AZOV REGION LAND SURVEY CONCLUDED BY SOVIET COM-MISSION: DATA EXAMINED

Available Through Drainage for Jewish Settlement

(Lewish Telegraphic Agency)

Moscow, Nov. 9 .- The survey of the Azov Sca region, inaugurated by the Soviet authorities to ascertain the possibilities for Jewish land settlement there, has been concluded.

The data obtained by the survey is now being examined with a view to ascertaining the possibilities of draining the swampy stretch of half a million desiatin land. Eighty specialists with 100 assistants including engineers, topographers, hydro-technicians and geologists, made the survey.

The manifesto continues: "For these reasons we will fight any attempt to modify the numerus clausus following the instinct of self-preservation. We appeal to the entire Hungarian public to support us because we are fighting for Christian Hungarian life."

PLUMER CONFERS TITLE ON TRANSJORDANIAN RULER (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Amman, Transfordania, Nov. 9. Emir Abdullah, ruler of Transjordania, was honored by the British Government today when Lord Plumer, High Commissioner of Palestine, conferred upon him the title Knight Commander of the Order of St. Michael and St.

SALONICA UNIVERSITY WILL HAVE JEWISH HISTORY CHAIR (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Salonica, Nov. 9 .- A chair for the study of Jewish history will be established at the University of Salonica by a decision of the Greek Ministry of Education.

The Ministry announced that Dr. Lazare Belleli, Greek Jewish scholar, will be appointed to head this department. Dr. Belleli is an authority on Arabo-Spanish period.

Warsaw, Nov. 9 .- One hundred and twenty seven Jewish communities in-Posen and Pomerania, the two provinces which were taken from Germany following the World war and incorporated in the new Polish Republic. have disappeared. Due to the emigration of the Jewish population from the P sen and Pomeranian towns the kchillahs have been liquidated. emigration was due to economic pressure and the new political situation.

An effort is now being made by Chief Rabbi Freimann of Posen to preserve the tombstones of the Jewish cemeteries which constitute valuable records of the history of the Jewish communities in this region.

HUNGARIAN ANTI-SEMITES OBJECT TO 'ABIE'S IRISH ROSE' (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Budapest, Nov. 9 .- The presentation of "Abie's Irish Rose," the play which with its six year run on Broadway exceeded the record of all productions in New York, has encountered difficulties in Hungary's capital.

The play is scheduled to open at the Metropolitan Theatre here. The police, having been informed of the intention of anti-Semitic students to demonstrate against the performance because it de-picts Jews in what they regard as a favorable light, announced that special guard will be placed around the theatre on the opening night. In attacking the play the anti-Semitic press asserts that Ann Nichols, the author of the play, is a Jewess.

UKRAINIAN PAPER REBUKES ASCH, NOTED AUTHOR, FOR HONORING SCHWARTZBARD (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Lemberg, Nov. 9. - Sholom Asch, well known Jewish novelist, was criticized by the "Dillo," organ of Ukrainian opinion in Eastern Galicia, in connection with the Schwartzbard trial.

The paper expresses astonishment that Mr. Asch attended a banquet in Paris at which it alleges Schwartzbard was the guest of honor. "Jewish so-lidarity is indeed great," the paper writes, "when such a well known writer sig on the highway in 1920. New Season of Jewish Activities Begins in Chicago; Community's Achievements Described

(By Our Chicago Correspondent)

Chicago, Nov. 7. — Chicago, the second largest Jewish community in the United States, has started this season's communal activities following the holding of the Constructive Relief Conference of the United Jewish Campaien here the end of October.

The Jewish Charities of Chicago has an annual budget of more than \$1,500 .-000 and a five-year building program of \$3,500,000 is now under way. The tremendous scope of the work done by the charities may be appreciated by perusal of a list of the leading institutions under the federation, some of which are: The Michael Reese Hosnital founded in 1878 and today one of the finest in the country; Mt. Sinai Hospital, built for Orthodox Jews who observe Kosher dietry laws; the Michael Reese Dispensary: the Jewish Social Service Bureau: the Infants' Aid Society; the Home for Aged Jews; the Chicago-Winfield Tuberculosis Sanitarium; the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society; the Jewish Free Employment Bureau; the Jewish Industrial Shops; the Chicago Home for Jewish Orphans; the Marks Nathan Orphan Home; the Dorothy Kahn Home for Crippled Children; the Aid Association for Incurable Jews and the Orthodox Home for Aged Jews. The lewish Charities of Chicago also contributes to the support of the Lying-Inn Hospital of Chicago, the Chicago Section, Council of Jewish Women; the Northwest Free Burial Society, the Leo A. Levi Memorial Hospital and the Hillel Foundation.

