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DAILY EXPRESS' RENEWS ATTACK ON ZIONISM; CRIT- ICIZES AMERICAN JEWS

**Says American Jews Don't Send
Money They Promised**
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, Jan. 27.—The occasion of the address of Col. Leopold H. Amery, British Colonial Secretary, delivered in Ottawa to a congregation of American and Canadian Zionists, was utilized by the "London Daily Express," anti-Zionist paper, to renew its attack on Zionism.

Declaring the whole enterprise to be a failure, the "Express" declares that American Jews are not sending the money they had promised to Palestine and that the income of the Palestine government is decreasing, resulting in stagnation of trade. The paper also expresses doubt of the prospects for the development of the Dead Sea concession.

CRIMEA JEWSH FARMERS ASK GOVERNMENT TO DIS- SOLVE CHALUZIM COLONY

Moscow, Jan. 27.—A request to the Soviet Government to disband the colony: Tel Chai, established and worked by Chaluzim, Zionist youth preparing to take up farming in Palestine, was directed by Jewish farmers of Crimea.

Three members of the administrative council of the colony were recently sentenced by the supreme court for alleged anti-revolutionary activities. The request to disband the colony was voted upon at a general meeting of the farmers after they had listened to a report of a member of the Yevsektzia, Lipsky, concerning the contra-revolutionary activities of the pioneer organization, Hehalutz. The Tel Chai colony is to be transformed into a purely communist enterprise.

JEWSH REVOLUTIONARY'S LIFE SOVIET FILM SUBJECT

Riga, Jan. 27.—The life of Hirsch Lekert, Jewish workman of Vilna and one of the heroes of the Russian revolutionary movement, who assassinated the Czarist governor general and was hanged for the act, is made the subject of a moving picture produced by the Communist government.

The film is the first of a series of what is termed Jewish revolutionary pictures prepared for propaganda purposes among the Jewish population. The film will have its first showing in Moscow soon.

COHEN LINARU, ROUMANIAN JEW, BEQUEATHES OVER \$2,000,000 TO ZIONIST FUND

**'If I Do Not, Who Will?' Is Testator's
Argument**
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Bucharest, Jan. 27.—The largest sum ever bequeathed to the Keren Hayesod, the colonizing fund of the Zionist Organization, was left by Mr. Cohen Linaru, president of the Sephardic Jewish community of Bucharest, it was learned today when the will was filed for probate. The will bequeaths property valued at ten million lei (over \$2,000,000) to the Keren Hayesod.

The will names the Board of Directors of the Keren Hayesod and the Roumanian delegate of the Keren Hayesod headquarters in London as the trustees of the fund. Should the Roumanian Government question the legality of the bequest because the Keren Hayesod is not recognized in Roumania as a judicial body, "I declare the British Government to be the legatee of the fund," the will provides.

The contents of the will caused considerable surprise in Roumania's capital: the testator never having been affiliated with the Zionist Organization or having contributed to Zionist funds.

The testament begins with the motto of Hillel the Sage, "Im Ein Ani Li, Mi Li?" (If I do not for myself, who will?)

The testator suggests that the Keren Hayesod buy land to be distributed to Jewish workers, preferably Sephardim, with the sum bequeathed.

VORONOFF CALLED TO TURKEY TO IMPROVE BREED OF SHEEP THROUGH GLAND GRAFTING

Paris, Jan. 27.—Dr. Serge Voronoff, Russian Jewish scientist, will proceed to Turkey at the request of Turkey's dictator, Mustapha Kemal Pasha, to introduce his method of gland grafting in the improvement of the breed of sheep.

Dr. Voronoff, has been experimenting with the grafting of glands in sheep and has found that the rejuvenated sheep produce better stock. From Turkey Dr. Voronoff intends to go to Syria and Palestine.

Dr. Serge Voronoff is the son of a so-called "Nicholas soldier." During the reign of Nicholas I in Russia Jewish children were kidnapped and drafted into life service in the Czar's army. They were known as "Nicholas

LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL FOR PALESTINE PLANNED BY EN- GLAND, NEW RUMOR CLAIMS

According to this information, a draft of the new proposal to assure representation of Palestine's population in the government work has been prepared by the Colonial Office and has been forwarded to High Commissioner, Lord Plumer, who is to offer it shortly to Arab and Jewish leaders.

