INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS CONGRESS TAKES NO ACTION ON EXCLUSION OF ROUMANIANS

Majority Votes Not to Discuss
English Motion After Stormy
Debate

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Paris, Aug. 16.—The International Congress of student organizations, which opened here yesterday, decided by a majority vote, after a stormy discussion, not to take any action on the motion of the delegation of British students to exclude the Roumanian Students' Federation from the organization because of their policy of anti-Semitic violence.

The motion to dismiss action, couched in the form of a resolution that the students congress is not to deal with "international questions" was advocated by the Roumanian delegation and supported by the Polish and French delegations.

When the matter was brought up in the open session it was at first referred to a special commission where the English delegation presented its facts and made the argument. The Roumanian students were represented on the commission by M. Romaneski.

AUSTRIAN JEWS EXTEND FELICITATIONS TO PRESIDENT HAINISCH ON 70th BIRTHDAY

Regard Him as Friend of Liberal
Thought Despite Party Affiliation

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Vienna, Aug. 16. — Delegations of leading Jewish organizations and institutions in the Republic of Austria called on President Hainisch yesterday to congratulate him on the occasion of his seventieth birthday.

Notwithstanding his affiliation with the Deutschnazionale party, President Hainisch is held in high respect and affection by Austrian Jews, having acted on many occasions as a friend of the cause of Jewish emancipation and of liberal thought. The President is said to be well versed on complicated Jewish questions and maintains close social contact with leading Jewish families in Vienna.

Recently President Hainisch was quoted as having said jocularly that "the anti-Semites have enlisted me into the Jewish family" because Mrs. Hainisch is of Jewish origin. "I am a liberty-loving democrat," he then observed.

ADDITIONAL LARGE AREA FOR JEWISH COLONIZATION IN CRIMEA ALLOTTED BY SOVIET GOVERNMENT

Stretch of 109,000 Hectares to Provide Land for 15,000 Jewish Families;
Crimean Body to Submit Plan Within Three Months

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Moscow, Aug. 16.—Jewish colonization work in Crimea, for which a sufficient sum will be made available through the \$10,000,000 Rosenwald fund, was given further impetus and opportunity by the decision of the All-Russian Zik, the Central Executive Committee, to allot an additional area in Crimea of 109,000 hectares where 15,000 Jewish families may be settled as farmers.

Such land in the area as is now unsuitable for colonization will be ameliorated for vineyards and tobacco growing. A plan for the amelioration and land distribution is to be furnished by the Comzet, the government department for settling Jews on the land, within the next three months.

It was stated that the land grants will be made to the Jewish settlers after the needs of the local peasants will be met completely. Should the land in Crimea be insufficient, the remainder is to be found elsewhere. (109,000 hectares equals approximately 272,500 acres.)

Moscow, Aug. 16.—Brighter prospects for Jewish colonization in Bureya (Bira-Bidzhan) undertaken by the Ozet, Jewish society for land settlement, were seen in the reports coming from that district.

JUDGE JACOB S. STRAHL FETED IN JERUSALEM

Jerusalem, Aug. 16. — A dinner in honor of Judge Jacob S. Strahl of the New York Municipal Court, president of the Judea Life Insurance Company, was given here last night, presided over by Col. Frederick H. Kisch, member of the Jerusalem Zionist Executive.

Among the speakers were Norman Bentwich, Palestine Attorney General, Dr. Thon who spoke on behalf of the Vaad Leumi, National Council of Palestine Jews, and Mr. Merchas for the Jerusalem community.

The name of Judge Strahl was inscribed in the golden book of the Jewish National Fund. Messages were received from the mayor, the chief justice and the governor. It was stated that the Judea has 2300 policy holders in Palestine.

He sees good possibilities for agriculture, including rice plantations, and also for fisheries. He stated that he believes a plan to settle 60,000 Jews in the territory within the next five years would be feasible.

The governmental department and the society sponsoring the project have decided that 400 transmigrants will be permitted to proceed to Bureya in the fall.

