to be held in Moscow. It will open on November 18 and will last one week. Invitations to participate in the conference, which was called some time ago but was postponed, were extended by the Ozet to the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee, the Ort, the Ica, the Argentine Jewish Committee to Help the Colonization Work in Russia, the Latvian Committee of Riga for Assisting the Jewish Colonization Work, the London Gezerd, the Hilfsverein der Deutschen Juden of Berlin, the Alliance Israelite Universelle of Paris, the Jewish Colonization Fund of South Africa, the Icor of New York and other Jewish societies.

Invitations were also extended to the Workmen's Circle of New York. A number of Landsmanschaften in the United States were also invited to send delegates. The Ozet leaders have declared that a number of the invited organizations have expressed their consent to participate in the conference.

The agenda of the conference includes reports on various phases of the work accomplished in the colonization movement and the continuation of the work.

COLONIAL OFFICE APPOINTS PALESTINE CURRENCY BOARD

London, Sept. 1.—The appointment of a Palestine Currency Board, which will have for its purpose a study of the possibilities for introducing a Palestine currency, independent of the English and Egyptian pound, was announced yesterday by the British Colonial Office. Mr. Ezechiel, one of the Crown Agents for the Colonies, was appointed chairman of the Board. Other members of the Board are Leslie Couper, manager of the British West Africa Bank, Edward J. Harding, assistant secretary of the Colonial Office, William L. C. Phillips of the treasury department. The secretary of the Board is Mr. Ransom. Offices of the Board will be at 4 Mill Bank, Westminster, London.

It is planned that the Palestine currency will be based on the Pound Sterling. The Board will also have control of the currency supply for Palestine, it was stated.

U. S. LABOR DEPARTMENT IS PREPARING TO ENACT NATIONAL ORIGINS PLAN

Acting Secretary of Labor Makes Statement on New Measure

Washington, D. C., Sept. 1.—Interesting details of the plans of the Labor Department for the abolition of the present quota system and the putting into effect of the national origin plan were given in a statement by Robe Carl White, Acting Secretary of Labor.

The department already is planning for operation of the immigration law under the new national origins plan, through an inter-departmental committee in which Walter W. Hubbard, Second Assistant Secretary of Labor, is the department's representative, Secretary White stated.

The law provides that the Secretaries of Labor, Commerce and State shall jointly, as soon as feasible, prepare a statement showing the number of nationals of other countries resident in continental United States, as determined by the United States census of 1890, to serve as the population basis for determining quotas of immigration: from the respective foreign countries.

"The three Secretaries, Mr. Kellogg, Mr. Hoover and Mr. Davis," Acting Secretary White said, "have not yet prepared their report, so there is nothing to say as to that. You will recall perhaps, that Statistician Trevor, long connected with the Carnegie Institute, compiled a statement of what the effect of the origins plan of determining would be on the different countries. According to his figures, Germany, Norway, Sweden and Ireland would be reduced in the quotas from their countries while Great Britain would gain in number. That is an unofficial estimate, however, and the official figures have yet to be determined.

"There have been many protests voiced against the national origins plan of determining immigration per country, but of course that is the business of Congress, not of the administrative functions of the Department of Labor. The national origins law, which the President approved on May 26, 1924, is

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AUSTRIAN KULTUSGEMEINDE REQUESTS THAT PENNINESS IMMIGRANTS BE BARRED

Vienna, Sept. 1.—A request to prevent Jewish immigrants without means from entering Austria was directed to the Austrian government by the Kultusgemeinde, the Jewish communal organization, of Klagenfurt, the capital of Carinthia.

The Kultusgemeinde urged the government to direct the Austrian consul in Trieste to refuse visas to immigrants without means, particularly those who are returned from Palestine.

SOCIALIST INTERNATIONAL TAKES UP COMPLAINT OF JEWS AGAINST UKRAINIANS

Appoints Special Commission to Inquire into Schwartzbard Case

Zurich, Sept. 1.—The slaying of Semion Petlura, leader of Ukrainian pogrom bands, by Sholom Schwartzbard, in revenge for the anti-Jewish massacres in the Ukraine during Petlura's rule, was the subject of discussion at a meeting of the Executive of the Socialist International held here.

