IMMIGRANTS MUST STATE THEIR RACE AND NATION-ALITY, BUREAU RULES Corroborates Instructions Issued by Norddeutcher Lloyd to Its Agents

(Jewish Daily Bulletin) Washington, D. C., Mar. 4.—The United States Bureau of Immigration today corroborated the instructions issucd by the Norddeutscher Lloyd in a

circular to its agents in Germany. The Bureau of Immigration here stated to the correspondent of the "Jewish Daily Bulletin" that it requires steamship companies to ascertain the race of aliens. Under the laws and regulations, every steamship must keep and submit a list or manifest of all alien passengers, giving test of all airen passengers, giving among other things the nationality, race and country of origin. For purposes of this record the race of the Jewish people is designated by the term "Hebrew", "Jewish" being avoid-time the property of the passengers of the p than race, and Hebrew being considered a racial designation. Nationality refers solely to the political allegiance, according to the Bureau, which states that the law requires both the nationality and the race to be given, a clear distinction being maintained between the two for purposes of statistical record. It was pointed out as an example that many races come from Canada, including, Irish, Scotch, English, yet such aliens may all be of British nationality, that is, political allegiance.

#### NATHAN STRAUS LEAVES PALESTINE ON RETURN TO UNITED STATES

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Jerusalem, Mar. 4 .- Nathan Straus, American Jewish philanthropist, left Palestine on his return to the United States following the laying of the cor-nerstone for the Health Center he is establishing in Palestine.

Mr. Strans took leave of the huge gathering which came to see him off with the traditional Jewish dictum: "Next year in Jerusalem."

Prior to his departure, Mr. Straus promised a substantial contribution for the B'nai Benjamin Bank of the or-ganization of the Sons of the Palestine Pioneers. The bank was established for the promotion of agriculture.

#### NEW AREA FOR JEWISH SETTLEMENT ALLOTTED IN CRIMEA TERRITORY

#### LORD READING RESPONDS IN HEBREW TO LLOYD GEORGE'S WELSH SPEECH

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) London, Mar. 4 .- How the Marquis of Reading met David Lloyd George, former Prime Minister of Great Britain in a linguistic encounter was related by the Marquis at a public meeting here recently.

The Marquis stated that once, at a dinner, Mr. Lloyd George addressed him in Welsh. Without having understood the former Prime Minister, the Marquis responded immediately in what the audience believed to be Welsh also. What he was actually speaking, how-

ever, was Hebrew.
"I recited a Psalm in Hebrew," the
Marquis explained, "but the dinner guests believed it was genuine Welsh.'

#### HITLER PROPAGANDA FINANCED BY NOTED GERMAN INDUSTRIALIST (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Berlin, Mar. 4.—The anti-Semitic propaganda carried on by Adolf Hitler, notorious agitator, was financed by one of the outstanding German industrial leaders, "Das Berlinner Tageblatt" revealed today.

According to the report of the newspaper, the German industrial king, Conrad Borsig, has given money to Hitler and has instructed him to carry on the propaganda.

#### CALIFORNIA ASSEMBLY PASSES KOSHER MEAT BILL (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Cal., Mar. Sacramento, Cal., Mar. . The Kosher Meat Bill introduced by Assemblyman Harry Lyons of Los Angeles was passed by the lower house of the legislature today.

The bill which is modelled after the

New York State Kosher Meat Law, provides punishment for falsely representing meat as kosher and requires merchants to display signs stating 2,000 families will be settled on this whether or not the meat they offer for land, it was stated. sale is kosher.

Washington, Mar. 4.-The House Washington, Mar. 4.—Ihe House yesterday passed the Johnson bill postponing for another year the national origin provisions of the immigration act of 1924, by a vote of 232 to 111, following a day of desperate filibustering. The resolution, which was passed by the Senate last month, now goes to the White House for the President's signature.

The national origin provision would exclude many immigrants of Scandinavian and Irish decent as well as immigrants from the countries of southern Europe. Representative Finis J. Garrett, minority leader, had led a filibuster against the bill all day. Finally, Representative John Carew, leader of the Tanmany delegation, with the Democrats from Rhode Island, New Jersey and Massachusetts, took a stand against filibustering. The bill passed on a voice vote.

