## CHURCH BELLS PROCLAIM ANTI-SEMITIC VICTORY IN BUDAPEST ELECTIONS

Excitement Prevails in Capital As Race Purifiers Celebrate

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Budapest, Oct. 2.—Hungary's capital seethed with excitement today when church bells proclaimed the victory of the anti-Semitic organization, Race Purifiers, in the municipal elections. The contest for city mayor was waged between Sipoecz of the Race Purifiers and the democrat, Barczy, who was supported by the government.

Barczy received thirty votes less than Sipoecz. All the forces of the government and of the anti-Semitic parties were thrown into the battle. It was stated that the outcome of the contest would determine the future course of events in Hungary. Count Bethlen came to Budapest expressly to aid in the election campaign.

When the new city council opened its session today large crowds of members of anti-Semitic organizations assembled outside to celebrate their victory.

Noise and tumult accompanied these demonstrations during which outcries of "Down with the Jews" were made. The police intervened, preventing violence.

## JEWS ATTEND INAUGURATION OF FIRST MOSQUE IN LONDON

London, Oct. 2.—Jewish dignitaries and representatives of the Jewish press were present yesterday at the inauguration of the first mosque erected in England.

The mosque was erected in Southfields, a suburb of London, and was built under the patronage of Emir Feisal, son of Ibn Saud, victorious leader of the Wahabis and ruler of Mecca.

## JEWISH LEADER IN PERSIA CHARGED WITH CONSPIRACY

Teheran, Persia, Oct. 2.—One of the Jewish leaders in Persia, Hayeem, a former member of the Majlis, the Persian parliament, was placed under arrest.

He is charged, along with other Persian leaders, with complicity in an alleged plot to kill Shah Riza Khan Pahlizi.

## BERLIN "VORWAERTS" CRITICISES KEHILLAH

Berlin, Oct. 2.—A strike of the workers in the cemeteries of Berlin was threatened today by the "Vorwaerts," the German Socialist paper.

The paper severely criticizes the administration of the Berlin Kehillah for its failure to regulate the wages of the workers in the Jewish cemeteries.

## DR. WEIZMANN WILL SAIL FOR NEW YORK, OCT. 25; CONFERS WITH MUSSOLINI

Italian Dictator Expresses Wishes for Success of Movement

London, Oct. 2.—Dr. Chaim Weizmann, president of the World Zionist Organization, will sail from here for the United States on October 23, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency is informed.

It was learned today that Dr. Weizmann visited Rome last week where he was received by Benito Mussolini. It is understood that the subject of the conference was the attitude of the Italian government toward the Palestine upbuilding work.

Dr. Weizmann acquainted Mussolini with the present situation in Palestine, the status of the Arab-Jewish relations and the development of trade between Palestine and Italy. Mussolini seemed to be well informed on all questions of Palestine and Zionism and expressed his wish for the success of the Zionist movement.

During Dr. Weizmann's stay in Rome a reception was arranged for him in the synagogue.

## 170 REFUGEES RELEASED FROM EASTLEIGH CAMP AFTER 3 YEARS INTERNMENT

London, Oct. 2.—The Feast of Tabernacles was indeed a Season of Joy for 170 Jewish refugees stranded in England because of the enactment of the United States quota law three years ago.

The refugees, who have been held in Eastleigh Camp, were permitted by an order of the Home Office to settle temporarily in London. The permission was granted on the condition that the refugees proceed to America or elsewhere as soon as possible and that they enter no employment unless such employment would in no way displace British labor.

Great joy prevailed among the refugees who were released after three years of a life confined to the barracks of Eastleigh Camp.

## COUNT S. TISZA TRACED ANTI-SEMITISM TO GERMANY

Budapest, Oct. 2.—The German origin of the anti-Semitic propaganda in European countries was emphasized in the writings of the late Count Stephan Tisza, Hungarian statesman and premier at the outbreak of the World War.

In a letter dated April, 1915, just made public, Count Tisza wrote "The anti-Semitic state of mind, which I have condemned, is of German origin. Even in Austria, anti-Semitism is mainly spread by the German circles."

## INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS SUGGESTS SPECIAL COUNCIL TO DEAL WITH MINORITIES

Proposal for League Protection of Minorities Is Outlined

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Salsburg, Austria, Oct. 2.—A new proposal with regard to how the League is to protect the interests of the national minorities in European countries was formulated at the International Congress of the Union of League of Nations Societies which opened here last Tuesday. The congress will be in session until October 4th.