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ANGLO-JEWISH M.P.'S MAY VOTE ON CHRISTIAN PRAYER BOOK CHANGE. JEWISH BOARD HOLDS

(J. T. A. Hall Service)

London, Jan. 25.—A motion "that the Board regrets the participation in the Prayer Book division in the House of Commons of members of Parliament of Jewish faith," was put before today's meeting of the Jewish Board of Deputies by M. J. Landa. On a vote the motion was defeated.

"We are greatly pained," Mr. Landa said, "by remarks which are made outside our community concerning our religion and we should be the last people to participate in a division which is purely Christian and of a religious nature. If the Prayer Book were lost by two votes, when as in this case, there were only two Jewish votes against it, it would have opened a very serious criticism against the Jewish members of Parliament in particular and the community in general."

Major Salomon, M.P., pointed out in reply that the Archbishop of Canterbury, as well as the Home Secretary, Sir William Joynson-Hicks had pointed out to the members of both Houses that they were sent there not as representatives of any religious denomination but of their constituencies and as such they should record their votes on this particular question. If questions of such a nature should be waved aside by the Jewish members of Parliament it would not help much to

CANADA ZIONISTS WILL HAVE JOINT DRIVE FOR KEREN HAYESOD AND J.N.F. Quota of \$500,000 Announced at Dinner to Lipsky and Freiman (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Montreal, Jan. 27.—A joint campaign for \$500,000 for the Jewish National Fund and the Keren Hayesod will be launched in Canada in March, according to an announcement made last night at a dinner given in honor of Louis Lipsky, president of the Zionist Organization of America, and A. J. Freiman, president of the Canadian Zionist Organization. The dinner was given by the National Council of the Canadian Zionist Organization at the Mount Royal Hotel.

Dr. Schmarya Levin will come to Canada to tour the country in the interest of the campaign which will open in Montreal, it was announced. Mrs. A. J. Freiman, president of the Canadian Hadassah, A. Levin, Dominion Chairman of the Keren Hayesod and R. A. Darwin, Dominion Chairman of the Jewish National Fund, have been elected to head the joint campaign.

Mr. Freiman, in his address, declared that American Zionists can have full confidence in the policy of the British Government. The experience of Canadians has proved that though Great Britain may appear slow in her procedure, the Government will carry out her pledge regarding Palestine. After listening to the statement of the Right Honorable L. C. M. S. Amery, British Secretary of State for Dominions, there is no longer any doubt of the sincerity and intentions of the British Government with regard to the final outcome of our work in Palestine. Mr. Freiman said.

ROSENWALD GIVES \$50,000 FOR INDUSTRIAL ARTS SCHOOL (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Chicago, Ill., Jan. 27.—A contribution of \$50,000 was made by Julius Rosenwald toward the fund raised to establish an industrial arts school in Chicago.

The fund of \$283,000 was fully subscribed, according to the announcement of Col. William Nelson Pelouze, president of the Association of Arts and Industries.

"The school will train American designers for service in different industries, including furniture, jewelry, printing, ceramics, textiles, architectural modeling, wall paper, interior decorating and costume designing," Col. Pelouze announced.

HOUSE COMMITTEE ADOPTS JOHNSON DEPORTATION BILL WITH SEVERE CLAUSES Executive Session to Consider Legislation Uniting Separated Families (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Washington, Jan. 27.—The House Immigration Committee, on a motion of Congressman Dickstein of New York, yesterday decided to begin consideration of legislation for uniting separated families or aliens now in the United States on the thirty-first of this month, when the Committee will go into executive session for this purpose.

According to this decision, no public hearings will be held as heretofore. Instead, the committee will forthwith start acting on the proposed legislation itself. Congressman Dickstein expressed satisfaction with this decision, declaring the question of the separation of families has been thoroughly discussed before and to hold public hearings again would only waste valuable time and thus endanger action before adjournment.

At its meeting yesterday the Committee also voted to favorably report Congressman Johnson's deportation bill. Congressman Dickstein made a strong fight against the most objectionable features of the bill, particularly that clause removing the limitation period for deportation of aliens convicted of any offense committed after enactment of the bill involving an imprisonment sentence of one year or more. The Committee decided to retain this provision and Congressman Dickstein succeeded only in obtaining a reduction of the limitation period from 7 to 5 years for certain deportations on other grounds. Congressman Dickstein also attacked the first mentioned ground of deportation because it would permit deportation for any offense, even a minor one, where the alien, perhaps because of poverty, could not defend himself and is given a sentence of one year or more. Under the present law only crimes involving moral turpitude have a limitation period of three years for deportation.

