ARABS MAKE FIRST-PUBLIC ALLEGATIONS THAT JEWS DELIBERATELY FOMENTED AUGUST RIOTS; CHARGE EXECUTIVE SECRETLY INSTRUCTED FROM ZURICH

Arab Council Dignities Hitherto Underground Rumored by Charging Conspiracy in Questioning Braude, Who is Subject to Grilling Examination by Arab and Government Counsels

Jerusalem, Dec. 11.—The first public allegation of a Jewish conspiracy in connection with the recent events in Palestine to be made by the Arabs, came like a bomb-shell today at the Commission's hearings when Auni, one of the Arab counsel, asked in the course of the second day's cross-examination of Isaiiah Braude, the first Jewish witness, "isn't it a fact that you received secret instructions from the Zurich Conference, encouraging you to organize demonstrations in the country for the purpose of creating the events?"

While such accusations had been made by the Arabs from time to time, especially in the Arab press, this was the first time that such a charge had been dignified by a public hearing. It had been previously hinted that the Jews encouraged the disturbances in order to create sympathy that would facilitate the collection of money for Palestine.

Braude, who was a member of the temporary Zionist Executive, while the Congress was attending, the Zionist Executive at Zurich last Summer, denied the allegations and declared them "absolutely ridiculous," adding that "no intelligent person believes such a story." Auni tried to show that the Arabs had come to Jerusalem on August 23, armed with sticks and knives, because they had been frightened by the acts of the Jews at Mizrahi's funeral. In support of this, he read a cable from the Zionist Executive to Zurich which read "the Arabs are afraid and excited." Braude explained this as being a general reference and not applying to the excitement attendant on the funeral. He pointed out that he had warned Acting High Commissioner H. C. Luke that attacks were expected by the Arabs on the Jews, not by the Jews on the Arabs.

Arabs Instigated Riots

The witness charged that "the Arab leaders instigated the disturbances on political grounds and they culminated in riots." Commissioner Hopkins then asked Auni did he instigate. Braude said the benefit of no one else but the Moslem Supreme Council. Chairman Shaw asked Braude whether he meant "such things as the alleged Auni's letter to the villages, which

was not found until after the riots." Braude said that "before the riots I saw reports in the papers that such letters had been circulated in Lifta."

By his questions, Auni apparently tried to prove that Braude, as the acting head of the Zionist Executive, was responsible for the mass meeting in Tel Aviv, and he cited the words "Jewish state," which were used in the resolutions adopted at Tel Aviv, to indicate the ambitions of the Jews. Referring to these words, Braude explained that "these youths were not within the Zionist influence and had disobeyed repeated pronouncements from the Zionist offices against individual action." Catching at this point, Auni asked, "then the Zionist influence does not extend to many tens of thousands of Jews in Palestine?" The whole meeting was "childish and probably the imaginative youth acting as secretary wrote the words 'Jewish

ENGLAND WILL COMPENSATE POLISH CITIZENS FOR LOSSES IN PALESTINE DISTURBANCES

Warsaw, Dec. 11.—The British government has agreed to compensate Polish citizens for personal and property damages suffered in the Palestine riots. It is understood that this agreement is the result of the intervention of the Polish ambassador to England, Contance Skirmunt. In replying to a letter of M. Skirmunt, the British government declares that the Palestine government is compensating Polish citizens and asks that those who suffered damages submit their compensation claims.

RABBI KOOK TO TESTIFY IN PRIVATE; COUNSEL PRESENT, PRESS BARRED

Jerusalem, Dec. 11.—It is stated here that Chief Rabbi Abraham Kook will give his evidence before the Inquiry Commission in the privacy of his own house in the presence of counsel for the Government, Jews and Arabs, and with the press barred.

In various circles here it had been reported that Rabbi Kook might testify publicly, and it was declared that Sir Boyd Merriman, chief of the Jewish counsel, had urged him to do so.

Anti-Semitism, Outgrowth of Post-War Depression, Growing Fast in Germany, Says Leader of German-Jewish Verein

Ernst Wallach Gives Illuminating Figures on Growth of Influence and Propaganda of Hitlerites, Whose Political Strength, He Says, Is a Menace; National Socialists Created Atmosphere of Jew-Hatred, Which Is Responsible for Anti-Semitic Feeling in Germany

Anti-Semitism and Nationalism, an outgrowth of the disaffection and hatred emanating from the post-war economic depression, must be reckoned upon as a growing factor in German political and social life, declared Ernst Wallach, vice-president of the Central Association of German-Jewish Citizens, an organization of 60,000 members, in an interview with the Jewish Telegraphic Agency yesterday. Mr. Wallach, who is also a member of the board of the College for the Science of Judaism in Berlin, is now in this country.

