GEORG BRANDES' NAME WAS NOT ASSUMED. SAYS PROF. SIMONSEN

Says "Brandes" Was Famous Writer's
Real Name

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Berlin, July 27.—At the time of the death of the late Georg Brandes, anti-Semitic publications in many countries alleged that Brandes was an assumed name, and that his real name was Morris Cohen. Professor David Simonsen of Copenhagen writing to the Society for Jewish Family Research, states that this is not the case. Brandes' great-great-grandfather came to Denmark from Altona in Germany, he writes, and not from Lithuania as is alleged. His grandfather, Israel Cohen, died in 1816 at an early age. The widow remarried her second husband being a Jew from Posen named Brandes. Their eldest son was Herman Moses Cohen Brandes and his son, who afterwards became famous as George Brandes, was named Georg Morris Cohen Brandes, his real and full name.

SOLOMON JOSEPH SOLOMON, ANGLO-JEWISH ARTIST, DIES

London, July 27.—Solomon Joseph Solomon, President of the Royal Society of British Artists and member of the Royal Academy of Arts, died here at the age of 66.

Mr. Solomon was, together with Israel Zangwill, one of the founders of the Society of Jewish Artists and Writers in Great Britain. He was also vice-president of the Maccabees.

At the beginning of the war, Mr. Solomon drew attention to the need for camouflage in modern warfare, and initiated it in the British army, where he had the rank of colonel.

Among his paintings is one called the "Coronation of King George". He also painted the portraits of Ramsay MacDonald, Israel Zangwill, Lord Asquith and others. He was the author of "Strategic Camouflage", published in 1920.

AQUARIUM NOW CALLS JEW FISH "JUNE FISH"

The name of the Jew fish, chief cause of annoyance to Charles E. Townsend, managing director of the New York Aquarium in Battery Park, has been changed to June fish, and employees began changing the signs above the star boarder's tank.

Mr. Townsend said the change was in response to the protests of Jews that a fish "so ugly and so named was an insult to their race."

He was also greatly annoyed by the many questions as to why the fish was called a Jew fish. Mr. Townsend

HERMAN BERNSTEIN RELATES EVENTS PRECEDING SUIT AGAINST HENRY FORD

Expresses Satisfaction at Ford's Retraction of Charges

Expressing satisfaction with the apology of Henry Ford, Mr. Herman Bernstein, in a statement to the "Jewish Daily Bulletin", related the events which preceded his suit.

"I am happy," Mr. Bernstein stated, "that Mr. Henry Ford has made so complete a retraction of the 'Dearborn Independent' articles in which the Jewish people were cruelly maligned for years, and in which I was personally wronged and libelled.

"There are but few people in this country who realize the full extent of the harm that was caused the Jewish people by the dissemination of the poisonous articles all over the world in Henry Ford's name. Just as Mr. Samuel Untermyer, on his recent trip around the world, witnessed the far-reaching injury to the Jewish people done by these articles, I have found in my extensive travels in various parts of the world during the past few years that Henry Ford's prestige as one of the world's foremost industrialists had lent force and given credence to the malicious myths and legends circulated widely by all sorts of anti-Semites who quoted Henry Ford and shielded themselves behind his name.

"And certainly no one knows better than I do the full extent of the injury caused me personally by the article in

ASH, TORRES AND LECACHE PLEAD FOR JEWISH COLONIZATION WORK IN RUSSIA

Paris, July 27.—M. Henri Torres, the counsel for Sholom Schwartzbard, was chairman at a public meeting of the French Society for Promoting Jewish Colonization in Russia, held here today.

M. Bernard Lecache, who recently visited Russia and the Ukraine, said that he had convinced himself during his tour of the Jewish colonies in the Jewish life in Russia and the Ukraine was reviving now after the many years of famine and pogroms.