At yesterday's meeting of the Congress Herr Kunz reported on the proposal concerning the protection of the national minorities by the League. He suggested that a special council of three delegates with headquarters in Geneva be appointed by the president of the League of Nations to deal with this matter. The council would have to make the decisions concerning the protection of the minorities whenever a question arises. The draft of the proposal which was submitted to the congress also suggests that the right of the national minorities to submit petitions should not be as limited as it is now, on condition, however, that no petition of the national minorities submitted to the League can demand a change in the frontiers of the state in which the minority is resident.

## BERLIN CRITICS DISPLAY ENTHUSIASM OVER HABIMA

Berlin, Oct. 2.—The Habima, the Hebrew art theatre of Moscow, made its first appearance here last night in a performance of "The Dybbuk."

The Hebrew players were enthusiastically greeted. Newspapers today praised the performance, declaring that it displayed the genius of the actors and the management for rhythm and enchantment. The Habima will soon leave for the United States.

## MALINA, STEIGER'S ACCUSER, IS DISMISSED FROM OFFICE

Warsaw, Oct. 2.—Tadusz Malina, one of the main initiators of the trial of Stanislaw Steiger and state attorney in the Lemberg Court of Appeals, was placed on the list of retired state officials.

Malina was attorney for the state in the trial of Stanislaw Steiger, who was acquitted of the charge of having thrown the bomb at former president Wojciechowski.

**SIR ALFRED MOND DENIES RUMORS OF HIS AFFILIATION WITH CHURCH OF ENGLAND Never Has and Never Will Leave Jewish Faith, He Says**

A denial of rumors spread in certain circles concerning Sir Alfred Mond's religious affiliation was made by Sir Alfred in an interview with the representative of the "American Hebrew," before his departure from New York. "Please make it known that I am not a member of the Church of England or of any other Church. I was born and reared in the Jewish faith: I have never left it and never will. The statements that have been made to the contrary from time to time annoy me. There is no excuse for them. It might have been of great advantage to me to join the Church of England, but I never would and never will," Sir Alfred declared.

Commenting on Lloyd George's recent attack on him on the occasion of his formally leaving the Liberal Party, Sir Alfred said: "George lost his temper. I doubt whether there are two men more closely knitted and ardent in their friendship than he and I. George just lost his temper."

The eighty-fourth anniversary of Gimbel Brothers' founding by Adam Gimbel, whose first business was done from a peddler's pack, is being celebrated this month.

Adam Gimbel carried on his back through the remote regions of Southern Mississippi such necessities as buttons and thread, needles and pins, cotton goods, shoe laces and soles. He was born in Bavaria in 1817 and came as a lad to New Orleans. After seven years of trading he had saved enough to open a small store in Vincennes, Ind. It was really more of a trading post than store. But the post prospered and in time he opened three more posts.

The family that Adam Gimbel founded still controls six extensive department stores. In the Gimbel organization now are active five sons and nine grandsons, of which one son of an adopted orphan.

Columbia University has instituted a program to include religious education in the class with outside activities. This religious training will be under the supervision of H. E. Evans, Director of the Columbia University Christian Association.

The new program was adopted in response to an unexpected interest in religion revealed by the students.

**METHODIST MINISTER IN OMAHA DENOUNCES KLAN**

**Is Second Minister This Week to Resign from Order (Jewish Daily Bulletin)**

Omaha, Neb., Oct. 2.—Rev. Edgar Merrill Brown is the second Omaha minister this week to resign from and denounce the Ku Klux Klan in this section of the country.

The controversies arose from the fact that the Klan is attempting to dictate the course of actions the ministers should take in their pulpits and private life, it is reported.

In a public denunciation of the Klan, Rev. Brown, who is pastor of the Dietz Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church here, declared:

"I will allow no man within or without my Church to dictate to me what my message as a minister of the Gospel shall be. I am opposed to black-listing and boycotting methods used by this organization across the country. This sort of coercion is un-Democratic un-Christian and un-American. I have many friends among the Catholics, Jews and Negroes and other groups in the city of Omaha and refuse to surrender my relationship with them without just cause."

Rev. J. L. Bebbe, Pastor of the Grave Evangelical Church here, resigned from the Klan last week, challenging, at the time, F. L. Cook, field representative of the organization in Omaha, to a public debate.

