

DETROIT COUNTY PROSECUTOR TAKES STEPS TO CLEAR UP OBFUSCURITY IN FORD ACCIDENT

Asks Ford Investigators for Report; Sapiro Charges Senator Reed Omitted Words in Reading Document to Court

(Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Detroit, Apr. 2.—Officials of the county prosecutor's office moved to puncture the bubble of obscurity surrounding the automobile crash in which Ford was injured here last Sunday.

Prosecutor Robert M. Toms asked officials of the Ford Motor Company for a complete report of their investigation of the affair. Mr. Toms said he did not intend to initiate an investigation unless the Ford organization report was such as to warrant arrest of those responsible.

In the face of persistent reports that the Ford coupe in which the man who makes them was riding deliberately was knocked from the road by a large speeding closed car Mr. Toms said he wanted "to find out what it is all about."

Official investigations were made by two agencies, the Police Department of Dearborn, the Detroit suburb just outside of which Mr. Ford's car was sidwiped, and the constable in charge of patrolling that point. Both reports leaned toward the theory of unavoidable accident.

Detroit, Apr. 2.—Senator Reed, continuing his cross-examination of Aaron Sapiro yesterday, took up an organization speech Mr. Sapiro had made in Alabama in 1920 and read it to the jury, changing no word, but effecting a complete parody by his sarcastic rendering, waving his hand as if he held a mock flag when he came to an ardent passage, until Mr. Sapiro's counsel protested in indignation.

Sapiro identified an account of one of his speeches made in 1921 printed in the Texas Farm Bureau paper. Reed read the article which quoted Sapiro as saying he was not interested primarily in money, but wished to take the children of Texas out of the cotton fields and put them in schools and to

take the women from the fields and put them in their homes.

EUROPEAN ANTI-SEMITES READ "JEWISH REVENGE" INTO FORD'S ACCIDENT

Vienna, Apr. 2.—The mystery which Ford's close associates have thrown about the accident of which the automobile manufacturer was a victim last Sunday, is being used by European anti-Semites to further accusations against the Jews.

The anti-Semitic newspapers here today ascribe Ford's accident to "Jewish revenge" and claim that Henry Ford is a "victim of Jewish hatred."

AT CUZA'S DEMAND ROUMANIAN MINISTER RELEASES 26 STUDENTS HELD FOR ANTI-SEMITIC RIOTS

While This Happens, Education Minister Uses Harsh Words Against Outbreaks; Demand Reprisals Against Filderman

Bucharest, Apr. 2.—The 26 students arrested by the Bucharest police because of their participation in boisterous anti-Semitic manifestations on March 28 were released by an order of Minister of Education Goga. The order was issued following demands made to the chief of police by Alexander Cuza, leader of the anti-Semitic student movement. As soon as the 26 were taken into custody, Cuza appeared at the office of the Chief of Police asking for their release.

The Chief of Police refused to free them, declaring angrily that suspicious elements participated in the disturbances, using the opportunity of the student manifestation. Cuza then appealed to the Minister of the Interior.

It was learned today that during these manifestations a conflict took place between the students and the gendarmerie. In the skirmish, many of the students

GERMAN REFORM RABBIS ADOPT A COMPROMISE RESOLUTION ON ZIONISM

Basic Character of Judaism Is Religious, Resolution Claims, But Leaves Free Choice to Individuals

Berlin, Apr. 2.—Reform rabbis in Germany are not bound, in their attitude toward the Zionist movement, by any policy of the synagogue which they represent.

At a conference of Liberal Rabbis which closed here on Friday, the question of the attitude toward Zionism was heatedly debated. The debate was concluded by the adoption of a compromise resolution which stated that "the basic character of Judaism is religious." Another part of the resolution states that "the conference, therefore, rejects the attempt to present Judaism in a national aspect." The conference went on record as "leaving it to the personal responsibility of each individual to take whatever attitude toward Zionism he thinks proper." The conference hopes the settlement of Palestine will proceed in the spirit of safeguarding Jewish religious life.

BRITISH CHIEF RABBI, HERTZ, SPEAKS IN LONDON CHURCH

London, Apr. 2.—Dr. J. H. Hertz, Chief Rabbi of Great Britain, delivered an address at Whitefields Tabernacle today on "The Bible as a Book." This, it is stated, is the first occasion that the British Chief Rabbi has spoken in a Christian house of worship.

Minister of the Interior Petrovici replied at Friday's session of parliament to the interpellation of Alexander Cuza concerning the government's attitude toward the student demonstrations. The Minister stated that the government refuses to take dictation from minors as to how the country is to be governed. While the students claim that they are prepared to sacrifice their lives, actually they are sacrificing the lives of others, threatening to break heads. The government must intervene in this matter, the Minister stated.

