## **DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE CONTRADICTS CHARGES OF NEW AGAINST LEVINE**

**No Suit Pending Against Flyer; Con-  
trovery Similar to Many Growing  
Out of War Material Transactions**  
 (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Washington, D. C., June 10.—The Department of Justice yesterday furnished the Jewish Telegraphic Agency correspondent here with information concerning the alleged trouble of Charles A. Levine with the War Department regarding his salvage transactions. According to this information, the War Department is making a claim against Levine for an amount ranging from \$100,000 to \$300,000, constituting profits which Levine is alleged to have made on abandoned war material turned over to him by the government on a fifty-fifty profit sharing basis.

The War Department now contends that Levine did not fully account for the government's share and therefore is endeavoring to collect the alleged difference. The Department of Justice took a different view than that of Postmaster General New, declaring that many such claims between the government and private individuals are pending and that there is nothing unusual about the affair. No court action of any kind has been taken by the government nor is any contemplated. It was stated that the government is endeavoring to reach an amicable settlement with Levine through his attorney and negotiations are still in progress.

Assistant United States Attorney General Galloway has charge of the matter for the Department of Justice. Levine's transactions with the War Department reached several millions, it is understood. He conducted his transactions with the government through the Columbia Salvage Company.

Berlin, June 10.—Charles A. Levine declared at the press conference at the American Embassy here that he is planning to form a company for regular passenger air service between the United States and Europe.

"I am ready to sink \$2,000,000 right now into the project," Mr. Levine said.

## **CHARLES A. LEVINE CALLS NEW'S CHARGES ABSURD**

## **FELIX M. WARBURG AND SIR ALFRED MOND VISUALIZE 10-YEAR PALESTINE PROGRAM**

**Felix M. Warburg Feted at Luncheon by Zionist Executive; With United  
Effort All Difficulties Will Be Overcome, He Says; Draws No  
Comparison Between Crimea and Palestine**

London, June 10.—Felix M. Warburg and Sir Alfred Mond, two of the leading members of the Jewish Agency Palestine Survey Commission, outlined their views of the future work in the upbuilding of Palestine, in addresses delivered at a luncheon given by the Zionist Executive in honor of Felix M. Warburg, upon his arrival here from a trip to Palestine and Russia.

The luncheon took place today, following a meeting of the Executive in which Mr. Warburg participated and was attended by Sir Herbert Samuel, Sir Alfred Mond, James de Rothschild, Bernard Baron, Mr. Hirst, Otto Schiff, Pinchas Rutenberberg and the members of the Zionist Executive. Dr. Chaim Weizmann presided.

Mr. Warburg, who alluded to a ten year program for Palestine upbuilding work, said that he was greatly impressed upon his second visit to Palestine. "This visit has strengthened the impressions of my earlier visit which I made during the administration of Sir Herbert Samuel," he said.

"I just returned from Crimea and from Palestine. My grandmother used to say, 'Never make comparisons,' so I am not going to draw a comparison between the Jewish work in Palestine and in Crimea. Economic and agricultural development can be conducted by Jews anywhere, but only Palestine is able to combine economic achievements with a spiritual rebirth. Palestine has been the home of our ancestors, and I have seen with my own eyes the great progress of agricultural and spiritual life in Palestine for which the university stands as a shining example," Mr. Warburg stated.

The speaker complimented Mr. Rutenberberg who, he said, has spread electric light and power in Palestine.

"I rejoice to know that the first group of experts of the Jewish Agency Palestine Survey Commission is already in Palestine. Their report would cer-

tainly give an account of the agricultural and other undertakings and formulate a plan which could be carried out for the next ten years. I am sure that the Commission will be able to provide a program of economic work in which Jews can unite in order to carry it out during the next ten years. It is unnecessary to pay much attention to pessimistic utterances, nor trouble one's self to correct statements which wandering journalists put in one's mouth," Mr. Warburg stated, referring to the statements ascribed to him recently by Paul Sandor, the Hungarian Jewish leader, a non-Zionist, who reported in the Hungarian press what purported to have been a conversation between him and Mr. Warburg, on the steamer "Redoute," concerning Palestine.