Sholom Ash, the famous Yiddish author, said that support of the work of Jewish colonization in Russia did not signify approval of the Soviet regime, "but" it was possible to be interested in Palestine and also in the Jewish colonization work in Russia. The establishment of the Jews in agriculture was a great work. It made for the Jews who till now had been an emigrant population leading vagabond lives becoming a settled people, attached to the soil. Looked at from this point of view, the work of

ROUMANIAN CONSUL MAKES PUBLIC SPEECHES OF JEWISH LEADERS IN ROUMANIA

Addresses of Dr. Filderman and Rabbi Niemirower Delivered on July 25

The Royal Roumanian Consulate General in New York released yesterday the following official summary of the speeches delivered by Dr. William Filderman and Rabbi Niemirower at the July 25th session of the Roumanian Parliament.

In the name of the Roumanian Jews, representative Filderman, president of the Union of Roumanian Jews, declared: "If all Roumanian citizens united in their love for the throne, bring their homage to the memory of our great King, we the Jews of Roumania, have special motives in glorifying Him forever. It was He who, in 1917, at Jassy, said that He had arrived at the conclusion that all the inhabitants of the country should be treated with equality, without distinction of religion and in the highest spirit of fraternity. Before the country and the throne, the Jewish population declare that they will continue to fulfill their duty in the spirit of the work accomplished by the glorious King Ferdinand. The Jewish population will always be found in the ranks of those who surround with their affection and devotion King Michael the First for the happiness and glory of the Fatherland."

The Jewish Senator, Rabbi Niemirower, declared: "The act of emancipation of the Roumanian Jews will forever be linked with the name of King Ferdinand. This act has placed the Jewish population of Roumania, from a point of view of rights and obligations, on the same footing of equality with the other Roumanians. In the name of all the Jews I express my sentiment of profound gratitude for the glorious King Ferdinand, and at this solemn hour when we express our condolences to our revered Queen, we take the oath of fidelity to His Majesty, King Michael."

LIBERAL JUDAISM GAINS FOOTHOLD IN INDIA

HARTFORD, CONN. JEWS ESTABLISH BUREAU OF HEBREW EDUCATION Dr. G. H. Cohen Appointed Head of New Organization

Centralization of the Hebrew Schools of Hartford was effected at a meeting Wednesday night at the Talmud Torah Hall on Pleasant Street. Dr. George H. Cohen, Assistant United States Attorney, was elected president of the combined organization.

There are four large Talmud Torahs or Hebrew schools and these will be conducted by the newly formed Hartford Bureau of Hebrew Education. Hitherto each school had its own board of directors and organization. Each raised money for operating expenses and each had its own system of teaching and grading; and inasmuch as they were started at different periods, there was little or no uniformity. Raising funds for operating expenses was found difficult.

The Hartford Bureau of Hebrew Education will immediately have a survey made as to the needs of the city in the way of Hebrew education. It is known that at present only 10 per cent of the Jewish children are receiving Hebrew instruction. The aim will be to reach the other 90 per cent. This will probably cause new schools to be started wherever the need is imperative. It is the intention of the Bureau of Hebrew Education to change its program by a membership roll and thus preclude the necessity of any campaigns for funds.

The Bureau will engage teachers for the different schools, establish a curriculum and system of grading. A finance committee will be created to take inventory of the assets and liabilities of the four schools and an educational committee will be appointed to direct the educational program for all the schools.

The officers are: President, Dr. George H. Cohen; vice-presidents, Eliezer Nisenzon, David Traub, Joseph Hoffenberg; treasurer, Samuel H. L. Goldman.

ABRAHAM HERMAN, HIAS PRESIDENT, STRESSES NEED OF IMMIGRANT AID WORK Entertained Before Leaving on European Tour

The Board of Directors and the National Advisory Council of the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society of America (Hias) tendered a Bon Voyage Dinner Tuesday night to Mr. Abraham Herman, the President of the organization, at the headquarters, 425 Lafayette Street, New York, prior to his departure for Europe.

Mr. Herman is going to Europe in connection with the new work undertaken by Hias with the Jewish Colonization Association and the Emigdirect which has for its purpose the settling of Jewish wanderers in South American Republics and other countries.

The dinner was attended by 145 members of the organization.

