Jewish Students Thrown Out of University Lecture Hall: Roumanian Embassy in Warsaw Issues Denial of Excesses

Berlin, Dec. 16.—Anti-Semitic stu-dent excesses continued in Bucharest during Monday and Tuesday, according The riots in Czernowitz were caused to reports received here. The excesses took place in the lecture hall of Professor Vladescu.

Notwithstanding the fact that policemen were in the hall, the lewish siudents were beaten and thrown out of the room. The slogan of the Roumanian students was "Numerus nullus!"

There are now 400 Christian students and 40 Jewish students in the medical college of the University of Bucharest.

AID JEWISH LAND SETTLE-MENT, MINISTER DECLARES Society to Promote Back-to-the-Land

Movement Founded (Tewish Telegraphic Agency)

Warsaw, Dec. 16 .- That the Polish government is not able to subsidize a lewish back-to-the-land movement was the declaration made by Minister of Agriculture Staniszewicz.

Commenting on the recently founded Jewish Colonization Society, Tor, the Minister declared that it was his opinion that the Jews are entitled to share in the division of the large estates in accordance with the agrarian reform law passed by the Diet. It is questionable, however, whether those lews who apply for land are qualified farmers, in view of the scarcity of Jewish agricultural laborers. The per-centage of Jewish landowners in Poland is small. Hitherto, the back-tothe land movement among the Jews has not been of pronounced char-acter. The government is unable to subsidize this movement, but is ready to consider grants for Jews who are already cultivating land, he said.

The "Daily News" publishes a report today that Sir Herbert Samuel has re-fused the chairmanship of the Central Washington, D. C., Dec. 16.—Danger of an unexpected delay of the Wadsworth amendment was seen yesterday when Chairman Johnson of the House Immigration Committee, instead of asking for the appointment of House conferees to discuss the amendment with the Senate conferees, requested Speaker Longworth to refer the measure to the House Immigration Committee where it will probably be discussed at the executive session of the committee this morning which originally was scheduled to be devoted to a hearing of Con-gressman Sabath's bill for the admission of certain relatives and the repeal of the national origins plan.

It is unlikely, however, that the committee will take action this morning, as Chairman Johnson made it known that he will oppose any effort to unduly rush the proposed legislation. He refused to say whether he is for or against the Wadsworth amendment, stating that he

must reserve his decision until later. Meanwhile, he made it known that he has asked the State and Labor Departments for further immigration statistics and information bearing on the question. It was within the power of any member of the Immigration Committee to have prevented reference of the bill to the Committee and to have forced the autointment and reference to the conferees by disagreeing from the floor with the action of the Senate, but the lewish members of the Committee agreeing as they do with the Warsworth amendment, were unwilling even for parliamentary purposes to go on record as objecting thereto. Moreover, they felt that even if there is a delay this may be utilized to develop a strong favorable sentiment among the members of the committee and if by virtue of this an affirmative committee report can be obtained, favorable action

GERMAN STATESMEN OF ALL POLITICAL PARTIES FORM PRO-PALESTINE COMMITTEE

BALFOUR URGING SUPPORT FOR HEBREW UNIVERSITY Dr. Brodetsky Takes Issue with Dr. Pritchett on Use of Hebrew in Exact Sciences

Dr. Selig Brodetsky, Professor of Applied Mathematics at the University of Leeds and one of the governors of

the Hebrew University, who arrived in New York on Wednesday, brought with him a letter from the Earl of Palfour, asking for the support of Americans for the Hebrew University in Jerusalem. Dr. Brodetsky came to

the United States to join the Weizmann delegation which includes Dr. Georg Halperin and Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff. Dr. Brodetsky will visit American

universities, and confine his activities to enlisting the support of America for the Hebrew University. Professor Brodetsky is regarded as one of the foremost authorities on mathematics and aerodynamics in the world. He has been listed as one of the ten who understand the Einstein theory.

The attention of Dr. Brodetsky was called to the recent statement made by Dr. Pritchett of the Carnegie Peace Endowment in his report on Palestine to the effect that the Hebrew language could not be utilized as a medium for scientific expression. Dr. Brodetsky took direct issue with Dr. Pritchett. He stated that when in Jerusalem in 1925, he delivered two lectures, both in the Hebrew tongue on mathematical subjects. One of them was on the principles of dynamics from Aristotle to Einstein. The other was on a technical problem of pure mathematics. In neither case had he any difficulty in expressing himself "in the language of the prophets."