"Upon my return to America I shall spare no effort to continue unifying the work which was started by Dr. Weizmann. He preached unity, and it is a great lesson which Jews everywhere should learn. With united effort we can overcome all difficulties and make Palestine a great center for Jewry," Mr. Warburg stated.

Sir Alfred Mond, in his address, greeted Mr. Warburg as his colleague on the Palestine Survey Commission. "I can only endorse Mr. Warburg's statement," Sir Alfred declared. "It is no secret that Dr. Weizmann and his colleagues are going through a period of great financial stringency. In my opinion they deserve some support. Dr. Weizmann and his colleagues have conducted their work during the past ten years most successfully upon voluntary subscriptions. I am sure they will receive immediate unqualified financial assistance," Sir Alfred stated.

## **ALFRED MOND CRITICIZES PALESTINE GOVERNMENT FOR SCANTY SUPPORT**

London, June 10.—The Palestine government was criticized for its scanty support of the Jewish work in Palestine by Sir Alfred Mond, president of the Economic Board for Palestine, at its annual meeting yesterday.

Sir Alfred reviewed the present situation in Palestine and stated that the crisis is not surprising. Fluctuation is possible after two rapid developments, he said. However, things are moving, he stated.

Greater participation on the part of British Jews in the Board's work was urged by the president.

## **VIENNA JEWS TO WELCOME CHAMBERLIN AND LEVINE**

**AMERICAN ARCHAEOLOGICAL  
EXPEDITION MAKES IMPORT-  
ANT FINDS NEAR JERUSALEM**

**Earthenware Pot Containing Food  
Left 2,500 Years Ago Unearthed**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Jerusalem, June 10.—New archaeological finds were made by Professor William Frederick Bade of the University of California who is carrying on excavations at Tel En Nasbeh.

Tel En Nasbeh is seven miles north of Jerusalem on the west side of the Nabulus road. The excavations revealed an exceptionally fine, well preserved Israelitish house of the seventh century before the Christian era. The street entrance and several rooms of the house stand. Inside were found a bread trough, a wine press and a large earthenware pot containing remains of food as left by the inhabitants 2,500 years ago. A water cistern was also disclosed.

**ROMANIAN JEWS PREPARE  
FOR PARLIAMENTARY ELEC-  
TION; MAY FORM A BLOC**

Bucharest, June 10.—The fall of the Averescu government and the prospect for an improvement in the Jewish situation in the country may facilitate the creation of a United Jewish front.

Leaders of the Jewish factions in the country are considering the creation of a parliamentary election bloc. The Jewish nationalist parties, as well as the Union of Roumanian Jews, will probably unite for the elections in view of the clause in the election law which provides that a group may obtain parliamentary representation only if its list obtains two percent of the total votes cast.

**NEW BANK ESTABLISHED  
IN PALESTINE WITH OVER  
ONE MILLION CAPITAL**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Jerusalem, June 10.—A new bank has been founded under the name of "Director, Bloom and Cohen, Bank of Palestine". Its foundation capital amounts to \$1,000,000 and the shares are divided among the three founders. The shares are not only paid up in full but an additional 10 per cent was levied on each share to form a reserve capital. The bank has at its disposal, therefore, a capital of \$1,100,000. The bank intends starting its operations next September.

The Palestine and Near East Economic Magazine has published an interview with S. Cohen, one of the founders of the Bank.

"We have decided to open this bank," Mr. Cohen said, "because it is our belief that Palestine presents a wide field for the operation of banking institutions, provided they have at their disposal the necessary capital and they are rightly managed from the beginning. The economic depression from which Palestine has been suffering for the last two years is very largely due to the absence of normal credit facilities in this country. It is true that several banking institutions work in Palestine but Jewish economy in this country suffers from the absence of such a bank operating on a large scale, round which could group themselves private capital and private initiative. We are convinced that private initiative only can solve the problem of the economic reconstruction of this country."