**STRAUS LIBRARY RECEIVED BY JERUSALEM LIBRARY**

The Jewish National and Hebrew University Library in Jerusalem has now received the complete library of the late Oscar Straus of New York which was bequeathed to the Library.

During his life time Oscar Straus had from time to time donated several hundred volumes to the Library and the books which the Library has now acquired number some thousand volumes pertaining to international law, to general history, to political history of America, and history of American Jews.

Among the books received are a series on the foreign relations of the United States, American History and the Report of the American Historical Association; a series of Makers of History, and the publications of the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace; many Encyclopedias; and also a volume of clippings and copies from different sources concerning the diplomatic correspondence of the United States with Turkey with reference to the Jews dating from 1840-1901.

A new translation of the Psalms has been made by Prof. J. M. P. Smith of the University of Chicago and is soon to be published by the University press.

Prof. Smith divides the Psalms into five books and gives a chapter heading to each Psalm. The second he calls "A Warning to the Nations"; the eighth, "The Dignity of Man and the Glory of God"; the sixteenth, "Faith and Hope"; the nineteenth, "God's Praise in the Temple and Moral Universe"; the twenty-third, "The Good Shepherd"; the forty-fifth, "A Royal Marriage Song"; the 12th, "A Warning to Liars"; the 130th, "De Profundis."

**Vienna Paper on Klebelsberg's Statement to J. T. A. Director**

The statement regarding the Hungarian numerus clausus made by Education Minister Count Klebelsberg to Jacob Landau, director of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, when the latter interviewed the Minister recently in Debreczin, is commented on by the "Wiener Morgenzeitung" of September 16.

Terming the modifications of the numerus clausus in Hungary, announced a few weeks ago by Count Klebelsberg, as "obviously a most infamous swindle, and a bid for Jewish apostasy rather than a modification of the anti-Jewish restriction, the "Morgenzeitung" observes: "That the Hungarian government has no intention at all of modifying the numerus clausus against Jewish students appears also from the interview given but a day before yesterday in Debreczin. The director of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, Herr Jacob Landau, spent a few days in Debreczin and had a talk with the Education Minister. In a statement, which was published in the Vienna press and elsewhere Herr Landau declares that the Education Minister had stated that the numerus clausus is to be regarded as a provisional measure which will become automatically void as soon as it will no longer be necessary. Count Klebelsberg, however, denies that he made this assertion to Herr Landau, and says such an assertion is senseless. He declares, moreover, that the numerus clausus is a transitional measure made necessary as a result of the conditions created by the Treaty of Trianon. As soon as this necessity disappears the numerus clausus will become of itself superfluous.

"That is clear enough!" the paper adds. "The Jews must wait until Trianon and the conditions created by it are removed from the world. Until then there can be no abolition or amelioration of this anti-Jewish law. At most, to appease Geneva and in order to trap the Jewish vote into the government net at the next elections, an ordinance is issued to hold the anti-Semitic law in strict abeyance. The only question is, will the League of Nations and the Jewish organizations be misled by this deceit."

The statement of Herr Lederer, president of the Budapest Jewish Kehillah, that the Hungarian Jews want no "foreign intervention" on the part of Jews in other countries in the question of the numerus clausus, is condemned by the "Day" of New York.

Declaring that Herr Lederer's assertion is "foolish and undignified" the paper, in its Sept. 29 issue, writes, in part: "Jewish rights, human, political and now also national, are not anyone's exclusive interest. They are important, broad principles which touch the whole

## MIAMI JEWS ISSUE APPEAL FOR FURTHER RELIEF

### I.O.B.B. to Raise Special Fund for Florida Sufferers

Daniel Cromer, chairman of the Miami Jewish Rehabilitation Committee, on a visit to New York City, when interviewed by the representative of the "Jewish Daily Bulletin", stated, "My latest advices from my associates on the Relief Committee from Miami, are to the effect that the sum of \$100,000, a call for which was issued to bring succor to the stricken Jewish community, is inadequate, because of the further distress revealed by actual facts."

"The Jews of Miami have but recently oversubscribed their quotas in the recent campaigns for the United Jewish Campaign and the United Palestine Appeal and we sincerely hope that at this moment of affliction, the American Jewish community will rally to our support."