The letter of the Earl of Balfour to Professor Brodetsky reads:

"I am much interested to hear that you propose visiting some of the great American universities for the purpose of enlisting their interest in the young University of Jerusalem. It is a most deserving institution and fully merits all the support you can obtain for it.

On the Proposal for a Congressional Inquiry Into Ford's Charges

A Congressional inquiry, as demanded by Congressman Sol Bloom's resolution. into Ford's charges, "would do a lot of into Ford's charges, "would do a lot of good," in the opinion of the N. Y. "Times." With special reference to Ford's assertion that "the international Iew is in direct control of all financial centres of government, including the United States Federal Reserve System," the "Times" observes:

"Certainly if one turns to the list of

the names of the officers and members of the Federal Reserve Board, and of the twelve Reserve Banks, it will be hard to find a single one which even nard to find a single one which even appears to bear out Henry Ford's rash deliverance. Platt, Miller, Hamlin, James, Cunningham—such is the frightful Semitic flavor of the Federal Reserve Board. And the names of the officers of the Federal Reserve Banks are like unto them—Harding, Strong, MacDougal, Young, Bailey, and so on.
To be sure, Mr. Ford, or the gentleman
who does his anti-Semitism for him. may be tempted to say that these well known and honorable men are only puppets and tools of 'the international Tew.' But if he were to do so directly. he might be at once sued for libel, in a way to make it inadvisable for him to visit other cities in the United States as he now finds it to come to New York, where a court summons awaits him in vain.

"The whole matter runs in importance beyond any question merely affecting the Federal Reserve. His inadvertent attack upon the latter gives Congress a proper occasion to examine him, if it wishes, but an exposure of him on that one point would have larger implications. It would hold him up before the country as one willing to use his position and the artificial hearing which he gets because of his great wealth to indulge in miscellaneous abuse of people whom he does not know and whom he does not dare to specify by name. . . . His course in this affair has been such as to create suspicion and distrust in ignorant minds easily in-flamed. If he were called to book by Congress for such rash and unpatri-otic behavior, it would do a lot of good. It might even do Henry Ford some good.

The position that Ford's charges are too absurd to be honored by a Congressional inquiry, is taken by the "Jewsh Morning Journal," which feels that for this reason the Jews "will not regard it as an unfriendly act if Congress fails to accept the proposal for an investigation."

It is possible, however, the paper be-lieves, that the Federal Reserve Board may desire an inquiry owing to Ford's charge that the Board is under Jewish influence. "This is a specific charge, giving a name and address," the paper explains, "and if the members of the

TRIKE OF JEWS" TO SILENCE ANTI-SEMITIC AGITATION IN GERMANY SUGGESTED BY MAXIMILLIAN HARDEN

Famous German Publicist of Jewish Origin Makes Remarkable Confession in Berlin Interview

Lemarkanic suggestion of how the Jews could silence anti-Semitic agitation by "a general strike of Jews" was made by Maximillian Harden, well known German publicist of Jewish origin, in an interview in Berlin with Jacob Landau, managing director of the "Jewish Daily Bulletin", during his recent visit in Europe.

In this interview, Mr. Harden gives expression to the feeling prevalent among many leading Germans of Jewish origin who have been reminded of their Jewishness by the recent strong anti-Semitic agitation in Germany.

"A general strike of Jews to bring the anti-Semites to their senses by showing them how indispensable the Jews have become to the life of the countries in which they live, would be the most effective counter-action to anti-Semitism," Mr. Harden declared. anti-Semitism, "It would be the very best of reprisals and could be counted upon to silence anti-Semitic agitation as nothing else could.

"The Jews in Germany participate in science, literature, commerce and finance to a much greater degree than they do in England or America. the arts they lead, and they are active in all branches of intellectual life.

"One expects, of course, that the anti-Semites will at least appreciate Jewish ability at its proper value. In anti-Semitic literature we always are being told that the Jewish average is much higher than that of other races, but that the Jews produce no really great creative individuals. I cannot accept this view. It must not be for-

body which manages the banking system of the United States feel that their good name is attacked or that the faithful discharge of their high responsi-bility is placed under suspicion by the accusations they would be justified in demanding that a thorough investigation be made into those accusations.

Objection to Congressman Bloom's resolution is voiced by the "Jewish Daily News," which finds that "Ford's slanders are beneath anything which may be brought before a parliamentary committee for investigation." The

paper adds:
"To apply the terms charges or insults to Ford's idiotic talk and to bring the matter to court, is to recognize that there is something in what Ford says that must be reckoned with, that his charges deserve consideration, and that in itself is a victory for Ford.