Mr. Herman will confer with the leaders of the Ica, the Emigdirect and of European Jewry generally and will particularly inspect the Hias European offices in Poland, Latvia, Lithuania and elsewhere. Mr. Herman will first go to Berlin, where the Hias European headquarters are located, and then proceed to Paris from which center he will begin his tour of inspection on which he will be accompanied by Dr. James Bernstein, the director of the Hias European work.

Mr. John L. Bernstein, Chairman of the Committee on Work in Foreign Countries, and former President of Hias, who was toastmaster, eulogized Mr. Herman for his service.

Other speakers were Albert Rosenblatt, Vice President of the society and President of the New York section of the United Synagogues of America; B. C. Wladick, manager of the "Jewish Daily Forward"; Adolph Baskin, President of the Amalgamated Bank; Jacob Wassil, Alexander Kahn, Paul Wladensky and Morris Weinberg.

According to the toast in his honor, Mr. Herman said:

"I am going to Europe because the time has arrived that we who are interested in the fate of the Jewish wanderers should know exactly what the situation is and in what manner the new work which is being done in connection with the Jewish Colonization Association and Emigdirect is being carried on. We have been in Europe now since 1922, and although I had hoped that the Jewish conditions in Europe would so shape themselves that Hias would be able to voluntarily and save Europe Jewry, wanderers and Jewish wanderers, work on its own program, this hope has not been realized. It has been found necessary and only to curtail our activities and to enlarge them. The demand came not only from the relatives of the Jewish wanderers everywhere but from the Jewish leaders in Europe themselves. And so, an agreement was entered into between Hias and the Emigdirect, which organization owes its existence to Hias, and the Jewish Colonization Association where-

by assistance will be afforded to Jews who desire to go to South American Republics and to other countries where they can settle and to which they can be admitted."

"The new work consists in gathering information as regards these new immigration countries and providing intending emigrants with complete and authoritative data as to conditions in these countries and what they can do there; affording emigrants all possible protection; opening in various European centers language courses, trade courses and instruction in agricultural pursuits; organizing in the new countries local immigrant aid societies and subsidizing and establishing immigrant homes at the various ports of arrival where these immigrants can be received and sheltered until they are settled. Furthermore, employment bureaus are to be established, loan banks created to provide these immigrants with means with which to engage at their trades, etc.

"This new work has now been functioning for a little more than two months and it is very encouraging to note that in various parts of Poland, Bessarabia, Latvia and France agricultural courses are given to intending emigrants. Some are working on farms, others in vineyards, so that they will be able to find work immediately when coming to the new country. Schools for the teaching of the languages of the countries to which these emigrants are going have been opened in Poland, Lithuania, Latvia and Roumania. In Lithuania, too, certain trade courses are already being given.

"So much for the countries of emigration. Now as to the countries of immigration.

"In Uruguay an immigrant home has already been opened at Montevideo, where also a loan and savings bank is being subsidized. Furthermore, an employment bureau has been established there.

"In Buenos Aires, Argentine, an employment bureau has been opened. Special women committees have been formed in the new countries and the names of all unaccompanied female immigrants are sent to these committees who meet the newcomers on their arrival.

"A Jewish-Spanish dictionary is now in the course of preparation.

"You will see from this that the new work has great possibilities and is likely to bear excellent fruit. When it is remembered that there are tens of thousands of Jewish refugees who already have left their native countries and who had hoped to come to America but have been unable to do so, the work which we have undertaken is of far-reaching consequences and must engage our closest attention and whole-hearted support.

"I hope that as a result of my investigation in Europe we shall be enabled to give to these unhappy brethren and sisters of ours the fullest measure of aid. We have been enabled to reunite thousands of families and we look to this new work to se-

JEWISH SECRETARIES FOR HEBREW NAMED BY JAFFA AND HAIFA MUNICIPALITIES

Jerusalem, July 10.—The Mayor of Jaffa in opening the meeting of the Municipal Council held last Thursday referred to the demand made by the Jewish members of the Council for the appointment of a Jewish Secretary to conduct the minutes of the meeting in Hebrew. He declared that he would not allow any discussion on this question because the demand was perfectly sound and justified by the existing laws of the country. He announced that he had already appointed a Jewish Secretary who will attend the meetings of the Council and conduct the minutes in Hebrew.