Cincinnati, Ohio., Oct. 2.—The Independent Order B'nai B'rith will raise a special fund among the constituent lodges of the Order for rehabilitation of the Jewish flood and hurricane sufferers in Miami, it was announced today by Alfred M. Cohen, international president of the Order. Mr. Cohen also announced that the Constitution Grand Lodge, which includes the national executive body and officers of the organization, today contributed \$5,000 to the Jewish Rehabilitation Committee of Miami.

Mr. Cohen also said that the appeal of the Miami Rehabilitation Committee had been sent to the five hundred constituent lodges, and that their individual contributions would make up a special B'nai B'rith fund for Miami reconstruction.

Mr. Cohen stated that the contribution of the I. O. B. B. was based on the report of Dr. Boris D. Bogen, executive secretary of the Order, who went to Florida immediately after the catastrophe to survey the situation and decide how relief could best be rendered by his organization. Dr. Bogen found that two thousand Jewish families in the Miami district had been affected in some way by the disaster, and that two hundred Jewish families were completely destitute. It was determined that a minimum of \$500 would be required to make each of these families self-sustaining, making the total required by the Jewish Rehabilitation Committee \$100,000. The constituent lodges of the I. O. B. B. are expected to make up a considerable part of the fund.

### Biological Anti-Semitism and Political Fascism in Roumania

(By Our Bucharest Correspondent)

Bucharest, Sept. 15.—The present splurge in the League of Christian Defence and the precarious position of Prof. Cuza as leader of this anti-Semitic body are explained by competent observers as an indication of a transition from biological anti-Semitism to political fascism in this country.

The Cuzist movement has always advertised itself as nationalistic, while the fascist idea was relegated to the second place and served chiefly as a means of combating the socialist and communist parties. Psychologically, the mainstay of Cuzism was anti-Semitism which found its expression in "direct action." One pogrom was regarded by the Cuzists as of more importance than a hundred meetings or the distribution of thousands of leaflets. Jew hatred was the be-all and end-all of the Cuzists' creed and fascism was merely an attitude, a phrase, which was intended to bestow on the movement a European character.

That was why Cuzism as a political creed was so poor and nebulous. The situation was made clear recently when Cuza appeared in triumph on the Parliamentary tribune. He was applauded as a talented orator, but his speech was received with a shrug, more like a matter sensational but very transient in its nature. Cuza's doctrine—the outlawing of all the Jews and the confiscation of their property—this Bolshevism of the Right—did not impress any one. Everybody became convinced that apart from demagogic outcries against the "Jewish peril" Cuzism had nothing in it, nothing of a constructive nature.

Anti-Semitism, however, has all the chances of a success if it is worked into the shell of Fascism which pretends to be a great system of Government and possesses a certain degree of counter-revolutionary passion. It is this the young Cuzists are after. To them hatred of the Jews is but a commonplace and they are desirous of introducing into Roumania the Imperialism of Mussolini. This has been plainly expressed in the manifesto published in the Nationalist organ, "Cuvintul." The manifesto criticizes the present Government and all the political parties and concludes with the statement that the only possible solution is a national dictatorship. "The democratic regime," it declares, "is an artificial thing forced upon the nation against its will." The manifesto does not claim to be original and is really repeating by rote the platitudes of the "Action Francaise." Still, even this feeble attempt at reasoning is a step forward in the process of differentiation within the camp of the Cuzists.

The publication of this manifesto was followed by the first political demonstration of the young Fascist movement. The movement was inaugurated at the celebration at Patne in Bukovina, where a memorial was unveiled to the Roumanian national poet, Eminescu. The

## JEWISH RELIGION INSTITUTE IS OPENED FOR FIFTH YEAR

### Other Jewish Schools Are Opened for New Term

The Jewish Institute of Religion, New York's only liberal school for the training of rabbis and Jewish communal workers, will hold its formal opening exercises for the fifth academic year this evening at the Institute. The main address of welcome will be delivered by Dr. William Rosenau, Associate Professor in Post-Biblical Hebrew Johns Hopkins University, and member of the Board of Governors of the Hebrew Union College, who will speak on "The Call for Readjustment."

Judge Julian W. Mack, vice-chairman of the Board of the Jewish Institute of Religion, and Dr. Stephen S. Wise, acting president of the Institute, will also speak.

The Hebrew Union College School for Teachers in New York City will open for its fourth year of work on October 13th, at Temple Emanu-El.