#### PALESTINE GOVERNMENT ASKED TO COOPERATE IN UNEMPLOYMENT RELIEF (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Jerusalem, Mar. 4.-The cooperation of the Palestine government in combatting the unemployment situation in Palestine was invoked by the Zionist Executive in Jerusalem in a memorandum submitted to the government.

The government was also urged to a greater participation in the Jewish education and health budgets.

The government, it was stated, has instructed the District Commissioners of Palestine to cooperate with the Jewish agencies in the matter of employ-

#### NEW PALESTINE COINS

TO BE READY IN FALL Gewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service) London Feb Z - The Egyptian currency now in use in Palestine will be replaced by the new Palestine currency by the antumn, Col. Leopold H. remey by the enturne, Cor. Leopord At. Amery, Secretary for the Colonies, stated in Commons in reply to the questions of Col. Josiah Wedgwood.

The new coins will be the mil or one thousandth part of a Palestine Pound, and multiples of the mil. The inscriptions will be in the three official languages of the country-English, Arabic and Hebrew.

In asking for information regarding the new issue, Col. Wedgwood de-manded why the head of a king other than George V of England appears on the currency.

Return to United States Before Receiving Permits Allowed in Urgent Cases (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Washington, D. C., Mar. 4.-Aliens who can prove to the satisfaction of American immigration officials abroad that because of an emergency it is not practicable for them to await the delayery of their permits to reenter the United States, will be permitted to depan prior to the receipt of the permits, Harry E. Hull, Commissioner General of Immigration, announced March 2 in an order amending Section 10 of the Immigration Act of 1924.

"Experience has demonstrated," Commissioner General Hull stated in the "that unwarranted hardships sometimes result from a refusal to mail abroad return permits in cases where aliens who have filed their applications and it necessary to depart prior to the permits being received by them." The order made clear that "no specious or frivolous" reasons are to be accepted by these immigration officials as satisfactory evidence of an "emergency."

The full text of the order, promulgated by Commissioner General Hull, and approved by Robe Carl White, Assistant Secretary of Labor, follows:

First amendment to General Order No. 74. Subject: Permits to reenter the United States as provided for in Section 10 of the Immigration Act of

Experience has demonstrated that unwarranted hardships sometimes result from a refusal to mail abroad return permits in cases where aliens who have filed their applications find it necessary to depart price to the permits being received by them.

To take care of strictly emergent cases, therefore, permits will be mailed to aliens when satisfactory evidence is presented by them at an immigration office, that it is not practicable for them to await the delivery of the permit prior to departure. No specious or frivolous reasons are to be accepted as satisfactory, nor will permits be sent abroad merely because it is inconvenient for the applicant to await delivery, and officers entertaining such applications will be expected to grant them favorable consideration only when the applicant has clearly demonstrated that an emergency has arisen which necessitates immediate departure.

The practice in cases where permits are to be mailed abroad will be as fol-

Applicants must submit in person their applications at an immigration office, together with the requisite photographs. Where requests are made that permits be mailed abroad, officers, if satisfied that an actual emergency exists which necessitates departure prior to issuance of same, will see to it that the foreign address is given in the application, and will affix a notation therete concerning the nature of the existing

#### Jewish Socialist Paper Rebukes Critics of America

That America shares, in a sense, the fate of the Jewish people, in that its faults are enlarged upon while its virtues are overlooked by the world, is the opinion expressed by the "Forward, Jewish Socialist paper, edited by Abraham Cahan. In an editorial of March 4, under the heading "It is Time to Ad-mit that America Has Virtues Too," the Forward" observes:

Europeans have a one-sided super-ficial view of America; they do not un-derstand her. In this respect the Americans share the fate of the Jews. Their feaths are observed more closely than their virtues. Their sins are advertised aloud, while the fine, noble traits in their character are either limber than the limber than or else delicerately ignored. When a Jewish thief is caught, all Jews are accused of being thieves; when a Jewish nouveau riche acts disgustingly, he is declared to be an example of the whole Jewish people. Exactly the same atti-tude prevails in Europe with regard to some undesirable Americans who go there on trips."

