

JEWISH DEPUTIES WAVER IN ATTITUDE TOWARD BARTEL GOVERNMENT

**Pessimistic Tone Evident Following
Government's Failure to Meet
Situation**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Warsaw, Sept. 21.—The attitude of the Club of Jewish Deputies toward the present regime in Poland, inaugurated by the May events termed the "moral revolution" and heralded as a new era in the life of the Jewish population and other national minorities in Poland, is beginning to waver.

This change of attitude became evident today when the Club held its first general session prior to the opening of the parliamentary session today. At that meeting, Deputy Apolinary Hartglass, president of the Club, submitted a report on the political situation. The tone of the report was entirely pessimistic. Deputy Isaac Gruenbaum introduced a motion that the Club decide to vote against the government budget in view of the fact that the Bartel government has not yet done anything to meet the demands of the Jewish population. Several speakers at the meeting urged a less drastic move, advising that the Jewish deputies merely refrain from voting on the budget question.

Deputy Frostig urged the deputies to veto lack of confidence in Education Minister Sojkowski, in view of the fact that the Ministry is still allowing the numerus clausus practice to be continued in the Polish universities and colleges.

A totally different view of the situation was taken by the "Dwa Grosze," (Continued on Page 4)

HUNGARIANS BLAME JEWS IN TRANSYLVANIA FOR THEIR DEFEAT IN SCHOOL QUESTION

Bucharest, Sept. 21.—The Jewish community in Transylvania, the Hungarian province annexed to Roumania, finds itself between the anvil and the sledge as a result of the school question now agitating Transylvania.

Since Transylvania was incorporated into Roumania a bid for Jewish support has been going on between the Roumanian government and the Hungarian minority. The Hungarians strive to include the Jews in their group, claiming that Hungarian is the mother tongue of Transylvanian Jews. If the Jewish group is added to the Hungarian group, their claim for Hungarian as the language of instruction in the Transylvanian schools would receive added strength. This demand formulated by the Hungarians was, however, refused by the Roumanian Minister of Education, Petrovitch. The question has now assumed an acute form because of the visit to Bucharest of Count Bethlen, Hungarian prime minister. He has in-

SUPPORT OF AMERICAN JEWRY FOR FLORIDA RELIEF IS OFFERED

**David A. Brown Places United Jewish Campaign Organization at
Disposal of American Red Cross**

The support of American Jewry in the efforts of the American Red Cross to alleviate the suffering of the victims of the Florida disaster was offered by the United Jewish Campaign.

The offer was made in a telegram addressed to John Barton Payne, chairman of the American Red Cross at Washington, D. C., by David A. Brown, national chairman of the United Jewish Campaign. The telegram read:

"As national chairman of the United Jewish Campaign, I desire to place at your disposal, for whatever service you may wish it, to render toward the alleviation of the suffering and distress due to the disaster in Florida, the entire national, state and local organization of the United Jewish Campaign, which was built up for the purpose of raising

\$25,000,000 for the reconstructive relief of European Jewry and which is at the present time not only completely intact but also functioning with remarkable success.

"Many of the fifteen hundred local organizations of the United Jewish Campaign, having completed the task for which they were created, have established themselves as social service groups for just such work as is required to bring prompt and maximum relief to the thousands of sufferers of the Florida disaster. They, the hundreds of other groups that are still functioning as campaign organizations and, in fact, the entire Jewish population of America stand ready to do your bidding in the name of humanity.

"I offer you not only the services of the entire organization of the United Jewish Campaign, numbering into the thousands, but also, for what use you care to make of it, my own personal services, whatever they may be worth to you and, on behalf of this organization and on my own behalf, await your orders."

AUGUST INCOME OF KEREN HAYESOD AMOUNTED TO £43,285

**Decides on Further Investment in
Electric Corporation**

London, Sept. 21.—The income of the Keren Hayesod, the Palestine Foundation Fund, for the month of August amounted to £43,285, according to a report made public today by the Keren Hayesod Board of Directors.

The total income of the Keren Hayesod so far is £2,516,322.

At a meeting of the Board of Directors held in Paris, it was decided that the Keren Hayesod acquire an additional number of shares in Rutenberg's Palestine Electric Corporation to the amount of £50,000, making a total investment of the Keren Hayesod in the company of £100,000.

The transfer of the Keren Hayesod headquarters from London to Jerusalem began today when the first group of the staff left for Palestine.