"The new bank is not established in order to compete with the existing institutions, but on the contrary in order to cooperate and improve financial activities in this country. The bank aims at helping trade industry and building activities. We think that Jewish mass colonization in this country will not be fully successful unless a way is found to settle in the towns those masses who either cannot or will not turn to agricultural pursuits."

"In this connection a predominating part will be played by the improvement of conditions in Tel-Aviv. Our bank will be registered both in America and in Palestine, but Palestine will be the only field of its activities. Nevertheless, the fact that the founders of the bank have business interests in Europe, America and Palestine will, we hope, greatly help the development of our institution," he said.

**TWENTY ARE EXECUTED IN  
MOSCOW AS RENEWAL OF  
RED TERROR IS PROCLAIMED**

Riga, June 10.—Solomon Gurevitch, son of a Jewish merchant, was executed yesterday on the charge that he attempted to assassinate Bucharin and Stalin on March 12. Gurevitch was one of a group of twenty who were executed following the official proclamation of the OGPU, the present name of the ill-famed Cheka, announcing the revival of the Red Terror in Russia.

**Levine and Official America**

It was not so much the honor of Levine as the honor of America that was involved in the action of Washington in ignoring Levine in the congratulatory message on the successful trans-Atlantic flight of Chamberlin and Levine, declares the "Jewish Daily News" of June 10.

"We do not wish to make too much of a fuss," the paper says, "about the attitude of our country to Levine, but it is undeniable that the Jews of America feel no small disappointment at the attitude of America, especially official America, to the Jew whose feat added to the glory and honor of this country."

"It was unquestionably a had oversight on the part of the President when he failed to mention Levine in his message of congratulation to Germany, an oversight which hurts and must hurt all Jews in America. But the chief guilt lies with those close to the President who advise him in such matters. Owing to these persons, he committed a deplorable error which has put not only himself but the whole country as well in a regrettable position."

"The impression made by this attitude to Levine cannot be erased. All the explanations do not avail in the face of the fact which speaks for itself. That fact reveals that while the whole world was enthusiastic at the great feat of the two American fliers, America, official America, recognized only one of the fliers, ignoring the other, who is a Jew. Official America should not have waited for Hindenburg's praises for the two fliers before admitting that there were two men in the Columbia."

Contending that Levine's heroism was not a whit less than that of Lindbergh and Chamberlin and that, besides being the first trans-Atlantic air passenger, Levine actually helped Chamberlin pilot the plane, the paper concludes:

"This is the view of the whole world, the whole world except official America which was unable to rise to the height of the occasion as it should have and thus darkened the American spirit of jubilation by smallness and narrow-mindedness. Such men as Postmaster General New unfortunately lack the vision and broadmindedness necessary for a person occupying his high post. He has exhibited the mental attitude of a small official rather than that of a statesman. But neither he nor any one else can belittle Levine's feat. No attempt to minimize, ignore or criticize can lessen the greatness of the deed. The officialdom of Washington is not in a position to minimize the achievement."

"We are concerned not about Levine. We are concerned about America."

## Anti-Semitic Press Charges Clarence Dillon and Other American Bankers Head Alleged "Jewish Conspiracy"

(By Our Berlin Correspondent)

Berlin, May 15.—That the source and headquarters of the alleged "international conspiracy" of Jewish financiers is in America, is the charge being made in the anti-Semitic press of Germany.

Special attention is devoted by such papers as the "Weltkampf", organ of the Voelkische group, to Clarence Dillon, head of Dillon, Read & Co. of New York, who together with other Jewish bankers of America, is accused by the anti-Semites of being at the head of the world wide "conspiracy".

Mr. Dillon, whom the Jew-baiting press regards as the man who controls Wall Street and as the greatest rival today of J. P. Morgan, was the subject of discussion in the Jewish press about a year ago in connection with a loan floated by his firm for Poland. It was then pointed out that he is of Jewish origin, his father, named Lapowski, originating from Lodz. In some quarters it was said that Mr. Dillon is a converted Jew. The "Lodz-er Tageblatt" at that time carried the following item regarding Dillon's origin:

"A well known Jewish citizen and philanthropist, who is a relative of Dillon's has given us the following interesting facts.