The Mayor's statement was accepted by the Council without opposition.

At the last meeting of the Haifa Municipal Council, the Council after prolonged discussion accepted the resolution introduced by the Jewish member of the Council, Mr. D. Cohen, to appoint a Secretary to conduct the minutes of the meetings in Hebrew.

HEBREW PLAYS IN PALESTINE NO LONGER REQUIRE ENGLISH TRANSLATION

Jerusalem, July 10.—The article in the Censorship Ordinance which requires the submission of an English translation of Hebrew plays will be deleted, the Attorney General, Mr. Norman Bentwich, told a delegation of the "Protectors of the Hebrew Language," who called upon him this week and asked him to remove this article from the Ordinance.

The Executive of the Keren Hatorah of Vienna has decided to arrange a tour for all interested for the purpose of visiting the important Yeshiboth of Eastern Europe. This suggestion was first made by Dr. Deutschlander, Director of the Keren Hatorah, at the Amsterdam Keren Hatorah Conference. Dr. Deutschlander has already inquired into the matter in Poland, Latvia and Lithuania, and it is now proposed that the tour should comprise Vienna, Pressburg, Cracow, Lublin, Warsaw, Vilna, Radun, Telch and Slobodka. At Cracow the tour will include participation at the foundation-stone laying of the Teachers' Academy of the Beth Jacob, and at Lublin the new Great Yeshibah will be inspected.

The notice of discontinuance of the two-hundred-thousand-dollar libel suit of Herman Bernstein against Henry Ford and the Dearborn Publishing Company was completed yesterday by lawyers representing both sides, and today Federal Judge Henry W. Goddard will be asked to sign it. The filing of the notice will end this action, which was begun on Aug. 18, 1925.

Twenty Jewish charitable organizations received from \$250 to \$5,000 in the will of the late Mrs. Scheffel, widow of Artur S. Scheffel, according to the accounting filed yesterday. The estate is valued at \$1,975,947.

2,000 NEW YORK ZIONISTS PAY TRIBUTE TO MEMORY OF DR. THEODORE HERZL

More than 2,000 New York Zionists assembled in Town Hall Tuesday evening to pay honor to the memory of Dr. Theodore Herzl, the founder of the modern Zionist Movement on the twenty-third anniversary of his death. The keynote address of the evening was delivered by Louis Lipsky, president of the Zionist Organization of America.

"For twenty-three years Zionists have assembled to mark Dr. Herzl's memorial day with the utterance of words designed to bring understanding and appreciation of the Great Liberator and to evoke inspiration to continue the labors he so magnificently began," Mr. Lipsky declared. "He began Zionist life with a vision that sustained him through a few long years of great devotion. With superhuman strength he struggled to bring the vision in contact with earthly realities. Whatever he had he sacrificed for its sake. When he was gathered unto his fathers, young in years, still rich in thought, the present which he had helped to make had content. He has left us an imperishable inheritance to bequeath to the children that come after us."

Dr. Schmarya Levin who is on a brief visit to this country, Mrs. Irma Lindheim, national president of Hadasah, Morris Rothenberg, chairman of the Executive Committee of the Keren Hayesod, and Maurice Samuel, author and lecturer, joined in paying honor to Dr. Herzl's memory in addresses that followed Mr. Lipsky's tribute. Cantor Israel Brie sang the memorial prayer.

Mr. Lipsky declared that Dr. Herzl's vision of a Jewish rejuvenation in Palestine was "a personal revelation." "An experience external to his own ordinary life," he declared, "set in motion subconscious racial processes which revealed to him, stark naked, unadorned, uncomplicated, a truth that had been slumbering for generations in the Jewish soul."

Speaking of the literary achievements of Dr. Herzl, Mr. Lipsky declared that "all else is being forgotten and the shrine at which we bow our heads in reverence is occupied by the translucent character of the Zionist leader, whose quality dominates not only these memorial meetings held throughout the world this month, but also the numerous perplexing problems of the Zionist movement."