Pointing out that the recent successes of the Right political parties, of which the National Socialist Labor Party is the most important, can no longer be overlooked, especially since their program includes militant anti-Semitism, Mr. Wallach, in speaking of the extent and political strength of the National Socialists, declared that "the unrowned king of that party, Adolf Hitler, can point with pride to its unusual growth. In 1920 his party had

only one local group with 64 members, while in 1928 it had 1,200 local groups with more than 100,000 members. In the Reichstag elections his party polled nearly 800,000 votes, but that this number is no real indication of its strength is evident from the fact that in the Prussian municipal elections alone it received more than 500,000 votes. This huge increase in vote accompanied by an increase in propaganda."

Asked about the intensity of this propaganda, Mr. Wallach said that "in 1928 there had been about 20,000 meetings addressed by 300 speakers. In October of this year more than 2,000 meetings were held. Jews are barred from these meetings, in which a military atmosphere prevails. The party has an important organ in the Munich 'Volkische Beobachter,' which is read all over Germany. In addition the National Socialists have five other daily papers, seven weeklies, one illustrated paper, seven other periodicals.

Egyptian Arab Press Tones Down Anti-Jewish Stories

Cairo, Dec. 11.—Although the Arab press in Egypt has toned down considerably its inflammatory anti-Jewish articles, due probably to government influence, the pro-Arab papers still utilize every opportunity for anti-Jewish incitement. Recently the "Alah-fan," in publishing the pictures of the two Chalutzim, Davidco and Levine, remarked that "these Zionists were caught smuggling ammunition, machine guns, grenades and rifles from Beirut to Haifa."

GET DEED TO PALESTINE LAND OF SOUTH AFRICAN ZIONISTS

Jerusalem, Dec. 11.—The Jewish National Fund has received the deed to the first cession of 12,000 dunams of land in the area purchased with funds raised by South African Zionists who have undertaken to raise \$385,000 within three years for land purchase. The land is situated in the plantation zone that is suitable for intensive cultivation.

JEW FOR LAND COMMISSAR

Moscow, Dec. 11.—A Jew, Yakovlev, whose Jewish name is Jacob Epstein, has been appointed Commissar of Land for all Russia. At 33, he has risen to this office from his post as Acting Commissar of Labor and Peasant Incooperation. He is the author of three works on agrarian problems. At one time he was the editor of the peasant paper, "Bednota" and Krestianskaya Gazette.

Jaffa Awards Lighting Contract

Jaffa, Dec. 11.—The contract for Luz lamps for lighting the streets of Jaffa has been awarded by the Jaffa municipality. Jaffa recently cancelled its agreement with the Rutenberg Company and had been troubled by the high bids submitted by gas contractors.

Furnishing of Corpses for Jewish Medical Students Poland; Conference Subject

Government, University and Kehillah
Offer a Confer on Question and
Difficulty May Be Solved
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Warsaw, Dec. 11.—A conference on the problem of supplying Jewish corpses to dissecting rooms of the Polish universities for the anatomical work of the Jewish students was held here yesterday under the chairmanship of the chief of the Educational Department, M. Suchodolsky. Representatives from the Universities of Warsaw, Vilna, Lemberg and Cracow as well as representatives from the Warsaw, Vilna and Cracow Jewish communities were present. The head of the Jewish Hospital in Lemberg also attended.

Suchodolsky emphasized the need for regulation with regard to the matter of corpses in order to put an end to the present undesirable incidents at the universities which arise because the Christian students resent the use of Christian corpses by the Jewish students. The anti-Semitic Professor Lode demanded that the Jewish students supply Jewish corpses, since this was not in violation of any Jewish religious precept. M. Vogodsky, representing the Jewish community of Vilna, in a long speech declared that the furnishing of corpses was not the concern of the students but rather of the government and demanded the legal regulation of the matter. A number of other Polish professors agreed with Lot. M. Farbstein of the Warsaw Jewish community reported to the conference a decision of the rabbis and the kehillah by which Jewish corpses can be provided from those dying in the hospitals and whose bodies are not claimed by relatives within 48 hours. Suchodolsky, in a closing speech, expressed satisfaction with the conference proceedings and declared himself convinced that the solution to the problem of the corpses lay only in special government regulation. Other conferences are to be held shortly.