"The name of Dillon's father was Samuel Lapowski. He was born in Wlana, near Lomza and came to Lodz, where he was employed in his father's concern at the end of Constantiu and Zachodni Streets. Samuel Lapowski's father, Dillon's grandfather, was Jehushia Lap and was the son of Berel Lap in Wlana where he is still remembered today.

"Samuel Lapowski emigrated to America in 1876. It was there that Clarence (Cuninus), who is now a well known financier, was born. Dillon's grandfather Jehushia Lap and his grandmother Pesse Lap are buried in the cemetery of Lodz. Pesse Lap's maiden name was Dillon. She was a daughter of Moshe Dillon.

"The reason why Clarence Lapowski changed his name to Dillon was as follows: Moshe Dillon's father, Leizer Dillon of Nesheva was the chief provision agent for Czar Nicholas the First during the Sevastopol war. He rode out on the battle front with the Czar and there is a photograph showing him wearing a 'strelmel' on his head, two rows of decorations bestowed on him by the Czar on his chest. This photograph was in the possession of Dillon's grandmother Lapowski in Lodz. On the request of Dillon's uncle, Professor

Telegram" and in all other Scripps-Howard publications, says:

"When offered \$100,000 to fly back home Charles A. Levine said he would consider the matter, but that if he accepted he would give the money to Chamberlin. Meanwhile he has sent back the 250 cancelled stamps which the Post Office Department has been fussing about, and which experts have estimated would be worth \$1,000 apiece, as a gift to the Brooklyn Institute of Arts and Sciences.

"He now declares that he and Chamberlin plan to establish a trans-Atlantic acrial service and that he is ready to put \$2,000,000 into the venture.

"Such things look like real sportsmanship."

Boleslaw Lapowski, who won the gratitude of Poland for his services on her behalf in America, the photograph of Leizer Dillon was sent to him in America. When Clarence Lapowski saw the photograph it impressed him so much that he adopted the name Dillon.

Clarence Dillon's aunt, who still lives in Lodz, has an candy factory on Podgorna Street. Dillon also has a cousin in Lodz who is a well known attorney.

"When Dillon was in Lodz on a visit, however, he refused to receive any of his relatives. He did not even pay a visit to the graves of his parents."

The "Weltkampf" and other anti-Semitic organs of course include Dillon in the international Jewish "conspiracy" and declare that in his bank and in the various banks under his control he employs Christian directors as a mere blind for his "conspirative" activities. Even Christian banks, where Jews are not to be found, are declared by the anti-Semitic organ to be secretly the tools of the Jewish "conspiracy." Relating some of the big transactions put through by Dillon's institution, foreign loans, etc., the "Weltkampf" concludes thus: "This is the story of a so-called 'Christian' banking firm, which through its bounden relations with Jewish high finance is contributing towards the erection of a state of financial slavery. Precisely the 'Christian' banks and the 'Christian' directors at the head of the Jewish banks serve as a method of moral impunity for Jewish high finance. The Jew prefers to work in the dark, behind the scenes."

A lengthy description of Dillon's rise to his present position in the financial world is given in the "Voelkischer Beobachter," another organ of the anti-Semites. This paper reveals some interesting facts regarding his career. Incidentally, the paper unintentionally throws light on what may well be one of the causes of Henry Ford's anti-Semitic campaign. The paper tells of a scramble that was made for the purchase of the Dodge motor stock after the death of the Dodge brothers. Among those who sought to gain control of the Dodge company were Henry Ford and J. P. Morgan. While the Dodge widows were considering the offers, Dillon proposed to pay them \$140,000,000 cash, provided the ownership of the firm were turned over to him within ten minutes. The offer was accepted and Dillon put \$180,000,000 of Dodge stock on the market and sold it. That was how he became the power he now is, being, according to the "Voelkischer Beobachter," second only to Ford as a striking financial genius in America.