The School prepares men and women for religious school teaching, offering a two years course of training, which includes a comprehensive survey of Judaism and its institutions, the Hebrew language and literature, the History of the Jewish people, and the Pedagogy of religious school subjects.

The School also conducts a Placement Bureau through which graduates and qualified undergraduates are placed in teaching positions in the religious schools of this city. There are twenty-nine affiliated Religious Schools in this city which give preference to the graduates of this School.

All applicants for admission to the School must be High School graduates. The School pursues an intensive curriculum in Hebrew for those who enter with a knowledge of the language. Beginners classes are also organized.

Tuition at the Hebrew Union College School for Teachers is free. A nominal registration fee of \$2 per semester is charged.

With a student enrollment of 220, the New Jersey Normal School for Jewish Teachers, the first of its kind in the state, will formally commence its sessions tomorrow night, October 5, with public exercises in Temple B'nai Jeshurun, in whose building the school will be housed. The speakers at the opening exercises will include Dr. David Corson, City Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Wilson Farrand, Headmaster of the Newark Academy; Abraham N. Franzblau, principal of the Hebrew Union College School for Teachers in New York; Rabbi Solomon Foster, president of the new school and Dr. Leon Mones, director. A musical program has been arranged by Cantor Maurice Cowan of the temple.

The new institution is privately supported and will be governed by a board of directors and a Students' Advisory Council. The instructors will be Rabbi Foster, Dr. Mones, Dr. Henry M. Goldstein and Charles Rubens. The subjects taught will include Hilstory, Hebrew, Religion, Pedagogy, etc. An advanced course in Hebrew and supplementary lectures will be given.

#### JUDEA INSURANCE COMPANY TO OPEN BRANCH IN ENGLAND

The Judea Insurance Company, Ltd., the first Jewish insurance company, with headquarters in Jerusalem, will shortly open a branch in London, according to the statement of Judge Jacob S. Strahl, President of the Judea Industrial Corporation who returned on the Steamer Aquitania from a three months trip in Europe.

European Jewry is watching with great interest the development of the first Jewish insurance company in Palestine and is mindful of the prospects of this institution as a medium in the rebuilding of Palestine. Some of the most prominent Jews in England have acquired shares in the Judea Industrial Corporation, which is chartered in the State of New York and is the owner of the Judea Insurance Company, Ltd., with the home office in Jerusalem, Judge Strahl declared.

#### FIRE DESTROYS JEWISH TANNERY IN JUGO-SLAVIA

Belgrade, Oct. 2.—The loss of a large fortune by a Jugoslavian Jewish firm was incurred when a fire broke out last night in the tannery of Abraham and Deutsch.

The plant was located in Zemlin. The entire plant including the storehouses were destroyed. The damage amounts to eight million dinar.

celebration was attended not only by Codreanu's group of young Fascisti but also by a few personages of official standing, including Princess Helena and the Minister for War, Hirtaescu. More characteristic of the movement than the speeches, however, was the inscription on the memorial.

"He who loves the alien," it reads "may his heart be devoured by dogs, may misery befall his house and children."

Dictatorship is in the air and the name of the Premier, General Averescu—the favorite of the army—is very much to the fore in this connection. The Roumanian Fascists have been spurred on by Mussolini who seeks to destroy the "little Entente" and promises that instead of it he will get Russia to recognize the Roumanian annexation of Bessarabia. Averescu is at present in Italy and the Roumanian press is full of praise for Mussolini and Italy.

The young Czuzists have accurately sized up the feeling of the moment and they are in a hurry to put on black shirts. This has been made clear enough in a speech delivered for the Parliamentary tribune by Deputy Valerian Pon who demanded the establishment of a dictatorship. "All Latin States," he declared, "had dictators at one time or another. A striking example is Mussolini in Italy. From among our own ranks, too, a dictator will arise who with his mailed fist will bring justice to the Roumanian people!"

On whose head the mailed fist of this dictator savior is to fall first, that goes without saying. The anti-Semitic fascists make no bones about their hatred of the Jews and do not try to conceal their intentions.

Mendel Zagat, sixty-two, who died Thursday in Lebanon Hospital, was five years President of the Bronx County Pharmaceutical Association and sixteen years prominent in civic affairs of the borough. He was born in Russia and had lived here forty-five years. Mr. Zagat was third Vice President of the New York State Pharmaceutical Association, had served two years as Secretary of the New York Pharmaceutical Association and was many years a member of the advisory council of the New York Department of Health.
