NEW FRENCH CITIZENSHIP LAW BECOMES EFFECTIVE

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) Paris, August 17. - Greater unity

and homogeneity in the ranks of French Jewry are expected to result from the new French naturalization law which became effective yesterday.

According to the provisions of the new law, wide facilities are granted for the acquisition of French citizenship. Instead of the ten years residence prior to naturalization required by the former law, applicants need only show evidence of three years residence in the country. In special cases citizenship will be granted after one years residence.

It is expected that the majority of the considerable immigrant Jewish population in France will become citizens of the Republic. It is also expected that this new measure will tend to abolish the division existing between French and foreign Jews. Under the statutes of the kehillahs. educational and philanthropic Jewish organizations are open only to French Jews. For this reason the Russian Jewish group in Paris was recently compelled to form a separate Kehillah.

Preliminary skirmishes, foreshadowing the differences prevailing among the various groups attending the conference, took place at yesterday's unofficial meeting prior to the formal opening of the conference to-day.

The Arreican delegates opposed the inclusion of this point in the agenda. It was argued that a discussion on this subject would involve a debate on the question of the work of the relief organizations. It was also seen as a veiled attempt on the part of the Voelkists to attack the Zionists. Deputies Gruenbaum and Farbstein, who are participating in the conference, supported the view of the American delegates. The proposal was rejected by a majority vote, the preliminary conference deciding that the agenda include only a discussion on the legal disabilities affecting the economic position of the Jewish population.

Much time was consumed at the preliminary conference to inform the delegates on the purpose of the conference. Some of the American delegates proposed the creation of a new permanant organization of wide accope to include not only Jewish minority right questions but general Jewish welfare.

Dr. Stephen S. Wise, Jacob Fishman, Dr. A. Coralnick and Bernard G. Richards explained to the meeting that the purpose of the conference is to reorganize the Committee of Jewish Delegations which was established during the Peace Conference and which still continues to function, that it become more representative of the Jewish communities, leaving to the minorities themselves the right to decide how they (Continued on page 4)

POLICE STAGE RAIDS ON

JEWS IN HUNGARY TOWNS (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Budapest, August 17 .- What virtually amounted to anti-Jewish raids were carried out by the Hungarian police in the last few days in the towns and villages in Northern Hungary. The gendarmerie and police surrounded Jewish homes synagogues and arrested 391 persons on the charge of being aliens. Among those arrested are persons who have lived in Hungary for the past thirty years. The action of the police called forth a vigorous protest on the part of the Jewish population Deputies of the government parts have addressed appeals to the author- | SECRET ANTI-JEWISH ORDER ities to stop the anti-Jewish raids.

Budapest, August 17.-A statement ssued by the Hungarian State Police b-day denied that the raids made by the police in Northern Hungary had an anti-Jewish purpose. It was learned that the raids were conducted on the instructions issued by the Ministry of Interior. Homes and synagogues were entered in the search for aliens.

The Jewish community of Szerencz submitted a protest to the Ministry of the Interior against the raids, declaring that the police in their course molested the Jewish population and invaded the synagagues during prayer.

SCORES MISSIONARY PROPAGANDA

Discusses Budapest and Warsaw Conferences; Raises Question Whether Good-will is Not Used as Screen

A protest against the decision of | the International Missionary Council to increase conversion propaganda among the Jewish population in Europe, taken at the Budapest and Warsaw missionary congresses held under the chairmanship of Dr. John R. Mott, general secretary of the Young Men's Christian Association in New York, was expressed by Dr. Abram Simon of Washington, former president of the Central Conference of American Rabbis. In a communication to the Jewish Daily Bulletin, Rabbi Simon

"The article under the caption '40,000 Hungarian Jews embraced Christianity since the war' arouses deep interest and concern. I am not in a position to correct the accuracy of round numbers. In respect to the whole matter, however, permit me to indicate the following interesting

items.

writes:

"First: As a sample of the accuracy of the information given out at that famous Budapest conference let me quote the following from the Press-Chief of the conference. 'Our aims are to realize peaceful relations between Jews and Christians and to convert Jews to Christianity. Nothing is more characteristic for our method that many of our members are of the Jewish religion and that many of the most eminent figures amongst our. leaders are Chief Rabbis of high standing. Wherever our organization went, peace between Jews and Christians was brought about.

FORMED IN GREAT BRITAIN

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, August 17-An attempt to transplant the spirit of the Ku Klux Klan into Great Britain is being made by a group of Britishers who have established a distinctly anti-Jewish which is to be known as the White Knights of Britain.

The order will be secret and accord-

ing to the program of the promoters its members must prove that their parents and grand-parents were of British blood, must declare they be-feve that "fews are a menace to Christian civilization" and their belief in God in the Christian sense and their belief in the supremacy of the white race

Some of the papers featured an interview with Lucien Wolf who termed the plan of the order "silly." English Jews do not regard the order as a menace but rather as a joke as no real anti-Semitic feeling exists in Great Britain, it is asserted.

"Second: For another side light permit me to quote a letter of April 7th from a minister in Budapest It is not popular teaching anymore to convert Jews in Anti-Semitic Budzpest, and I learned from many sources that a number of Baptised Jews are seeking re-admission to Judaism. A young Scottish pastor has started a similar mission in Cluz (Kolozvar) Transylvanian Roumania, but with little success. Would that time were ripe for liberal Judaism to be taught and preached in these countries to save many from a forlorn position."
"Third: We must remember that

because of the duress and the agony following the close of the war many Jews found it expedient to accept formally the Christian religion. Since the war and since conditions are growing more stable a new phenomenon of 20th century Marranoism has made its appearance. We must recall that the Jewish papers have to publish the list of converts because, under the Hungarian law, the people are taxed according to their denominational label, and that they have to have some label or other.