Other Jewish bankers of the United States have also been especially conspicuous in German anti-Semitic literature of late. In their effort to bolster up their charge of an international Jewish "conspiracy," the anti-Semitic papers here have been publishing descriptions of all American bankers, bearing Jewish names, including in their lists many names of Jewish financiers

## SEEK WAYS AND MEANS TO IMPROVE PALESTINE GRAPE EXPORT INDUSTRY (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Jerusalem, June 10.—In view of the favorable prospects for grape export from Palestine, particularly to Egypt and England, the Zionist Executive is considering ways and means to secure appropriate packing and transport conditions for the fruit which has been widely and successfully planted in late years.

The Jewish villages engage in special propaganda for the sale of their grapes, some varieties of which have fine qualities. "Ezi More Grapes" is the slogan of Jewish Palestine in the summer time.

During the Palestine orange season which has just concluded, Great Britain purchased 1,803,368 boxes of oranges from Palestine, or 446,000 more than last year. The principal towns of entry were Liverpool, 624,417 boxes; Glasgow, 423,504; Hull, 301,432; and Manchester, 306,186.

## REPORT NEW MASS ARRESTS OF ZIONISTS IN RUSSIA

Riga, June 10.—Reports of new mass arrests of Zionists throughout Soviet Russia, particularly in the southern part of the Union, were reported here.

Seligmann & Co., Goldman, Sachs & Co., Hallgarten & Co., Mortimer L. Schiff, Otto H. Kahn, Lazarus Freres, Ladenburg, Thalmann & Co., Knauth, Nachod & Kuhne, Lewishon & Sons, Guggenheim Brothers, Bernard M. Baruch, Samuel Untermyer, Eugene Meyer, Jr., S. W. Straus, Joffes (San Francisco), Süss, Levy-Gerstle (Sacramento), Hellman Bank, Newmarks (Los Angeles), The Warburg Brothers, Paul and Felix, are also included.

## LEAVES \$180,000 TO HOSPITAL FOR JOINT DISEASES

The Hospital for Joint Diseases, Madison Avenue and 124th Street, will receive \$160,000 in trust and \$20,000 outright, according to the terms of the will of Leo L. Doblin, it was announced by Frederick Brown, president of the hospital. Mr. Doblin died on May 17.

The provisions of the will include a trust fund of \$100,000 for the erection of a building by the Hospital for Joint Diseases and maintenance of an annex for the free treatment of crippled children; in trust for the building and maintenance of a dormitory and Training School for Nurses, \$60,000; outright for the maintenance and operation of a moving picture machine previously presented by Mr. Doblin to the hospital, \$10,000; outright for the endowment of two beds for the parents of the deceased, \$10,000.

The will also provides that the hospital receive \$30,000 towards a pathological endowment upon the death of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Doblin.

## DEDICATE RATHENAU MEMORIAL IN BERLIN

Berlin, June 10.—The Walter Rathenau Endowment Museum was dedicated here today at Freienwalde Palace.

The Palace was built by Queen Frederica Louise, the wife of the Prussian King Frederick William II.

Rathenau, the late German Jewish statesman, who was assassinated by anti-Semites, acquired the palace from the Crown in 1909.

The rooms which Rathenau occupied will be dedicated as a Rathenau memorial.

## PALESTINE AND EGYPT TO BE CONNECTED BY CABLE

London, June 10.—Negotiations have practically been completed with both the Palestine and Egyptian Administrations for the laying of a new cable between Egypt and Palestine. A statement to this effect was made by the Chairman of the Eastern Telegraph Company at the general meeting held here. ## QUEEN MARIE GETS PETITION OF 30,000 AMERICANS URGING OPPRESSION BE ENDED

Bucharest, June 10.—The petition addressed to Queen Marie, signed by over 30,000 Americans, appealing to her to exercise her influence in favor of the minorities in Roumania has been received here through the Roumanian Ambassador in Washington, according to the "Adeverul."

The petition states: "We take this opportunity to express our wish that your Majesty take under your protection the minorities in Roumania who are at present treated unkindly—namely, the Catholic Rottmanians, the Protestants, the Jews and the Baptists."