RABBI WISE PREACHES IN PRESIDENT'S CHURCH

Washington, Sept. 21.—Dr. Stephen S. Wise delivered two sermons on Sunday before the First Congregational Church, which is regularly attended by President Coolidge. This church worships in the local Reform Jewish Temple Sunday evenings since their church was condemned a few months ago as unsafe. The Pastor and Board of the church accepted the offer of Rabbi Abram Simon of the Temple for its use pending the reconstruction of the church.

HUNGARIAN STUDENTS OBJECT TO NUMERUS CLAUSUS LAW MODIFICATIONS

Budapest, Sept. 21.—The slight concessions granted by the Hungarian Minister of Education in the application of the numerus clausus to Jewish students in the Hungarian universities caused a violent protest on the part of the anti-Semitic leaders among the students.

Large groups of anti-Semitic students, led by the Hungarian Race Purifiers, demonstrated along the streets of Budapest today, protesting against the ministerial ordinance. The police intervened, dispersing the demonstrators.

The concessions granted by the Minister were to the effect that Jewish converts to Christianity are not to be subject to the numerus clausus and that the percentage of Jewish students admitted to the universities and colleges should not be based on the general enrollment in all the universities and colleges, but that each college should be considered separately.

**NOTED JEWISH PHILOSOPHER
HONORED ON 70TH BIRTHDAY**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service)

Berlin, Sept. 3.—The noted philosopher and authority on Kant, Professor Ernst Marcus, attained his seventieth birthday this week.

It was some time after he had become famous as a legal authority that he entered the field of philosophy and published a number of works which have placed him as one of the most prominent philosophers in Germany today. Much of his work is devoted to the explanation and confirmation of Kant.

Dr. Robert Durr, the philosopher, publishes in the "Frankfurter Zeitung" an appreciation of Professor Marcus in which he acclaims him as a great and independent thinker. "Marcus," he writes, "has not gone on hanging to Kant's coat tails. He had made an independent effort to solve his problems. If we study the writings of Marcus, we shall immediately see that he dominates his material independently. He has opened new paths, not just for the sake of opening new paths, but because they really lead to the goal, and this is the deciding point—although by different paths, he has reached complete agreement with Kant. Marcus's writings are no commentaries on Kant, but independent works, which, by their independent results, completely confirm Kant's claim to have discovered a secured, scientific philosophy."

**SIR ALFRED MOND, M.P.

Sir Alfred Mond, British Member of Parliament, former cabinet member and Zionist leader, arrived in New York from Canada yesterday. He is stopping at the Hotel Ambassador. Sir Alfred is accompanied by Lady Mond.

A Jewish "Lady Martyr"

The story of a Jewish woman who was runner-up in the Virginia state golf finals for women, but who refused to play last week because the contest was set for Yom Kippur and thus forfeited by default the possible honor of winning the state championship, is related editorially in the "Jewish Morning Journal" of Sept. 21, wherein we read:

"The scene or the battlefield, is on the golf links of Richmond, Virginia. The city is aristocratic and only the chosen are admitted to the links. But it so happens that a Jewish woman, Mrs. I. J. Spitz, is one of the best players there and she had good prospects of winning the championship for women golfers in Virginia. The decisive battle between her and a Mrs. Jones was to have taken place last Saturday, Yom Kippur, and the request of Mrs. Spitz that the finals be postponed was rejected. Mrs. Spitz refused to play on Yom Kippur and Mrs. Jones won the championship by default of her opponent.

"We leave it to others," the paper says "to express the necessary opinion regarding the committee that refused to alter the date of the finals. It happens sometimes that Jews themselves are forgetful on such days, and it is not our habit to accuse anyone of anti-Semitism without sufficient proof to that effect. But the 'lady martyr' of Virginia has our full sympathy and we feel that the recognition which she will receive from Jews, and even Christians, is worth more than the honor which might have been hers on that day."

**Says President Has Power to Nullify
"National Origins" Measure**

some authorities, by the failure of the President to proclaim and make known as required by the terms of this measure, the quota of each nationality which is to be determined and reported to him by a board of six.

"A conditional Federal law to discriminate for the first time among Nordics in favor of the British in immigration, is in the hands of one man—the President. This one-man option will be based upon the findings of six other men, who, to date, have found little but chaos and have begun the descent of their statistical Everest," writes Mr. Thackrey.