The discussion came up as a result of a complaint submitted to the Executive by B. Locker, a delegate of the Poale Zion, and Dr. Abramowitz, representing the Bund, against the Ukrainian Social Democrats who have taken sides with the Petlura forces in the Schwartzbard case which will come up shortly before the Paris court. A special committee was appointed by the Executive to inquire into the matter and to render judgment.

The Executive Committee of the Socialist International also adopted a motion introduced by Mr. Locker which purports to add a paragraph to the Washington agreement. The paragraph is to the effect that the Socialist parties urge the mandatory powers to introduce an eight-hour day in the mandated territories and legislation for the protection of labor. Mr. Locker described the difficult conditions from which Palestine labor suffers. Mr. Williams declared on behalf of the British Labor Party that his party will support the fight of Palestine labor for proper labor legislation.

ARAB EMIGRANTS ASK PALESTINE GOVERNMENT FOR PROTECTION ABROAD

Jerusalem, Sept. 1.—A request that the Palestine government protect the interests abroad of Arabs who emigrated from the country was made to E. Mills, Acting Chief Secretary, by a deputation of Bethlehem Arabs.

Mr. Mills told the deputation that the emigrants must apply for Palestinian nationality, so that the British representatives abroad should be able to take them under their charge. They are now said to be Ottomans, and applications must be made to the Turkish consular officers.

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HOPE DESPITE CRISIS IS DOMINANT IN PALESTINE. U. P. A. WORKER REPORTS

Hope despite the crisis is the marked characteristic of present day Jewish life in Palestine, according to M. A. Zeldin, director of the New York City United Palestine Appeal, who just returned from Palestine.

"When one travels through Europe and visits Palestine afterwards, he sees that almost the whole of Europe is living on its past. One can hardly see, in the big cities, any new constructions outside of hotels. You do not feel any striving for the future. When you enter Palestine, you feel that although the real development began only about seven or eight years ago, the country is growing from hour to hour. New buildings are springing up everywhere and in spite of the hardships that many of the Jews living in the cities and towns are enduring, they are full of hope for the future and everybody is striving to have something of his own in the country," Mr. Zeldin stated.

"There is really a heavy crisis now in some of the cities, especially in Tel-Aviv. This is mainly due to the fact that the Polish Jews that immigrated into Palestine within the last two years invested all they brought with them in buildings, and were left penniless. Their funds which were left in Poland, with the hope of bringing them into Palestine later in order to establish some industry, have lost value on account of the drop of the Polish Zloty. Many of the well-to-do Jews of Poland who prepared themselves to migrate into Palestine, lost all they possessed and were not able to fulfill their wish. Therefore, the present immigration into Palestine consists mainly of Chalutzim, workingmen ready for any sacrifice, but without anything of their own. The Zionist Organization has a serious problem to solve as to how to decrease the number of unemployed," he said.

CATTLE PLAGUE CAUSES PALESTINE MEAT SHORTAGE

Jerusalem, Aug. 10.—A shortage of meat prevails in Palestine owing to the little slaughtering carried on as a result of the government's drastic measures in connection with the cattle plague. The price of meat has risen appreciably.

The shortage of meat resulting from the Government's measures to combat the cattle plague, writes the "Ha-aretz," is arousing serious concern in official quarters, and may affect public interests during the coming months. It is learned that the authorities are deeply interested in the question and plans are being drawn up to guarantee adequate supplies for the winter. One of the great difficulties is that there are no refrigerators for the preservation of killed meat in Palestine, and it will be necessary to import the meat from Egypt. As this will not solve the Kasher meat question, it is learned that beasts will be imported from Roumania under strict sanitary supervision.

The cattle plague is raging in the villages around Ludd. In the villages of Jimzu and Beit Jaballah many cattle have died. Quarantine has been proclaimed at Mikveh Israel. Owners of herds are warned against allowing their animals out to graze, and are instructed to take effective precautions against the spread of the epidemic. Lydda, Safrieh, Ramleh, Sarafand, Al Amar, Jimzu, Annabeh, Nebi Daniel and Dabriel have been proclaimed an infected area.