The petition was prepared and signed by 60 prominent Americans and was intended to be submitted to the Queen during her stay in America. In the meantime another 30,000 Americans, including writers, university professors, judges, and representatives of various religious denominations, expressed their wish to join in the petition.

Mr. Ornstein has served as Chairman of the Open Forum Committee of the Foundation during the past year, and is captain of the Hillel Foundation Debate Team. Helen S. Wickerman, of Fort Wayne, Ind., was elected secretary and vice-president of the Student Council.

Dedictory celebrations will be held from June 12 to June 19 for the new West Philadelphia Jewish Community Centre.

The centre has a synagogue, chapel, an auditorium with stage, 14 classrooms, a 12,000 volume library, gymnasium, swimming pool, men's and women women's club rooms, fifteen meeting rooms, dining rooms, and a tennis court outside. The cost of erection was approximately \$750,000.

The synagogue will be dedicated next Sunday morning, when 1,000 school children from the West Philadelphia Hebrew School will march with the Talmud Torah from Sixth and Larchwood Avenue to the centre. A community dinner will be held in the evening.

The cornerstone laying of the community center of the Adas Kodesh Synagogue in Wilmington, Del., will be held this afternoon. Rabbi Louis A. Mischkind of Temple Beth Shalom, Wilmington, will be the principal speaker. The chairman in charge of arrangements is Louis Rosenblatt. The building will be four stories high and will contain reading and school rooms, and gymnasium. There will be a swimming pool and gymnasium. The cost of erection will be \$150,000.

A farewell dinner will be tendered to the members of the American Jewish Congress Delegation to the Conference on Jewish Rights to be held in Geneva in August. The dinner will be held at the Hotel Biltmore on June 15.

The Delegation is headed by Judge Julian W. Mack. Questions pertaining to the immediate action of the Congress will be discussed at the dinner in addresses to be delivered by Dr. Stephen S. Wise, President of the American Jewish Congress and a member of the Delegation, Carl Sherman, Chairman of the Administrative Committee, Max D. Streum, Judge Gustave Hartman, Dr. A. J. Rongy, David Podell, Dr. Joseph Tennenbaum and other members of the Delegation.

Aaron Sapir will also address the gathering.

The cornerstone of the Community Center building of the Congregation Sons of Israel, Bensonhurst, Brooklyn, will be laid this afternoon.

Among the speakers announced are Judge Otto Rosakly, Judge Mitchell S. Way and Judge Alexander Geismar. Dr. Bernard Revel and Harris L. Selig. Rabbi Nachman H. Ebin, the rabbi of the congregation, Samuel Kramer, president of the Congregation, and chairman of the committee, will also speak.

## ALFRED M. COHEN, PRESIDENT, I. O. B. B., SAILS FOR EUROPE

Alfred M. Cohen, president of the Independent Order B'nai Brith, sailed yesterday on the Leviathan for a trip of several months in Europe in the interests of the Order. Mr. Cohen will first visit London, where he will install the officers of the I. O. B. B. District Lodge of Great Britain and Ireland. A meeting of the District Grand Lodge will be held in London on June 19, and in the evening the annual dinner of the first lodge of England will be held. Mr. Cohen will be the principal speaker at both meetings. Rabbi Louis Mann of Chicago accompanied Mr. Cohen.

The I. O. B. B. is the only American Jewish fraternal organization that has branches in Europe and Asia.

Rabbi Leo Jung of the Jewish Center, New York, will sail on June 22nd on the President Harding for a two months visit to Europe. He will participate in the exercises of the laying of the cornerstone for the first Orthodox Jewish Girl Teacher's Training College in Poland and will also make a tour of inspection of Jewish schools in Central and Eastern Europe.

Ground breaking for the new Jewish Community Center of Yonkers, N. Y., will take place on Sunday, June 26.

Kurt Peiser, Superintendent of the United Jewish Social Agencies of Cincinnati, was elected President of the Board of Trustees of the Helen S. Trounstein Foundation.

The Helen S. Trounstein Foundation constitutes the Research Division of the Community Chest and Council of Social Agencies.