"But the obvious confusion," we read further, "of an attempt to separate such a mixed population as that of the United States into its national origins is heightened by the indefinite conflicting clauses of the origins provision itself, which reads in part:

"Such officials shall, jointly, report to the President the quota of each nationality, determined as provided in subdivision (b), and the President shall proclaim and make known the quotas so reported. Such proclamation shall be made on or before April 1, 1927.

"If the proclamation is not made on or before such date, quotas proclaimed therein shall not be in effect for any fiscal year beginning after the expiration of the proclamation. . . . If for any reason quotas proclaimed under this subdivision are not in effect for any fiscal year, the quotas for such year shall be determined under subdivision (aa) of this section."

"That is, if the national origins provision does not become operative, the existing arrangement shall continue, but shall be subjected to change every year, upon proclamation by the President, giving ninety days' notice.

"The confusion resulting from the mandatory terms of the first paragraph requiring determination of national origins quotas, a report on the same to the President, and a Presidential proclamation by April 1, 1927, in juxtaposition to the 'if' clause of the second paragraph has baffled Government department experts. The President is delegated as a mere orderly in the first and clothed with power as a dictator in the second.

"Taking advantage of the wording," the writer tells us, "several members of Congress opposed to the provision have introduced bills to repeal it. Representative Sabath, Democrat, of Illinois, who twice successfully led opposition to the measure but was overwhelmed by the final compromise on the entire law, is making an issue of such a move to repeal and has announced he will press for action on it at the short session this year."

STATE DEPARTMENT MAKES CLEAR RIGHTS OF NATURALIZED AMERICAN CITIZENS

(Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Washington, Sept. 21.—The State Department in an additional announcement, has reiterated that while it objects to and protests against the enforcement of laws by foreign governments impressing American naturalized citizens into military service, "it can give no assurances that any objections which it makes will result in a remission or release." The full text of the announcement is as follows:

"While this Government objects to the punishment of naturalized Americans by fines, forced military service or imprisonment for any unperformed military service which accrued after the entry of the naturalized citizen into the United States, it can give no assurance that any objections which it makes will result in a remission or release.

"This Government can not properly protest against punishment for any infraction of foreign law committed prior to the naturalized American's entry into the United States.

"Naturalized citizens of the United States who come from countries with the governments of which the United States has not concluded naturalization treaties should, before visiting such countries consider the advisability of inquiring of the appropriate authorities thereof whether they will be immune from molestation in such countries, under the military service or other laws. The Department of State does not act as intermediary in such inquiries."

LONDON JEWS SUBSCRIBE TO JUDEA INDUSTRIAL CORP.

London, Sept. 21.—The amount of \$10,000 was subscribed by a group of London Jews to the Judea Industrial Corporation, a company which controls the Judea Insurance Company in Palestine and which was organized by the American Zionist fraternal order, Order Sons of Zion.

The subscriptions were made at a private gathering held in the home of Mr. Hassatassin, prominent London Zionist, following an address by Judge Jacob Strahl of New York City, who described the activities of the Judea Insurance Company.

Joseph M. Lewis, President of the Free-thinkers' Society of New York, protested to Mayor Walker against the use of the municipal broadcast station WNYC for broadcasting religious services. He said that a Yom Kippur musical service with religious songs by Cantor Sol Fuchs had been put on the air by the city's station.

"If we permit one religious organization to use the municipal broadcasting station," said Mr. Lewis, "then we are in duty bound to let all religious organizations broadcast their services. This, as you know, would lead to a disastrous state of affairs."

Albert Goldman, Commissioner of Plant and Structures, said he considered this complaint to be ill-founded.

"We are broadcasting musical programs, including religious music," he said. "For instance, nearly every broadcasting station in the country broadcasts Easter services. Music is non-sectarian. I would not permit a sectarian sermon to be preached through WNYC, but I cannot see any objection to religious music."

RADICAL ZIONISTS HOLD BERLIN CONFERENCE; REITERATE STAND ON AGENCY

Berlin, Sept. 8.—A demand that the Mandatory Power in Palestine replace its passive policy of carrying out only the purely administrative duties in the country, by a policy of active support of the Jewish upbuilding work in Palestine, was made at a Conference of the Federation of Radical Zionists which held its sessions here. The Conference was attended by Deputy Isaac Gruenbaum and Dr. Lifshitz of Poland, Mr. Robert Stricker of Vienna, Dr. Nahum Goldmann, Dr. A. Olschwanger and Dr. M. Soloweitschik of Berlin and Dr. Margulies of Czecho-Slovakia.