"It was through Zionist service that he was transformed into the diplomat and leader," Mr. Lipsky said. "You do not see the feuilleton writer in the man who gave testimony before the Royal Immigration Commission in 1902. You do not see the social lion in the man who greeted the Kaiser at the Gate of David in Jerusalem. You do not see the playwright in the man who conferred with Von Plehve. You do not see the man of fastidious taste in him who invaded the Russian Zionist caucus to plead with an obdurate group to give him an opportunity to utilize Uganda in a grand Zionist maneuver. He had become the carrier of an everlasting racial responsibility."

Jewish colonization in Russia had the same moral and economic value as Jewish colonization in Palestine.

There are people who oppose the Jewish colonization movement in Russia, Mr. Ash continued, because they are afraid that if the Soviet Government were overthrown, there would be fresh pogroms against the Jews who had occupied the land, but they forgot that Jews who had learned to cultivate the fields, had learned also to defend themselves.

M. Pierre Lamaziere, the French author, who recently visited Palestine, said that the success of the Jewish colonization work in Palestine had convinced him of the great importance of agricultural colonization as such to the Jewish people. Judging from what he had seen in Palestine, he believed that the Jewish colonization work in Russia would contribute quite as much to the spiritual renaissance of the Jewish people.

M. Henri Torres said that Jewish colonization in Russia was transferring a large number of declassed Jews to productive work.

He welcomed just as much the revival of the Jewish people in Palestine. The reconstruction of Palestine is an essential part of the Jewish program. It is their duty, he said, to support all efforts and all movements directed towards bringing about a Jewish renaissance, whether in Palestine, or in Russia.

HIGH COMMISSIONER PLUMER RETURNING TO PALESTINE

London, July 14.—Field Marshal Lord Plumer, the High Commissioner for Palestine who is now on leave in London, has decided in consequence of the earthquake in Palestine to curtail his leave and he will depart for Palestine on July 29. Lord Plumer feels it an obligation to carry out first his undertaking to dedicate the Menin Gate Memorial, the ceremonies in connection with which have been fixed for July 24.

"Let us not squander that inheritance," Mr. Lipsky declared. He made the age-long ambition of the Jewish people a program of action to which nations have given their recognition and approval. He raised us, in thought, to be a nation among nations. the "Dearborn Independent" and the interview about me, attributed to Henry Ford and published in various newspapers.

"In 1920, upon my return from one of my European trips, I was shocked to learn that Henry Ford's 'Dearborn Independent' had started a series of vicious articles maligning the Jewish people. I could not believe that Henry Ford had sanctioned the publication of these articles. Before commenting on this, I telegraphed Mr. Ford on June 16th as follows:

"Upon my return from Europe my attention was called to articles denouncing the Jews published in the 'Dearborn Independent' with which you are identified. The articles in question are so malicious, filled with distortions of the truth, that I cannot imagine you sanctioned their publication. I am asked to comment on your 'Dearborn Independent' articles. Before doing so I should like to have a statement from you whom I always regarded as a broadminded, warm-hearted, humanitarian American. Such was my impression of you when we met on your Peace expedition.

Herman Bernstein."

"The answer came from the Dearborn Independent Publishing Company and read as follows:

"We have your telegram June sixteenth addressed to Mr. Ford. Its contents clearly indicate that you reached your conclusions and that any further comment we have to express in connection therewith would not influence your biased judgment thereon.

The "Dearborn Independent". "I endeavored to draw Mr. Ford's attention to the grave wrong committed in his name against my people, but all my efforts in that direction were of no avail.

"I then commenced to expose the absurdity and falsity of the material presented in the 'Dearborn Independent' articles, and also proved that the foundation upon which most of the articles were based—The Protocols of the Wise Men of Zion—consisted of a cruel and sinister forgery. With the valuable aid of Mr. Louis Marshall, I exposed the various stages entitled 'The History of a Lie'. Then the London Times made the expose complete by disclosing, beyond the shadow of a doubt, the original source of the forgery.