HUNGARY PLANS NUMERUS CLAUSUS AGAINST JEWISH ATTORNEYS AT BAR

Limitations for Medical Men and
and Other Professions to Follow

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Budapest, Aug. 16.—Introduction of a numerus clausus against Jewish attorneys at the Hungarian bar is now being planned by the government, it was stated here on good authority. Steps for the introduction of this limitation are to be taken in the fall by the authorities, notwithstanding the protest of the association of Hungarian lawyers.

If put into effect this numerus clausus would affect a great number of Jewish jurists as seldom, if ever, is a Jew appointed to the bench.

The liberal press commenting upon the latest device of the government, expresses the fear that the limitation will be extended to the medical and other professions, driving the class of Jewish intellectuals into a situation of despair.

TO PLANT FOREST IN MEMORY OF POGROM VICTIMS

Jerusalem, Aug. 16.—The plantation of a forest in memory of the victims of the Ukraine pogroms is to be undertaken here.

Palestine residents who came from the Ukraine and the Jewish National Fund are considering the plan for such a memorial.

JEWISH GIRL ESTABLISHED
RECORD AT OLYMPIC GAMES

(J. T. A. Mail Service)

Amsterdam, Aug. 4.—Miss Fannie Rosenfeld, a Jewish girl from Canada, created a world speed record in winning the 400 metres relay race at the Olympic Games here.

Montreal, Aug. 12.—Commenting on the accomplishments of Jewish athletes at the Olympic Games, the "Jewish Eagle" of Montreal writes:

"The classic Olympic Games have just ended their Amsterdam meet. For the first time women participated in these international contests, and Canadian women have emerged the victors, having gained more first places than any other national team. Canadian Jewry had its able representative in the victorious ladies' team in the athletic person of Miss Fannie Rosenfeld of Toronto, an exceptionally fine all-round sportswoman, who appears to have failed to have captured the hundred-metre final by a hair's breadth.

"The Canadian men, though they did not gain quite the same distinction as the women, did notably well, and helped to maintain the reputation of Canada in the field of sports.

"The Olympic Games are a splendid institution that serves in its own way to bring together the different nationalities of the world, and help to create a broader sympathy amongst them. Instances sometimes occur that are not entirely pleasant. Petty jealousies are sometimes stirred up. But these are soon enough forgotten.

"National jealousies should be sublimated by international contests of this peaceful character only."

CO-OPERATION POLICY
AMONG WOMEN'S GROUPS

The movement for cooperation among local Jewish Women's organizations made tremendous strides during the past year, it was declared in a statement issued by Mrs. Theodore Mack of Fort Worth, Texas, National Chairman of the Department of Community Cooperation of the Council of Jewish Women. Associations of Jewish women's organizations have been established in the cities of Hartford, Connecticut; Stamford, Connecticut; Detroit, Michigan; Kansas City, Missouri; New Brunswick, New Jersey; North Shore Long Island; Rochester Staten Island, and Yonkers, New York; Providence, Rhode Island; Charleston, South Carolina; and Tacoma, Washington.

Approximately 60 cities have already established such local associations which have been fostered by Council Sections through their Committees on Community Cooperation. Jewish women's organizations are beginning to realize the advantages to be gained through the elimination of duplication in activities and of conflicts in dates for events and meetings, Mrs. Mack stated.

FUCHS, CHIEF RABBI OF
LUXEMBOURG, DIES

Berlin, Aug. 3.—Dr. Samuel Fuchs, Rabbi of the Duchy of Luxembourg, died at Luxembourg at the age of 52.

Dr. Fuchs was born in Hungary, in a section of the country now belonging to Czechoslovakia. He studied at Budapest University and the Budapest Rabbinical Seminary, and afterwards at Berlin University and the Berlin High School for the Study of Judaism. He was a Rabbi of Luxembourg for a quarter of a century, and was held in high esteem by the entire population. In addition to the representatives of the Jewish community, the funeral was attended by representatives of the Grand Ducal Family and the Government, the Commander of the Army, the Mayor and many members of the Chamber and the City Council.