The resolutions adopted stated:

"The Federation of Radical Zionists regards the present political position of Zionism as being in the highest degree unsatisfactory. It regards the non-fulfillment of the most important political demands of the Zionist Organization by the Mandatory Power and the unsatisfactory reply of the Mandates Commission of the League of Nations to the complaints of the Jewish Agency and the Vaad Leumi as the symptom of a grave political situation. The Federation of Radical Zionists therefore places on record with particular satisfaction that the Actions Committee at its last meeting ranged itself unanimously in support of the political conception previously opposed by the majority of the movement, namely, that the Mandatory Power must in place of its policy pursued up to the present of carrying out only the purely administrative duties in Palestine, adopt a policy of active support of the Jewish upbuilding work in the country. The Federation of Radical Zionists regards it as essential to declare that the policy of the Zionist Executive has so far not been moved in the direction of this demand and it definitely awaits that the Executive will now orientate its policy in this way. It will be the duty of Zionist public opinion to see to it that the resolution of the Actions Committee is carried out by the Executive in all its implications and that negotiations with the Mandatory Power are started at once with a view to the realization of the demands of the Actions Committee."

"The Federation of Radical Zionists is convinced that the present crisis in Palestine is definite proof that the process of upbuilding the country is possible only in the form of a systematic and consciously directed colonization aiming at the permanent rooting in of the immigrants on the land and in the productive activity of the country. The immigration and colonization policy of the Executive during the past year was not carried out in a systematic manner. The Federation of Radical Zionists demand that in addition to summoning up all the forces of the Zionists and the Jewish people as a whole for the purpose of overcoming the crisis, especially by the raising of much larger sums of money, there must above all be a central regulation and a conscious direction of immigration to Palestine."

ALGERIA HAS SCHECHITA QUESTION; JEWS SEEK TO COMBAT PRESS CAMPAIGN

Algiers, Sept. 3.—The Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals in Algeria has been engaged for some time in an agitation against Shechita, and the local general press has been giving the campaign considerable space. On behalf of the Jewish population, the Assistant Rabbi of Algeria, Rabbi Serore, has addressed a letter to the local paper, "La Depeche Algerienne," in which he writes:

"I want first to express my sympathy with the aim of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals to prevent suffering being inflicted upon cattle in the slaughter houses. But I protest energetically against the expressions of 'savagery, barbarous slaughter' employed by the President with regard to Jewish ritual slaughter. The question is not a new one. In 1867 it raised a very heated controversy and these are the conclusions arrived at regarding it by M. Chauveau, the Director of the Veterinary School at Lyons:

"I have examined carefully the Jewish process of slaughtering animals in order to discover whether this process is more barbarous and inflicts more suffering on the animals than the ordinary process. I have come to the conclusion that the Jewish process is inconceivably a more humane way of slaughtering. In fact, this method which consists in severing the veins of the neck and the windpipe and the gullet is performed with such rapidity that it leaves nothing more to desire. In the very short time—one or two seconds—which the operations takes, the animal suffers no more than if it received a violent blow on the head and it is absolutely certain that it is not necessary to repeat the operation. The method of slaughtering practiced in the ordinary non-Jewish slaughter houses inflicts suffering on the animal for a longer time and the suffering is sometimes really barbarous in character as I have several times had occasion to witness. To sum up, killing through hemorrhage is one of the least cruel of methods and it would be against all physiological principles to prohibit this method of killing under the pretext that it constitutes an act of cruelty against the animal."

"This report by M. Chauveau has been approved by M. Bouley, Inspector General of the Veterinary Schools of France and M. Thiernes, the Director of the Veterinary School of Brussels. I hope," Rabbi Serore concludes, "that the President of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals will admit that he has been misinformed. The Mosaic Law which ordains in the Ten Commandments one day's rest even for animals cannot be accused of inhumanity."

PRESIDENT OF NUREMBERG JEWISH COMMUNITY DIES

Berlin, Sept. 4.—Dr. Siegmund Held, president of the Nuremberg Jewish Community, died in Nuremberg at the age of 66.

Dr. Held had been a member of the Board of the Community since 1895 and President since 1909.

He took a prominent part in the formation of the Federation of Bavarian Jewish Communities and was a member of its Council. He was also President of the Chamber of Advocates in Nuremberg.