Deputy Ilescu, a member of the Cuza group in parliament, raised the question why the government has stopped its action against the Union of Roumanian Jews, which he charged, is spreading anti-Roumanian reports abroad. He directed his attack particularly against Dr. William Filderman, head of the Union.

GOEMBOES TO LIQUIDATE BRANCH OF HUNGARIAN ANTI-SEMITIC MOVEMENT

Anti-Semites in Greece Renew Ritual Murder Agitation

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Vienna, Apr. 2.—One branch of the anti-Semitic movement in Hungary will soon go out of business, according to despatches to the evening newspapers from Budapest.

Deputy Julius Goemboes, notorious anti-Semitic leader who has been offered the post of Minister of the Interior in the Bethlen cabinet, announced today, the despatches state, that he will liquidate the Hungarian Race Protection movement of which he is the head. He found the movement to be utterly fruitless, he said.

The organization headed by Goemboes, known as the Rassenschutzweler, was responsible for many anti-Jewish outrages in Hungary in recent years.

Salonica, Apr. 2.—With the approach of Passover, the anti-Semitic organization of Florina repeated the ritual murder accusation it conducted in 1925 and 1926 against the Jews of the town.

Two Greek children aged 5 and 7 were reported lost. The parents said that they were sure that the Jews had kidnapped them to kill them for ritual purposes. A mob gathered in the streets and shouted "Kill the Jews."

The Chief of Police said that he believed the Jews had kidnapped the children, and he instructed the Rabbi of Florina to restore the children to their parents. The Greek Metropolitan, however, intervened on behalf of the Jews and persuaded the police to undertake a search for the missing children. Feeling in the town ran high and militia had to be posted in the Jewish quarter to protect the Jewish population from the infuriated mob. Eventually the children were found by the police in a neighboring village.

An investigation into the affair has been ordered by the authorities.

The Issue Is Clear

No matter what will be the outcome of the libel suit brought by Aaron Sapiro against Henry Ford, declares the "Jewish Tribune" of April 1, "the real issue cannot be obscured by legal technicalities, the police court methods of the chief of defense counsel, or the academic wranglings by both sides.

"The truth is," the paper explains, "that Sapiro was singled out for attack because he is a Jew, and not because Henry Ford or his hiring thinkers were concerned about the fate of the 'poor American farmer. These attacks were all part of a vicious and malicious policy adopted in 1920 and adhered to with that arrogant asinine stubbornness characteristic of ignorant fanatics,—the policy of casting suspicion upon any Jew who has become praiseworthy in America, of putting sinister interpretations upon the acts of such Jews no matter how purely motivated, of denouncing the cooperation of Jews in any field as a 'conspiracy.' It is this policy which which should be looked into; it is maintenance of this policy of character-assassination which Ford should be required to explain, for excuse it he cannot! This is the real issue in the present suit, and we feel that the ends of justice will not be served if the issue is evaded."

The Milwaukee (Wis.) "Journal" (Mar. 23) while agreeing with the ruling of Judge Raymond that technically a race cannot be libelled and the trial is therefore a personal issue between Sapiro and Ford, feels, nevertheless, that "the attempt of Mr. Sapiro's attorneys to make the whole Jewish race in effect a party to the suit may serve a useful public purpose. We may get to thinking a little more carefully of our mental attitude toward races and groups of all kinds. We could do a deal of clearing up our minds of rubbish growing out of group prejudices. CONFIRM REPORT JEWISH CONSISTORY WAS LEGALIZED BY BULGARIAN GOVERNMENT

Paris, Apr. 2.—Confirmation of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency report that the Bulgarian government has legalized the Jewish consistory in the country was received here by the Committee of Jewish Delegations.

The committee directed an inquiry to Col. Tadger, president of the consistory, concerning the report. Following the receipt of Col. Tadger's confirmation, the committee despatched a telegram to Premier Liaptchoff expressing gratitude.

A somewhat agitated view of the Ford accident and the mystery surrounding it is taken by the "Jewish World" of Philadelphia (April 1). Speaking of "the black shadow of the spirit of libel—the angel of evil with green eyes, yellow wings and bloody talons—hovering over Detroit, the residence of Henry Ford's kingdom of libel", the paper denounces the insinuating statements of Cameron, editor of the "Independent", regarding the Ford accident, as an attempt to link the Jews with Ford's mishap. This the paper likens to a "blood-ritual accusation", saying: "The Ford investigators could not help themselves and were compelled to publish a denial of the report that Ford was a victim of a plot to kill him. But when did they make this denial? After a lapse of a day and a night during which the blood-ritual charge had sufficient time to poison the atmosphere in Detroit and throughout the country."