New York Zionists Will Honor Late Dr. Leon Reich Tonight

A memorial service to honor the memory of Dr. Leon Reich, member of the Polish Parliament and foremost Polish Zionist leader, who died last week, will be held tonight at the Jewish Institute of Religion, under the auspices of the New York Zionist Region.

Eulogies on the deceased, who was considered one of the foremost figures in European Jewish life, will be delivered by Dr. Shmarya Levin, Dr. S. Margoshes, editor of "The Day," Z. H. Masliansky, Bernard Semel, and Dr. Joseph Tenenbaum. Jonah J. Goldstein, president of the New York Zionist Region, will preside, and Cantor Joseph Rosenblatt will chant the traditional Hebrew prayer for the dead.

Limit Private Needs, But Not Communal Obligations, Prof. Einstein Tells German Jews

Berlin, Dec. 11.—Limit your private needs, but do not, because of economic depression, save by neglecting your communal obligations, was the gist of an appeal addressed by Dr. Albert Einstein in an address to a gathering of notable Jewish leaders, arranged by the Hilfsverein Deutscher Juden.

"We Jews," declared Dr. Einstein, "have always been a threatened minority. Therefore the individual is threatened economically by attempts to crowd him out of his profession, threatened morally because of isolation. Only Jewish solidarity can prevail against this. We require a systematically working organization, as, for example, the Hilfsverein is, occupying a high position of social worth in the past as well as in the present."

The gathering was presided over by James Simon, president of the Hilfsverein.

Attorney-General Bentwich's Appeal for a More Severe Sentence for Jew Denied

Jerusalem, Dec. 11.—Sentence of Leon Hurlitz, a Jew, for retaining his revolver during the attack on the Sharchessed quarter was upheld by the Court of Appeal yesterday. Hurlitz was originally fined \$15. The case was appealed by Attorney-General Norman Bentwich, who urged a more severe sentence. The Court of Appeal also reduced the 15-year sentences imposed on twelve Safed Arabs, charged with burning a Jewish house, to five years. Jacob Hassun, a Jew, charged with looting the Arab tax office during the riots of last August, was acquitted.

NOTED GERMAN-JEWISH PHILOSOPHER DIES

Frankfort-on-Main, Dec. 11.—Franz Rosenzweig, Jewish philosopher, died today at the age of 45. He was the translator of the works of the Hebrew poet Yehuda Halevi, and together with Martin Buber created the famous modern Bible translation in Germany. A physical defect prevented him from accepting a call to Frankfort University in 1922 as professor of religious science.

GERMAN-AMERICAN CATHOLIC, FRIEND OF JEWS, DIES

Vienna, Dec. 11.—Anton Wedl, a well-known German-American resident of New York, died here today in the Wiener Sanatorium. Mr. Wedl was a notable friend of the Jews and was an important supporter of Austrian Jewish writers, despite the fact that he was an orthodox Catholic. The Vienna papers recall the fact that he was an intimate friend of the former Chief Rabbi Chajes.

state," but we paid no attention to the whole thing," said Braude.

"Commissioner Hopkins interposed: 'But they unfurled the flag and sang Hatikvah at the Wall. This was consistent with a Jewish state attitude, and while it was admittedly not official, it nevertheless shows the state of the public mind.' In answer Braude asserted that "their excitement led them into mistakes." Chairman Shaw then said that "Zurich wired you to dampen down the excitement. The words 'dampen down' are used with regard to a fire that one wants to reawaken later." Braude's answer to this was "It never was our intention to stir the fire. I kept informing them of the excitement and they said 'dampen it.'" At this point, Commissioner Snell helped Braude by pointing out that the "dampening attitude" of the Zionists extended over a long period of time and that the Zionist Executive had always objected to public demonstrations.

Charges Braude Remiss

Auni charged that Braude had been remiss in his duty by failing to officially deny the resolutions adopted at Tel Aviv, but Braude declared that "we do not deny one percent of the statements appearing in the press. This was a childish matter." The Arab lawyer, continuing on this point, declared that "a meeting of ten thousand people, asking for the establishment of a Jewish state, is a danger to public security. If ten thousand Arabs passed resolutions demanding that the Jews be thrown into the sea, would that be called a childish rumor?"

To this Braude replied "it would be the duty of the Moslem leaders to call such a resolution to the attention of the government, as we did." Auni charged that resolutions like those adopted at Tel Aviv would have been impossible before the issuance of the Balfour Declaration, while Braude said that "there is nothing to prevent people from meeting any time and anywhere, and passing resolutions."