In conclusion the paper adds:

In many respects America stands higher than our old home, on the other We are speaking not only of the material things; we are speaking of the spiritual things too. And America is making steady progress, not only in the economic field but in the sphere of the spirit as well. It is time to admit this. It is time to confess that taken on the whole America is all right."

#### NO DANGER OF POGROMS IN CASE OF OVERTHROWAL IN RUSSIA, SAYS KERENSKY

The opinion that in case of the overthrowal of the Soviet government, no fear of anti-Jewish pogroms is to be entertained was expressed by Alexander Kerensky, Menshevik leader, who signed the decree abolishing the legal disabilities of the Jews in Russia in 1917, prior to the Bolshevik Revolution.

Kerensky, in a press interview on his arrival in New York this week, his arrival in New York this week, isstated: "The Jews are-suppressed under the Soviet regime as are the other peoples of Russia. There are a few Jewish Commissars who have benefitted by the Soviet regime, but the overwhelming majority of Jews are ruined. Jews probably suffer more than anybody else because the desire for freedom is traditionally stronger with the Jews than with the

Asked whether an overthrowal of the Soviet government would not be accompanied by anti-Jewish pogroms, as was the case during the attempts of Denikin and other White generals, Kerensky stated that there is no danger of a monarchistic restoration in Russia. "The fear that a monarchistic reaction would follow the overthrowal of the Soviet regime is purposely spread by the Bolsheviks themselves in order to tame the masses who are as afraid of Czarism as they are of poison. The truth of the matter is that Denikin's movement was artificial and did not have the support of the masses. It was a result merely of foreign intervention. We do not desire any intervention and place our hope only in the Russian people it-self. A movement which will have its origin in Russia and will be based on the peasantry will assume the same character as the February revolution of 1917 and will not be accompanied by pogroms," he declared.

In reply to the question as to his opinion on the Jewish land settling work in Russia, Mr. Kerensky de-clared: "In essence I have nothing against part of the Jewish population proceeding to agriculture. I would like, however, that in this work there proceeding to agriculture, would also be equality on the other side, that is, that the Russian peasants should not be treated worse than the Jewish transmigrants. Asked for further explanation, Mr. Kerensky stated: "It is generally known that in stated: "It is generally known that in the Ukraine there is a great land hun-ger among the peasants. When the Ukrainian poor peasants need land they are sent to the Altai. The col-onization of Jews in the Ukraine proper creates the impression of spe-cial privilege," he said.

"The campaign for the United Palestine Appeal in the greater City of New York has already resulted in the first million dollars. This achievement com-pares favorably with the record of previous campaigns and bears evidence of the ever increasing understanding by world of the significance of Palestine to world Jewry and particularly that portion of it which finds in Palestine not only spiritual promise but promise of the solution for their pressing problems of material existence.

"At this point in our effort, I turn again, as chairman of the Campaign, to my fellow-Jews of New York, and particularly to the workers who are bringing the message to their fellows, not to slacken in their efforts, but to carry the work forward until the total of \$2.500.-000 shall be obtained for our great cause from the Jews of New York.

"Palestine is at this moment beset with urgent needs, the needs of preserving intact the gains that have been made and of extending them in con-structive enterprises along every line, agricultural, industrial, land purchase, sanitation, etc. It is only necessary for every Jew to visualize the Palestine of today and all that Palestine may be for the Jewry of the world to rouse him to deeds of devotion and generosity.

"Let us carry forward the responsibility we have assumed until we have completely discharged it."

#### ROLE OF JEWS AS SOLDIERS IN ARMIES OF ALL NATIONS REVIEWED BY BERLIN PAPER (Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service)

Berlin, Feb. 18.-The centenary of the Czaristic Ukase is the occasion of the publication by the "Schild", the organ of the Federation of Jewish exsoldiers in Germany, of an article in which it traces the history of the Jews as soldiers.