A special notice has been posted by the Chief Veterinary Offices in Palestine stating that whereas Rinderpest, Cattle Plague or Peste Bovine exists in Palestine, it is prohibited to hold any exhibition of stock or sale of stock in any open market or private sale yard in Palestine until further notice.

An order has also been issued stating that since a number of cases of cattle plague have appeared in villages of the districts of Jafa, Nablus, Ramallah and Tiberias and in order that this disease may not be conveyed to other

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crop in the vineyards and orchards. The "kvutzoth" and "moshovim" are also in a better position now than they were before. But here, too, if the Kerem Hayesod would have more money, it would enable the Zionist Organization to settle more on land which the National Fund has in its possession and is not being developed as yet.

"There is some dissatisfaction in Jewish circles in Palestine concerning the Government's policy, but on the whole, they do not pay very much attention to the political situation. Every Jew in Palestine feels that nothing can stop them from their work and the only thing that bothers them is the financial and economic means which must be provided to secure the settlements that are established and, what is more important, to create new settlements and to increase the Jewish immigration into Palestine," Mr. Zeldin declared.

Declares Jewish Communists Seek a "Jewish Republic"

That the Jewish Communists are seeking through the colonization of Jews to establish a Jewish "republic" in Russia, is the statement made in the "Freiheit," Jewish Communist paper of New York. This statement is emphasized in the course of an article denying the recent assertion of A. Revutzky, in the "Jewish Morning Journal," to the effect that the Jewish Communists have always regarded as "chauvinistic" the idea of a Jewish "republic," such as Soviet president Kalenin declares is being planned for Siberia.

"Does not Mr. Revutzky know," the "Freiheit" asks, "that in the 'Emes' (organ of the Jewish Communists in Russia) and in other Jewish papers in Soviet Russia, the fact is constantly emphasized that the Jewish colonization is being led in such a direction as to make possible the creation of a Jewish autonomy? Does he not know that in these Jewish Communist papers the close settlement of the Jews is welcomed? Does he not know that the 'Yevsek' (Jewish Communist) Tchermirsky wrote a book on the subject? Has he not seen excerpts of this book in the 'Emes,' precisely the excerpts relating to the question of a Jewish autonomy? Then how can he deliberately state that the 'Yevseks' have been striving to scatter the Jewish colonists, to keep them far from each other, in order to take revenge on the Zionists?"

"It is true the Communists objected to the 'boom' which the American press gave to the 'Crimea Republic.' This was a pure invention and it could only injure the cause. A couple of years ago it was a question regarding a very modest work, a question of settling several thousand families on the land in order to save them from ruin. But who does not know that from the very beginning it has been the desire of the Jewish Communists to settle the Jewish colonists as close to each other as possible so that they might be able to create their own cultural center—and this in fact is taking place now.

"As regards the question of Siberia," the "Freiheit" continues, "everyone knows that this is nothing new. It may be news for a correspondent of the 'Herald-Tribune,' but those who read the resolution of the Executive Committee of the Ukrainian Soviets of May 19, know that it was pointed out there that since Ukraina has not sufficient land, an effort should be made simultaneously with the present colonization work to settle Jews in Siberia. And Revutzky knows that Siberia is one of the food providers of Russia, furnishing treasures of wheat, and that only children entertain the idea that

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proposed to take the place of the present quota, with its maximum of 150,000 immigration from all countries. Unless the Congress should repeal the origins law of 1924, it automatically, beginning next July, will replace the present quota system, with the same maximum of 150,000, according to origin.

"The new law says, among other things, that the annual quota of any nationality shall be two per cent of the number of foreign-born individuals of such nationality, resident in continental United States, as determined by the United States census of 1890, but the minimum quota of any nationality shall be 100. It says that the annual quota of any nationality for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1927, and for each fiscal year thereafter, shall be a number which bears the same ratio to 150,000 as the number of inhabitants in continental United States in 1920 having that national origin bears to the whole number of inhabitants in continental United States in 1920.