In addition, Chicago Jews have donated millions of dollars to the Red Cross and other relief organizations.

Outstanding in the Jewish and non-scetarian philanthropic endeavors is Julius Rosenwald, chairman of the board of directors of Sears Roebuck and Company, whose benefactions have made him an international figure. Mr. Rosenwald has given away millions of dollars. He has given freely of his time and money not only to Jewish but to non-fewish charities as well. He has given \$3,000,000 for an Industrial Museum to be erected in Chicago.

There are more than 125 Jewish consergations in the city, of which about 100 are orthodox. The rest are either conservative or reform. Chicago has some of the most beautiful synagogues and temples in America and plans have just been completed for two more. In connection with many of the temples, there are attached social and educational centers.

Among Chicago's outstanding Jewish leaders in the educational activities of the city are Professor Albert A. Michelson, world famed physicist, or the University of Chicago; Dr. Berthold Laufer of the Field Museum; Dr. Edward Sapir of the University of Chicago, noted anthropologist; Prof. Ernst Freund, leading authority on constitutional law, and Dr. Julius Stieglitz, professor of chemistry at the University of Chicago.

The principal Jewish education institutions in the city are the Hebrew theological College under the direction of Rabbi Saul Silber; the Jewish People's Institute, directed by Philip L. Seman and the College of Jewish Studies now affiliated with the University of Chicago, under the direction of Dr. Alexander Dushkin. In addition, there are hundreds of Talmud

In the field of education again the name of Julius Rosenwald is a leading one. Besides contributing liberally to the Jewish People's Institute, he has given several millions of dollars to the University of Chicago, of which he is a trustee.

There are four Jewish daily papers published in Chicago—The Daily Jewish Crossist Courier; the Daily Jewish Press; the Daily Jewish Forward, and the Jewish Daily Freiheit. There also are four Anglo-Jewish weeklits—The Chicago Israelite, the Chicago Chronicle, the Reform Advocate and the Sentinel.

In music and art, this city boasts of many Jews of prominence. The late Fannie Bloomfield Zeisler was recognized as the world's greatest woman pianist. Giorgio Polacco, director of the Chicago Civic Opera company; Rosa Raisa, Giacomo Rimini, her husband, and Irene Pavloska, operatic stars, are all Jewish. The summer opera season at Ravinia Park, famous the world over, owes its great success to its director and financial underwriter, Louis Eckstein, Jewish philanthropist. Leopold Godowsky, famous pianist; Adolph Muhlmann, noted vocal instructor; Alexander Zukovsky, second concertmeister of the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, and Herman Devries and Maurice Rosenfeld, noted music critics, are Jews. Aong the Jewish authors of note who began their careers in Chicago, some of them still being here, are Edna Ferber, Dr. Morris Fishbein, editor of the Journal of the American Medical Association; Ben Hecht, Jack Lait and Lester Cohen.

In the business world, large firms owned or controlled by Jews have become internationally famous.

Jewish real estate men have played an important part in the vast expansion that Chicago has undergone in recent years. Among the foremost builders in that field are Edward Dato, of Krenn and Dato, who handle the interests of Mrs. Edith Rockefeller McCormick; Mark Levy of Mark Levy & Bro, and B. F. Lindheimer. One of the leading Jews in the insurance business is Jacob Loeb, head of the lewish People's Institute.

In the theatrical business Balaban and Katz, Lubliner and Trinz, Jones, Linnick and Schaefer, Marx Brothers and Asche Brothers are the leaders. In professional life, Jews have time and again demonstrated their ability. Dr. Issac A. Abt, noted child specialist who was recently presented a Legion of Honor decoration by the French government, and Dr. Joseph DeLee obstetrician and founder of the Chicago Lying-In hospital, are Jews who have achieved an international reputation.

A large number of Chicago Jews are among the city's leading layers. Adolf Kraus, for twenty years grand president of the International Order of Binai Brith, and Lessing Rosenthal are typical of the high calibre of Jewish lawyers here.

In the advertising world, the outstanding figure is Albert D. Lasker, bead of Lord and Thomas and Logan, and former chairman of the United States shipping board. Among the leading architects we find Samuel Alschuler.