VATICAN ORGAN SEES "JEWISH
INFLUENCE" IN MEXICO

Despatches from Rome quote the comment of the "Osservatore Romano," official organ of the Vatican, on the Mexican situation.

The Osservatore says that President Calles chose as Home Minister "one of the most cunning mystifiers of the revolutionary movement," and as Foreign Minister a "Protestant Jew who opened the gates in the most barefaced fashion to the immigration of his coreligionaries."

SEES SPORT ASSOCIATIONS
AS GOODWILL MEDIUM

Friendly competition of men of all creeds in sports makes for better understanding, states the Pittsburgh "Jewish Criterion," in an editorial in its current issue headed "A Good-will Medium."

"We were interested in the amateur and professional golf games played by contestants for the championship of Western Pennsylvania at the Westmoreland Country Club this week, from purely a Jewish standpoint," the paper writes. "Discussion of athletic supremacy belongs more properly in other mediums. But what impresses us is that, through just such coming together of men from all walks of life, men of all creeds in friendly competition, makes for a better understanding of each other. It's really a good-will medium which, if elaborated, is sure to be beneficial to the social relationships of Jew and non-Jew."

"It is unfortunately true that only on the rarest occasions do we meet with our neighbors of other faiths outside of business hours. We may have a business associate with whom we are friendly enough to spend some time in a social way, but generally the rule obtains that Jew and Gentile take different paths when their business desks are closed for the day.

"So the Westmoreland Country Club does, perhaps unknowingly, render a distinct service outside of its contributions to the athletic life of our community. And speaking quite frankly, we are glad, having in mind the subject under discussion, that the Westmoreland is a club of such excellent standing and reputation, and conducted on such splendid sportsmanship lines. The president of the club, Chester H. Lehman, has done much to place the club in its present high position among the country clubs of this section of the state. And it was no small compliment to his standing and to his personality that he was chosen as president of the Western Pennsylvania Golf Association. Men of this type and clubs of this type do become good-will ambassadors to our neighbors.

"Perhaps as time goes on and our friends get to know us better, then Pittsburgh will not be so completely narrow and intolerant in its attitude towards the representative Jews of the city in the matter of social intercourse. Every time we think of the policy of the exclusion of all Jews from the University Club, we are more convinced that the name 'University' should not be permitted to be used by a group of men so completely intolerant and prejudiced. But even they may in time come to see light and realize their responsibility in the premises," the editorial concludes.

EMES' CHARGES SOVIET WITH SABOTAGING THE YIDDISH LANGUAGE

Writer Cites Instances in Towns Where 50% of Population is Jewish

Moscow, Aug. 16. — The Yiddish language is sabotaged by the Soviet authorities, charges a writer in the "Emes," Moscow Yiddish Communist daily. The writer, Matz, cites instances in Nevel, Velizh and other towns in the Vitebsk district where over fifty percent of the population is Jewish.

Local officials disregard decisions of the communal Soviets, Yiddish is not used in the government offices, Jews speaking Yiddish are ignored. Notices that Yiddish is permitted were removed by the Velizh authorities. A woman who was employed to help Yiddish speaking Jews, admitted that she did not understand the language.

No books in Yiddish, nor the "Emes," are permitted in the Velizh library, the writer states. These conditions are not merely local, he writes, believing the situation to be no better in the Ukraine and White Russia.

The article concludes with a charge against the Soviet authorities and the Committee for the National Minorities of neglecting their duty.

Smolensk, Aug. 16.—A synagogue here has been converted into a workmen's club. The change was made at the insistence of the Jewish Communists.

CARLSBAD RABBI CELEBRATES FORTY YEARS AT POST

Prague, Aug. 16.—The fortieth anniversary of his services as Rabbi of Carlsbad was observed yesterday by Dr. Ignaz Ziegler.

Dr. Ziegler was born in Also-Kubin in Hungary in September 1861 and was educated at Budapest University and the Budapest Rabbinical Seminary. Immediately after his graduation he was called to the Rabbinate of Carlsbad, a post which he still holds. Through his efforts, the Carlsbad Hospital was established, which provides food, shelter and medical treatment for poor Jews who come to Carlsbad for treatment. He was also responsible for the foundation of the Jewish Home for the Aged, which is to be opened in a few days. He is the author of a number of works, including the "History of Judaism," "Religious Disputations in the Middle Ages," "Spiritual Religion and Jewish Religious Law," "Romain Rolland and Judaism" etc.