"National origin is to be ascertained by determining as nearly as may be in respect of each geographical area, treated as a separate country (except Canada, Newfoundland, Mexico, Cuba, Haiti, the Dominican Republic, Canal Zone, or an independent country of Central or South America), the number of inhabitants in continental United States in 1920 whose birth or ancestry is attributable to such geographical area. The determination is not to be made by tracing the ancestors or descendants of particular individuals but to be based upon statistics of immigration and emigration, together with rates of increase of population as shown by successive decennial United States censuses and other reliable data.

"Secretaries Kellogg, Hoover and Davis, after getting expert information and assistance from the Census Bureau, are to report to the President the quota for each nationality and the

Pointing out that "it is due to Mr. Lipsky that an open break has occurred between the Joint Distribution Committee and the American Zionists," Mr. Nombreg concludes with the assertion: "Mr. Brainin's words can be regarded as an expression of Jewish public opinion."

Secret "German Brotherhood Against Jewish Solidarity" Exposed in Berlin

(By Our Berlin Correspondent)

Berlin, Aug. 15.—A secret anti-Semitic organization for the purpose of putting into effect a nation-wide economic boycott against the Jews in Germany has been at work for some time, according to revelations made here by Helmut von Gerlach, the noted Liberal publicist, in his weekly, "Welt am Montag."

A considerable amount of material information regarding the secret organization, which is called the "German Brotherhood Against the Jewish Solidarity," was secured by Herr von Gerlach from a person who is familiar with the doings of the anti-Semitic society. According to this information, the organizer and leader of the movement to oust the Jews from German industry and business through a boycott is one Beythien, twenty-seven years old, formerly private secretary to the National anti-Semite, Alfred Roth. This Beythien is sponsored by Professor Goerke of Brandenburg and Prince Salvator von Ysenburg, Director Meier of the Reichsverband Deutscher Lohndempfänger, has placed his office at Belle-Alliance-Platz 17, at the disposal of Beythien's organization.

In approaching leading Christian personalities and business firms for the purpose of securing their support for his anti-Jewish "brotherhood," Beythien uses the following appeal, which constitutes the platform of the organization:

"To take money from the Jews, wherever possible, but to spend it only in places that are in right standing! In this way the Jewish money front will be effectively weakened. To be as unscrupulous as the Jews! To learn from the Jews and become cleverer! To fight the Jews to the knife!"

Beythien is striving to create a national German chain, from which Jews will be completely barred. Every phase of business and the leading professions, such as law, medicine, etc., are represented in his society and the members pay dues ranging from 10 to 300 marks each. Herr von Gerlach has a list of all the members, among whom are found 112 Berlin members, and of these he publishes the names of the following members, who are more or less prominent:

NEW YORK IMPORTS \$7,000,000 WORTH OF FOWL FOR THE HIGH HOLIDAY FEASTS

Thirteen cars of live poultry are being brought into New York City for the High Holidays. These consignments include 5,850,000 fowl valued at \$7,000,000.

The health authorities are alarmed over the fact that diphtheric roup has been discovered among the fowl in some of the cars. City Health Commissioner Louis I. Harris has ordered steps taken to prevent the spread of the epidemic and to kill all the sick fowl. Inspectors were appointed at the various freight yards in the city.

One hundred and eighty-four Jewish students were among the high school pupils who were awarded New York State scholarships by the Board of Regents.

The holder of one of these scholarships will be entitled to \$100 a year for the first years of his college course while attending any college in the State of New York approved by the Regents.

The Jewish Division of the New York Public Library will be closed on the Day of Atonement.

In view of the great interest shown by the public in the exhibition of materials relating to Jewish life in Oriental countries which opened shortly before Passover, it has again been decided to prolong the exhibition for another month covering the period which includes the Jewish holidays so as to enable those who have not seen the exhibition heretofore to avail themselves of this opportunity.

Isaac Untermyer, seventy-three, elder and only brother of Samuel Untermyer, died Tuesday in New York City.