"Between 1900 and 1909," the article states, "170,244 Jews served in the Russian army. According to official figures there were at the outbreak of the Great War 400,000 Jews who had served in the Russian army and the general mobilization brought the figure up to 600,000, about 16 per cent of the total Jewish population. In Germany there were over 100,000 Jews in the Army during the War, in Austria 300,000, and in the rest of Europe and in Turkey about 200,000, so that without counting those Jews who had fought in the American army, there were a quarter of a million Jews on active service.

"As for the ability of the Jewish soldiers, Czar Nicholas I, himself, had acknowleged that the Jews served him, in 1812, loyally and faced death brave-The article concludes that from all

the evidence available the Jews had in all times and in all countries proved themselves good and loyal soldiers."

A hundred years ago, Czar Nicholas I issued his famous Ukase by which the Jews of Russia, who until 1827 had paid a specified sum for relief from conscription, as was done also by the Russian merchant class, were called upon to serve in the Russian army. Boys of twelve were taken at night out of their beds and compelled to serve in the army till the age of 37. Children were torn by force from the arms of their mothers in broad day-light by the "catchers." This was done for lack of able-bodied men to supply the demands of the authorities Jewish conscripts, and besides children, cripples, invalids and old men were seized and placed in auxiliary companies.

#### PALESTINE GOVERNMENT PROTECTS PICA HOLDING FROM ARAB ATTACKS

Jerusalem, Mar. 4 .- The Chesarea area recently attacked by Arabs who uprooted 4,000 eucalyptus trees planted by the Jewish Colonization Association, was proclaimed a closed forest area in order to protect it from further attacks.

#### CORRECTION

#### PLAN ESTABLISHMENT OF PRO-PALESTINE COMMITTEE IN ITALY, Z.O. LEADER SAYS

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service) Rome, Feb. 12.—The prospects for the establishment of a Pro-Palestine Committee in Italy were considered favorable by Dr. Victor Jacobsohn who left here today after a stay of a week. During his visit Dr. Jacobsohn conferred with Italian statesmen, leaders of public opinion and prominent men in the Jewish community. Dr. Jacobsohn is satisfied that the necessary conditions exist at present in Italy for the formation of a Pro-Palestine Committee, similar to those in Germany and France.

Dr. Jacobsohn intends to return to Italy in April in order to proceed with the work of forming the Pro-Palestine Committee.

The New York cast of "Abie's Irish Rose" will be guests of honor at the open meeting of the Jewish Theatrical Guild of America this afternoon at the Republic Theatre.

The International Fur Workers Union of the United States and Canada dissolved the Joint Board of Furriers, suspended its constituent local unions and expelled thirty members of the union. Among the charges were that Benjamin Gold, manager of the Joint Board, had permitted the Communist Party to shape the policies of the last furriers' strike, that certain members had misappropriated funds and that the Joint Board had issued its own union books, thus in effect establishing a dual union

Announcement of the action was made by Ozier Schachtman, President of the International Union, following a meeting of the subcommittee which investigated the charges. The International Union ordered the Joint Board and Locals 1, 5, 10 and 15 to deliver at once all funds and properties to the special committee of the American Federation of Labor-Matthew Woll, Hugh Frayne and Edward F. McGrady-who would hold such property in trust.

Jacob Epstein, Baltimore merchant, who a few weeks ago purchased Van D; ck's "Rinaldo and Armida", has now bought the portrait of Emilia Pia de Montefeltro, by Raphael, whose work is found in some of the big museums but rarely in private ownership. This canvas is said to have cost Mr. Epstein \$250,000, which was his reported cost for the Van Dyck. Both are believed to be destined ultimately for the Baltimore Museum.

News of the purchase was announced by the Kleinberger Galleries, who negotiated it, Delivery has already been made to Mr. Epstein.

the permit be mailed abroad, officers when satisfied that an emergency has arisen subsequent to the time when the original application was filed, will forward to the bureau a photograph of the appilcant similar to the one originally submitted, together with the name and foreign address to which the permit, if issued, is to be mailed, and give the date when the original application was mailed.