"Fourth: In view of the leadership on the part of Dr. John R. Mott of the International Missionary movement, I wonder with what intellectual and moral consistency the Jewish people can continue the financial support of the Young Men's Christian Association of which Dr. Mott is general secretary

"Fifth: This whole movement sounds a warning to us Jewish people to be on our guard lest good will be used as a screen to hide the mask of conversion. At the same time it should arouse the Jewish people all over the world to help their brethren remain true to their ancestral faith," Dr. Simon concludes

THREATENS RIOT IF IRISH MOTION PICTURE | YIDDISH COLUMN APPEARS IN IS NOT WITHDRAWN

rish Newspaper Publishes Articles Attacking Jewish Producers of Film It Terms Objectionable

A threat of a riot against the movng picture, "The Callahans and the Murphys," a Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer broduction in several New York moion piture theatres was made by the "Irish World," weekly newspaper published in New York, in its issue which will appear on Saturday, Aug-

Irish individuals and societies have for the past few weeks been carrying on an agitation for the withdrawal by the Metro-Goldwyn of the picture which it is claimed is offensive to the Irish. The objectionable features of the picture are said to by scenes in which Mrs. Callahan and Mrs. Murphy are shown in a beer drinking contest in the course of which they succeed in disposing of the entire contents of a keg. The scene takes place at a picnic and is followed by a free-forall fist fight. The other objectionable feature in the film is said to be a close up of Marie Dressler, who

acts the part of Mrs. Callahan.

Prior to the release of the film the Metro-Goldwyn company declared that it had obtained the endorsement of Cathelic organizations and an officer of the Daughters of Erin, an Irish women's organization. It was stated that the amount of \$500,000 was involved in the production. When further objections were raised, Metro-Goldwyn company offered tο revise the film in accordance with the suggestions of the "Irish World." Last Monday afternoon the revised version was shown in one of Loew's theatres before Owen Bohan, Assistant District Attorney, and prominent Catholic priests of the New York Diocesic and a representative of the "Irish World."

Reporting on this revised version the "Irish World" says:

"While much of the beer-drinking scene has been 'cut,' the facial distortions of Marie Dressler remain in evidence throughout the film. These alone are sufficient to condemn the production. They are an insult to every conception of Irish woman-

a riot before the end of the week." The controversy with the Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Corporation gave the Irish World ground for publishing an article in the current issue entitled "Plain Words to Movie Directors." it which it attacks what it terms "the Jewish motion picture pro-

ducers," stating:
"Conflicting reports are coming from the camp of the enemy, in which the Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Corporation of 1340 Broadway, New York City, and Warner Brothers, 1600 Broadway, New York City, and the Loew companies in general, are conspicuous among the Jew organizations that have aroused Irish indignation all over the country by the indepent liberties they have presumed to take with the modesty and grace of Irish womanhood. It is a horrible thing to connect the low-class men. of which some of these organizations are a collective type, even in the mind, with the glory of Irish feminine innocence and beauty. To think of these dirty Orientals presuming to maul and paw our women in public. to hold them up to ridicule in moving pictures, to pick out German and Jew actresses, brutal in countenance and in manners and to give them the names of women honored in Irish history, to place Irish girls in an atmosphere of swinish filth such as would occur only to a producing director of the most ignorant and ruffianly type, is insupportable to any decent Irishman. It will arouse repercussions of which these dull men will do well to take heed. The sort of men who go round taking liberties with women who live in a different world from theirs and who have no use for them, are courting a speedy disaster. We do not know what there is about the Loews and the Warners that is going to save them from Irish indignation if they do not take their dirty hands away from the mothers and the sisters and the daughters of

Trishmen. "If Marcus Loew and Abraham or Jacob or Izzy Warner want to make money by holding women up to indecent laughter let them confine their showmen's talents to the Rebeccas and the Marthas of their own families. If they want filth and stupidity and indecency they needn't go out of the Chetto to find it. If they want grotesque figures, Hester Street is full of them. and Marcus Loew is well acquainted with it. But they are not meing to put their filthy hands on Irish women any more, or if they do they will do it at their peril. We at any time afterwards."

CHRISTIAN SCIENCE MONITOR

The column appears in the section, "The Home Forum," which frequently prints trans-lations of the articles in languages other than English.

The article, entitled "Courage in the Crisis" advocates the principles of Christian Science and urges the reader to acquaint himself with the work. "Science and Health with a Key to the Scriptures," the work of the founder of Christian Science, Mary Baker Eddy

The "Irish World" then outlines the following plan of campaign for the withdrawal of the picture.

"Individual and isolated protests

will have little effect.

"In every town, city or section where 'The Callahans and the Murphys' is advertised for showing, a committee or delegation should wait upon the mayor or whatever other official has charge of theatrical performances and, as American citizens of Irish birth or parentage, demand that permission for the showing of the film be refused.

"The same committee should also visit the management of the theatre and tell him that the showing of 'The Callahans and the Murphys' will be a deliberate insult to his patrons.

"The point to make clear to theatre managers is that it is not necessary for him to show this picture. He has no excuse for insisting upon its exhibition. He can easily secure another picture to take its place.

"Let every theatrical manager be made clearly to understand that, if he insists upon showing this vile caricature of an Irish woman, he, at least. cannot insist upon the Irish people in his neighborhood attending his theatre either during the performance or