"It was only after I had published these exposes of the 'Dearborn Independent' articles and of the 'Protocols' that I was singled out for attack and was labelled by those who spoke in the name of Mr. Ford. To prove the falsity of the accusations against the Jewish people and myself I determined upon the only channel open to me. I instituted a suit for libel. I was fortunate in the cooperation of that distinguished, public-spirited jurist, Samuel Untermyer, who conducted this case with great vision and energy and most painstaking efforts.

JEWISH PRESS AT INTERNATIONAL PRESS EXHIBITION

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mail Service)

Berlin, July 13.—In connection with the projected Jewish section at the International press exhibition to be held in Cologne in 1928, Herr Josef Lin, Librarian of the Berlin Jewish Community and a member of the Organization Committee of the Exhibition, has told the J. T. A. here that it is intended that the Jewish section should give a complete picture of the life of the Jews as expressed in Jewish periodical publications. The section would endeavor to depict the Jewish press in its entirety from its beginnings to the present day. The entire press of the Jews embraces about 4,000 newspapers and periodicals published in thirty different languages, about 650 in Hebrew, 1,500 in Yiddish, 550 in German, 500 in English, 100 in French, 200 in Russian, 100 in Judo-Spanish, 50 in Polish, 50 in Hungarian, 50 in Dutch, 30 in Roumanian, 30 in Arabic, and 30 in Italian. These include dailies, weeklies and monthlies, party organs belonging to all movements and trade organs.

The Organization Committee, Herr Lin said, is non-partisan and is carrying out its work from the purely historical and scientific point of view.

A majority of Jewish members have been returned to the town councils of Kovel and Vladimir-Volinsk, polling for which took place yesterday. Over 90 per cent of the electors voted. The new Municipality of Kovel consists of 14 Jews, 9 Poles (3 Socialists, 2 Nationalists and 2 non-Partisans) and 2 Ukrainians. At Vladimir-Volinsk, the new Council consists of 14 Jews, 6 Poles (2 Socialists, 2 Democrats, one Nationalist and one non-Partisan) and 4 Ukrainians.

Many small stones from the Third Wall of Jerusalem have recently been sent to America at the request of subscribers here to the fund for the excavation of the Wall. The Palestine Department of Antiquities gave its authority for the stones to be sent out of the country.

Establishment of an alleged pro-Klan broadcasting station in Washington seems to be assured as a result of the action by the Radio Commission today in approving the sale of the good-will and equipment of Station WTCB, Brooklyn, N. Y., to the Independent Publishing Company, which prints and operates "The Fellowship Forum", a weekly newspaper devoted in large part to the furtherance of the principles and purposes of the Klan.

LIBERAL JUDAISM GAINS FOOTHOLD IN INDIA

R. Reuben, B.A., Principal of the Israelite High School, Bombay, who is a Hebrew scholar, and has made a deep study of Judaism, both Conservative and "Liberal." It is chiefly on her that the burden of expounding the principles of "Liberalism" to the members falls. She is assisted in this by Miss A. M. Chincholkar, another Hebrew scholar. The Union has on its roll some prominent members of the Bene Israelite community.

The movement is at present small and the membership is confined to the Bene Israelites; but considering the circumstances under which it has had to commence work it is regarded a success. The Sabbath services held by the Union every Saturday attract a large congregation. The holy-day services are also well attended. The services are conducted in Hebrew and English, and the Prayer-books issued by the "Liberal" Jewish Synagogue of London, are used. Members of the community who have no knowledge of English cannot at present take advantage of the services held by the Union, and the holding of supplementary services in Hebrew and Marathi is being considered. When this is done, it is hoped to interest most of the members of the community in the work of the Union. The services are, at present, held at the residence of Miss R. Reuben.

Though there is no Religion School attached to the Union, the members have formed a Study Circle for studying literature on "Liberal" Judaism and discussing its various aspects. The Union at present conducts a class for teaching Hebrew to the children of members, and it may be found necessary to develop this into a Religion School in future.