London "Telegraph" Predicts Distinct Jewish Drama on World's Stage

The belief that a purely Jewish drama is destined to take a conspicuous place in the world's literature of the stage, is voiced in the London "Daily Telegraph." In a series of articles, which began on Mar. 17, on the role of the Jews in the theatre of the nations, the writer L. A. H. Jones, says in part:

"Today most of the French theatres are in the hands of Jewish shareholders, the majority of the actors of Jewish nationality and three-quarters of the dramatic productions the work of Jewish authors.

"The revolution of 1784 enunciating the principle of the equality of all men, gave French Jewry its permit d'entree into the lists of open intellectual competition in France. The coming of Meyerbeer, Halevy and Offenbach and later Saint-Saens—all of them Jews—may be said to have heralded the birth of Jewish influence in the French theatre.

"The most eminent, and one is almost tempted to say, the most disinterested among the present-day Jewish dramatic authors, is unquestionably M. Porto Riche, a Porto Rican Jew. M. Henri Bernstein's plays are frankly brutal and almost cyclonic in their handling and effect. M. Tristan Bernard exercises a mordant wit."

The writer then goes on to give a long list of prominent Jewish dramatic authors in France, including M. Edmond See, Fernard Moziere (Weill), M. Francis de Croisset, M. Alfred de Saviour (a Jew of Polish origin), M. Henri Kistenmaekers, M. Romain Coulus (President of the French Society of Authors) and Henri de Rothschild, who writes under the names of Andre Pascal and who, the better to

PALESTINE RABBIS MOVE TO ENFORCE STRICT SABBATH OBSERVANCE IN PALESTINE

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service)

Jerusalem, Mar. 4.—A Conference of Rabbis and orthodox communal workers of all sections was held in Jerusalem this week. About 200 persons from all parts of the country were present. Chief Rabbi Kook, Rabbi Sonnenfeld, Chief Rabbi Aaronson of Jaffa and others took part in the discussions which centered on the question of how to strengthen Jewish religious life in Palestine, the observance of Sabbath and the enforcement of the supervision of Kosher meat.

The Conference has adopted a number of resolutions providing for the establishment of Committees to watch over the observance of Sabbath in all the towns and colonies, the issue of a prohibition of football matches on Saturday, to take measures against the violation of Sabbath at the "Nesher" factory in Haifa, the submission of a demand to the Government that Jewish officials should be released from work on Saturday, to appeal to the Zionist Executive, Keren Hayesod, Jewish National Fund and American Jewry that measures be taken against the violation of Sabbath in Palestine.

The Conference proclaimed it the duty of all Jews to employ Jewish labor and to use the products of the land.

Further we read: "The revival of the Jewish national spirit is already contributing a repertory to the world theatre. The latter has for generations been under conspicuous obligation to Jews. Innumerable actors and actresses of first rank have been or are Jews. The modern stage is rich in works of Jewish playwrights. As impresarios, designers, promoters and patrons of dramatic art, the Jews are preeminent. The support of the Jewish population, including many enthusiastic, appreciative, discerning playgoers has assisted materially in the advance of modern theatrical art internationally.

"Inevitably then, a purely Jewish drama seems destined to take a leading place in the literature of the stage. Until lately, however, Jewish authors generally concerned themselves primarily with international general subjects, taking the conventions and conditions of the peoples among whom they found themselves as their artistic stock in trade, rather than themes, characteristics and material of their own nationality. Meanwhile definite Yiddish literature is coming into being, claiming wide international appreciation. With the development of purely Jewish theatres in Russia, Germany and New York, the Yiddish theatre should come into prominence," the writer states.

RADIO COMMISSION HOLDS HEARING ON FREE SPEECH

Washington, Apr. 2.—The right of broadcasters to censor material to be sent out over the radio was questioned before the Radio Commission yesterday by Morris L. Ernst, counsel for the Civil Liberties Union, who claimed unfair treatment.

There is one station in New York, according to Mr. Ernst, where no Protestant may broadcast on matters pertaining to religion, and Norman Thomas, Socialist, has been denied requests repeatedly to speak to the radio public, he said.

In Springfield, he added, a professor in Smith College went to deliver an address on the policy of the Government in the Near East and was instructed to cut out two paragraphs of his address. Mr. Ernst told the commission Hudson Maxim had not been permitted to make his speech, and asserted that when an editor, Mr. Kaltenborn, criticized the policy of a party he was advised he could have no further facilities for broadcasting.

Reference was made to a speech by William J. Burns, the detective, which was alleged to contain attacks on different organizations in New York. The latter, witness said, were not permitted to reply, although they wished to have speakers, among them Norman Hapgood.

Mr. Ernst insisted the principle of free speech and free press should apply also to use of the radio.

Representative Emanuel Celler recently contended in addressing the commission, that by receiving a license from the Government the radio broadcaster becomes something of a public utility and should deal fairly with all schools of thought. Commissioner Bellows gave an opinion that by exempting from censorship the speeches of candidates for office, the Radio Control act implies that all other matter may be censored by the broadcasting stations. Censorship by the Radio Commission is prohibited.