Mrs. Esther V. Greenfield, mother of Alfred M. Greenfield and a resident of Philadelphia for forty-two years, died Wednesday in her summer home in Atlantic City, at the age of 70 years. She survived her husband, Jacob Greenfield by less than four months.

J.D.B. NEWS LETTER

Resent Appeal of Hungarian Leaders to Jewish Communities to Further Hungary's Irredenta Movement

(By our Vienna Correspondent)

Vienna, Aug. 6. — If you did not know what a difficult struggle Hungarian Jewry must continually wage for simple equality of civil rights, one would have to consider the newest political adventures of official Jewish organizations and prominent Jewish personages as a symptom of well-being, of carefree luxury. This is the comment in Jewish circles in many of Hungary's neighboring countries where the Jewish communities have been placed in a most embarrassing position by the action of some Hungarian Jewish leaders.

A person with ordinary common sense cannot grasp at all the constant hyper-patriotic activities of the Jewish elements in Hungary who want to harness the Jews of the entire world to the service of the Hungarian Irredenta, and are ready to drag into a miserable position approximately two million Jews of Roumania, Czechoslovakia, and Yugoslavia. They are willing to do this as long as they can carry favor with several Magyar noblemen who do not care if the whole world is again drawn into war, as long as they can enlarge the present frontiers of Hungary by ten or twenty kilometers.

At the same time, when Parliament discussed a scandalously anti-Semitic bill against Jewish landholders and even against the leasing of land by Jews, the Federation of Jewish Communities sent out a circular to the larger Jewish communities the world over, urging them to support with the great "Jewish world influence" the struggle of Hungarian Jewry for the revision of the Trianon Peace Treaty and for the restoration of Greater Hungary in its pre-war boundaries. One cannot imagine a greater tragedy. The Jews of Budapest demand of the Jewish communities of Belgrade, Prague and Bucharest that they become traitors to their own countries and help to wrest provinces from their present fatherlands in order to enlarge Hungary.

There are to be found in this Hungarian Jewry some religious Jews who are supporting the Hungarian Irredenta movement through the political misuse of the Jewish religion. They are printing prayer books and pentateuchs with especial prayers for the restoration of Greater Hungary by means of cutting off Slovakia from the Czech territory.

These prayerbooks are sold and distributed gratis among the naive Jewish

POLISH GOVERNMENT GIVES LEGAL STATUS TO 315 JEWISH LOAN SOCIETIES

Average of Loans Issued Monthly is 14,000

Legal status has been granted by the Polish government to the greater part of the Jewish free loan societies established through the help of the Joint Distribution Committee. A report received by David A. Brown, National Chairman of the United Jewish Campaign, from Dr. Bernhard Kahn, European Director of the Joint Distribution Committee, indicates that out of the total number of 520 Gemilath Chesed Kassas, loan societies, 315 have so far been "legalized." Of this number 210 are in Congress, Poland; 58 in the district of Vilna; 45 in Western Galicia and 2 in Eastern Galicia.

In most instances the Government has placed no obstacles in the way of any of these societies becoming legalized. Only in the former Russian provinces of Podolia and Volynia where portions of the Jewish population have not yet been naturalized, the authorities have requested that a provision be embodied in the constitutions of these societies limiting the right to receive loans to citizens only. This difficulty has now been overcome and the loan societies are functioning in these provinces also.

According to the figures reported, the average monthly number of loans issued by these kassas throughout Poland was about 14,000; the loans amounting to about 1,400,000 Polish zlotys. The loans repaid in the same period amounted to about 1,300,000, thereby resulting in a monthly deficit of 100,000 zlotys which these kassas have had to face. Despite the support which some of these institutions have won from the Government and from the Jewish communities themselves they are, the report stated, for the present at least, not in a position to meet their requirements and to work profitably and develop normally without some aid from outside sources, such as the Joint Distribution Committee advances.