Auni then turned to a discussion of a cable sent to London on September 1 concerning the meeting of Horowitz, one of the members of the temporary Zionist Executive, with Luke and the Arab notables in Luke's house. Auni charged that Horowitz, in describing this meeting, where the Arabs asked that the Jews be disarmed, had called the notables a "band of murderers and traitors."

Preedy, government counsel, then took up the questioning, and suggested that Braude had overstepped his authority during the absence of the Zionist Executive. He showed that Harry Sacher's correspondence over the Wailing Wall question had not referred to any breach of the status quo, whereas Braude took it upon himself to publicly point out three infringements

of the status quo in his communique of July 24. Defending himself on this point, Braude declared: "I believe that the Zionist Executive also regarded and still regards these as infringements, although Sacher had not stated so in his letter of July but had used the words 'interference with existing rights.' I had to make a public statement due to the agitation in the press and I could not wait for instructions. I submitted to Mills a communique saying that the Zionist Executive would point out to the government the departure from the status quo, and Mills agreed to its publication."

Preedy Quotes "Davar"

Referring to Braude's efforts to quiet the press, Preedy began to read an article that appeared in the "Davar" on August 1, in which it referred to the biting insult to the Jewish nation and demanded that the Jewish community protest. "Do you call that a quieting article?" demanded Preedy. Braude erased the effect of Preedy's reading by asking him to read the rest of the article, which went on to demand that the Jews act through existing institutions. "Let not private individuals deal with this matter. If a group of lunatics write and publish militant articles daily in the papers, let no one listen to these destructive voices."

Government Counsel Preedy grilled Braude for four hours. The cross-examination was still unfinished when the session closed. In the seven weeks that the Commission has been taking testimony, Preedy has never been as tenacious and belligerent as he was in attempting on the one hand to draw from the witness an admission that the Jews were responsible for the riots and on the other hand to defend the government against the charges of Merriman, counsel for the Jewish side, that the British Government had failed to heed the most apparent warnings of impending trouble and had failed to take adequate precautions. Preedy had been somewhat indifferent and lackadaisical throughout the taking of the Arabs' testimony, which had been definitely unfavorable to the government. He did his best, however, to assail Braude's credibility and to save the honor of the British administration and the Palestine police.

Says Press Cooperated

Preedy tried to get Braude to contradict his former statement that the "Davar" and the "H'Aretz" cooperated with the Jewish authorities to check agitation for two weeks preceding the outbreaks, while the "Doar Hayom" remained unamenable to national discipline. He succeeded only in marshalling translations of articles tending to discredit the Government because it did not recognize the sanctity of the Wailing Wall for the Jews, and warning the Jews against "the smell of fire

Jews Brought \$225,000,000 Into Palestine Declares Hooften as Merriman Quotes Facts, Figures

Witness Says New Development of Country Makes Temporary Dislocation Inevitable, Jews or No Jews

Jerusalem, Dec. 11—The Jews have brought \$225,000,000 into Palestine, declared Sigfried Hooften, general manager of the Anglo-Palestine Company, and the first Zionist witness called by Sir Boyd Merriman to repel the Arab frontal attack, at the morning session of the Inquiry Commission today. Merriman quickly disposed of the events leading up to the riots so far as Hooften, a temporary advisory member of the Zionist Executive, was concerned, and used the last half hour of the morning's sitting to plunge into essential facts and figures.

The Arab counsel stressed at the statement by Hooften that the Arab population had reaped great benefits from the Jewish immigration. Hooften explained that Jews or no Jews after the World War, Palestine entered into a new stage of development and passed from extensive to intensive cultivation. Dislocation of parts of the population was inevitable, he claimed, where cultivation replaced grazing. Hooften admitted that a peculiarity of the country was that the Jews who are bringing prosperity are instrumental in this temporary dislocation.

Hooften pointed out that the Jews had brought \$225,000,000 into the country, of which the Jewish National Fund had contributed \$33,500,000. He declared that the Arabs had materially benefited, since much of this Jewish money had passed into the Arab economic system through the Jews paying for rural and urban lands, for goods, services and rent. As an example of what he meant, Hooften said that the annual rent bill of the Jews of Haifa to Arab landlords reached \$275,000.

coming out of the crevices of the Wall." These articles also abused the Zionist Executive for "knuckling" to the Government. Preedy's point in regard to the articles was that it was dangerous for the public peace to discredit the government. Braude, however, said he did not mind the attacks on the Zionist Executive or even on the government, so long as the Jewish press did not preach violence as the Arab press was doing. Braude admitted that the "Doar Hayom" tried to force the hand of the Executive through articles calling for action regarding the Wailing Wall. He refused to admit, however, that it was anybody's intention to enable the Zurich here in order to enable the Zurich Congress to exert pressure with the London authorities about the Wall. Preedy tried to make the witness admit that the general tenor in the Jewish press was that the Government should have acted regarding the Wall regardless of consequences, even if it

were necessary to expropriate the pavement.