The Civil Liberties Union counsel suggested that each broadcasting station be compelled to keep a full log of everything happening in its relationship with the public.

Franklin Ford, of station WHAP took exception to conclusions that free speech has been interfered with in decisions preventing Mr. Thomas from making an address through the ether.

"There is no inherent right to any individual," he said, "whether he be Socialist, such as Mr. Thomas, or anti-Socialist, vivisector or anti-vivisector. Protestant or anti-Protestant, to demand that a radio station broadcast his views because it has previously broadcast against his views as a matter of principle and conviction."

The commission took under consideration the mass of evidence and opinion it has received at the public hearings conducted this week.

JEWISH AGENCY COMMISSION WILL BE AIDED BY PALESTINE FINANCE COUNCIL

Jerusalem, Mar. 4.—The first meeting of the Finance and Economic Council called by the Palestine Zionist Executive was held here yesterday. The meeting was attended by M. Ussishkin, director of the Jewish National Fund, Dr. A. Hautke, director of the Keren Hayesod, S. Hoofien of the Anglo-Palestine Company, Mr. M. Dizenhoff, director of the Department of Urban Colonization of the Palestine Zionist Executive, S. Kaplansky, director of the Department of Agricultural Colonization of the Palestine Zionist Executive.

Colonel Kisch who opened the meeting on behalf of the Palestine Zionist Executive, dwelt especially on the important tasks which devolved upon the Finance and Economic Council in connection with the problems bound up with the forthcoming visit of the Jewish Agency Commission to Palestine.

Upon the suggestion of the Palestine Zionist Executive, Dr. Ruppin was unanimously chosen chairman of the Finance and Economic Council.

The following resolutions were adopted:

"Inasmuch as the Commission of the Jewish Agency is to arrive in Palestine within a short time, and the Zionist Congress will be held soon thereafter, the Finance and Economic Council finds it advisable to postpone the definite constitution of the Council until the next Congress.

"At the same time the Finance and Economic Council agrees to assume the task of preparing the concrete program which the Council is to submit to the next Congress. It will be ready to pass an opinion upon the economic questions which will be submitted to it from time to time by the Zionist Executive, and will concern itself especially with the preparation of the material required in connection with the work of the Commission of the Jewish Agency."

JEWISH DEPUTIES PROTEST AGAINST COURT MARTIALS

Kovno, Apr. 2.—The Jewish deputies in the Lithuanian parliament joined the protest against the continuation of the series of court martials which have followed the coup d'etat.

Representatives of the national minorities, the Jewish deputies and the Socialist deputies, left the Sejm session in a body on Friday as a demonstration against the court martials.

JEWISH STUDENT WHO SHOT IN SELF-DEFENSE OUT ON BAIL

Bucharest, Apr. 2.—Lespianu, the Jewish student who was arrested here because he shot in self-defense, was released on bail pending trial. Presentations were made in his behalf by Dr. William Filderman, president of the Union of Rumanian Jews.

Lespianu fired his revolver when he was attacked by Rumanian students.

SOUTH AFRICAN JEWS TACKLE PROBLEM OF JEWISH EDUCATION

Johannesburg, S. Africa, Mar. 5.—The world-wide problem of Jewish education has come to the fore in the Jewish community of South Africa.

A public meeting was called by the South African Jewish Board of Deputies to discuss the question of the Jewish education of the young and to decide on the amalgamation of the Talmud Torahs of Johannesburg. A resolution was unanimously adopted, approving the amalgamation and pledging them support. S. Raphaely, acting president of the Board, was chairman of the meeting.

The Chief Rabbi said that the problem was the most vital question facing Jewry in South Africa.

meaning. Corrected by the witness, himself an attorney, Reed said the word was almost obliterated and he had not seen it.

Petersburg, Va., launched its campaign for the United Palestine Appeal at a meeting on Tuesday night. A. Tannenbaum is chairman of the campaign for \$1,000, Petersburg's nota. Danville, Va. launched its drive for \$2,000 last week.

The West Philadelphia Jewish Community Center will dedicate the building, which is now nearing completion, on June 12, 1927. Nathan Beck is chairman of the Dedication Committee.

The Community Center will be one of the most beautiful in Philadelphia. The approximate cost of the building is \$500,000. There will be a synagogue with a seating capacity of 1,500; a Beth-ha-Midrash for daily use; fourteen class rooms will be available for about 1,000 children; a library containing several thousand volumes; a gymnasium; and a swimming pool. The auditorium has a seating capacity of 600. There is a gymnasium and swimming pool. The Rabbi S. Joshua Kohn is rabbi of the West Philadelphia Jewish Community Center. Aaron Sherman is President of the Congregation.