Congressman Dickstein pointed out that the proposed drastic change will encourage the blackmail of innocent aliens and destroy families after they have been in this country for many years. He also opposed the clause calling for the deportation of persons of "psychopathic inferiority" which is such a vague clause, he said, that anyone could be deported since this phrase has never been satisfactorily defined.

The bill will be formally filed in the House within the next few days. Congressman Dickstein obtained leave to file a minority report which in all probability will be signed also by Congressman Sabath, Goldner and McGregor.

Washington, Jan. 27.—The Senate Committee on Immigration ordered a favorable report on the Senate joint resolution introduced by Senator Copeland.

Polish Jewry Divided in Three Camps for Forthcoming Elections (By our Warsaw correspondent)

Warsaw, Jan. 7.—Jewish voters in Poland will go to the polls in the February elections of the third Polish Sejm in divided ranks. The election campaign having reached its height, finds the forces concentrated around to conceptions, one advocating support for the bloc of national minorities, the other for what is termed a Jewish bloc composed of the Orthodox Agudath Israel, the Jewish People's Party (Folkists), and the Central Federation of Jewish Small Traders.

This applies only to Congress Poland. In Galicia, a separate Jewish list supported by the majority of local Zionists, under Dr. Leon Reich, will be presented.

A statement issued by the Jewish bloc in Congress Poland declares:

"The approaching election has again confronted the Jewish population of Poland with the question of a national representation, which will be capable of fighting for the still unrealized Jewish national, religious, citizenship, social and economic equality of rights, and should in numbers be sufficiently strong to be reckoned with. The election constituencies and the election ordinance have been so tendentiously arranged that the Jews, even if they are united, cannot secure even half the representation to which they are entitled by their numerical proportion in the country. Even the most favorable election ordinance would not improve matters very much because as a non-territorial minority, we must always be in an unfavorable position so long as there is no national election curie, which is the only guarantee of real equality of rights in the elections. As there is no Jewish national curie, it is essential in the Jewish national interest to form a united bloc of all the Jewish political parties and economic organizations, or at least of the bourgeois organizations in order partly to diminish the danger of the pres-

entended to permit wives and minor children of alien-declarants to enter the United States as nonquota immigrants.

The bill as reported is amended from the original so as to omit husband's. It applies to declarants between July 1, 1921 and July 1, 1924 and children under sixteen. Application must be made within a year after passage of the act.

The committee also ordered a favorable report on a bill introduced by Senator Reid, Republican of Pennsylvania, increasing the salaries of immigrant inspectors, and another bill by Senator Reid intended to amend the law of 1924 so as to make more strict the admission of teachers from foreign countries.

ent election ordinance. It was therefore the duty of the Jewish political parties and economic organizations to come to an understanding for the establishment of a united Jewish front. One group, unfortunately, ignored this need and without asking any one concluded on its own account an agreement with individual groups of the territorial minorities, who have entirely different interests and aspirations from the Jewish minority. Realizing the gravity of the position and the danger threatening the interests of the Jewish population in Poland, we have formed a general Jewish national election bloc. Invitations were sent to all the Jewish parties, but none of the Zionist leaders even replied to the invitation. The doors of the bloc remain open, nevertheless, for all who desire victory for the Jewish cause.

"The general Jewish National election bloc stands on the basis that the Jews in Poland ought to conduct their own Jewish policy and cannot, especially in the present political moment join with elements with whom it is not in the Jewish interest to join in their policy and tactics. The so-called minorities bloc has in addition proved itself unwearable because the majority of the Ukrainians and White Russians, as well as the German Labor Party, have refused to join it, and it cannot therefore give its Jewish participants even those minimum benefits which the Minorities' lists gave them in the elections of 1922 and can only result in the Jewish votes cast for it being lost and spoiling the chances of Jewish candidates.