Born in Lynchburg, Va., June 23, 1853, Mr. Untermyer came to New York with his parents at fifteen.

Having been graduated from Columbia Law School he was admitted to the bar in 1874. Shortly afterward he became a member of the law firm of Guggenheimer & Untermyer, of which Samuel Untermyer became a member the following year. He retired from the law firm fifteen years ago.

Abraham B. Becker, Chicago, banker, who left an estate of \$3,946,720, included among his bequests \$50,000 to the Jewish Charities of Chicago and the Art Institute of Chicago.

As for propaganda and publicity, he hopes to have the assistance of the anti-Semitic 'Stahlhelm' organization, with whom he is already negotiating. He is asking the 'Stahlhelm' to furnish him two of its members in 3,000 cities. In this way the whole country is to be covered with an anti-Jewish boycott net."

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President, under the law, has to issue proclamation of such quotas by next April 1. Nationality is to be determined by country of birth, treating as separate countries the colonies, dependencies or self-governing dominions, as separately enumerated by the 1890 census, with certain specific exceptions.

"There is an interesting field of study in our recent compilations of alien immigration. Compare them with our official figures for the year ending June 30, 1914, approximately a dozen years ago, but comparable as a year before the operation of the present quota restriction law and before the disturbed conditions of the World War.

"Germany, which during the past year furnished the largest number of immigrant aliens, furnished 79,871 in 1914, but 58,675 in 1926. England, from which the next largest number came in 1926, dropped from 51,746 in 1914 to 44,206 in 1926. Mexico furnished 13,089 alien immigrants in 1914, which increased to 42,638 in 1926. From Ireland came 33,898 in 1914, which advanced to 42,475 in 1926; from Scotland, 18,997 in 1914, but 27,298 in 1926.

"French alien immigrants numbered 18,106 in 1914 and 22,237 in 1926. Scandinavian countries in 1914 furnished 36,053, but these Norwegian, Danish and Swedish arrivals dropped to 19,418 in 1926. Hebrew immigrants, who numbered 138,051 in 1914 were but 19,267 in 1926. Italians, from the north of that country, in 1914 were 44,802 and in 1926 were 1,486, while from the south of Italy the 251,612 in 1914 are compared with 7,888 in 1926.

"The Polish numbered 122,657 in 1914; in 1926 their alien immigration into this country had dropped to 3,175. There were 12,566 Dutch and Flemish in 1914; in 1926 there were 3,156. Spanish American immigration registered in 1914 1,544 as against 2,519 in 1926. There were 9,298 Bohemians and Moravians among the alien immigrants of 1914; they numbered 2,494 in 1926. There were 49,957 Russians among the alien immigrants here in 1914; there were 938 in 1926. Japanese numbered 8,941 in 1914, and 598 in 1926; Chinese, 2,354 in 1914, and 1,375 in 1926; Cubans, 3,539 in 1914, numbered 1,476 in 1926. Magyars numbered 44,538 in 1914, but 1,076 in 1926; Welsh, 2,538 in 1914, 1,314 in 1926.

"All the other races or peoples enumerated for 1926 were less than 1,000. The others, for 1914 and 1926, respectively, were:

"African (black), 8,447 in 1914 and 894 in 1926. Armenians, 7,785 in 1914, and 741 in 1926; Bulgarians, Serbians and Montenegrins, 15,084 in 1914 and 532 in 1926; Croatians and Slovenians, 37,284 in 1914 and 692 in 1926; Dalmatian, Bosnian and Herzegovinian, 5,149 in 1914 and 75 in 1926; East Indian, 172 in 1914 and 50 in 1926. There were 12,805 Finnish in 1914 and 674 in 1926; Greeks, 45,881 in 1914, against 1,385 in 1926; Koreans, 152 in 1914 and 52 in 1926. There were 21,384 Lithuanians in 1914; in 1926 they numbered 393. There was only one Pacific Islander alien im-

Other peoples, a general classification not included in those I have mentioned, numbered 3,830 in 1914 and 381 in 1926," the statement concluded.

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