333 JEWISH IMMIGRANTS ARRIVED IN CANADA IN JULY

Montreal, Aug. 16.—The Jewish Immigrant Aid Society of Canada met 41 boats which arrived at the ports of Halifax and Quebec during the month of July according to the Society's report. These boats brought 15,352 immigrants of whom 333 were Jews.

The Jewish immigrants were destined to provinces as follows: Quebec 104, Ontario 144, New Brunswick 5, Manitoba 46, Saskatchewan 23, British Columbia 7, Alberta 3 and Nova Scotia 1.

There were two detentions. They were later admitted through the intervention of the legal aid department of the Society.

populations of small Slovakian towns,
without thought of the terrible dis-
asters that can be brought upon the
Slovakian Jewry, by making the Jews
of the entire country suspected of
treason.

It is true that the Hungarian Jews
are Magyarized and strongly patriotic.
No one would possibly demand of the
Hungarian Jews that they weaken
their patriotism, but they must remem-
ber that the Czechoslovakian Jews have
at least as many reasons for being
good patriots in their own countries,
as the Jews of Hungary, is their ar-
gument. They must know that there
must be certain limits even to the
most ardent patriotism, and that they
have a special duty of exercising a cer-
tain amount of reserve because of the
much larger Jewish communities in
Hungary's neighboring countries. One
should not play with fire at the ex-
pense of more than two million Jews,
towards whom the Hungarian Jews
should have at least one one-thousandth
of the spirit of sympathy which they
have toward their Christian fellow-cit-
izens in Hungary, the Czechoslovakian
Jews declare.

If the fine feeling of patriotism on
the part the Hungarian Jews opposed
the readiness of Jewish organizations
of other countries to help them in fight-
ing against the numerus clausus, why
shouldn't the civic loyalty at least of
Czechoslovakian Jewry rebel against
the suspicion of high treason? It is
not believable, moreover, that the Jews
of Hungary will not feel grieved when
this activity will develop a terrible
movement of anti-Semitism in Czechos-
lovakia, or Jugo-Slavia, where the
Jewish population will have to pay with
sacrifices of human lives and property
for a thoughtless propaganda of their
own brothers across the border. It is
foolish and a mere theatrical effect,
because the entire question is one of
the most intricate international terri-
torial problems, and one upon which the
Jewish community can have no influ-
ence of any kind.

It has been proved, moreover, that
this egocentric and extravagant policy
of responsible Jewish circles of Hun-
gary will also not save Hungarian
Jewry from official and non-official
anti-Semitism in Hungary. This is
shown by the series of new anti-Semi-
tic laws introduced by the government
and parliament with the purpose of en-
tirely forcing the Hungarian Jewry
out of all social and economic positions
in the country, until they will have to
follow the fine advice of Prime Min-
ister Count Bethlen, namely, mass im-
migration from Hungary into other
countries.

The irony of the Jewish lot in Hun-
gary goes still further, however. A
group of Jewish politicians under the
leadership of the family of the late
Jewish Minister of Justice Vaszonyi
has begun to create a strong mono-
archistic movement among the Jewish
population of Hungary. This Jewish
group intends to favor Hungary and
the world with the restoration of the
Hapsburg monarchy. Should such a
movement be born on the shoulders of
Hungarian Jewry? Has the Jewish
population of Hungary no other cares
to worry about?

Immigration to Canada for June, 1928,
totalled 20,303, as compared with 15,055 for
June a year ago, an increase of twelve per-
cent. For the three months April, May and
June of this year, immigration amounted to
70,927. The principal sources were British
23,695, and United States 9,343. Belgium con-
tributed 658, Denmark, 1,517, Holland 849,
Finland 1,201, France 272, Germany 5,812,
Norway 1,092, Sweden 1,554, Switzerland 229,
all other countries 24,405.

During June 3,526 Canadians who had gone
to the United States intending to live there
permanently returned to Canada, declaring
their intention of remaining in this country.