"The new Sejm will be called upon to change the Constitution and the basis of the election ordinance. The Polish reactionaries are therefore making efforts to obtain such a majority in the new Sejm to enable them to make these changes in the way they wish and in opposition to the interests of the masses and especially of the Jewish national minority. The new Sejm will also have to solve a large number of burning economic problems affecting the trade of the country and therefore primarily the Jews. It is accordingly necessary that the Jewish population should have a proportionate representation in the Sejm. The success of our fight for national rights and economic opportunities demands that we should enter into close contact with the Polish Democratic groups which stand out against reaction and in that way prepare for the realization of the Constitution. The example of Jewish emancipation in Western Europe shows us that it was the victory of democracy which made it possible. The general Jewish National bloc therefore appeals to the Jewish masses to support it in its fight for the realization of the Jewish National program in Poland," the statement concludes.

Tribute was paid Mrs. Solomon in recognition of her contribution to the cause of Jewish women.

A special program was arranged by the Chicago Council Section in celebration of Mrs. Solomon's seventieth birthday. Mrs. Samuel Alschuler, president of the Section, and former National Chairman of the Department of Social Service, directed the program for this occasion.

Three holidays, the Jewish Arbor Day, Lincoln's Birthday, and Washington's Birthday, occurring in February, will be celebrated by Jewish Centers and Y.M.H.A.'s. The Jewish Welfare Board is cooperating with the associations in planning programs celebrating these holidays. Jewish Arbor Day (Chametz) will be observed February 6.

The Jewish Welfare Board has issued a bulletin for Lincoln's Birthday and for Washington's Birthday, containing suggested programs, selections in prose and verse suitable for use in programs.

For the Jewish holiday, the Board has furnished material which includes a statement of the significance of the festival, a series of "Questions and Answers" relating to it, a selected list of plays, suggestions for tableaux, and readings and songs appropriate to the occasion.

The same conditions, Deputy Gruenbaum said, exist today. There had been no change in the Election Ordinance. If the Jews stood alone they would only be able to secure a negligible number with

UNMASKING OF KLAN SHOWS IT HAS LOST ITS INFLUENCE

"The unmasking of the Klan, which will take place on Washington's Birthday, is welcome news whatever its significance or explanation," writes the New York "Herald Tribune" in an editorial on Friday. "The hood as a symbol of intolerance and terrorism, deserves its malodorous reputation. With the action of the Klan it will lose its last remnant of popular sanction. Good—superlatively good—ridiculous!"

"But we cannot persuade ourselves that this excellent reform will rehabilitate the Klan, or that it marks anything in the fortunes of that discredited order except consciousness of defeat and desecration. The hood, in all probability, has constituted the Klan's greatest attraction in the eyes of the kind of persons from whom it recruits its membership. Its implied promise of power without responsibility, of the satisfaction of savage impulse without discovery, makes a powerful appeal to insolent natures and undoubtedly helped to build the Klan up to the peak it attained only a few short years ago. Its leaders now would not abandon it if they had the power to forestall the anti-Klan legislation which an aroused public opinion is threatening."

"In other words, the Klan, except in a few widely separated sections where its grip, though relaxing, is still maintained, is virtually impotent; and hence is making haste to be good. And in being good, such is the irony of fate that dogs an organization founded on race and religious prejudice, it is further weakening itself. We can foresee no future spectacle of fire-eating native white Protestants 100 per centers to join at \$10 a head an order whose only remaining inducements are the nightgown uniform and an opportunity to gnash the teeth in chorals at the mention of Al Smith."

"It may be that Emperor Hiram Evans endorses the notion that the Klan, by putting its house in order at this time, will find itself in a stronger position to exert some influence on the Presidential campaign. If so, he is laboring under a delusion. Except as one of a host of fraternal orders based on dark odds and fancy ritual, the Klan, we should say, is through."

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PALESTINE FRUIT EXPORT REGULATIONS ROUSE PROTEST

Jafo, Jan. 26.—The new regulations on fruit export published by the authorities last week have caused much dissatisfaction among the orange merchants here and several protest meetings have been held.

Resolutions of protest have been sent to the High Commissioner and the District Commissioner. A special commission has been elected by the fruit exporters to negotiate with the Government to secure the amendment of the regulations, particularly in regard to the article providing for the payment of an inspection fee of 1 mil per case. The merchants intend stopping all exports if their demands are not granted.