Reading an article by Prof. Klausner in the "Palestine Weekly," and also Ben-Avi's proposal to divide Jerusalem into three "national cities" Jewish, Moslem and Christian, the Government counsel remarked as his opinion that some Jews claimed the Wailing Wall itself.

Says Police Beat Jews

The witness denied that there was an unusual influx of Jews to Jerusalem at Tisha B'Ab time and belittled the previously mentioned mass meeting at Tel Aviv. He said he saw the raising of the Zionist flag at the Wailing Wall, but heard no shouts from the Jews such as "the Wailing Wall is ours; shame to the government and all who desecrate our Holy Places," as officially reported. He agreed with Preedy that the speaker at the Wall should have been arrested, but adhered to his original statement that British police beat Jews near the post office while charging through the crowd with batons, after the funeral of the Mizrachi boy. They did this, he said, "without pity or discretion."

Braude refused to agree that anyone had made any attempt to turn the procession away from the course chosen. Preedy asked him if he knew that one of the policemen whom the Jews had accused of brutality had been transferred for his own safety because the authorities had feared the Jews would "get him." The witness replied that he had specifically named one constable, but that all were guilty of unnecessary brutality.

The session was closed as Preedy was cross-examining Braude as to whether the Zionists were justified in their charge that the Government had not heeded warnings of impending trouble. It was brought out that the day before the outbreak, Acting High Commissioner Luke received a warning. A friendly Arab had warned his Jewish neighbor of impending trouble and had invited the latter to seek shelter in his house. "What should the Government have done?" queried Betterton, member of the Commission.

"I don't know what the Government did," replied Braude. "I think the results showed that insufficient precaution was taken. I believe more police should have been stationed in the vicinity. More searches should have been made in an effort to disarm the crowd, and the policemen should have been armed."

Preedy will continue his cross-examination of Braude today.

SAYS ANTI-SEMITISM IS GROWING IN GERMANY. HITLERITES MENACE JEWS

and they publish over 400,000 books and pamphlets."

From some of Mr. Wallach's statements it appears that even foreign policies in Germany are influenced by the Hitlerites, who while they are not alone in opposing the Young Plan, "do play the leading role in this propaganda. In addition to this influence on external affairs, the National Socialist movement, while not directly responsible for, has at least created, the atmosphere of Jew-hatred which has had a good deal to do with the vandalism in connection with the desecration of 76 Jewish cemeteries in Germany."

In explanation of why the "Voelkische" ideas have found such wide acceptance among the German people, Mr. Wallach says "the main thing to blame is the bad economic condition. The post-war depression, together with the almost unbearable tax burden, have hit certain sections of the middle class unusually hard. On this soil of dissatisfaction, hatred and envy grow easily and will seek any sort of outlet. For many this outlet is radicalism and anti-Semitism."

Mr. Wallach's organization has made intensive efforts to apprehend the culprits guilty of cemetery violation and was instrumental in getting evidence to refute slander against the Jewish religion made by the editor of one of the Hitlerite organs, a slander which led to the famous "Talmud trial."

He concluded his interview with a number of remarks explaining how the Central Association of German-Hellenic Citizens is combating the Hitlerites. "We have local groups in more than 3,500 places in Germany.

In the last election we fought both anti-Semitism and radicalism by means of pamphlets, placards and election sheets, but in normal times, too, we conduct a propaganda of enlightenment among various groups. One hundred thousand copies of our "Central Verein Zeitung" were distributed throughout Germany. We not only make efforts to repulse anti-Jewish attacks, but we devote ourselves to the dissemination of a propaganda of enlightenment in order to rid the German body politic of the poison of Jew-hatred. As a result of our work we are in perhaps a better position than one would imagine to stem the tide of Jew-hatred. Our sincerest wish is to disseminate among the masses of Germans ideas of people and state, or religion and fatherland, as they were taught by the greatest liberal and humanitarian personalities of all nations of all times. And because of this it is all the more to be regretted that our financial resources are so limited. Since anti-Semitism everywhere receives its spiritual armor from Germany, it is the duty of world Jewry to help us in our fight against anti-Semitism, for in the last analysis we are fighting for the honor of Judaism."

Rabbi Klepfisch Dead at 75