"Moreover: the appointment of a

Congressional committee to investigate whether the Jews control the finances of America would put forth a new principle, namely, that if a Jew has a share in a bank, it means that the Jews, i.e., the Jews collectively, have a share in it and therefore they must continu-ally apologize for every Jewish banker (Continued on Page 4)

A remarkable suggestion of how the gotten that after all the Jews are a very small and much scattered people of only about twelve or fourteen mil-lions all told. So we cannot compare them with the Germans or with the English. In Germany the Jews num-ber less than 1 per cent of the total population. Is it possible then that this handful of people should have the power to imperil the life of the great and mighty, industrious, highly culand inighty, industrious, fignity cultured and superlatively efficient German people? Even to hint at such a possibility is humiliating to the Germans. There is no doubt about it that the Jews have sufficient great and creative geniuses in proportion to their numbers. Did not the Jews give the world Jesus, the Rabbi of Galilee; did they not produce the Bible, the Sacred Book of the West; did they not give forth Paul and the other Apostles? Are their myths of less moral value to civilization, of less poetic vision than those of Homer and the Edda? Is not Baruch Spinoza one of the noblest and most splendid figures in the whole his-tory of mankind? Side by side with those Jews who because they were nowhere allowed to take root, nowhere allowed to become settled citizens, but had to be always intent upon enriching themselves quickly, we have had every-where and at all times many of those selfless Jews who go unrewarded, never seeking reward, giving gladly all they can for the general good, for res publica," he said.

"We must not forget also that the

Jews have to go through a much harder time than the non-Jews, and that often they have reached their goal only after overcoming very big obstacles. Jews even of the first rank are frequently not given a chance of developing their talents simply because they are Jews.

"Take for example a man like Max

Warburg in Hamburg, whom I regard as a wise and in a certain sense a statesmanlike man. Is he being made use of by Germany? He rendered Germany great services during and after the War. His friend and my friend, Albert Ballin, placed the whole of his great shipping machinery at the disposal of the State and made possible the provisioning of the Fleet. Professor Haber saved German agriculture during the War and he also invented the stuff which made possible checked that terrible scourge, syphilis. Rathenau in the War Ministry organ-ized the means of ensuring for Germany the raw stuffs essential for the war. World famous Jewish surgeons, physicians and engineers did great work untiringly and without a thought for themselves year after year for the army and their Fatherland. Without the talents and the self-sacrifice of all these Jews Germany would not have been able in the blockade to have gone on with the War for as long as she

JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE INCURS NEW LOAN OF \$400,000

Needs \$2,000,000 in Cash to Cover **Budget Until December 31**

A new loan for \$400,000 was incurred by the Joint Distribution Committee for the purpose of covering the current expenses of the relief work in Europe. Another \$2,000,000 are necessary to cover the budget of the Committee until the end of 1926.

This situation was described in an appeal issued by David A. Brown, na-tional chairman of the \$25,000,000 United Jewish Campaign, to the campaign workers throughout the country, urging them to collect piedges and send in cash as speedily as possible.

A short time ago Mr. Brown appeared before the Joint Distribution Committee and, in answer to the question whether the campaign will be in a position to produce \$3,000,000 cash necessary for the work until the end of the year, he promised this fund with the certainty that American Jews who have underwritten their obligations to the campaign will meet them, Mr. Brown declares in his statement. In the course of six weeks, \$1,000,000 was paid in, but the other two millions are still outstanding, Mr. Brown stated.

Outside of the \$400,000 loan, the Joint Distribution Committee needs another \$1,254,500 up to December 31.

But a strike of all the Jews would very quickly show that Germany cannot nowadays go on without the Jews, would show how indispensable the Iew has become to the German and to what extent Germany's successes in many fields all over the world are dependent upon just this admixture and complementing each other of these two 'races'.

"I myself, who grew up in a purely German atmosphere, was bred in the Christian faith and have had very little at all to do with the Jews and have in every respect considered myself a German, had to find out one fine day that the pure racists do not consider me a real German. They disregard the fact real German. They disregate the first that there is hardly any pure race any-where, and that in Germany, especially east of the Elbe, the population is pre-dominantly a Wend-Slavic-Prussian admixtuc, and the aristocratic families in the East of Germany, as is shown by their names and features, were to a large extent Slavicized very early. Many others besides myself have had the same experience. No matter what the Jews of Germany have done to serve their people with all that lay in their power and with absolute loyalty, has been useless," he said. "The ignorant mob is fed with fool-
